FOOTBALL TAKES ON NAVY IN ANNAPOLIS FOR THE FIRST TIME IN 60 YEARS

- UC concludes a three-game road trip at Navy on Saturday, Sept. 23, 2017. The Bearcats and Midshipmen will kick off at 3:30 p.m. ET at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium. The game will be televised on CBS Sports Network and airs on 102.7 WEBN FM. UC and Navy have not met on the field since 1956, but will face each other in each of the next two seasons as cross-divisional opponents in American Athletic Conference play.

THE SERIES

- Saturday marks only the third meeting between the two schools and first since 1956. Navy holds a 2-0 advantage with both games coming in Annapolis at Thompson Stadium.

THE COACHES

- Ohio native LUKE FICKELL was named the 42nd Football Head Coach at the University of Cincinnati in December 2017. Fickell took the reins of the Bearcats program after spending 15 years at his alma mater, Ohio State. An experienced 18-year coaching veteran at the FBS level, Fickell was a part of nine Big Ten Conference titles (seven as a coach, two as a player) and two national championship squads with 15 postseason games and 12 NFL Draft selections under his belt.
- KEN NIUMATALOLO is in his 10th year at Navy with a record of 79-42 (.650). The program's all-time winningest coach, Niumatalolo is 8-1 all-time against Navy's biggest rival, Army West Point, and had led the Midshipmen to nine bowl games.

STREAKS, STORYLINES, SIDEBARS ...

- The University of Cincinnati football team plays its 130th season in 2017. The program dates to 1885 and is one of the 10 oldest in major college football.
- UC has won a league title in five of the last 10 seasons and played in a bowl game nine times in the past 11 years.
- UC is one of 30 NCAA FBS teams with 100 wins since 2005. The Bearcats' .667 winning percentage since 2007 ranks among the Top-20 teams in the NCAA FBS, winning at least nine games seven times in the last 11 years.
- The Bearcats returned to Nippert Stadium in 2015 after a 20 month, \$86-million renovation and drew 222,578 fans in the first year back at Nippert Stadium, a single-season record average of 37,096. The Oct. 24, 2015 attendance of 40,124 was the largest in Nippert Stadium history. The previous stadium record was 40,101 set on Oct. 1 against Miami (Fla.).
- UC has won back-to-back American Athletic Conference FB Team Academic Excellence Awards in 2015 & 2016.
- UC started 2017 with five takeaways (2 INT, 3 FR) and five sacks after closing 2016 with 24 takeaways (17 INT/7 FR) and 21 sacks. UC forced only 14 takeaways (9 INT/5 FR) and 13 sacks during the 2015 season.
- UC had 28 players take the field for the first time during the opening three games of the 2017 season.
- Almost sixty-nine percent of UC's roster (77 of 112) is made of up freshmen, RS freshmen and sophomores.
- UC is closing out a three-game road trip with games at Michigan (Sept. 9), at Miami (Sept. 16) and at Navy (Sept. 23).
- Due to Hurricane Irma, UC will now face USF on Oct. 14 at Raymond James Stadium and have their bye week on Oct. 28.
- UC is 3-6 all-time in games against service academies (0-1 vs. Air Force, 3-3 vs. Army West Point, 0-2 vs. Navy). This the Bearcats first game against one of the service academies since facing Army West Point on Oct. 9, 2004.
- UC is looking to snap a four-game slide in American Athletic Conference opening games and a three-game skid against American West Division foes. UC won its first conference game of the season from 2007-12.
- The Bearcats have beaten longtime rival Miami (OH) 12-consecutive times in the annual Battle for the Victory Bell.
- UC's 11-point comeback in the fourth quarter at Miami is the biggest since a 14-point fourth-quarter come-from-behind win at Pittsburgh on Dec. 5, 2009. In that game, UC trailed 38-24 with 12:26 left in the game and won 45-44.
- S Malik Clements' 14-yard INT return for a TD capped the Miami comeback with 1:07 left in the game. It was Clements' first-career interception and TD. Clements was named the AAC Defensive Player of the Week on Monday, Sept. 18.

WEEKLY MEDIA LUNCHEON

UC holds a weekly media luncheon each Tuesday in the second floor Bob Goin Team Room of Richard E. Lindner Center. Lunch is served at 11:30 a.m., selected players are available for one-on-one interviews from 11:45-noon, and head coach Luke Fickell takes the podium at noon.

PRACTICES

During a typical Saturday game week, media may interview players and coaches immediately following practice on Tuesday. Practice is generally closed to the public. Anyone hoping to observe practice should contact UC Athletics Communications in advance. Failure to do so may result in an individual's removal from the venue. During regular-season practices, unless otherwise noted, still and television photographers will be allowed to shoot stretching and the first 20 minutes (four periods).

INTERNET POLICIES

Live updating of websites, blogs and social network feeds is not allowed during practices.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

The UC locker room will remain closed following all football games. Media should request players through UC Athletics Communications during the fourth quarter. Media will be allowed to enter the field (for home games) late in the fourth quarter but will not be allowed to conduct interviews with UC football players on the field (home or away). Only the originating television and radio networks will be allowed to conduct interviews on the field.

There will be a 10-15 minute cooling off period between the end of the game and start of the postgame interview sessions. Coach Fickell will address the media in the designated interview area following home games. Players will be brought into the interview area as soon as possible.

NEW MAN IN CHARGE

- Luke Fickell takes over as Cincinnati's head coach in 2017.
- Fickell had served as the defensive coordinator at Ohio State from 2005-16, with the exception of the 2011 season, when he was the Buckeyes' head coach.
- Fickell, a native of Columbus, Ohio, has spent his entire coaching career in the state of Ohio.

ROAD TRIP!

- UC concludes a three-game road trip Saturday at Navy which started with a trip to Michigan (Sept. 9) and featured a game at Miami (OH) on Sept. 16.
- It has been 17 years since UC has played three-straight on the road with the 2000 Bearcats taking on Wisconsin, Indiana and Tulane in consecutive weeks.

PLAYING THEM CLOSE

- Of the 122 meetings between UC-Miami, 53 have been decided by seven points or less, including the seven ties in series history.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Former Naval Academy QB and Heisman Trophy winner Roger Staubach is a Cincinnati native.

NAVY-MARINE CORPS MEMORIAL STADIUM

- UC has not faced Navy since 1956, but the Bearcats have game experience in Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium after facing Virginia Tech in the 2014 Military Bowl.
- CB Grant Coleman started at corner and RB Mike Boone, K Andrew Gantz, S Carter Jacobs, CB Linden Stephens and DE Mark Wilson all saw action against the Hokies.

TARGETED

- LB Perry Young was ejected for a targeting foul in the fourth quarter at Miami and will miss the first half of UC's game at Navy.

TALE OF TWO HALVES IN OXFORD

- QB Hayden Moore was 14-of-21 for 176 yards and a TD in the and WR Kahlil Lewis hauled in all seven of his catches for 83 yards and a TD in the final 30 minutes at Miami (OH).

SPREADING THE WEALTH

- Through three games, QB Hayden Moore has completed passes to 11 different receivers.
- Kahlil Lewis has been the top target with 15 catches and three TDs.
- Gerrid Doaks (16.7), JJ Pinckney (14.0) and Rashad Medaris (12.0) have the top yards per catch averages.
- Doaks (29), Lewis (27), Thomas Geddis (21) and Devin Gray all have catches for 20 or more yards.

DON'T CALL IT A COMEBACK

- UC trailed Miami 17-6 with 4:45 to go and scored 15 unanswered points to win 21-17. It was the Bearcats second-straight come-from-behind win in the series as the Bearcats trailed the RedHawks 20-17 heading into the fourth quarter a year ago before winning 27-20.
- The 11-point comeback in the fourth quarter is UC's biggest since a 14-point fourth-quarter comeback at Pittsburgh on Dec. 5, 2009. In that game, UC trailed 38-24 with 12:26 left in the game and won 45-44.

CLEMENTS MAKES THE BIG PLAY

- S Malik Clements' 14-yard interception return for a TD at Miami capped the comeback with 1:07 left in the game. It was Clements' first-career interception and TD and UC's first interception return for a TD since LB Tyrell Gilbert ran a 58-yard pick for a score against UT Martin on Sept. 1, 2016. Clements added seven tackles.

STRONG SECOND OPTION

- WR Thomas Geddis has emerged as UC's second-leading pass catches on the season with nine receptions for 100 yards and a TD. The sophomore has averaged 33.3 yards per game and 11.1 yards per catch.

OFFENSE COMING AROUND

- After showing some flashes against Michigan, UC totaled season highs in rushing (139), passing (222) and total offense (361) against Miami (OH).

GET SACKS

- UC had three sacks at Miami (OH), a season high.
- DE Kevin Mouhon had two and DT Marquise Copeland had one.
- Mouhon had four stops and set a career mark with 2.5 tackles for a loss.
- Copeland set a career best with 3.0 tackles for a loss to go with his seven tackles. He has 56 tackle in UC's last 10 games.

THREE-HEADED MONSTER

- UC has three strong options in the backfield in 2017 with RBs Mike Boone, Gerrid Doaks and Michael Warren II.
- Boone has averaged 72.0 yards per game with a pair of TDs, Doaks had a career-best 71 yards on the ground at Miami and Warren rushed for a career chart topping 51 yards against the RedHawks.
- QB Hayden Moore has shown some flash with rushes of 56 and 18 yards in the last two games.

KICKING IT AROUND

- K Josh Pasley had a 41-yard field goal at Miami to cap a 12-play, 47-yard, 5:15 scoring drive which gave UC a 3-0 lead with 5:12 left in the first quarter. It was his first made field goal of the 2017 season and his longest since hitting a 43 yarder against ECU on Oct. 22, 2016.
- Pasley hit a 36-yard field goal early in the fourth quarter, the fourth multiple field-goal game of his career.
- Pasley beat Andrew Gantz out in a practice-week competition after the season opener against Austin Peay.
- The two seniors will continue to battle it out in practice each week for the starting kicker spot on gameday.

CLOSING THEM OUT

- After a 10-yard TD from QB Hayden Moore to WR Kahlil Lewis with 11:15 left in the third quarter at No. 8 Michigan, UC trailed 17-14, overcoming an early 14-0 deficit.
- The Bearcats, who entered the game as a 34.5-point underdog, could not capitalize on the momentum and had four-straight three-and-outs before a safety and an interception for a TD put the game out of reach.

GET THE BALL

- LB Tyrell Gilbert recovered a fumble on a punt at the Michigan 38-yard line in the first quarter. The ball bounced, caromed into a UM player and Gilbert pounced on it.

- It was his first fumble recovery of the season and second of his career. The turnover led to UC's first score of the game, also the Bearcats first points off a turnover in 2017. Gilbert had his third-career forced fumble against Austin Peay.

GET THE BALL

- RB Mike Boone scored on a 1-yard TD run with 2:13 left in the first quarter to put UC on the board.
- It was Boone's second rushing TD of the season and 22nd of his career. UC has a rushing TD in consecutive games after going nearly 10 games in 2016 without scoring on a rush.
- Boone's 22 career rushing TDs ties him with Bob Heuck (1910-12) for sixth-place all-time. Boone tallied 44 yards on 12 carries and five receptions for 28 yards, both team highs.

WELCOME TO THE PARTY

- RB Gerrid Doaks made his first appearance in a UC jersey at Michigan. Doaks' first carry went for 15 yards and a UC first down. He finished with 25 yards on six carries.
- HC Luke Fickell said postgame Doaks will continue to feature in the offense as a compliment to RB Mike Boon.

STEPPING UP ON THE BIG STAGE

- DT Cortez Broughton recovered a Michigan fumble with 9:35 left in the first half. It was Broughton's first career fumble recovery, UC's second of the game and third of the season.
- Broughton recorded his first sack of the season in the second quarter. He has 3.5 for his career.
- He finished with three tackles, including one for a loss.

OFF TO THE RACES

- QB Hayden Moore had a 46-yard run on UC's first drive in the third quarter at Michigan.
- It was the longest rush of Moore's career, surpassing his 23-yard scamper at Purdue in 2016.
- The run stands as UC's longest play from scrimmage in 2017 and UC's longest run play since Kahlil Lewis' 79-yard end around at Purdue in 2016.

OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

- Three seniors, RB Mike Boone, OL Korey Cunningham and LB Jaylyn Minor were elected as UC's 2017 team captains via a preseason vote of the team.

ALL THE NEWS THAT WOULDN'T FIT

HIGH TECH EQUIPMENT

- Cincinnati is one of a handful of teams to wear the Russell Athletic CarbonTek shoulder pad system. The pads are a collaboration between Russell Athletic and Boeing that uses excess carbon fiber from 787s.

PROTECT THIS HOUSE

- UC announced a long-term partnership with Under Armour, naming the global performance brand as the its official outfitter starting July 1, 2015.
- As part of the multi-year agreement, Under Armour will exclusively design and supply the footwear, apparel and equipment for training and gameday uniforms for each of UC's 19 men's and women's varsity athletic teams beginning in the 2015-16 season.

TAKE ME TO HIGHER GROUND

- For the past 19 years, the UC football has called the Higher Ground Conference and Retreat Center in West Harrison, Ind., its preseason training home.
- The 280-acre facility is located about 30 miles from campus and has served as the Bearcats training camp location since the lead up to the 1999 season.
- Among many amenities, Higher Ground features a pair of 100-yard artificial turf practice fields, including a new surface installed in 2017, ample living and meeting spaces and no distractions from football.

DOUBLE DUTY

- UC radio voice Dan Hoard also serves as the play-by-play man for the NFL's Cincinnati Bengals, joining Bill Hillgrove (Pittsburgh Panthers & Steelers) and Gene Deckerhoff (Florida State/Tampa Bay Buccaneers) as the only broadcasters in the country to handle radio play-by-play duties for both an NCAA FBS and NFL team.
- Michigan's Jim Brandstatter is the color analyst on both Wolverines and Detroit Lions broadcasts while ESPN's Dave Pasch (Arizona Cardinals) and Bob Wischusen (NY Jets) are NFL play-by-play voices.

GRAY MATTERS

- WR Devin Gray averaged 13.7 yards per catch, hauling in three receptions for a team-high 41 yards.
- Gray burst onto the UC scene in 2016, becoming the first UC wideout in 129 years to tally 100 or more receiving yards in his Bearcats debut.
- A year ago, he hauled in a team-high 58 receptions for 860 yards and five TDs, averaging 14.8 yards per catch. Gray led the squad in receiving in five games, breaking the 100-yard mark on three occasions.

MINOR DETAILS

- LB Jaylin Minor led the defense with a career-high 11 tackles. Minor has hit double-digit tackles and set career marks in each of the first three games after tallying 10 stops in the opener against Austin Peay and 10 at Miami (OH).
- A native of Navasota, Texas, Minor has one of the more unique biographical notes as he grew up competing in the rodeo, taking part in calf roping and steer wrestling.

PLAYING IN BIG HOUSES

- With its trip to Michigan Stadium on Sept. 9, UC has played games in the top five venues by capacity in college football.
- Michigan Stadium (107,601 - 2017) tops the list followed by Penn State's Beaver Stadium (106,572 - 2005), Ohio State's Ohio Stadium (104,944, 2014), Texas A&M's Kyle Field (102,733, 1971) and Tennessee's Neyland Stadium (102,455 - 2011).

CAN I GRADUATE?

- UC ranks second in the NCAA FBS with 14 players on the roster in possession of undergraduate degrees.
- Among FBS schools, only Northwestern (18) has more, according to figures provided by the National Football Foundation. Coastal Carolina also has 14.
- The UC players with degrees are: Kendall Calhoun, Tyler Cogswell, Grant Coleman, Korey Cunningham, Andrew Gantz, Carter Jacobs, Lyndon Johnson, Jaylin Minor, Chris Murphy, David Niehaus, Josh Pasley, Will Steur, Jon Vincent and Mark Wilson.

LOCAL FLAVOR ON O-LINE

- UC has had the same starting offensive line in the first two games of 2017 with LT Korey Cunningham, LG Garrett Campbell, C David Niehaus, RG Will Steur and RT Kendal Calhoun.
- The interior of the line features three local players who are former walk-ons in Campbell (St. Xavier), Niehaus (Colerain) and Steur (Madeira).

100-YARD GAMES!

- RB Mike Boone rushed for 100 yards in the season opener against Austin Peay, his sixth career 100-yard game and the first for UC since Boone tallied 137 yards on the ground against Tulsa on Nov. 14, 2015.

GROUND ATTACK ACTIVE AGAIN

- RB Mike Boone scored on a three-yard rush in the fourth quarter against Austin Peay, snapping a UC streak of almost 10 games without a rushing TD.
- UC had two rushing TDs against USF on Oct. 1, 2016, by RB Tion Green with 3:27 left in the first quarter and by QB Ross Trail with 13:25 left in the first half.
- They were the last rushing TDs UC would score until Boone's scamper in the end zone in the season opener, a span of 518 minutes and 12 seconds.

SPREADING THE WEALTH

- QB Hayden Moore threw three TD passes against Austin Peay to three different targets.
- He found Thomas Geddins on 16-yard pitch and catch in the first quarter; threw a 6-yard out to Kahlil Lewis who made a great second effort to get to the pylon and threaded the needle on a 6-yard strike to Tyler Cogswell in the third quarter.
- It was Moore's fourth three TD game of his career.

RETURNING THE FAVOR

- After throwing a TD pass to QB Hayden Moore in the 2016 finale, TE Tyler Cogswell saw the roles reversed in the season opener against Austin Peay as Moore found the senior on a 6-yard strike in the third quarter.
- Cogswell, a former HS QB, had a 29-yard throwback pass to Moore in the first quarter of the last game of 2016 at Tulsa.
- It was the first career pass and passing TD for Cogswell and the first career reception and receiving TD for Moore.
- The last time a non-QB threw a TD was RB Tion Green completing a 1-yard TD pass to DJ Dowdy at BYU in 2015.

THE STAFF HAS SEEN THIS BEFORE

- HC Luke Fickell, an 18-year veteran of the coaching ranks, put together a veteran, experienced staff when he took the reins at the University of Cincinnati
- UC's 2017 coaching staff boasts 221 years of on-field experience at all levels of football.
- S coach Jon Tenuta (36), CB coach Willie Martinez and OC/QB coach Mike Denbrock (31) have 30+ years of experience while WR coach Joker Phillips (29), OL coach Ron Crook (28) and STC/TE coach Doug Phillips (21) have 20+ years in.
- DL coach Al Washington has coached for over a decade 11 and DC/LB Marcus Freeman (8) and RB coach Gino Guidugli (7) joined the coaching ranks after professional playing careers.

FROM DOWN UNDER, WAY DOWN UNDER

- It's 9,683 miles from Wangaratta, Australia to Cincinnati, Ohio, the journey of a lifetime for freshman punter James Smith.
- Smith, who grew up playing Australian Rules FB, made his first appearance in UC's season opener against Austin Peay.
- The 23-year old freshman, a product of Prokick Australia, had six punts for 253 yards, a 42.2-yard average, including a long of 64 yards and three inside the opponent's 20-yard line.
- The 64-yard boot is the longest for a UC punter since Pat O'Donnell had a 65-yard boot against USF on Nov. 23, 2012.

QUITE A TRANSFORMATION

- LT Korey Cunningham has come a long way since his arrival at UC, going from a 225 lb TE as a freshman to a 318 lb OL as a senior. The 6-6 native of Montevallo, Alabama started 12-games and was on the field for 831 of UC's 850 offensive plays in 2016.

FIVE BEARCATS ON SENIOR BOWL WATCH LIST

- RB Mike Boone, CB Grant Coleman, OL Korey Cunningham, LB Jaylin Minor and CB Linden Stephens were named to the initial watch list to the 2018 Reese's Senior Bowl.
- The Senior Bowl annually features the country's best senior collegiate football players and top NFL draft prospects on teams representing the North and South that are coached by the entire coaching staffs of two NFL teams.
- The 2018 Reese's Senior Bowl takes place on January 27, 2018 at Ladd-Peebles Stadium in Mobile, Alabama and is televised on NFL Network.

FROM HOCKEY SKATES TO FOOTBALL CLEATS

- OL Morgan James does not have the traditional background of a college football player.
- He did not play in high school and spent time after graduation playing hockey in the Southern Professional Hockey League. The big man was an enforcer on ice.
- His first exposure to playing football occurred when he joined the Bearcats during training camp in the fall of 2015.

THE FRENCH CANADIAN CONNECTION

- TE Bruno Labelle, a native of Quebec, Canada, had a dream of playing NCAA FBS football since he was young.
- Discovered by the Bearcats during a summer prospect camp on campus, Labelle earned a scholarship offer and enrolled at UC in January 2016, going through spring ball.

FOOTBALL ADDS GRAD TRANSFER WR JAQUAY SAVAGE

- Graduate transfer WR JaQuay Savage joined UC in late Aug.
- Savage, a 6-3 native of Tyrone, Georgia, spent the past three years at Louisville and earned his bachelor's degree in 2017.
- He has 19 career collegiate games under his belt, starting six. He has 16 receptions for 206 yards and a pair of TDs.
- The Sandy Creek HS product comes out of the same prep program as former Bearcats standout WR Alex Chisum and UC freshmen RB Jaelen Greene and WR Javan Hawes.

MEDARIS ELIGIBLE THIS FALL

- WR Rashad Medaris is eligible this fall after sitting out 2016 following a transfer from Western Illinois.
- Medaris is the brother of former UC standout WR Anthony McClung and was a Class 6A All-State Selection out of Pike HS in 2014. Medaris had 88 receptions for 1,218 yards and 12 TDs during his two year HS career.

FORMER WALK-ONS DOT ROSTER

- The 2017 edition of the Bearcats features eight players who came to UC as walk-ons and earned a scholarship through hard work and dedication, including CB Grant Coleman, OL Garrett Campbell, S Sheldon Doss, OL Morgan James, OL David Niehaus, WR JJ Pinckney, OL Will Steur and LS Jon Vincent.

TROUT NETS A LANDING SPOT AT UC

- OL Kyle Trout will be eligible to play this fall as a graduate transfer from Ohio State.
- Trout earned his degree in family resource management from OSU in three years and is a junior with two years left.
- Trout played in nine games for the Buckeyes in 2016, seeing action in eight straight to end the season, including the College Football Playoff game against Clemson.
- The Lancaster, Ohio native was a four-star recruit out of HS.

SITTING OUT 2017

- UC has three Division I transfers sitting out the 2017 season due to NCAA regulations in CB TJ Johnson (Penn State), DE Ethan Tucky (Boston College) and TE Garrett Weaver (Mt. St. Joseph). They will become eligible to play in the fall of 2018.

ATTENTION TRAINING

- UC went through a series of 6 a.m. workouts in January, a period called Attention Training.
- The workouts, which took place outside in the snow and mud, forced the Bearcats to focus on details and not let the little things slip through the cracks during strenuous training.
- The Bearcats did not wear UC-issued gear during the first week as players and coaches had to earn the C.

T.E.A.M.

- Simply put, HC Luke Fickell's mantra Together Everyone Achieves More is one of the guiding forces for the UC program.
- The phrase adorns the team's workouts shirts, Coach Fickell's gameday attire and a band worn by members of the team.

THE CINCINNATI STRIPE

- A prominent feature on UC's football helmets and uniforms is a stripe with elements unique to the University and its beautiful campus.
- The height of the stripe is equal to that of the Cincinnati script on the home and road uniforms. The angles represented were inspired by the angles on numerous campus buildings and structures, including the new Nippert Stadium press box and the long red stairway inside the Richard E. Lindner Center. The triangles are representative of the windows of the Lindner Center, which are visible from Nippert Stadium on gameday and all throughout campus.

C-PAW PRIDE

- UC closed out its summer with the C-PAW Pride Dinner, recognizing top performers from the workout program.
- End of summer awards were given out recognizing those who were accountable to coaches, staff and teammates, achieved in the classroom and maintained positive attitudes.
- Points were kept for all workouts, events and activities during the summer with the top five point earners, OL Korey Cunningham, LB Joel Dublanko, DT Marquise Copeland, LB Perry Young and LB Jaylyn Minor, grabbing honors.
- QB Hayden Moore was recognized as the most improved from the start to end of the summer workout period.

IRON BEARCATS

- Director of FB Sports Performance Brady Collins and his staff implemented a new award during the summer program, the Iron Bearcat Award.
- The award doesn't recognize the strongest or fastest, but it recognizes the student-athletes who lead, show toughness, give incredible effort and are the most accountable.
- The inaugural winners of the Iron Bearcat Award were: Carter Jacobs, Devin Gray, Jaylyn Minor, Mike Boone, Marquise Copeland and Korey Cunningham.

A LEGEND RETURNS HOME

- RB coach Gino Guidugli, a member of UC's James P. Kelly Sr. Athletics Hall of Fame and a charter member of Nippert Stadium's Ring of Honor, returned to his alma mater after spending six seasons at Central Michigan.
- Guidugli was named CMU's offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach following the 2016 campaign after previously serving as the running backs coach and recruiting coordinator.
- Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Guidugli played professionally in the Arena and Canadian Football Leagues.
- He still holds seven UC school records and is the only signal-caller in school history to throw for 3,500 or more yards in a season and had 14 career 300-yard passing games.

FORMER BEARCATS ON STAFF

- Guidugli is not the only former Bearcat on the coaching staff. Joker Phillips (WR) and Ron Crook (OL) had previous stints on the coaching staff while Austin Bujnoch (offensive GA), Pat Lambert (defensive intern) and Doug Rosfeld (director, player development) all played for the Red & Black.

Carson Field at Nippert Stadium has been the venerable home of the University of Cincinnati football team since 1901 and provides the Bearcats with one of the best home-field environments in college football.

The third-oldest NCAA FBS stadium entered a new era in 2015 following the completion of a 20-month, \$86-million, privately funded renovation and expansion project. The reopening of Nippert Stadium coincides with the 100th anniversary of the 1915 original construction of the facility.

UC has used the Nippert site as a playing field since 1901, making it the second-oldest playing site in the nation for college football behind Penn's Franklin Field (1895).

Among NCAA FBS schools, Nippert is the third-oldest stadium still in use, behind Bobby Dodd Stadium (Georgia Tech - 1913), Davis Wade Stadium (Mississippi State - 1914) and ahead of Ole Miss' Vaught-Hemingway Stadium (1915) and Wisconsin's Camp Randall Stadium (1917).

Through numerous renovations, the structure situated in the middle of the Clifton campus has retained its early-century brickwork, wrought-iron gates, and trim giving Nippert a comfortable old-time stadium charm and appeal, while remaining a classic showplace for college football.

Both east and west concourses were completely renovated and widened and fans will find new concession stands and restrooms throughout the stadium, including ADA accessible seating and facilities. Concession stands feature the usual stadium staples along with offerings from premium local vendors. Nearly 75 permanent point-of-sale concession locations are available on gamedays.

East-side patrons with seats in Herschede-Shank Pavilion will notice the skywalks connecting O'Varsity Way to the upper deck, allowing them to bypass the main concourse and have a quick and easy route to and from their seats. Electronic ribbon boards will be installed on the face of the press box and Herschede-Shank Pavilion. These feature statistics, graphics, out-of-town scores and more.

All the seating benches are covered by red and silver Perma-Cap vinyl bleacher covers by Hussey Seating. The covering gives the

bleachers a different look and includes a CPAW painted in the south end zone student section.

The most striking changes, however, sits five stories above the west concourse. At 105,000 square feet and 130 yards long, the five-story West Pavilion rises out of the stadium concourse in glass and angles which contain a host of new premium seating along with state-of-the-art press facilities.

The curvature of the facility matches that of Herschede-Shank Pavilion on the east side of the stadium and contains four levels; a press and operations level, suite level, scholarship club level, and patio suites mezzanine level.

UC went from having nearly no premium seating options to the addition of 1,100 scholarship club seats and 53 indoor and outdoor suites of varying sizes. A skywalk connects Tangeman University Center to the West Pavilion with premium area customers able to access the facility on gameday from the other side of campus.

In addition, three new lighting poles were installed along with new lights on existing poles and on the roof facing of the press box. The stadium lighting averages 165 footcandles, a vast improvement over the previous number.

The 2015 project was the latest in a series of enhancements that began in 1916 when construction began on a permanent brick-and-concrete stadium structure, which was completed, section-by-section, as funds were raised.

In 1936, the playing field was lowered 12 feet to allow spectator seating to increase to 24,000.

The Reed Shank Pavilion was added in 1954 to bring the capacity to 28,000. In 1991, the capacity was upped to 35,000 through extending the upper deck, now called the Herschede-Shank Pavilion.

In 2005, a permanent grandstand added new and improved seating and gameday locker rooms in the North end zone along with a new videoboard, doubling the previous display.

Artificial turf was first installed in 1970 and in 2000, the stadium became one of the first in the U.S. to utilize FieldTurf, a grass-like

synthetic surface.

Prior to the 2013 season, UBU Sports' Speed Series S5-M synthetic turf system was installed as the playing surface at Nippert. The stadium's field orientation was shifted slightly north and west to even out the sideline areas and add a run-off area around the south end zone.

The stadium served as home for the Cincinnati Bengals, in 1968 and 1969, while their original permanent home at Riverfront Stadium was being constructed. It is currently the home field for FC Cincinnati, a professional soccer team in the United Soccer League.

The playing surface was widened and a new perimeter wall was constructed following the 2016 season, giving Nippert the ability to play host to international friendly matches on a FIFA regulation field.

A new LED video display was installed for the 2017 football season, called Lindner Family Vision thanks to a donation from the longtime Bearcats supporters. Nearly four times larger than the size of the existing active video display area, the new end zone display from Daktronics measures 31 feet high by 114 feet wide. The display is the same quality and model installed by the Cincinnati Reds in right field of Great American Ball Park prior to the 2015 MLB All-Star Game. It features a 13HD pixel layout for excellent image clarity, contrast, wide-angle visibility to ensure a great view from any seat within Nippert Stadium.

Nippert has also served as a venue for concerts by Britney Spears, Michael Jackson, NSYNC, Janet Jackson, KT Tunstall, The North Mississippi All-Stars, The Roots, the Cincinnati Opera Company and many more.

Two US Presidents have spoken at the stadium. On Oct. 16, 1936, President Franklin Roosevelt, running for a second term, appeared at Nippert Stadium and spoke from an open car in the rain to a crowd estimated at 15,000 and on Nov. 2, 2008, President Barack Obama held a campaign rally at Nippert two days before the 2008 Presidential Election to an estimated 27,000 attendees.

USA Today named Nippert as the best home-field venue in the former BIG EAST Conference and ESPN's Scott Van Pelt cited Nippert as a "one of the gems of college football".

WHAT'S IN A NAME?

- » During the season-ending clash with rival Miami (Ohio) in 1923, Jimmy Nippert sustained a spike wound injury and died a month later from blood poisoning. His grandfather, James N. Gamble of Procter and Gamble, provided the funds needed to complete the horseshoe-shaped structure, and the James Gamble Nippert Memorial Stadium was dedicated on Nov. 8, 1924.
- » The stadium's founder was Arch Carson, who as captain and principal organizer played a significant role in starting football on the UC campus in 1885. In 1901 as physical director of the university, Carson guided the construction of the field which was later named for him -- the playing surface is still called Carson Field.

LUKE FICKELL

HEAD COACH • FIRST YEAR • OHIO STATE '97

Veteran defensive coordinator and Ohio native Luke Fickell was named the University of Cincinnati's 42nd football head coach in December 2016.

The 18-year veteran of the FBS coaching ranks took the reins of the UC program after spending 15 years at his alma mater, Ohio State.

Fickell was hired on Dec. 10, 2016 and in the span of less than eight weeks, he hired a staff and put one of the top recruiting classes in the American Athletic Conference together. Since he hire, Fickell has been a tireless advocate for the Cincinnati program, speaking at numerous events and schools to continue to build the Bearcats brand inside the State of Cincinnati, the 50-mile radius surrounding the Clifton Hts. campus.

His impressive resume includes being on the staff of two national championship winning teams, seeing 12 of his players selected in the NFL Draft, and coordinating outstanding defenses over the last 12 seasons as a co-coordinator or defensive coordinator.

He is also an excellent recruiter with strong Midwest and Florida relationships, a national presence when needed and a discerning eye for talent. He was named the American Football Coaches Association assistant coach of the year in 2010 and he was named a "top recruiter" in 2012 by both Rivals and ESPN.

No stranger to championship-level football, Fickell was a part of nine Big Ten Conference titles (seven as a coach, two as a player) and two national championship squads at Ohio State. During his coaching tenure with the Buckeyes, OSU qualified for the College Football Playoff twice and played in 15 postseason games.

The former standout football player, college graduate, NFL player, husband and father is most-noticed as a developer of talent.

His NFL Draft selections include first-round picks A.J. Hawk, Bobby Carpenter, Ryan Shazier and Darron Lee, NFL standout James Laurinaitis and Joshua Perry, Anthony Schlegel, Larry Grant, Marcus Freeman, Austin Spitzer, Ross Homan and Brian Rolle.

The 2016 Buckeyes earned a spot in the College Football Playoff semifinal against Clemson after finishing the regular season 11-1 and ranked No. 3 in CFP poll. OSU won five consecutive games to close the season and boast the nation's No. 4 total defense (282.3 yards per game allowed), including the No. 1 pass efficiency defense and the No. 3 scoring defense (14.2).



Since 2005, Fickell-coached defenses at Ohio State have ranked among the NCAA FBS Top-40 in yards-per-play allowed, averaging a ranking of No. 17 and earning its highest rank of No. 3 in 2016. Cincinnati based ProFootballFocus ranks OSU's defense as its No. 3 overall unit in 2016.

Fickell's coaching career began at Ohio State. After spending a year on the injured reserve list with the New Orleans Saints, he was hired in 1999 as a graduate assistant at OSU by his college coach, John Cooper.

Fickell's first full-time coaching position came in 2000 under Lee Owens at Akron, spending two years as defensive line coach. Jim Tressel brought him to Ohio State as special teams coordinator in 2002 and he also worked with the defensive front on the BCA National Championship squad. He was named linebackers coach in 2004, and added co-defensive coordinator duties to his resume in 2005.

In May of 2011 he was asked to take over an Ohio State program staggered by the loss of its head coach, the unexpected departure of a star quarterback and on the cusp of NCAA penalties, and against stacked odds, he led the Buckeyes to a bowl game. Prior to his appointment to serve as head coach, he had been promoted to assistant head coach in March 2011.

He returned to his role as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach in 2012. Over the past five seasons, coaching under UC alumnus Urban Meyer, Fickell's defensive units have been a big reason the Buckeyes went 61-5 and won the 2014 College Football Playoff National Championship.

A native of Columbus, Ohio, Fickell is a graduate of DeSales High School, where he was a three-time, undefeated state wrestling champion, and he is a 1997 graduate of Ohio State. He played for the Buckeyes from 1992-96, redshirting the first year and then starting the next four seasons at nose guard. He started a school-record 50 consecutive games between 1993 and 1996.

Fickell graduated from Ohio State in 1997 with a degree in exercise science. Luke and his wife Amy have six children: Landon, Luca, twin sons Aydon and Ashton, and twin sons Laykon and Lucian.

DEFENSIVE LINE · FIRST YEAR · BOSTON COLLEGE '06

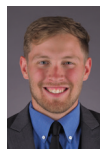
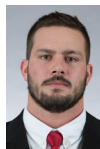
