SEASON REVIEW



BEARCATS ROUND OUT FINE SEASON

After advancing to the second round of the NCAA Tournament with a five-set win over Western Kentucky, Cincinnati fell in three tough sets to the ninth-seeded Illinois Fighting Illini. The win over Western Kentucky gave UC its second NCAA win in program history, while also upping its season win mark to 27. The 27 wins are the second most wins in a season in program history, one short of 1999 (28).

NEVITT EARNS ALL-REGION HONORS

On Wednesday, Dec. 10, the AVCA announced its all-region selections and senior Jessie Nevitt was tabbed an All-Northeast Region selection for the third time in her career. Nevitt averaged 3.13 kps, 1.34 bps, and hit .389, which is the third-highest single-season hitting percentage in school history. Nevitt finished her career as a four-time first-team all-BIG EAST selection, a three-time AVCA all-region selection, and she ranks on eight of UC's career charts.



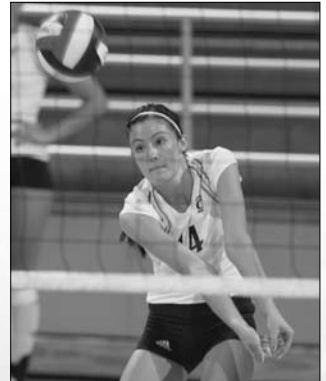

ELLEY ECLIPSES MILESTONE IN FINAL MATCH

A kill in the early stages of the third set in Cincinnati's second-round NCAA Tournament match against Illinois put UC up 11-8, forcing Illinois to use a timeout to halt UC's momentum. However, it was that kill that made senior Jessica Elley the 14th Bearcat in program history to record 1,000 career kills. Elley finished her final match with 10 kills, giving her 1,002 kills for her career.

YOUNG GUNS

During the 2008 NCAA Volleyball Tournament, the play of Cincinnati's underclassmen helped the Bearcats earn the program's second NCAA Tournament win over Western Kentucky and battle to the end with No. 9 seed Illinois. Against Western Kentucky, sophomore Stephanie Niemer emerged as UC's go-to player after recording a season-high 22 kills, including six kills in the fifth set, to lead the Bearcats to the victory. Niemer also recorded a team-high 12 kills in a three-set loss to Illinois. Fellow sophomore Lindsay Upton went the entire tournament without making an error. Upton connected on 12 kills in 22 attempts to finish the tournament with a .545 hitting percentage. Freshman Missy Harpenau put together two terrific all-around performances with back-to-back nine kill, nine dig performances in the tournament. For the tournament Niemer, Upton, and Harpenau combined for 64 kills, which was 68.8 percent of the team's kills for the tournament, while also recording 76.0 of the team's 122.5 points (62.04 percent).

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

With a three-set win over Rutgers and a St. John's loss at DePaul on Sunday, Nov. 16, Cincinnati earned a share of the program's first regular-season BIG EAST Championship. The regular-season championship is the third BIG EAST title for the school, as the men's soccer team won a BIG EAST Red Division championship in 2006 and the football team won a BIG EAST championship in 2008.

HARDWARE SHOW

At the 2008 BIG EAST volleyball banquet, four UC volleyball players and head coach Reed Sunahara earned conference awards. Sunahara won the BIG EAST Coach of the Year award after leading Cincinnati to the program's first BIG EAST regular-season championship. Senior Jessie Nevitt and sophomore Stephanie Niemer took home first-team all-BIG EAST honors, while senior Jessica Elley and sophomore Annie Fesl were second-team all-BIG EAST selections. Nevitt joined Bonita Wise as the only two Bearcat players to earn four all-conference awards, while becoming the first UC player to earn

four first-team all-conference awards. The first-team selection for Niemer was the first of her career, after earning second-team honors and Freshman of the Year honors in 2007. Elley and Fesl both earned their first all-conference honors.

BACK ON TRACK

After falling one win shy of recording its 13th consecutive 20-win season and its eighth under Sunahara with a 19-12 record in 2007, Cincinnati got back on track with a 27-7 campaign in 2008. The 27 wins match the most wins of any Bearcats team under Sunahara and the 15 consecutive wins dating from Oct. 3 to Nov. 16 equal the second longest winning streak in program history.

NOTHING LIKE HOME

The Bearcats improved to 14-0 at home with a three-set win over Rutgers on Nov. 16. It was the second time in school history that the Bearcats have gone undefeated at home in a season. The 2003 UC team went 13-0 at home. The 14 home wins were also the most home wins in a single season in program history. Under Sunahara, UC is 94-13 at home (.879), and has won 16 consecutive home matches dating back to Nov. 3, 2008.





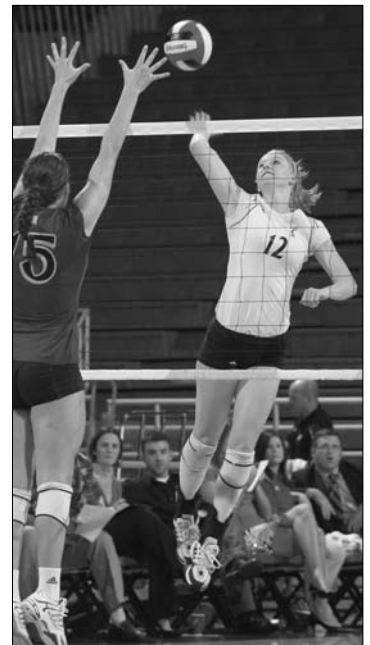

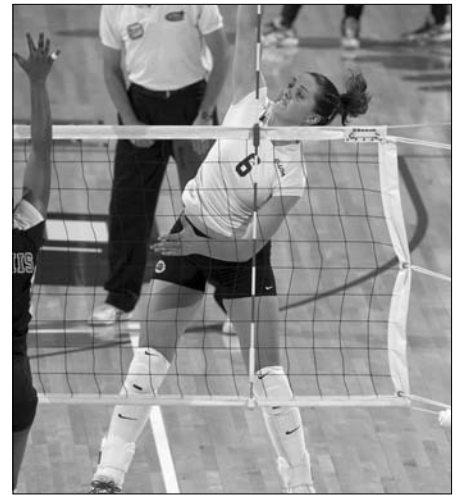
UC'S FIRST ALL-AMERICAN JULIE DUPONT

Julie DuPont's road to All-American status at Cincinnati began after a stellar prep career at Muskego (Wis.) High. Upon arriving at UC, DuPont spent her freshman year as both a middle blocker and right side hitter. But it was during DuPont's sophomore year with a move back to outside hitter that she began to flourish into one of Conference USA's premier players.

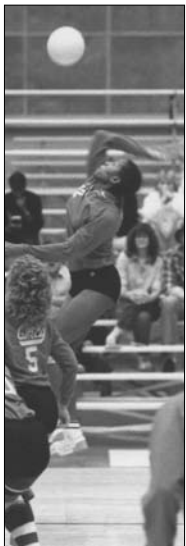
As a sophomore, DuPont showed a preview of things to come when she earned second-team all-conference honors. It was the 2003 season that DuPont really shined, however, as she won her first of two consecutive C-USA Player of the Year awards. During that same season, DuPont gave UC its first volleyball all-American when she was tabbed to the third team by the American Volleyball Coaches Association. One year later, DuPont was again honored by the AVCA as an honorable mention All-American, while taking her second C-USA Player of the Year award.

In addition to the individual honors, DuPont also contributed to the Bearcats' team success. During her career, UC posted a combined record of 95-34, went to the NCAA Tournament three times and won or shared two C-USA crowns. Off the court, DuPont was a three-time CoSIDA Academic All-American, including a first-team choice in 2004.

VOLLEYBALL REPRESENTED BY THREE IN UC ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME



Sonja Jackson (left) was inducted into the UC Athletics Hall of Fame in 2002. Jackson was the first Bearcat with 1,000 career kills and 1,000 career digs, while twice being named first-team all-conference.

UC'S FIRST THREE-TIME ALL-AMERICAN

In 2008, Jessie Nevitt capped off one of the finest careers in UC volleyball history by earning her third AVCA Honorable-Mention All-America Honor. Nevitt became the first player in program history to be named an all-American three times, and she

also became the first player in school history to earn four first-team all-conference honors. For her career, Nevitt finished with 1,498 career kills and 652 total blocks, becoming the second player in BIG EAST history to finish her career with at least 1,400 career kills and 600 total blocks. A staple in the UC record books, Nevitt ranks in the Top 10 on eight of Cincinnati's career charts.

PREISS, LADUSAW AMONG ALL-TIME NCAA STATISTICAL LEADERS



A pair of former Cincinnati greats in Lisa Preiss (1981-84) and Trish Ladusaw (1999-2002) are ranked among the NCAA all-time leaders in a pair of statistical categories.

Preiss is one of the NCAA's leaders in service aces per game. The four-year letterwinner connected on 180 aces over her final two seasons, spanning 152 games for an average of 1.18 per game. She is the only player in NCAA history to average more than an ace per game. Although Preiss played four seasons at UC, aces and games played were not kept as statistics until 1983.

Ladusaw closed out her remarkable career having accumulated the third-most digs in NCAA history with 2,074, 706 behind all-time leader Kim Diehlmann of Hartford. Ladusaw also ranks among the Top-10 in digs per game with 4.38.

OLYMPIAN SHARON (MOORE) FURLONG

Sharon (Moore) Furlong raised the level of Cincinnati volleyball in her career with the Bearcats then stepped to greater heights to pursue her dream of being an Olympian. Furlong, a 5-11 hitter, concluded her Bearcat career after her junior year when she led UC to a 34-10 mark and a runner-up finish in the state tournament under head coach Georgeanne Green.

Furlong withdrew from UC on Dec. 27, 1976, and joined the U.S. squad in Pasadena, Texas, to begin training for the 1980 Olympic games. She trained with the national team for four years, helping the U.S. qualify for the Olympics in April of 1979 after finishing second to Cuba in the North, Central America and Caribbean Volleyball Championships in Havana, Cuba. Furlong's Olympic dream was dashed when the United States boycotted the 1980 Olympics in Moscow.

In 1981, Furlong returned to school at Indiana and graduated in 1984 with a B.S. in education. After graduation, she began a 12-year career in the Finneytown school district. She began teaching and coaching at Finneytown to pass on her dreams of success to future Olympic hopefuls.

Furlong was the head coach at Finneytown from 1984-1990, leading the team to five Cincinnati Hills League championships, three district titles, one regional championship and a state runner-up finish in 1990. She acted as an assistant coach at Mount Saint Joseph from 1991-93 and is frequently consulted for her volleyball knowledge.

"UC was my first intense experience in training for volleyball. Back then, we worked hard simply for the love of the game because we had no scholarships. We were there because we wanted to be. I've stayed in touch with the program at UC, and it's a treat to watch the program turn around, especially by bringing in the local athletes." --Sharon (Moore) Furlong.
