Our second Founders Day was celebrated with much aplomb with a large number of well-wishers in attendance.



12/12/2024




Bharati Vidyapeeth Institute Visit

From far and wide they had come - their simplicity and care had our girls enjoying an evening of fun and frolic with them.



THE YEAR GONE BY

Ghar provides a secure and nurturing environment for girls in need of care and protection, those without homes and family ties and those who are vulnerable to abuse and exploitation. During the year, 46 residential girls and four non-residential children received support through this initiative.

We have provided our beneficiaries good amenities, healthy nutrition, good healthcare, recreational facilities and quality education and counselling and are doing what it takes to make them grow into well informed and responsible adults, empower them and mainstream them in society as productive and conscientious citizens.

Ghar is a home of warmth, encouragement and learning where children dream and reach for the stars; the quintessence of happiness and aspirations, of hope and a sound future; of opportunities to realise one's potential.



Education

Quality education in good schools was imparted. Except for five older girls, all other girls are studying in English medium schools viz Army Public School, St Joseph's Convent School, Kendriya Vidyalaya and Chetan Dattaji Gaikwad English Medium School.

Extensive in-house tuition was imparted by a team of tuition teachers. Volunteers chipped in with regular classes in conversational English and subjects in which the girls needed more attention. Regular training in computers and online education on computers was imparted to all girls.

A wide array of educational visits were organised to reputed institutions and defence establishments and places of learning and interest to widen their horizons and raise their aspirations.

Our girls were encouraged to participate in all activities in school and in Ghar in order to make them confident and capable to participate and compete in all activities.



Sports and Games

Participation in field games was encouraged to build character, team spirit, initiative and courage. Coaching in football and basketball was imparted during the summer vacations. Table Tennis coaching was regularly imparted on weekends.

Our girls participated and competed in sports and games in their schools and in competitions that were organized by various organisations. Several of them won medals in these competitions.

Extracurricular Activities

Participation in extracurricular activities was encouraged. 23 girls participated in a 13 days Summer Camp organised by BEG & Centre, an Army establishment wherein they performed various activities viz field games, swimming, golf, yoga, tree plantation, craftwork etc. They performed dance and yoga on stage during the closing ceremony and won several prizes.



Yoga and Dance

Development of body and mind was facilitated with regular yoga training on Saturdays and Sundays by a qualified yoga teacher. Many girls excelled in yoga and qualified in various tests in yoga. Periodic meditation classes were also conducted.

Regular dance classes were conducted in semi classical dance forms once a week. Our girls performed dance in front of large audiences several times.



Workshops and Activities

Workshops covering a wide array of activities viz craft work, drawing, painting, self-defence, Garbah dance etc were conducted on weekends for new learnings, increasing awareness and holistic development.

A Robotics course was conducted for all girls in multiple batches. Regular robotic classes were conducted for selected girls. Five girls participated in the National Robotics Competition 2024 organised by Robotex India.

A session on Astronomy was conducted by an experienced team of Astronomers. Our girls viewed planets and their moons through a high powered telescope.

Our girls were encouraged to organise and celebrate all festivals to foster patriotism, team work, initiative, creativity, confidence and a sense of responsibility. Our Founders day was conducted entirely by our girls with performances, felicitation of well-wishers and compering done by them.

Corporates, schools, colleges and various organisations conducted numerous activities of learning, play and fun during the year.

Recreational activities were organised. Several musical evenings with a live band and magic shows were organised for the recreation of our girls. Motivational talks by senior Army officers and people of imminence were organised.



Adventure Activities

Eight of our eldest girls undertook a two days overnight trip to Raireshwar, 94 kms from Pune, camped overnight in tents and trekked up to Raireshwar Temple and Kenjalgad Fort. They learnt about the historical significance of these places and had a very eventful experience.

Healthcare and Counselling

Quality and timely healthcare was provided to our girls. An under seven years old girl with a heart complication underwent a heart operation wherein a device was inserted in her heart. A nine years old girl who had undergone a cornea transplant in September 2023 was provided a special Scleral lens for improving her vision.

Several girls underwent dental root canal procedures. Treatment for braces is undergoing in respect of three girls. A complete health checkup was carried out for 17 girls as in-patients in a reputed hospital.

A dental camp and lectures on healthcare, menstruation and good and bad touch were conducted. Counselling by a Psychologist and IQ Tests of some girls were carried out.

A healthy and nutritious diet was provided for good health and physical development. All our girls are in good health.



Living with Love

The good standard of living and quality of life provided to our beneficiaries in itself is a motivation for them to strive to succeed in life. Strong sisterly love and bonding is encouraged amongst our girls.



LEARNINGS

Children of all strata of life are the same. What differentiates them are opportunities which largely depend on the financial status of their families. If underprivileged children are provided the same opportunities that the children of well off families get, they too can realise their potential and excel. We provide the same opportunities to our girls as we provide to our own children, be it in quality education, nutrition, healthcare, holistic development and care and affection. Many street children have shown remarkable progress in education and aspire to become Army officers, IPS officers, doctors and the like. We are highly motivated to do the best we can to ensure they realise their dreams; we are confident they will.

Every child should grow up in a family. Institutionalization is a measure of the last resort. Our constant endeavor has been to identify, counsel and restore those girls who have families who are capable of looking after them. Over the years we have restored several girls to their families.



OVERCOMING CHALLENGES

Ghar was conceptualized as a family and has tackled the many problems that we face with the very approach that parents adopt for their children. Good education and healthcare, counselling, a healthy and nutritious diet, participation in various activities, conducting activities that foster team work and a feeling of belongingness and above all abundant love and affection are amongst the methods adopted to overcome the challenges faced and to make our girls genuinely feel a part and parcel of the family of Ghar. Newly admitted girls are taken under the wings of older girls who help them settle down and feel loved and cared for. The management and staff deal with the girls likewise and provide realistic feedback that helps us in understanding the problems, behavior and conduct of individual girls and in doing what is needed to course correct them.

The primary need of most children is a sense of belongingness, security and a feeling of being loved. Children pine for love and affection. Their initial sense of insecurity is largely overcome with the sense of warm welcome and belongingness they feel right from the first instance. Having a clear picture of the background of a child and the trauma she has undergone helps in understanding a child's behavior and what needs to be done to bring her on track and amalgamate her as a member of the family of Ghar.



WAY FORWARD

Ghar is an incubator of fulfilling, purposeful and meaningful lives and about them learning how to use that to make an impact and a difference to the lives of others; about growing into good human beings who care.

We are fully geared up to realize our vision of our girls growing into successful, compassionate and conscientious adults who will impact society in a meaningful manner in times to come.

We envisage, nay we know, that our girls will impact society in a meaningful manner in times to come - in their own ways help others climb up the tallest mountains as we are doing for them.

Our conviction emerges from our belief that nature creates us as equals. There's no difference between a child born in a well-to-do family and a child born in an underprivileged family. The only difference is in opportunities.

Inequality on account of birth, circumstances or societal norms is what we, in our own little way, are bridging because we look at humans from the eyes of nature that created us - as equals.

This belief is being naturally imbibed in our girls by what they experience in *Ghar* and in their upbringing - the unadulterated care and affection and opportunities they get immaterial of their backgrounds. There is no gap between them and us - they are us.

It is this belief that will spur them to reach out to others in times to come. And they will!

Her eyes moistened, so did ours.

She had lost her father a few years back, a mother she did have, being cared for by an NGO in another city that looks after mentally ill people.

Her mother, unaware of her child's whereabouts, broke down when we told her that her daughter is with us. She was normal but her family had washed their hands of her.

At a crossroad we stood - the future of the child was bright if we sheltered and cared for her. But was it fair to deny the child the natural love and affection bestowed by a mother-daughter relationship?

The moment for parting had come.

We watched with immense happiness as the mother embraced her daughter - three years had gone by since she had held her.

As we released her from our embrace her eyes moistened, so did ours.

In the one month she had stayed with us, she had become one of us.

Adieu lil' girl - we'll miss you.

She sobbed as he held her close to his chest.

Didi please mummy se panch minute ke liye baat karao...she would every now and then plead with our staff.

In the lap of a staff member she would lie and cry...mummy ko milna hai.

Mummy aur papa hospital mein hai...her belief since she was just three years old.

Years had flown by since her parents had crossed over to the next world, in a short span of time COVID had torn apart a happy family and left a three year old and her sisters bereft of their love and care.

Two years back they had made *Ghar* their home.

Time flew by. She grew and blossomed in Ghar. Her belief that her parents were alive remained undiminished. The time had come to reveal to her the truth.

He held her closely in his arms and softly whispered to his child, his daughter, that mummy and papa will never be coming back.

Tears streamed down her cheeks. He felt the pain and yet it was a moment of relief for him.

Emotions engulfed him, he felt from within the immense responsibility he had towards her - of being her mummy and papa as they would have been had they been alive.

He felt an urge, a strong resolve, to do everything for her to scale the tallest mountains.

As he held her to his chest, the words of Edward Hale resounded in his mind.

"It is wonderful what one person can do when he is dedicated to doing it.

I am only one, but I am one. I can't do everything, but I can do something.

And what I can do, that I ought to do. And what I ought to do, by the grace of God, I shall do."

She aspires to become an Army officer. Her aspirations may change over time but our resolve to see her one day stride as a young successful lady with purity in her heart, shall never waiver.

Memories came flooding back. The very room in which she had spent her happy childhood, her home, was now dilapidated and engulfed in a smog of palpable sadness. The bed on which her mother had breathed her last lay as it was.

Chastened we were by the grief we saw and felt, and the huge responsibility we have towards our daughter. We are now her world as she is ours.

As we sat in our vehicle to return, she put her head down on the lap of her sister and sleep engulfed her.

She ran across the room into his arms. They held onto each other as the clock ticked away, emotions engulfed them and all those around.

A long drive it was, tucked away in a remote corner of a small hamlet, surrounded by lush fields, the orphanage which housed her.


