Pressing on in Christ

Philippians 3:12–16

Year-end moments make us evaluate our lives and our walk with God. Before we step into 2026, God gives us a word of encouragement. In Philippians 3:12–16, Paul shows us what it means to keep moving forward in the Christian life. He reminds us that we have not yet arrived—but because Christ has made us His own, we are called to press on toward Christlikeness.

I. Our Motivation: Press on Because Christ Made Us His (v. 12)

- A. We press on because we have not yet reached complete Christlike maturity. (v. 12a, Philippians 3:1–11)
“Not that I have already obtained this or am already perfect,”
- B. We press on because Christ has made us His own. (v. 12b, John 1:12)
“but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own.”

Application: As you close 2025, don't measure your worth by your spiritual performance this year. Measure it by Christ's unchanging hold on you. And let it inspire you to grow more in Christlikeness in the coming year.

II. Our Marathon: Press on With Focused Perseverance (vv. 3:13–14, Hebrews 12:1–2a)

- A. We press on by letting go of what is behind. (v. 13a)
“Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind”
- B. We press on by straining forward to what lies ahead (v. 13b)
“and straining forward to what lies ahead,”
- C. We press on by pursuing the goal God has set before us (v. 14, 1 Corinthians 9:24–25)
“I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.”

Application: As 2025 ends, press on with focused perseverance. Let go of past failures or distractions and enter 2026 with a clear, focused plan to grow in Christlikeness.

III. Our Mindset: Press on Together to Spiritual Maturity (vv. 15–16)

- A. We press on by adopting the same Christ-centered mindset (v. 15a)
“Let those of us who are mature think this way,”
- B. We press on by trusting God to correct and guide our understanding (v. 15b)
“and if in anything you think otherwise, God will reveal that also to you.”
- C. We press on by walking faithfully according to what we have already attained (v. 16)
“Only let us hold true to what we have attained.”

Application: As we step into 2026, let us press on **together** with humility, unity, and faithful obedience, growing side by side toward Christlikeness.

Final Thoughts

As we end 2025 and step into a new year, let us do so with confidence. Not that we have arrived, but because Christ has made us His own. And because Christ has made us His, we press on together—with focused perseverance—toward Christlikeness. ■

Pagpapatuloy Kay Kristo Hesus

Philippians 3:12–16

Sa bawa't paglipat ng bagong taon, mayroon tayong kaugalian na ilista ang mga pagbabago na nais natin sa ating buhay — pagbawas ng ating timbang, paghinto ng isang bisyo o masamang nakaugalian, pagkamit ng isang layunin sa ating karera, at marami pang iba. Para sa isang Kristiyano, ang mga ito ay dapat nalampasan na ng mga biyayang kalakip ng ating kaligtasan kay Kristo — pagkamit ng kapatawanan (Ephesians 1:7), pagiging isang bagong nilalang (2 Corinthians 5:17), pagkabuhay na maguli, at pagkakaroon ng tiyak na pagasa (1 Peter 1:3–4). Para kay Pablo ang lahat ay wala ng halaga kumpara sa Kanyang pagkakilala kay Kristo Hesus, at pagkakaroon ng isang katuwiran na mula sa Diyos (Philippians 3:8–11). Dahil siya ay inaring-ganap na ni Kristo, inari na rin niya ang pagpapatuloy kay Kristo, at pagiging katulad Niya, bilang kanyang tanging layunin sa buhay.

1. ANG DAHILAN NG ATING PAGPAPATULOY (Philippians 3:12–13a)

- Dahil hindi pa tayo ganap sa ating buhay espirituwal — “Not that I have already obtained this...I do not consider that I have made it my own” (vv. 12a, 13a; Romans 7:22–25; Galatians 5:17)
- Dahil tayo ay inaring-ganap kay Kristo, at inangkin na ni Hesus — “...because Christ Jesus has made me his own.” (v. 12b; Galatians 2:20; 1 Peter 2:9)

2. ANG PARAAN NG ATING PAGPAPATULOY (Philippians 3:13–14) — “But one thing I do....” (v. 13a)

- Pagbitaw sa mga inakala nating tagumpay at inamin natin na pagkukulang sa nakaraan — “forgetting what lies behind” (v. 13b; Philippians 3:4–7; Hebrews 12:1a)
- Pagpapatuloy na may pagpupursige — “straining forward to what lies ahead” (v. 13c; Hebrews 12:1b; 1 Corinthians 9:24)
- Pagtuon ng ating pagtingin kay Hesus — “I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus” (v. 14; Hebrews 12:2; Romans 8:29; 1 John 3:2)

3. ANG KAISIPAN NG ATING PAGPAPATULOY (Philippians 3:15–16)

- Pagkakaroon ng pag-iisip na nakasentro kay Kristo Hesus — “Let those of us who are mature think this way” (v. 15; Philippians 3:10; 1 Corinthians 2:16; Colossians 3:16)
- Pananatili nang tapat sa ating paglakad sa Kanya — “Only let us hold true to what we have attained” (v. 16; Philippians 2:16; 1 Corinthians 4:2; 2 Timothy 4:7)

Ibinigay na ng ating Panginoon ang lahat ng ating kailangan para sa isang buhay na maka-Diyos (2 Peter 1:3). Maging tapat tayo sa ating pag-ibig at pagsunod sa Kanya (John 15:10; 2 Peter 1:10–11). Iyan lang dapat ang ating resolusyon sa bawat bagong taon, dahil tayo ay bago nang nilalang! ■

"So the church throughout all Judea and Galilee and Samaria had peace and was being built up. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, it multiplied." — Isaiah 9:6-7 (ESV)

Paul, after encountering Jesus on his way to Damascus to persecute Christians (Acts 9:1-18), turned his life around by dedicating his life to boldly preaching the Gospel (Acts 9:19-22). This radical transformation as God's "chosen instrument" in teaching and discipling Jews and Gentiles alike about Jesus (v. 15), resulted in the church being built up (v. 31). The persecutor had become Christ's fearless proclaimers of the Gospel, all by Jesus' enabling. In the same way, much like how the LORD added to those who were being saved (Acts 2:47; 5:14, 16:5), He remains faithful in reconciling people to Himself (Romans 5:10; Colossians 1:20) in our church this 2025.

We praise God for what he has done for us:

- 2,508 average weekly Worship Service attendance (1907 on-site and 601 via livestream)
- 1,539 first-timers at our Worship Services (955 welcomed at the Visitors Center)
- 185 new members (including 112 baptized)
- 483 prayed to receive Christ at the Visitors Center
- 581 prayed to receive Christ (from 854 guests at Ortigas Community Outreach)
- 6,453 individuals served by the Mercy Ministry

This 2026, we pray to strengthen our efforts to **build up and reach out together — in Ortigas and our Oikos**, by God's grace and for His glory. We do this by dedicating ourselves to **GROW** together in God's Word, **Relationship**, **Outreach** and **Worship**, and by dedicating ourselves to our **Oikos** approach of **PRISM** by **Praying**, **Relating**, **Inviting**, **Sharing** (the Gospel), and **Mentoring** others (Matthew 22:36-40; 28:18-20).
