The Communicable Attributes of God

The Justice of God: He is Just and He Justifies

Deuteronomy 32:4; Romans 3:25–26

The measure of what is “truly just” finds its source not in society, legal systems, or our own inner sense of right and wrong, but in the very character of God. While the Old Testament lays the foundation for understanding His Justice, the New Testament brings it into sharp focus, revealing it in a stunning display at the Cross.

(Deuteronomy 32:4) God Himself is the Unchanging Standard of Justice.

- God’s Justice is a foundation of His character: “The Rock”, immovable and immutable.
- God’s Justice is perfectly shown in all His works.
- God’s Justice governs all His ways.
- God’s Justice is inseparable from His holiness.

(Romans 3:25–26) God’s Justice was Fulfilled at the Cross.

- God’s Justice requires that sin be punished.
- The Cross displays both God’s Justice and God’s Love:
 - The Cross is the public demonstration of God’s Justice.
 - The Cross is the means of God’s Forgiveness.

The Justice of God shapes how we live.

- Let us trust God’s Justice in our broken world: “*Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says the Lord.*” (Romans 12:19).
- Let us live as people who reflect God’s Justice: Let us do Justice, love mercy, and walk humbly with God (Micah 6:8).
- Let us proclaim the Gospel as God’s just solution for sin, because God has appointed a day to judge the world (Acts 17:30–31).

Final Thoughts

In the end, we see a God who is perfectly just and without any fault. He fully satisfied the demands of His own Justice in Christ, making a way to save sinners without in any way compromising His perfect holiness. Our only fitting response is to worship this just God who, astonishingly, also became our Justifier. ■



The Communicable Attributes of God

Ang Katarungan ng Diyos

Deuteronomy 32:4; Romans 3:25–26

Ang sukat ng tunay na katarungan ay hindi matatagpuan sa lipunan o sa mga sistemang legal ng tao, o sa ating sariling mga pamantayan ng mali at tama, kundi sa likas na katarungan ng Diyos. Habang ipinapakita ng Lumang Tipan ang dapat nating pag-unawa sa Kanyang Katarungan, inilalarawan naman ito ng Bagong Tipan sa walang-salang buhay at pagkamatay ni Kristo Hesus sa krus.

Ang Diyos Mismo ang Di-nagbabagong Pamantayan ng Katarungan (Deuteronomy 32:4).

- Ang katarungan ng Diyos ang pundasyon ng Kanyang kalikasan: “The Rock”, di magagalaw, di nagbabago (v. 4a; Psalm 18:2).
- Ang katarungan ng Diyos ay malinaw na makikita sa Kanyang mga gawa (v. 4b; Psalms 18:30; Matthew 5:48).
- Ang katarungan ng Diyos ang namamahala sa lahat ng Kanyang mga pamamaraan (Daniel 4:37; Revelation 15:3).
- Ang katarungan ng Diyos ay hindi mahihiwalay sa Kanyang kabanalan (Psalm 50:6).

Ang Katarungan ng Diyos ay Natupad ng Ganap sa Krus (Romans 3:25–26).

- Hinihingi ng katarungan ng Diyos na ang Kasalanan ay maparusahan (Romans 1:18; Ephesians 5:6).
- Makikita sa krus ang katarungan at pag-ibig ng Diyos:
 - Sa krus, pinarusahan ng Diyos si Hesus bilang demonstrasyon ng Kanyang katarungan (v. 25; Isaiah 53:4-6).
 - Sa krus, binuksan ng Diyos ang daan para mapatawad ang mga makasalanan (v. 26; 1 John 4:10; Colossians 1:20).

Ang Katarungan ng Diyos Ang Dapat Humuhubog ng Ating Buhay.

- Asahan natin ang katarungan ng Diyos sa isang sirang sanlibutan: “*Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says the Lord.*” (Romans 12:19).
- Ang buhay natin ay dapat sumasalamin ng katarungan ng Diyos: “*...but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?*” (Micah 6:8).
- Ang ebanghelyo ay lagi nating ipahayag na makatarungang solusyon ng Diyos sa kasalanan. Darating ang araw ng Kanyang paghuhusga (Acts 17:31).

Sa huli, mayroon tayong Diyos na ganap na makatarungan at walang kahit anong pagkukulang. Kanyang tinupad ang lahat ng mga hinihingi ng sarili Niyang Katarungan kay Kristo Hesus at sa gayon gumawa Siya ng paraan na iligtas ang mga makasalanan na hindi binabali ang Kanyang ganap na kabanalan. Ang tanging tugon dito ay ang sambahin Siya na ating makatarungang Diyos, na Siya ring Tagapagbigay ng ating pagiging matuwid. ■

God is holy, pure, and just. He rightfully and righteously judges and punishes all sin.

"Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!" (Isaiah 6:3)

"Who will not fear you, O Lord, and glorify your name? For you alone are holy." (Revelation 15:4)

THE CRISIS WE FACE

We all have failed God's standard and face God's righteous judgment.

"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God..." (Romans 3:23)

"For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth." (Romans 1:18)
