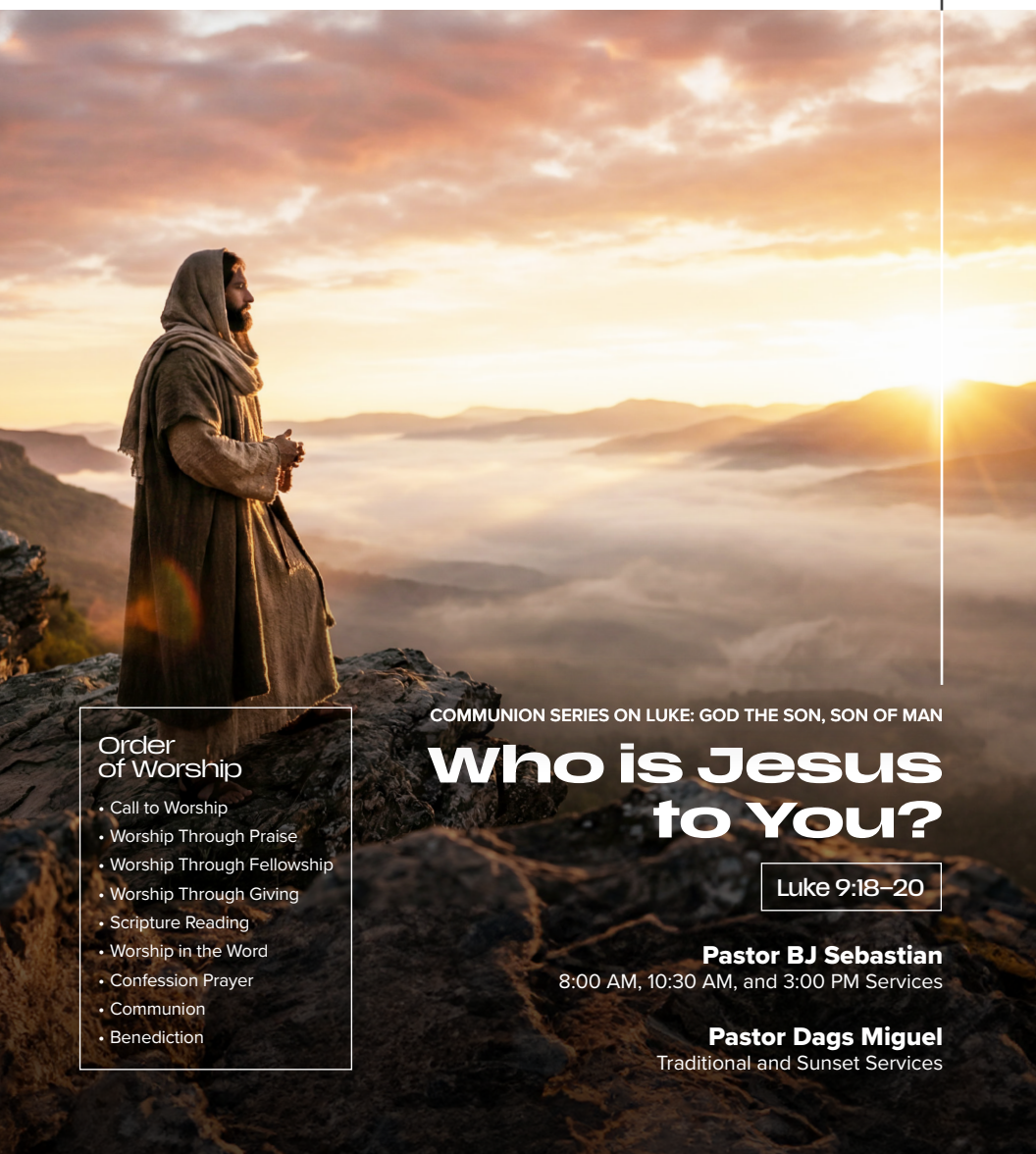

Who is Jesus to You?

Luke 9:18–20

Our answer to this question will determine our eternal destiny. Jesus as the Messiah is a dominant theme in Luke (Luke 2:11, 26; 4:18, 34; 7:22). Jesus' disciples asked this question in Luke 8:25. Jesus answered them: by healing a man with a demon (Luke 8:29); by healing a woman with a discharge (Luke 8:43–44); by restoring Jairus' daughter to life (Luke 8:54); by empowering them to preach and heal (Luke 9:1–2); and by feeding up to 20,000 people (Luke 9:16). Jesus asked two questions that will show 1) the world's opinions, and 2) the Lord's revelation about Him.

THE WORLD'S OPINIONS, vv. 18–19

- They were in Caesarea Philippi (Matthew 16:13; Mark 8:27) and Jesus was “praying alone” as He often did (Luke 3:21; 6:12; 11:1), probably for the Father to reveal Him to His disciples.
- Jesus asked what the “crowds” said
 - John the Baptist (Malachi 3:1)
 - Elijah (Malachi 4:5)
 - A prophet (Deuteronomy 18:15)
- They were confused despite what the Scriptures said about the Messiah (Genesis 49:10; Isaiah 11:1; 42:1; Micah 5:2), and despite the supernatural signs He has done so far, indicating spiritual blindness (1 Corinthians 2:14; 2 Corinthians 4:4).
- Our world today continues to be blind about Jesus despite the abundance of Biblical revelation.
 - He was just a man
 - He was a great prophet
 - He is a cosmic “genie”
- It is easy to be swayed by the world's opinions, so we must rely on the Lord's revelation.

THE LORD'S REVELATION, v. 20

- Contrasted against what the world considers as wisdom – “*But...*” (James 1:17; 3:15; 1 Corinthians 1:24–25)

Here are “**15 Questions to Help You Grow in Corporate Worship**” by Pastor Rich Penix. May it be a blessing to all of us:

Preparation

1. Prior to Sunday morning, do I orient my heart and my schedule so that I am as prepared as possible—mentally, spiritually, emotionally—to worship with God’s people?
2. Do my Saturday evening activities compromise my ability to worship well on the Lord’s Day?
3. Before Sunday, do I make an effort to read the sermon text, familiarize myself with the songs, and plan my giving so that my heart is prepared to worship?
4. Do I pray for an undistracted mind and a focused heart in anticipation of corporate worship?

Participation in Worship

5. As worship begins, do I listen attentively to the call to worship, recognizing the privilege of being summoned by God himself?
6. Do I actively fight distraction by resisting intrusive thoughts about responsibilities, worries, and upcoming tasks?
7. Do I resist cultivating a critical spirit about things I find distracting, distasteful, or personally undesirable?
8. During corporate prayers, do I track with the flow of thought, adding my “Amen” as I pray along with the person who is leading?
9. During congregational singing, do I offer a joyful noise to the Lord—even when I feel timid or self-conscious?
10. While singing, do I allow the beauty of the music to enhance truth without allowing it to overshadow the truth?
11. Do I resist judging those on the platform as “performing,” choosing instead to assume the best about their motives?
12. During the sermon, do I listen carefully, asking the Spirit to help me obey while still thinking humbly and critically through the passage being preached?
13. During the Lord’s Supper, am I thinking only of my own experience, or am I also remembering that Christ died to create a people—the brothers and sisters beside me—who will one day share together in the Marriage Supper of the Lamb?

Departing

14. As the worship service concludes, do I receive the benediction as God sending me into the world to live out the truths I’ve received?
15. As I depart, do I intentionally build up the body through purposeful fellowship, prayer, or words of encouragement?
