1.1 Gilion AB, reg. no. 559264-9726, (“**Gilion**”) is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. We want you to feel safe when we process your personal data. This Privacy Notice (“**Privacy Notice**”) explains how we ensure that your personal data is handled in compliance with applicable legislation.

DATA CONTROLLER</b></p> <p>Gilion is the data controller for the processing of your personal data and is responsible for ensuring that the processing is carried out in accordance with applicable legislation. If you have any questions regarding the processing of your personal data, you will find our contact details at the end of this Privacy Notice.</p>

**Why we process your data:** We process your personal data to provide and administer a register of angel investors at our Website. The purpose with the processing is to allow for companies to find and get in touch with angel investors that might be interested in investing in their businesses, which in turn allows Gilion to market its services to the visitors at its Website. The register of angel investors is not limited to Gilion's users but is instead open to the public.

Your personal data may originate from publicly accessible sources, as further described in Section 4 below.

**▼ Categories of personal data:**

Contact information such as name and domicile.

Work related data such as job title and position, name of organization and previous experience.

**Legal basis:**

The processing is necessary for the purposes of our legitimate interests, as we assess that our interest in keeping a register of angel investors available to the public, and thereby allowing for

<p><b>Why we process your data:</b> In case of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale of transfer of Gilion's assets we may need to process your personal data in order to enable such transfer. If Gilion is to be restructured, <i>e.g.</i>, divided into several different businesses, or if a third party acquires Gilion or our customer database, Gilion will also disclose your personal data to the acquiring company. That company will continue to use your personal information for the same purposes as those stated in this Privacy Notice, unless you are informed otherwise in connection with the disclosure.</p>

<p><b>Retention time: If Gilion ceases to exist, e.g., through a merger, liquidation or bankruptcy, or if Gilion’s customer database is transferred to an acquiring company, we will erase the personal data as long as the retention of such personal data is not required by law. In such case your personal data will be processed in accordance with this Privacy Notice.</b></p>

<p><b>Why we process your data: In case of a dispute, we are entitled to process your personal data to establish, exercise or defend the legal claim.</b></p>		
<p><b>▼ Categories of personal data:</b></p> <p>All of the above.</p>		<p><b>Legal basis:</b></p> <p>In case of a dispute, we are entitled to process your personal data with legitimate interest as legal basis since we assess that our interest in safeguarding our interests in a dispute overrides your interest of protection of your privacy.</p>
<p><b>Retention time: Your personal data is retained as long as they are needed to establish, defend or enforce a legal claim, for example in the event of a dispute over payment, however a maximum of three (3) years.</b></p>

We may also need to disclose personal data at the request of public authorities or to other parties in the context of court proceedings, mergers and acquisitions or similar.</p> <p>7.2      We will not sell your personal data.</p>

In some circumstances we may need to transfer your personal data to a country outside of the EU/EEA (“<b>Third Country</b>”). YOUR RIGHTS</b></p> <p>9.1      <b>Our responsibility for your rights ►</b></p> <p>▼</p> <p>9.1.1      In our capacity of a data controller, we are responsible for ensuring that your personal data is processed in compliance with the law and that you can exercise your rights. You may contact us at any time if you wish to exercise your rights. You will find the contact details at the end of this Privacy Notice.</p> <p>9.1.2      We have an obligation to respond to your requests to exercise your rights within one month from receiving your request. If your request is complex or if we have received many requests, we have the right to extend this deadline by two more months. If we are unable to take the action you have requested within one month, we will inform you of the reason for the delay and of your right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority and to seek a judicial remedy.</p> <p>9.1.3      You will not be charged for any information, communication or measures that we implement. However, if your request is manifestly unfounded or excessive, we may charge an administrative fee for providing the information or taking the action requested or refuse to act on your request altogether.</p>



9.2 **Your rights to access, rectification, erasure and restriction ►**



9.2.1 You have the right to request:

- a) Access to your personal data. This means that you have the right to request access to personal data that we hold about you. You also have the right to be provided, at no cost, with information about which personal data we are processing about you. We have the right to charge a reasonable administration fee if you request further copies. If you make a request by electronic means, *e.g.*, via email, we will provide you with the information in commonly used electronic format.
- b) Rectification of your personal data. At your request or on our own initiative, we will correct, anonymise, delete or complete data that we know to be inaccurate, incomplete or misleading. Also, you have the right to complete any incomplete personal data if something relevant is missing.
- c) Erasure of your personal data. You have the right to request that we erase your personal data if we no longer have a compelling reason for processing the data. Compelling reasons for continuously processing the data are if the processing is necessary:
  - (i) for the right of freedom of expression and information;
  - (ii) in order for us to comply with a legal obligation;
  - (iii) for reasons of public interests in the area of public health;
  - (iv) for archiving purposes in the public interest, scientific or historical research purposes or statistical purposes; or
  - (v) for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.

Your personal data will be erased if none of the circumstances above are applicable and if:

- (i) the personal data are no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected;

- (ii) you object to the processing of your personal data which is based on a legitimate interest assessment and we have no compelling interest that overrides your interests or rights and freedoms;
- (iii) we have processed the personal data unlawfully; or
- (iv) we are required to erase the personal data due to a legal obligation.

However, there might be requirements under applicable legislation, or other compelling reasons, that prevents us from immediately erasing your personal data. In such case, we will stop using your personal data for any other reasons than to comply with the applicable legislation, or the relevant compelling reason.

d) Right to restrict processing. This means that we temporarily restrict the processing of your data and that we must inform you before the restriction of processing is lifted. You have the right to request restriction of the processing when:

- (i) you have requested rectification of your personal data in accordance with Section 9.2.1 b) above, during the period of time we are verifying the accuracy of the data;
- (ii) the processing is unlawful and you do not want the data to be erased;
- (iii) Gilion, in its capacity as data controller, does no longer need the personal data for the purposes for which it was collected, but you require us to retain the information for the establishment, exercise or defend a legal claim; or
- (iv) you have objected to processing based on our legitimate interest in accordance with Section 9.3 below, during the time we determine whether our legitimate interest overrides your interests, rights or freedoms.

1.2.1 At Gilion, we will take all reasonable and possible measures to notify any recipients if your personal data regarding any rectification, erasure or restrictions carried out by us in accordance with this Section 9.2. At your request, we will also inform you of which third parties we have shared your personal data with.

	<p>1.3 <b>Your right to object to processing</b> ► ▼</p> <p>You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data when such processing is based upon legitimate interests as the legal basis (see Section 3 above). If you object to such processing, we will only continue with the processing if we have compelling reasons for doing so that overrides your interests, rights and freedoms, or if the processing is necessary for the establishment, exercise or defence of a legal claim.</p> <p>1.4 <b>Your right to data portability</b> ► ▼</p> <p>1.4.1 You have right to data portability when we process your personal data by automated means and when the legal basis for the processing is your consent or performance of a contract.</p> <p>1.4.2 Right to data portability means that you have the right to receive the personal data we process about you in machine-readable format which allows you to transfer these personal data to another data controller. You may also request us to transfer the personal data directly to another data controller.</p> <p>1.5 <b>Your right to complain to a supervisory authority</b> ► ▼</p> <p>You have the right to lodge a complaint with the Swedish Authority for Privacy Protection (<i>Sw. Integritetskyddsmyndigheten, IMY</i>) if you are not satisfied with our processing of your personal data.</p>
