Communion Series on Luke: God the Son, Son of Man

What Following Jesus Means

Luke 9:1–6

After a series of astounding miracles to prove His authority—culminating in raising Jairus' daughter to life—Jesus continues demonstrating the authority of the Messiah when He sends His disciples to proclaim God's kingdom, teaching them to depend on God's provision, and to trust Him with the results. In many respects, this is the way He calls every Christian to serve Him today:

Following Jesus means being sent with His authority (vv. 1–2).

- Christ advances His kingdom by sending ordinary people with His power and authority. Christian ministry flows from divine empowerment, not our adequacy.
- Serve with confidence because Christ's authority stands behind our obedience, and with humility, recognizing that the authority is from Christ.

Following Jesus means a life that is totally dependent on God (vv. 3–4).

- Total dependence on God demonstrates faith and focuses attention on the message more than the messenger.
- God may place you in situations where self-sufficiency is stripped away, forcing you to trust Him.
- Cultivate such trust in God's faithfulness so that you're not anxiously stockpiling resources or relying primarily on material provision to do God's will.

Following Jesus means faithfully persevering regardless of how the message is received (vv. 5–6).

- Faithfulness does not guarantee acceptance. Faithfully proclaim the Gospel while recognizing their response is ultimately in God's hands.
- But every hearer is accountable for their response to the Gospel message.

Final Thoughts

Like the Twelve, Christ sends us to proclaim the Gospel with a finished work, an empty tomb, and a message that still demands a response. We don't go to earn the kingdom. We go because the King gave Himself for us: *"He who did not spare His own Son but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also with Him graciously give us all things?"* (Romans 8:32)

Let us now come before this risen King, trusting His grace and submitting ourselves again to His saving rule. ■

Communion Series on Luke: God the Son, Son of Man

Pagsunod sa Pagsugo ng Panginoon

Luke 9:1–6 (Matthew 10:5–15; Mark 6:7–13)

Sa mga nakaraang salaysay sa Luke ipinakita ni Hesus ang kapangyarihan Niya at awtoridad laban sa mga unos, sa mga demonyo, sa sakit, at kahit na sa kamatayan. Pagkatapos Niyang ipakita sa Kanyang mga alagad ang Kanyang kapangyarihan at awtoridad bilang Mesias, isinugo sila upang ipahayag ang mabuting balita ng pagdating ng kaharian ng Diyos sa katauhan ni Hesus. Sila ay sinugo na may kapangyarihan at awtoridad para sa kanilang misyon; pinagbilinan na umasa sa Kanya para sa kanilang pangangailangan, at hinikayat na magpatuloy kahit na ano pa ang resulta ng kanilang pamamahayag. Ito pa rin ang Kanyang hinihingi sa lahat ng Kanyang niligtas upang maglingkod sa Kanya ngayon.

1. MAGPAHAYAG NA MAY KAPANGYARIHAN AT AWTORIDAD (vv. 1–2).

- Mga ordinaryong tao ang isinusugo ng Panginoon upang ipahayag ang Kanyang ebanghelyo (Luke 4:43). Taglay nila ang Kanyang kapangyarihan at awtoridad upang ang resulta ay dahil sa Kanya, at hindi sa galing ng mga sinugo Niya (2 Corinthians 12:12; Hebrews 2:4; 1 Corinthians 1:26–29).
- Maglingkod tayo nang may kumpiyansa sa gagawin ng Diyos sa pamamagitan natin, kahit na tayo ay marupok na tao lamang (Matthew 10:19–20).

2. MAGLINGKOD NA MAY PAG-ASANG LUBOS SA SUPORTA NG PANGINOON (vv. 3–4).

- Ganap na pagtitiwala sa Diyos para sa ating pangangailangan ay maglilihis ng atensyon mula sa mensahero patungo sa mensahe (1 Thessalonians 2:13).
- Gagawin kung minsan ng Diyos na alisin ang ating pagdedepende sa ating sarili upang palakasin ang pagtitiwala sa Kanya (Philippians 4:12–13).
- Gamitin sa paglilingkod at huwag imbakin para sa sarili lang ang mga pagpapala ng Diyos. Huwag mag-alala tungkol sa ating pangangailangan na tapat naman na ibibigay ng Panginoon (Matthew 6:33; 1 Timothy 6:17–19).

3. MAGPATULOY KAHIT ANO PA ANG RESULTA NG PAMAMAHAYAG NG MABUTING BALITA (vv. 5–6).

- Ang resulta ng ating tapat na pamamahayag ay ipasa-Diyos natin, sapagkat ang kaligtasan ay sa Kanya lamang (Romans 1:16; 1 Corinthians 1:18).
- Ang bawa't makarinig ng ebanghelyo ay mananagot sa kanilang pagtugon (John 3:18).

Tayong lahat ay isinugo ng Panginoon upang ipahayag ang mabuting balita tungkol sa natapos nang gawain ni Hesus sa krus para sa kaligtasan ng lahat ng mananampalataya sa Kanya. *"He who did not spare His own Son but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also with Him graciously give us all things?"* (Romans 8:32). Tayo'y lumapit muli sa Kanyang dulang at ialay ang ating buhay bilang mga lingkod sa Kanyang kaharian. ■
