When Giants Stumble:

How Do We Respond When Famous Christian Personalities Fall?

Selected Verses

A sad reality of living in a fallen world and carrying a fallen nature is that, at times, those whom we look up to and admire—people whose books we read, sermons we replay, songs we sing, or links we forward—may fall into grievous and public sin. This breaks our hearts and leaves us with many questions. How should we respond to these painful realities? While we cannot answer every question arising, we can be guided by God's Word with the right responses:

The Personal Response of the Christian: 1 Corinthians 10:12–13

¹² Therefore let anyone who thinks that he stands take heed lest he fall. ¹³ No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and He will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation He will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it.

This answers two common wrong responses:

- Self-righteousness: *"How in the world could he do that? I would never stoop to that level."*
- Anxiety: *"If they fell, how can I ever be safe?"*

"What should I do with their books, songs, sermons, videos, etc.?"

If you still find value and blessing in them, continue to use them.

If not, feel free to use other resources without guilt.

The Public Response of the Church: Galatians 6:1–2 ¹ Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted. ² Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

The Role of the Church:

1. Restoration of the offender when applicable (1 Timothy 5:19–21)
2. Self-vigilance
3. Compassion for any victims and the family of the erring person, not just him/her

FINAL THOUGHTS

The Proactive Remedy for every Christ-follower: Hebrews 12:1–2

¹ Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, ² looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

- Let us run our race with unwavering spiritual focus and endurance.
- Let us keep our focus on Christ alone, not on mortal men.

Clear the Air Series

Kapag Nahulog ang mga Tinitingala na Pinunong Kristiyano

1 Corinthians 10:12–13; Galatians 6:1–2; Hebrews 12:1–2

Tunay ngang malungkot kapag hayag na nahuhulog sa kasalanan ang mga sikat at hinahangaan na mga pinunong Kristiyano. Ito ang isang malungkot na realidad ng pamumuhay sa gitna ng makasalasang sangkatauhan. Kamakailan, may mga tanyag na manunulat, musikero, tagapagturo at pastor na nahulog sa malubhang kasalanan. Nadurog nito ang ating mga puso at nag-iwan sa atin ng maraming katanungan. Paano tayo dapat tumugon sa mga masasakit na kaganapang ganito? Bagama't hindi natin masasagot ang bawat tanong, maaari tayong magabayan ng Salita ng Diyos.

1. ANG TAMANG TUGON NG BAWAT MANANAMPALATAYA (1 Corinthians 10:12–13)

- Sinasagot nito ang dalawang karaniwang maling tugon:
 - Pagiging matuwid sa sariling paningin: "Paano niya nagawa iyon? Siguro hindi siya tunay na Kristiyano" – "...let anyone who thinks that he stands take heed lest he fall" (v. 12; Matthew 7:1–3; Romans 11:20; James 4:6).
 - Pagdududa sa sariling kaligtasan: "Kung nahulog sila, paano pa kaya ako magiging ligtas?" – "God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability..." (v. 13; 2 Peter 2:9).
- "Ano ang dapat kong gawin sa kanilang mga libro, kanta, sermon, video, atbp.?"
 - Kung ang mensahe ng mga ito ay tapat naman sa Biblia at patuloy na nagbibigay ng pagpapala, hindi kailangan talikuran.
 - Kung hindi kayo tiyak, huwag mag-atubiling gumamit ng ibang mapagkukunan ng tamang katuruan mula sa mga tapat na lingkod ng Panginoon.

2. ANG TAMANG TUGON NG IGLESYA (Galatians 6:1–2)

- Tulungan manumbalik ang nagkasalang kapatid – "restore him in a spirit of gentleness" (Matthew 18:15-17; 1 Timothy 5:19–21; 2 Thessalonians 3:14–15).
- Tiyakin ang sariling puso – "you who are spiritual... keep watch on yourself" (Matthew 7:3).
- Tulungan ang lahat ng naapekto – "Bear one another's burden, and so fulfill the law of Christ" (Romans 15:1; 1 Thessalonians 5:14; John 13:34).

3. ANG TAMANG KAISIPAN PARA SA BAWAT KRISTIYANO (Hebrews 12:1–2)

- Tumingin tayo sa mga halimbawa ng tapat na pananampalataya – "we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses" (v. 1).
- Tumingin tayo higit sa lahat, kay Kristo na Siyang nag-umpisa at magtatapos ng ating buhay espirituwal – "looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith" (v. 2).

Ang lahat ng mga tinitingala natin, dito man o sa ibang bansa, ay gawa sa marupok na laman na madaling maguho. Huwag tayo tumingin sa kanila. Alalahanin natin ang mga naging tapat (Hebrews 13:7). Kapitan natin ang Salita ng Diyos, at laging tumingin kay Kristo Hesus na Siyang magdadala sa atin na sakdal sa harap ng kaluwalhatian ng Diyos (Jude 1:24-25). ■
