The Privilege of Prayer: Intimacy with God

Psalm 27:4–8

We celebrate 48 years of God's faithfulness to our church by starting a Five-Sermon Series on Prayer. Our passage helps us see David's reasons for praying, and they are worth emulating for every Christ-follower today:

(v. 4) THE SUPREME PETITION OF A BELIEVER— GOD HIMSELF!

- "One thing!" David stripped his life down to only one thing: to know God intimately (Philippians 3:8). He wanted the Giver, not His gifts. No life is simpler or more powerful than a rightly focused life (Philippians 3:13-14).
- We have access to God through Christ (Romans 5:2). Because of Jesus, every Christian can be as close to God as they want to.

(vv. 5–6) THE SAFETY OF BEING IN THE PRESENCE OF GOD HIMSELF.

- David had real enemies (v. 2, 12). So does every believer (1 Peter 5:8). But everyone who seeks God finds Him (James 4:8), and when you do, He not only protects you but, in His perfect way and time, lifts you up.
- Some people think other Christians are more blessed because they look more joyful. But such "more joyful" believers are those who have learned to take refuge in God amid heart-rending situations. God lifts them up, so they sing!

(vv. 7–8) THE SUMMONS TO PRAYER BY GOD HIMSELF.

- Amid confident praise, David knew he was still in hard times. Much of a Christian's life is like that, praising God in the storm, worshiping while wounded. But the same hands lifted up in worship are the same hands grasped by a loving Savior before you drown (Matthew 14:30-31).
- To seek God is another way of saying, to love Him, and this is commanded of all His people (Deuteronomy 6:5). And because David responded with love, he became the man "after God's own heart." That is something everyone in Christ can become today. Prayer is an expression of our love.

FINAL THOUGHTS

May God inspire us all to pray because we want God Himself, not just His gifts. And as each one in our faith community yearns to seek God Himself, we will see our church reach new heights it has never gained before, because when we seek the face of God, it glorifies God. God will then do *far more abundantly than all that we ask or think*, according to His power at work within us.
