CINCINNATI STORYLINES

- » Cincinnati returns two starters and eight lettermen from last season's team that finished 22-12 overall and advanced to the NCAA tournament for the third consecutive season.
- » The 2013-14 Bearcats are led by senior guard Sean Kilpatrick who was named first team All-American Athletic Conference by the league's coaches at AAC Media Day on Oct. 16 in Memphis. Kilpatrick averaged 17.0 points, 5.2 rebounds and 2.41 three-pointers last season and leads all current AAC players with 1,444 career points.
- » Senior forwards Justin Jackson and Titus Rubles man the UC frontcourt. Jackson ranked eighth in the BIG EAST Conference in blocks (1.37) last season. Rubles is UC's returning leader in rebounds (5.9) and assists (2.0).
- » The Bearcats were picked fourth in the American preseason coaches' poll. UC received 58 points to finish behind predicted league champion, Louisville (81 points), UConn (69) and Memphis (68). Temple was

picked fifth with 40 points, followed by SMU (39), Houston (28), USF (27), UCF (24) and Rutgers (16).

- » UC's Sean Kilpatrick and Carleton's Philip and Thomas Scrubb played against each other when USA met Canada in the final preliminary game of the 2013 World University Games in Kazan, Russia in July. The Canadians earned a 94-85 win over Kilpatrick and USA Basketball, preventing the Americans from advancing to the medal round. USA finished ninth while Canada took fourth.
- » The Bearcats are 3-0 in exhibition contests against Carleton. UC has won all 14 preseason exhibition games during the Mick Cronin coaching era and each of its last 34 dating back to an 85-82 loss to Athletes in Action on Nov. 18, 1995.
- » UC plays host to Bellarmine on Nov. 2 at 2 p.m., in its second preseason exhibition game before tipping off the 2013-14 regular season against North Carolina Central on Nov. 8 at 8 p.m. ET.

PREVIEWING THE GAME

- » The University of Cincinnati men's basketball team gives its fans their first glimpse at the 2013-14 squad on Saturday, Oct. 26 when the Bearcats play host to Canada's Carleton University at Fifth Third Arena. The exhibition contest tips at 2 p.m. and will be available only on BearcatsTV via a live stream at GoBEARCATS.com.
- » Saturday's matchup is the first meeting between the teams since 2010 when Cincinnati and Carleton played twice before the 2010-11 campaign. UC posted an 87-70 win on Sept. 4 in Ottawa, Ontario, during a three-game trip in Canada. The Bearcats also defeated the Ravens 89-57 in an exhibition contest at Fifth Third Arena on Nov. 1.
- » The Bearcats return two starters and eight lettermen from last season's team that posted a 22-12 overall record and advanced to the second round of the NCAA tournament. Senior guard Sean Kilpatrick returns for his final season as a Bearcat after averaging 17.0 points and 2.41 three-pointers a year ago. He was tabbed a preseason first team All-American Conference selection by the league's coaches last week at the league's media day.
- » Saturday's contest with Carleton is the first of two preseason exhibition games for the Bearcats. UC also welcomes Bellarmine on Nov. 2 at 2 p.m. The regular seasons starts against North Carolina Central on Nov. 8 at 8 p.m.

SCOUTING CARLETON

- » The Carleton University Ravens posted a 31-1 overall record last season en route to their ninth Canadian Interuniversity Sport men's basketball championship in the past 11 years. Carleton has won more CIS crowns than any other school in Canada.
- » The Ravens recorded an 87-game winning streak from 2003 to 2006.
- » Fourth-year guard Philip Scrubb was named the 2012-13 most outstanding player in CIS men's basketball for the second consecutive season. He finished the regular season with a team-high 18.6 points while connecting on 42.6 percent of his three-pointers. He also averaged 3.4 assists and 3.2 rebounds per game.
- » The Ravens finishes first in the Ontario University Athletics East with a 19-1 conference record while leading the league in scoring (91.0 points per game) and leading the nation in team defense (61.6 points allowed).
- » Earlier this summer several NCAA Division I schools visited Carleton's campus in Ottawa, Ontario. The Ravens defeated Towson (67-41 on Aug. 7), TCU (77-51 on Aug. 11) and Wisconsin (95-82 on Aug. 21). Syracuse also visited Carleton, edging the Ravens 69-65 in overtime on Aug. 23.
- » Carleton's Philip and Thomas Scrubb were also members of the Canadian national team that earned a 94-85 win over UC's Sean Kilpatrick and USA Basketball in the final preliminary-round game at the 2013 World University Games on July 12 in Kazan, Russia.
- » Thomas Scrubb had eight points and seven rebounds against USA while Philip Scrubb added five points, four rebounds and five assists. Kilpatrick has three points, two rebounds and an assist in 13 minutes against Canada. The setback was Team USA's second loss in the preliminary round and prevented the Americans from advancing to the medal round. Team USA finished ninth while Canada took fourth.

PREVIOUS MATCHUPS WITH CARLETON

- » Cincinnati is 3-0 against Carleton during the Mick Cronin coaching era. The Bearcats won the first meeting, a 64-54 decision on Nov. 1, 2008 in an exhibition contest at Fifth Third Arena.
- » The two teams met twice prior to the start of the 2010-11 season. The first matchup came in Ottawa on Sept. 4, 2010 when the Bearcats played three games against Canadian teams. UC posted an 87-70 win at Scotiabank Place thanks in part to Dion Dixon, who poured in a team-high 21 points on 8-of-9 shooting. Philip Scrubb led the Ravens with 15 points.
- » Carleton visited Fifth Third Arena for an exhibition game on Nov. 1, 2010 with the Bearcats posting an 89-57 victory. Yancy Gates led UC with 23 points while Dixon added 19 and Sean Kilpatrick contributed 16 points. Elliot Thompson led Carleton with 20 points on five three-pointers.

UC'S EXHIBITION RESULTS LAST SEASON

- » The Bearcats won both of their exhibition contests prior to the start of the 2012-13 season, posting an 80-60 win over Grand Valley State on Oct. 29 and earning an 86-51 victory over Bellarmine on Nov. 5.
- » Sean Kilpatrick led all scorers with 18 points to go with eight rebounds against Grand Valley State. JaQuan Parker (16), Cashmere Wright (13) and Titus Rubles (11) also reached double figures in scoring.
- » Parker produced a game-high 16 points on 7-of-9 shooting while Wright, Rubles and Jeremiah Davis all scored 13 points in UC's win over Bellarmine.
- » Runs to start the second half proved to be key in both games as UC used a 19-6 second-half run to pull away from Grand Valley State and a 19-0 spurt after intermission that sealed the win over Bellarmine.

EXHIBITION GAME WINNING STREAK

- » Cincinnati has won its last 34 preseason exhibition games dating back to an 85-82 loss to Athletes in Action on Nov. 18, 1995. The Bearcats owned a 22-point advantage only to see AIA comeback and take the lead on a four-point play by Scott Highmark with eight seconds left. Danny Fortson led UC with 23 points but fouled out with 7:07 to play.
- » The 1995-96 team went on to post a 28-5 overall record; claim the Conference USA regular season and tournament championship; and advance to the Elite Eight of NCAA tournament before falling to Mississippi State 73-63.

- SEASON NOTES -

AMERICAN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE COACHES PICK BEARCATS FOURTH

- » The Bearcats were picked fourth in the American Athletic Conference preseason coaches' poll the league announced Oct. 16 at its inaugural men's basketball media day at FedExForum.
- » UC received 58 points to finish behind predicted league champion, Louisville (81 points), UConn (69) and Memphis (68). Temple was picked fifth with 40 points, followed by SMU (39), Houston (28), USF (27), UCF (24) and Rutgers (16) in the 10-team conference.
- » The Cardinals were a unanimous preseason favorite to win the league, receiving all nine eligible first-place votes in the balloting of the coaches, who could not vote for their own teams. UConn, which received the other first-place vote, edged Memphis for second in the preseason poll.

KILPATRICK NAMED PRESEASON FIRST TEAM ALL-AAC

- » UC senior guard Sean Kilpatrick was selected preseason first team All-AAC by the league's coaches at the AAC's inaugural men's basketball media day on Oct. 16 at FedExForum.
- » Kilpatrick was joined on the first team by UConn's Shabazz Napier, Louisville's Chane Behanan and Russ Smith and Memphis' Joe Jackson.
- » Kilpatrick enters his final campaign at UC as a three-time all-conference selection in the former BIG EAST Conference. He earned back-to-back second team all-league honors in 2012 and 2013. As a junior, Kilpatrick averaged 17.0 points, 5.2 rebounds and 2.4 three-pointers, ranking fifth in the league in scoring and fourth in three-pointers made.
- » The preseason second team included UCF's Isaiah Sykes, UConn's Ryan Boatwright, Houston's TaShawn Thomas, Louisville's Montrezl Harrell and USF's Anthony Collins.
- » Louisville's Russ Smith was tabbed the conference's preseason player of the year while SMU's Keith Frazier was chosen as the league's preseason rookie of the year.

AMERICAN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE HOOPS

- » The 2013-14 basketball campaign marks the inaugural season of the American Athletic Conference. The league consists of 10 teams including five members of the former BIG EAST Conference (Cincinnati, Connecticut, Louisville, Rutgers and USF), four former members of Conference USA (Houston, Memphis, SMU and UCF) and Temple from the Atlantic 10 Conference.

- » The 2014-15 campaign sees the addition of East Carolina, Tulane and Tulsa. Louisville and Rutgers are scheduled to depart the league following the 2013-14 season. Louisville will join the Atlantic Coast Conference while Rutgers joins the Big 10 Conference.

KILPATRICK'S FINAL SEASON AT CINCINNATI

- » Senior Sean Kilpatrick closes out a standout career at Cincinnati this season and could end the year ranked among the school's best in several categories.
- » Kilpatrick enters the season 16th overall in scoring at UC with 1,444 career points. He needs 556 points to become only the second player in school history to score as many as 2,000 career points. (Oscar Robertson amassed 2,973 career points [1958-60].)
- » Kilpatrick has made 220 three-pointers during his career and needs 80 this season to rank as one of only three players in UC history to make 300 or more career triples. (Deonta Vaughn made 313 three-pointers [2007-10] while Darnell Burton made 306 [1994-97].)
- » He enters the 2013-14 campaign leading all returning American Athletic Conference players in career points (1,444) and career three-pointers made (220).
- » The fifth-year senior has played in every UC game (106) in his career (since 2010-11) and needs to see action in each of UC's first 26 games to set the school record for consecutive games played. (Keith Gregor played in 131 consecutive games [1993-96].)
- » Kilpatrick enters the season 34 games shy of becoming UC's career leader for games played. (Cashmere Wright played in 139 games [2010-13].)
- » With 3,166 career minutes of action, Kilpatrick is on pace to become only the second player in UC history to log as many as 4,000 career minutes played. (Deonta Vaughn played 4,310 career minutes [2007-10].)
- » See chart on page 5 for a complete listing of Kilpatrick's ranking in several UC career statistical categories.

KILPATRICK NAMED TO USA BASKETBALL WORLD UNIVERSITY GAMES TEAM

- » Senior guard Sean Kilpatrick was one of 12 players in the nation selected to represent USA Basketball at the 2013 World University Games in Kazan, Russia this summer.
- » Kilpatrick averaged 7.5 points and 2.0 rebounds in eight games with USA Basketball helping the squad to an eighth-place finish.
- » He scored a team-high 18 points on 7-of-14 shooting with four three-pointers against the United Arab Emirates in 24 minutes in the tournament opener.
- » Kilpatrick became the fourth UC player to compete for the U.S. team at the World University Games, joining Eric Hicks (2005), Kenyon Martin (1999) and Pete Mickeal (1999). Martin and Mickeal led the U.S. to a gold medal and 8-0 record. Martin led the team in scoring (13.9) and rebounding (6.6) while Mickeal led the squad in steals (3.3) and was third in scoring (9.1). Hicks' 2005 team also went 8-0 and claimed the gold medal. He averaged 6.6 points and 3.1 rebounds.

NEWS FROM THE WEIGHT ROOM

- » The 2013-14 Bearcats squad has made great strides in the weight room since the end of last season according to director of strength and conditioning Mike Rehfeldt.
- » Senior center David Nyarsuk has increased his weight to 250 pounds, gaining 33 pounds since the end of last season. At 7-foot-1, Nyarsuk owns the longest wingspan (7-foot-1.5) and longest reach (9-foot-6) of any player on this year's team.
- » Sophomore Shaquille Thomas has added 15 pounds and is listed at 205 pounds entering the season. He has gained 30 pounds since arriving on campus in August 2011. Despite the added weight to his frame, Thomas has increased his maximum vertical by five inches since last season and owns the best vertical touch on the team at 12 feet, 5 inches.
- » Senior Justin Jackson has gained 15 pounds of muscle since the end of the 2012-13 campaign while maintaining his body fat at 4.8 percent. He was recorded as bench pressing 185 pounds 18 times this summer, five more than the average forward at the NBA combine. His wingspan (7-foot) and reach (9-foot) are the second-longest on the team.
- » Senior Titus Rubles added 15 pounds to his frame since the end of last season. He tested as the most agile player on the team, finishing the team's lane agility in a team-best 10.32 seconds. His max vertical of 41 inches ranks among the best on the team.
- » Junior Ge'Lawn Guyn added 13 pounds during the offseason. He ranks first on the team for the highest maximum vertical (45.5 inches) and no-step vertical (38.5 inches).
- » Since arriving on campus this summer several freshmen have made strides as well in the weight room. Deshuan Morman (17 pounds), Kevin Johnson (15 pounds) and Jermaine Lawrence (10 pounds) all added weight.

TIP-INS

- » The 2013-14 freshman class was ranked among the Top 25 in the nation by several recruiting services, including Rivals.com and Scout.com. The class was led by freshman forward Jermaine Lawrence who was tabbed a five-star prospect and among the Top 25 players overall according to four recruiting services.
- » Cincinnati is one of 23 programs in the nation to participate in the NCAA tournament each of the past three seasons (joining Belmont, Duke, Florida, Georgetown, Gonzaga, Kansas, Kansas State, Louisville, Marquette, Memphis, Michigan, Michigan State, Missouri, North Carolina, Notre Dame, Ohio State, San Diego State, Syracuse, Temple, UNLV, VCU and Wisconsin.)
- » The Bearcats are a combined 74-32 during the past three seasons.
- » UC head coach Mick Cronin earned a contract extension in April, keeping him as the Bearcats head coach through the 2018 season. He earned his 200th career coaching victory during the 2012-13 campaign.

HIGHLIGHTS FROM LAST SEASON

- » Cincinnati made its third consecutive appearance in the NCAA Championship for the first time since 2003-05 behind strong team defense, a determined senior class and the talents of standout guard Sean Kilpatrick.
- » The Bearcats finished the 2012-13 season 22-12 overall and 9-9 in the BIG EAST Conference.
- » The senior class of Alex Eppenstein, Cheikh Mbodj (joined team beginning with the 2011-12 season), JaQuan Parker and Cashmere Wright helped lead the Bearcats to 93 overall wins, 39 BIG EAST Conference wins, three 20-win seasons (2011-2013), three NCAA Championship appearances (2011-13), an NCAA Sweet 16 appearance (2012) and a BIG EAST Championship runner-up finish (2012) during the past four seasons.
- » Guard Cashmere Wright finished his career as the only player in school history to tally at least 1,300 points, 475 assists and 175 steals. He ended his UC tenure as the school's leader in games played (139), ranked third in assists (482) and 22nd in points (1,317).
- » Center Cheikh Mbodj ended the season ranked 16th in the nation in blocked shots (2.65 per game). His 90 blocks ranked fourth for most in a single season at UC.
- » Gritty JaQuan Parker led all BIG EAST guards, averaging 2.04 offensive rebounds and ranking 12th in the league among players at all positions. He enjoyed the best offensive season of his career in 2012-13, averaging 10.9 points and shooting 40.0 percent from three-point range.
- » Guard Sean Kilpatrick was named second team All-BIG EAST by the league's coaches on March 10. He received the same award in 2011-12 and was named to the BIG EAST All-Rookie as a freshman in 2010-11.
- » Kilpatrick finished fifth in the BIG EAST in scoring at 17.0 points per game and was fourth with 2.41 three-pointers each contest. His 577 points during the 2012-13 campaign were the most scored in a season during the Mick Cronin coaching era.
- » Kilpatrick was named to the John R. Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 list by the Los Angeles Athletic Club and also was selected as one of 30 candidates for the 2013 Naismith College Player of the Year award.

CRONIN COACHING NOTES

- Signed contract extension in April 2013 keeping him as the Bearcats head coach through the 2018 season.
- Owns a 74-32 record during last three seasons with three consecutive trips to the NCAA tournament, including a 2012 Sweet 16 appearance.
- Has directed five teams to the NCAA tournament as a head coach. Has taken 12 teams as a head coach or assistant.
- Earned his 200th career coaching victory during the 2012-13 season.

CINCINNATI HEAD COACH MICK CRONIN

In his eighth season at his alma mater, Mick Cronin has returned pride to the University of Cincinnati basketball program by restoring its winning tradition with three consecutive trips to the NCAA tournament and reclaiming its place as a national contender.

Though the process was anything but easy - with a roster that included only one returning letterman when he arrived at UC in March 2006 - Cronin's steadfast determination and loyalty for UC spearheaded what could be considered one of the nation's top rebuilding efforts.

Cincinnati was the only program from a major conference to improve its win total every season from 2007 to 2011, building from 11 wins in 2007 to 26 victories and a return to the NCAA tournament in 2011. A year later, the Bearcats won 26 games again while advancing to the school's first NCAA Sweet 16 appearance since 2001. UC made its third consecutive NCAA tournament appearance last season as attendance figures at UC's Fifth Third Arena climbed to their highest average of the Cronin coaching era and a Top-50 national ranking.

A trip to the NCAA tournament in 2014 would make Cronin only the second coach in school history to take the Bearcats to the Big Dance four consecutive times (Bob Huggins sent 14 UC teams from 1992-2005).

Last season he earned his 200th career victory and enters the 2013-14 campaign with a 204-124 overall record after 10 seasons. He owns a 135-100 mark after seven years at UC, ranking third in school history. Cronin and UC reinforced their commitment to one another in April 2013 when the head coach signed a contract extension through the 2018 season.

TRACK RECORD OF SUCCESS

Success seems to follow Cronin, who came to UC after serving three years as head coach at Murray State (2004-06). As mentor of the Racers, Cronin compiled a 69-24 overall record while earning a pair of NCAA tournament berths.

In his debut season as head coach, Cronin directed Murray State to a school-best 28-6 record, the Ohio Valley Conference tournament championship, and an NCAA tournament appearance. His 28 wins are the sixth most in NCAA history for a first-year head coach. He earned OVC Coach of the Year honors two seasons later, guiding Murray State to another OVC title, league tournament crown and NCAA tournament appearance with a 24-6 mark in 2005-06.

Prior to earning a head coaching position, Cronin built a sterling reputation for his ability to evaluate and recruit top talent. In his stint at UC as an assistant coach for Bob Huggins from 1997-2001, Cronin recruited several top players, including NBA Draft selections Steve Logan (Golden State); DerMarr Johnson (Atlanta); Pete Mickeal (Dallas); Kenny Satterfield (Dallas); and Jason Maxiell (Detroit).

Following the 2000-01 season, Cronin became the associate head coach and recruiting coordinator at Louisville, under Rick Pitino. In his first year, Cronin helped attract a top-10 ranked recruiting class.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

Cronin's passion for success on the court also carries over to the Cincinnati community where he is committed to making a difference. He currently serves as a board member of the American Cancer Society's Coaches vs. Cancer of Southwest Ohio chapter.

He also assists with a major fundraising event - Soul of the City Soiree - for Our Daily Bread that has generated more than \$100,000 each of the past two years to assist the soup kitchen located in the Over-the-Rhine area of Cincinnati.

Cronin also annually speaks with the Young Executive Group of the Catholic Inner-City Schools Education (CISE) Fund. The group raises money from area corporations to help give children from low income urban settings the opportunity to attend Catholic schools.

PATH TO COACHING

Cronin has long held great pride in the Queen City, the University of Cincinnati and the sport of basketball. As a child growing up on the west side of town, he used to follow his father, Harold "Hep" Cronin -- a highly successful local high school coach with more than 400 career wins -- around the gyms of Cincinnati. A product of LaSalle High School, Cronin had his playing career end sooner than expected due to a knee injury in high school.

That didn't stop his desire to find his place in basketball. While completing his undergraduate degree at UC, Cronin served as assistant varsity coach and head junior varsity coach at Woodward High School. He helped develop six players who went on to play Division I college basketball, including former Bearcat Damon Flint, who ranks among the top 25 scorers in program history.

Cronin made the jump from high school to college coaching during the 1996-97 season joining Huggins as video coordinator for UC basketball. A year later, Cronin was elevated to an assistant coach for the Bearcats, setting the stage for his long tenure in college basketball.

Cronin resides in Cincinnati with his seven-year old daughter, Samantha.
