How Long Is Too Long to Leave Your Dog Alone?

Not so long ago, no one gave a second thought to leaving a dog home alone for a day or two with a supply of kibble and plenty of water to drink. It just didn't occur to pet owners to wonder how their dog felt being left alone, whether indoors or outside. Fortunately, these days most people know better than to leave their dog alone for such a long stretch, but it's very common for dogs to be left home for 8, 10 or 12 hours; up to five or six days a week.

Finding alternatives to leaving your dog home alone will depend on your budget, your freedom to manage your time during the day, your family and social support system, and other factors.

-  See if your employer will let you work from home.
-  See if you can bring your dog to work with you.
-  Come home for lunch.
-  Ask a stay-at-home family member or friend to dog-sit.
-  Arrange for someone to stop by and walk your dog.
-  Hire a professional dog walker.


