LESSON AIM

- GG members will persevere through persecution because of God's promises found in His Word.
- GG members will be vigilant against false teaching by diligently studying God's Word.

INTRODUCTION

God used the Reformation to take the Church out of what many termed "the Dark Ages," where erroneous tradition and false teaching reigned. The Baptist movement was greatly blessed and influenced by the Reformation. One of its influences was the Five Solas, which formed the core of the Reformation's beliefs. Sola Scriptura, translated as Scripture alone, is the doctrine teaching that Scripture alone is the ultimate authority for faith, doctrine, and daily living.

Scripture helps believers overcome obstacles to the Christian life (vv. 12-17)

One truth found in the Bible is that believers will experience persecution and that deception will abound both in the world and in the church community (2 Timothy 3:5). However, the believer who diligently and regularly meditates on God's Word can overcome these obstacles.

- 1. According to Paul, what will people who desire to live a godly life experience?
- 2. Who did Paul contrast with these people? How does Paul describe their behavior?
- 3. What did Paul encourage Timothy to do in light of these?
- 4. What is it about Scripture that sets it apart from all other literature? (cf. 2 Peter 1:20-21) Enumerate the blessings that come from Scripture.
- 5. What are some ways God's Word can help believers overcome persecution and deception?

Application

Spend some time thanking God for providing us with His Word and preserving it throughout the centuries. How are you using this blessing today? How regularly and for how long do you think you should be studying God's Word?


PRAYER ITEM
