UCFACTS

► Following the UCF football team's first regular season loss since 2016, the Knights rebounded with 56 unanswered points to start last week's 56-21 win over UConn. Since the start of the 2017 season, UCF has won 29 of their last 31 games overall and have won 18 straight league games in American Athletic Conference play.

► After the win over the Huskies, UCF looks to start American Athletic Conference play 2-0 for the third straight season when the Knights take on Cincinnati Friday night on ESPN. UCF is on their journey for a third straight American Championship after winning back-to-back titles in 2017 and 2018. UCF has won six conference championships since joining a conference in 2002 and four conference titles since 2013, one of just four programs in FBS to achieve the feat (Alabama, Clemson, Oklahoma).

► UCF is in its second season under head coach Josh Heupel, who led the Knights to a 12-1 record in his first season in Orlando and now has a career mark of 16-2. Heupel was named FWAA First-Year Coach of the Year after becoming just the third FBS coach in history to record an undefeated regular season in his first year as a head coach (Larry Coker - Miami, 2001; Chris Peterson - Boise State, 2006).

► UCF played in the 2019 PlayStation Fiesta Bowl last season. The Knights' men's and women's basketball teams both played in the NCAA Tournament last season. UCF and Michigan were the only schools in the nation in 2018-19 to have their football team in a New Year's Six Bowl and both basketball teams in the NCAA Tournament.

► For the last two full seasons, every sport that plays a head-to-head schedule at UCF has finished with a winning record. The Knights are the only FBS athletics program in the nation to do so in 2017-18 and 2018-19. CBS Sports ranked UCF as the 17th best athletics department in the nation for the past year.

The Knights and the Bearcats have met four times since both teams joined the American Athletic Conference, beginning in 2015 when Cincinnati defeated UCF 52-7 during the Knights' 0-12 campaign.

UCF has now won three in a row over Cincinnati, including last season's 38-13 in primetime after hosting ESPN College GameDay on campus earlier in the day.

In last season's victory, UCF held Cincinnati scoreless in two quarters and recovered three fumbles.

McKenzie Milton threw three touchdowns and rushed for one, while Greg McCrae added a score on the ground to lead the UCF offense.

• Fickell led Cincinnati to a record of 11-2 last season, but both losses came during conference play, including a road loss at UCF late in the season.

• So far in 2019, Cincinnati has defeated UCLA, Miami (Ohio) and Marshall, but lost 42-0 at Ohio State.

• Desmond Ridder has completed 64.3 percent of his passes and thrown eight touchdowns, while Michael Warren has rushed for 262 yards and four scores on the ground in 2019.

LAST TIME OUT

Following its first regular season loss in over two seasons, the UCF football team bounced back in a big way Saturday night, scoring 56 unanswered points to start the game and ultimately defeating visiting UConn 56-21 in front of 44,164 at Spectrum Stadium.

The UCF defense, which came into the game having forced just three turnovers in its first four games, came away with four on Saturday, the most since forcing five at ECU on Oct. 20, 2018.

And it was the Knights' (4-1, 1-0) defense that made the first move, as Antwan Collier picked off Jack Zergiotis on the Huskies' (1-3, 0-1) third play from scrimmage.

Dillon Gabriel hit Otis Anderson on a 25-yard strike on UCF's first offensive play, before Greg McCrae rushed twice, the second into the end zone, and gave the Knights a 7-0 lead they did not look back from.

UCF got three of its four turnovers in the first quarter, which led to a 28-0 score at the end of one period.

Gabriel connected with Gabriel Davis on a 73-yard touchdown and Adrian Killins Jr. exploded for a 75-yard touchdown run up the middle to help the UCFast offense keep pace with the defense.





ORLANDO'S HOMETOWN TEAM NOTES

AWESOME ACADEMICS

- ▶ This past spring, UCF Athletics posted a department grade-point average of 3.24, the fifth highest in program history, which now gives UCF 11+ years and 23 straight semesters with a department average GPA of 3.0 or better.
- ▶ This spring, 64 percent of UCF's student-athletes posted a 3.0 or better, with 30 Knights posting a 4.0 GPA for the semester.
- ▶ The Knights' football team earned NCAA's Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition award this past spring for posting a multi-year score within the top 10 percent of all teams in the sport, the third time in the last four years the team has done so.

SOLD OUT SEASON TICKETS

- ▶ All of the success on the field has led to success in the seats, as season tickets for all home games at Spectrum Stadium have been sold out for the first time in program history in 2019.
- ▶ The atmosphere in the "Bounce House" is always electric and recently 247 Sports ranked Spectrum Stadium as the fourth toughest home-field advantage behind Alabama, Clemson and Georgia.
- ▶ ESPN.com cited UCF's Zombie Nation tradition among the best in college football. When "Kernkraft 400" by Zombie Nation starts playing inside the stadium and 45,000 fans start bouncing...let's just say there's a reason for the nickname. Don't mind the shaking.
- ▶ The announced attendance for week one against Florida A&M was 44,073, for week three against Stanford it was 45,008, and this past week's game against UConn was in front of 44,164.

MCNAMARA COVE (THE LAZY RIVER) IS A GO!

- ▶ McNamara Cove—and "Covegating"—officially are coming to UCF in 2020. Covegating in McNamara Cove will generate new operating revenues for UCF Athletics while also delivering college football's most unique gameday tailgating experience for both individuals and corporate clients.
- ▶ UCF will offer a capacity of 250 all-inclusive "Covegating" membership packages for all regular-season home football games that includes food, beverage and parking among other amenities.

THREE NEW YEAR'S SIX BOWLS SINCE 2013

- ▶ UCF played in its first BCS Bowl game in 2013, defeating Baylor in an upset in the Tostitos Fiesta Bowl, finishing the year ranked 10th in the AP Top 25.
- ▶ The Knights have now played in back-to-back New Year's Six bowls, defeating Auburn in the 2018 Chick-fil-A Peach Bowl to secure an undefeated national championship season in 2017, and then playing LSU in the 2019 PlayStation Fiesta Bowl last year.
- ▶ UCF is one of just nine teams in all of FBS to have played in three BCS/New Year's Six bowls since 2013, joining Florida State, Michigan State, Ohio State, Alabama, Clemson, Oklahoma, Washington and Auburn.

KNIGHTS IN THE TOP 25

- ▶ The Knights were ranked 17th in both the Preseason AP Top 25 Poll and the Preseason Amway Coaches Poll prior to the start of the 2019 season and are currently 18th and 19th in the AP Poll and Coaches Poll, respectively.
- ▶ It marked the highest UCF has been ranked before the season, the second time being ranked prior to the season and the second straight year earning a preseason ranking.
- ▶ As it stands, UCF has been ranked in the Top 25 for 33 straight weeks, dating back to week 6 of the 2017 season. The Knights have been in the rankings 46 times in total with the first being week 11 of the 2010 season. UCF's highest ranking was six, the final ranking of the 2017 season.

PICKED TO WIN THE AMERICAN

- ▶ UCF was picked to win the American Athletic Conference by the polling media at this year's American Kickoff in Newport, R.I.
- ▶ The Knights have won six conference championships in program history, but last season was the first time they were predicted to win their league. UCF is now 1-0 when picked to win the league and will aim to keep that record perfect in 2019.

#UCFAST OFFENSE NOTES**PRETTY DARN OFFENSIVE**

- » UCF has been one of the best offensive teams in the country the last three seasons and has put up the points to prove it, scoring 30 or more points in 31 straight games, which is the longest streak in the AP Poll era (since 1936).
- » The Knights have scored 40 or more points in 19 of their last 31 games and have reached the 50-point plateau 11 times in the last 31 outings.
- » Through five weeks of the 2019 season, UCF ranks second in the nation in total offense with 568.6 yards per game and sixth in scoring offense with 49.0 points per game.
- » UCF's 136 first downs in 2019 rank second in the nation.

TIME IS A FLAT CIRCLE

- » The Knights rank 122nd in the nation out of 130 teams ranked in 2019, but they don't care.
- » UCF has held the ball on average for 26 minutes and 18 seconds per game, but the team is still outscoring its opponents 49.0-19.4.
- » The Knights get it done with quick scoring drives. In fact, they have had 29 of their 36 offensive scoring drives under three minutes.
- » Twenty-four of those have been under two minutes and 12 have been under a minute.

DAVIS IS DOMINATING

- » Gabriel Davis has been impressive since stepping foot on the campus of UCF, starting in 2017 as a true freshman, but he's been at his best in his junior season, leading the Knights with 25 catches, 499 yards and eight receiving touchdowns through five games.
- » Davis's eight touchdowns rank second and he's already one score shy of cracking UCF's top 10 for touchdown receptions in a single season
- » His 19 career scores through the air rank eighth all-time at UCF
- » Davis has had back-to-back 100-yard games and ranks 11th in the nation with 499 yards.

FRESHMAN FINDING HIS WAY

- » True freshman Dillon Gabriel has earned the starting role for the Knights in 2019, and has been prolific through five games, currently 74-of-120 for 1,338 yards.
- » Gabriel has thrown multiple touchdown passes in all five games of his collegiate career, ranking seventh in the nation with 14 touchdowns in 2019
- » He has been extremely efficient, ranking sixth in the nation with a 190.5 passing efficiency. To put that in perspective, McKenzie Milton owns the UCF single-season record with a passing efficiency of 179.29 in 2017.
- » He was named the Walter Camp National Player of the Week, the AAC Offensive Player of the Week and the Manning Award Star of the Week for his performance against Stanford.

AK ALL THE WAY

- » Adrian Killins Jr. has made his mark on the UCF program with his blazing speed, earning all-conference honors the last two seasons in The American.
- » Killins is second only to Greg McCrae in UCF's record books with a 5.8 yards-per-carry average in his career. He is also fourth in school history with 31 total touchdowns, tied for sixth with 22 rushing touchdowns, and ninth with 2,140 career rushing yards.
- » He has rushed for 310 yards and four scores, while catching five balls for 102 yards and a score in 2019.

MCCRAE MAKING MEMORIES

- » Former walk-on Greg McCrae made the most of his time in the backfield last season, becoming the first UCF back to rush for over 1,000 yards since 2013.
- » His 1,182 yards on the ground were the fourth most in a single season in UCF history, while his 8.9 yards-per-carry average ranked second in the nation and set a program record.
- » McCrae leads the Knights with 323 yards and four scores through five games in 2019 and is now the current school record holder for career yards per carry at 7.8.





#UCFIERCE DEFENSE NOTES

STRONG START

- ▶ The UCF defense has looked solid in 2019, ranking in the top 40 in the nation in both total defense and scoring defense.
- ▶ The Knights forced 13 Florida A&M punts in week one, which was a new program record for UCF. Winning 62-0, it marked UCF's first shutout since Sept. 8, 2018, a 38-0 win over South Carolina State.
- ▶ This past week, the Knights held UConn scoreless until the fourth quarter.

BREAKING UP AIN'T HARD TO DO

- ▶ The Knights have broken up 36 passes as a team through five games in 2019, an average of 7.2 break-ups per game.
- ▶ Nevelle Clarke leads the way with eight break-ups and ranks eighth in the nation with 1.8 passes defended per game
- ▶ Aaron Robinson and Richie Grant have five each for the Knights.

TERRORIZING TFL NUMBERS

- ▶ The UCF defense has been making it tough on offenses in 2019 with their ability to get pressure on the quarterback.
- ▶ The Knights rank sixth in the nation with 9.2 tackles for loss per game, but it's been a team effort. Not a single UCF player has enough to even be ranked nationally.
- ▶ Senior linebacker Nate Evans and senior defensive end Brendon Hayes lead the way with 4.5 tackles for loss each.

BAKING TURNOVERS

- ▶ The UCF defense was very good at turning its opponents over the last two seasons, ranking sixth in the nation with 28 turnovers gained in 2018.
- ▶ In fact, the Knights had recorded at least one turnover in 32 straight games, dating back to 2016, a streak that led the nation by 14 games before it was snapped in week one.
- ▶ UCF was third in the nation with 14 fumbles recovered in 2018. Linebacker Nate Evans had two himself, returning one for a 94-yard touchdown at ECU.
- ▶ The Knights finished the 2018 campaign ranked third in the nation in turnover margin with a mark of 1.08, but had only come up with three turnovers in the first four games of 2019.
- ▶ That changed this past week when UCF used four turnovers to dismantle UConn. The Knights now rank 32nd in the nation with a 0.60 turnover margin.

DEEP DEFENSIVE BACKFIELD

- ▶ The UCF secondary looks like its running back, wide receiver or offensive line groups when talking about depth, which will be needed after Brandon Moore's injury suffered in week one.
- ▶ First-team all-conference member Richie Grant ranked third in the nation with six interceptions last year, while Nevelle Clarke's 13 pass break-ups led the Knights.
- ▶ Clarke is back at it in 2019 with his eight break-ups and a pick, while newcomer Tay Gowan has been a part of two turnovers, recording a pick and recovering a fumble.

SPECIAL NOTES

KICKIN' IT

- ▶ Matthew Wright left UCF as the program's all-time leader in field goals made, field-goal percentage, extra points made and consecutive extra points made.
- ▶ Dylan Barnas is the next man up and has gone 5-for-6 on field goal attempts this season, including two makes over 40 yards.
- ▶ Freshman Daniel Obarski has taken over kickoff duties and connected on his two extra point attempts this season.

OTHER SPECIALTIES

- ▶ Mac Loudermilk is also gone, so Andrew Osteen has taken over as the Knights' punter.
- ▶ Osteen has punted 19 times for 825 yards in four games, an average of 43.4 yards per punt in his first collegiate action. Osteen's 71 yard punt at Pittsburgh was the third longest in UCF history.
- ▶ Alex Ward is in his first season as the first team snapper.

Josh Heupel is the 11th head coach in the history of UCF Football. UCF Vice President and Director of Athletics Dr. Daniel J. White announced the hire on Dec. 5, 2017.

Heupel made an immediate impact during his first year at UCF, leading the Knights to their second consecutive undefeated regular season and American Athletic Conference Championship. Heupel became just the third coach in history to lead a team to an undefeated regular season in his first year coaching. (Chris Peterson, Boise State, 2003 and Larry Coker, Miami, 2001).

Preaching a 1-0 mentality every week, Heupel's fast-paced offense posted 43.2 points per game that ranked sixth in the nation with an average margin of victory of 20.5 points. The offense churned out an average of 522.7 yards per game to finish the season ranked fifth in the nation. The ground game set a program single-season record with 3,448 yards on the ground. UCF averaged 265.2 yards rushing per game, good for eighth in the country. Running back Greg McCrae became UCF's first 1,000-yard rusher since 2013 with 1,182 yards on the ground, the fourth most in program history.

The passing attack was also one of the best in country behind quarterbacks McKenzie Milton and Darriel Mack Jr. UCF averaged 257.5 yards per game and 29 touchdowns on the year, including 14.94 yards per completion for the ninth best mark in the country. The quarterbacks were effective, posting the 21st best passing efficiency mark of 149.71, while throwing just seven interceptions, the fewest by a UCF team in program history. The offensive line kept the backfield clean with just 19 sacks allowed on the season.

Not to be outdone, the UCF defense had a stellar 2018 campaign. UCF allowed just 22.7 points per game and ranked sixth in the nation with 28 forced turnovers on the year. The Knights racked up 8.2 tackles for loss per game, the fifth most in the nation, and had 29 sacks. Richie Grant led the way with six picks, the third most in the nation, while Nate Evans had a pair of fumble recoveries, including a 94-yard touchdown recovery against ECU. Second-half adjustments were key to the Knights' success, as opponents scored just 8.5 points per second half, including 3.3 points per third quarter.

The Knights put a league-record 17 student-athletes on All-American Athletic Conference teams. Milton became the first player in conference history to repeat as the Offensive Player of the Year. He, offensive linemen Jake Brown, Cole Schneider and Jordan Johnson, linebacker Nate Evans, cornerback Nevelle Clarke and safety Richie Grant earned first-team honors. Wide receiver Gabriel Davis, offensive lineman Wyatt Miller, defensive linemen Titus Davis and Brendon Hayes, linebacker Pat Jasinski, kicker Matthew Wright and running back Adrian Killins, who was also honored as a kick returner, garnered second-team honors, while tight end Michael Colubiale and cornerback Brandon Moore achieved honorable mention status. Milton finished sixth in the Heisman Trophy voting.

UCF went 11-0 in the regular season, earning the American Athletic Conference East Division title and a spot in the championship game. The Knights came back from down 17 points to defeat Memphis in The American Championship, 56-41. The Knights earned a berth to the 2019 PlayStation Fiesta Bowl, where they ultimately fell to LSU, 40-32, snapping the team's 25-game win streak.

Heupel was named the First Year Coach of the Year by the Football Writers Association of America and was a finalist for the AP National Coach of the Year Award, the Paul "Bear" Bryant Coach of the Year Award and the Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year Award. He led UCF to as high as seventh in both the AP Top 25 and Amway Coaches Poll, the highest regular season rankings in program history. The Knights finished the year ranked 11th in the AP and 12th in the Coaches Poll.



National Championship Playing Career

Heupel was a national-championship winning quarterback at Oklahoma. He was runner-up for the Heisman Trophy in 2000 while leading the Sooners to a victory over Florida State in the 2001 Orange Bowl, sealing the national title for OU. In 2001, Heupel was the Associated Press Player of the Year, Walter Camp Award winner, Archie Griffin Award winner and a consensus All-America performer.

During his two seasons as the starting quarterback at Oklahoma, Heupel posted a 20-5 record. He passed for 7,456 yards and 53 touchdowns. Overall, he still ranks among OU's top three quarterbacks in passing yards, completions and touchdown passes, despite playing just two seasons. He was a junior college All-America performer at Snow College in Utah in 1999, throwing for 2,308 yards and 28 TDs. He was drafted in the sixth round of the 2001 NFL Draft by the Miami Dolphins.
