Notice at Collection

California Consumer Privacy Act

Under the California Consumer Privacy Act (“CCPA”), Ark Kapital AB (under name change to Gilion AB) (“**Gilion**”, “**we**”, “**our**”) is required to disclose to California residents certain information about our Personal Information processing practices at the time of collection. 1. Collection of Personal Information

We have collected and will collect the following general categories of Personal Information about Consumers:

- Personal identifiers, including real name, alias, postal address, unique personal identifier, online identifier, Internet Protocol address, email address, or other similar identifiers;
- Customer records (*for California residents, see Cal. Civ. Code § 1798.80(e)*), including signature, telephone number, or state identification card number;
- Internet or other electronic network activity information including, browsing history, search history, and information regarding a consumer’s interaction with an Internet website application, or advertisement; and
- Professional or employment related information.

2. Use of Personal Information

We may use the categories of Personal Information described above for the following business or commercial purposes:

- To deliver our service in accordance with our Terms of Use;
- Provide customer service;
- To analyze the use of our Website;
- Comply with legal obligations;
- Enable mergers, divestitures, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution and other sale or transfers of Gilion’s assets; and

- Establish and defend against legal actions or claims.

3. Selling and Sharing of Personal Information

While we do not sell your Personal Information in exchange for money, some of the ways in which we may disclose your information to third parties or use analytics or online advertising tools, may result in the disclosure of your information to third parties for a commercial purpose that is considered a “sale” as defined under the CCPA, and which is subject to consumer right to opt out of such “sale.”

In this context, we may sell or share the following categories of Personal Information:

- Personal Identifiers; and
- Internet or other electronic network activity information.

4. Retention of Personal Information

We take every reasonable step to ensure that your Personal Information is processed for the minimum period necessary for the purposes set out in this Notice. The criteria for determining the duration for which we will retain each category of Personal Information collected are as follows:

(1) we will retain Personal Information in a form that permits identification only for as long as:
(a) we maintain an ongoing relationship with you (e.g., where you have a contract with us for our services, or you have contacted us for more information regarding our services); or
(b) your Personal Information is necessary in connection with the lawful purposes set out in our Privacy Policy, (e.g., to maintain or service your account; to verify your information; or where we have a legal obligation to retain your Personal Information information);
plus:
(2) the duration of:
(a) any applicable limitation period under applicable law (i.e., any period during which any person could bring a legal claim against us in connection with your Personal Information, or to which your Personal Information is relevant, or required to be held by applicable law for compliance purposes); and
(b) an additional six (6) month period following the end of such applicable limitation period (so that, if a person brings a claim at the end of the limitation period, we are still

afforded a reasonable amount of time in which to identify any Personal Information that are relevant to that claim),

and:

(3) in addition, if any relevant legal claims are brought, we continue to process Personal Information for such additional periods as are necessary in connection with that claim.
