Victories from coast to coast defied predictions for the 2022 midterms. Pro-climate, pro-democracy candidates overcame aggressive gerrymandering, economic turbulence, and historically unfavorable trends for the incumbent party. Despite the "red wave" pundits predicted, voters shifted the tide for a greener future. You helped ensure 77% of climate champions supported by GiveGreen were re-elected or won important races.

This year GiveGreen also reached a pivotal milestone:

Surpassing the \$100 million mark in dollars raised to elect pro-climate, pro-democracy champions since 2009.

This cycle, our community raised more than \$27 million—the most yet in a non-presidential year.

We set out to protect the pro-environment majority in the Senate—and we did. Although anti-environment, anti-democracy leaders took control of the House, they won far fewer seats than expected. GiveGreen donors also powered significant gains in Governors' offices, state legislatures, and other down-ballot races, including flipping chambers in Minnesota, Michigan, and Pennsylvania.

GiveGreen had an amazing roster of pro-climate champions up and down the ballot this year!

These candidates were significantly stronger than their extremist opponents, and your support helped elevate their pro-environment messages to voters across the country, leading to historic electoral success in a midterm year. Voters, particularly young voters of color, showed up in droves to support candidates who helped

pass or support the historic Inflation Reduction Act—making it clear that addressing climate pollution, advancing environmental justice, saving families money, and creating good-paying jobs is incredibly popular.

When GiveGreen donors join forces, we are powerful. Even as we celebrate progress, we're gearing up to drive even bigger wins in 2023 and 2024.

President Joe Biden has championed climate like no president in history. We can't risk the backslide we would see if an anti-science, anti-democracy candidate like Donald Trump takes the White House. We will also fight to ensure pro-environment majorities in both chambers of Congress, state houses, and down the ballot all across the country.

Thank you for your support. Let's continue to build a powerful, pro-democracy environmental movement to drive long-lasting change in our political system.





2022 OVERVIEW

Critical Wins at Every Level

Your investment helped elect candidates in federal, state, and local races in key states. You helped us expand our proenvironment majority in the Senate. You helped us overcome historically unfavorable midterm trends and block polluter allies from gaining a huge margin in the House. You built power to protect election integrity at the state level—stopping election deniers from controlling elections as we head into the presidential race in 2024.

How does GiveGreen determine priority races?

GiveGreen strategically targets competitive races where pro-climate, pro-democracy candidates are critical to ensuring a pro-environment Congress and building power in key states. Our political teams carefully evaluate each candidate's publicly available environmental record, along with their chances of winning, to invest in races where your dollars will have the biggest impact.

Contributions made via GiveGreen include direct and in-kind contributions by individuals or PACs. These contributions can be to federal or nonfederal candidates, leadership PACs, state parties, joint fundraising committees, and coordinated expenditures where state law dictates that they count as in-kind contributions to candidates. \$4.7M was raised for federal party committees.

GiveGreen donors came together to raise unprecedented resources for U.S. Senate candidates during the 2022 cycle.

We set out to protect the pro-environment majority in the Senate and that's just what we did. Together, donors raised over \$400,000 each for Senators Catherine Cortez Masto, Raphael Warnock, Mark Kelly, and Michael Bennet. You helped flip Pennsylvania's open Senate seat from anti-environment to pro-environment by electing John Fetterman.

Despite generous support from GiveGreen donors, candidates lost tough races in Florida, North Carolina, Ohio, and Wisconsin.









House

Your deep investment in House races across the country helped elect numerous incumbent and new climate champions. We are proud to have supported so many candidates who made history, helping to build a House of Representatives more reflective of the nation's racial and gender diversity.

In the 2022 election cycle, GiveGreen donors supported the most diverse slate of candidates ever. Of the 202 U.S. House races supported - 50% were women, 37% people of color, 7% LGBTQ+, and 12% were candidates under 40.

While we lost 41 hard races, the GiveGreen community invested heavily to re-elect 161 pro-environment members and elect 25 new climate champions to the House. Anti-environment leaders financed by Big Oil will now control the House agenda, but the opposition picked up far fewer seats than expected, positioning us to regain the majority in 2024.

Race Highlights



DR. YADIRA CARAVEO (CO-08)

a pediatrician and state legislator who has championed clean air, climate action, and environmental protections in the State House, won a tight race, becoming the first Latina to represent Colorado in Congress.



REP. ANDY KIM (NJ-03)

defended the seat he flipped in 2018, defeating Bob Healey, and will continue his leadership on climate resiliency in his third term in Congress.



REP. SHARICE DAVIDS (KS-03)

defended her seat and will continue to champion climate-smart initiatives, such as tying tax incentives to carbon-reducing home improvements and historic funding to help Kansas dairy farmers reduce emissions.

She is the first openly LGBTQ+ Native American to represent Kansas in Congress.



REP. ANDREA SALINAS (OR-06)

a longtime champion for environmental justice, working families, and racial equity in the Oregon legislature will now fight for clean energy, jobs and justice in Congress. Salinas is the first Latina to represent Oregon in Congress.



REP. ABIGAIL SPANBERGER (VA-07)

successfully defended her seat, defeating extreme candidate Yesli Vega who has a record of voting to protect polluter profits over people and called the January 6th insurrectionists "just a group of Americans exercising their first amendment right."

Governors

The 2022 Governor's races defied expectations. 12 of the 18 candidates supported by GiveGreen donors won their races, including seven incumbents and five newly elected climate champions.

Choosing state executives who will champion climate action and protect democracy has never been a higher priority. These leaders will play a key role in the implementation of the Inflation Reduction Act as they ensure the funds are allocated to build a stronger clean energy economy and invest in those communities that need it most. GiveGreen donors contributed over \$250,000 for gubernatorial candidates in Michigan, Pennsylvania, and Wisconsin.









2022 Cycle Gubernatorial Outcomes



GOVERNOR GRETCHEN WHITMER

Race Highlights

won re-election having, during her first term, advanced aggressive climate action in a battleground state known as an auto industry hub. She opposed the Line 5 oil pipeline and invested in electric vehicle and battery manufacturing, pledging economy-wide carbon neutrality by 2050.



GOVERNOR JANET MILLS

secured her second term having set ambitious climate goals in her first term. In addition to installing solar panels on the governor's mansion in Augusta, she has vowed to reduce fossil fuel emissions by 45% and obtain 80% of electricity from renewable sources by 2030.



GOVERNOR MICHELLE LUJAN GRISHAM

won nearly 52% of the vote in a tightly contested race to retain the governor's mansion, after advancing landmark energy legislation that sets bold renewable energy standards and makes New Mexico a national leader on wind and solar energy.



GOVERNOR TINA KOTEK

rode to victory by reminding voters how she led a fight to reduce greenhouse gas pollution as Oregon House Speaker and pledging to invest in green transit infrastructure. She is now one of the nation's first LGBTQ+ women elected as governor.

State Executives and Legislators

The health of our democracy is inextricably linked to shaping a healthier, greener future for all people – and our planet. State elected officials, from lieutenant governors to state legislators, represent a critical coalition of pro-democracy, pro-climate champions who shape the pipeline to power.

Across state legislatures, 80% of the candidates GiveGreen donors supported won their races. Critical wins include establishing new proclimate majorities in state legislative chambers in Michigan, Minnesota, and Pennsylvania. Michigan and Minnesota, along with Maryland and Massachusetts, will now have new pro-environment, pro-democracy trifectas – governor, state senate, and state house. You also helped prevent anti-environment supermajorities in North Carolina and Wisconsin, which would have allowed pro-polluter allies to override vetoes by pro-climate governors.

You helped elect secretaries of state and attorneys general committed to voting rights and election integrity in key states that could be decisive in the 2024 presidential election. And you invested in winning campaigns for five pro-climate mayors, building the pipeline of environmental champions who will shape our future.

These leaders will play key roles in protecting and strengthening democracy, enforcing climate policy, and advancing environmental justice.

was re-elected to his second term with an 8% margin over extremist opponent Sigal Chattah. Ford was among a group of Attorneys General who sued the Trump Administration for environmental rollbacks in 2020.

Winning Propels Climate Action

Electing pro-climate, pro-democracy champions matters.

The only path to a just clean energy future is to elect candidates committed to advancing climate legislation and environmental justice. Thanks to the investments of GiveGreen donors and the hard work of our partners in recent elections, we are witnessing pro-climate, prodemocracy victories across the country.

Last summer, President Biden signed the Inflation Reduction Act—
the most significant action Congress has ever taken to address climate
change. The bill includes a nearly \$370 billion investment in clean
energy, energy security, and environmental justice. As we celebrate
the landmark victory for climate, we remain committed to fighting
provisions that could harm communities—especially communities of
color and low wealth communities—near fossil fuel infrastructure. This
progress would have not have been possible without GiveGreen donors
like you who helped elect a pro-environment majority Congress and
White House in 2020.






