



season **OUTLOOK**

The 2008 season presents a unique set of challenges for the Cincinnati men's soccer team. Just 10 letterwinners return from the 2007 season, including four starters. The Bearcats welcome an incoming class of 17 student-athletes primed to compete for playing time.

FORWARDS

With the loss of Kenny Anaba, the seventh-leading scorer in UC history, and Patrick Baxter, the Bearcats will feature fresh faces up top in 2008. Sophomore Branden Stelmak, an NSCAA/adidas High School All-America selection in 2006, is a scrappy goal-scorer and should have an opportunity to earn a starting spot. Incoming sophomore Nick Weightmann trained with the team in the spring and the Scotland native looks for a starting spot. A trio of freshmen will bring needed depth and ability to the position. Local product Matt Bahner earned first-team all-state honors as a senior at Lakota West High School. Colby Catlett, a four-time all-conference selection, scored 58 career high school goals. Illinois state champ Francesco Furio scored 24 goals on his prep squad's run to the 2007 title and could play along the backline as well.

MIDFIELDERS

Junior Judson McKinney and redshirt sophomore Chris Thompson return to anchor the midfield group that loses three-year starter Noah Davidson and Matt Telting, who started all 20 matches last year. McKinney and Thompson combined for 35 starts, one goal, and four assists in 2007. Sophomore Mark Konitsch, who came on strong at the end of his freshman season and throughout the spring, returns after posting a goal and two assists in 18 matches in 2007. Junior Kieron Gradwell, healthy after spending the spring season recovering from injury, will have an

opportunity to make an impact at the defensive midfield position as well as adding depth to the backline. Junior Paul Hoste returns after seeing action in 15 matches as a sophomore. Sophomore Chris Mitchell, who transfers in from SUNY-Plattsburg, will have an opportunity to start on the left side. Freshman Alex Fernandes will fill an attacking midfielder role, while classmates D.J. Albert will compete for the defensive midfield job. Jabari Shaw, Nate Robinson and Darren Webber will provide depth on the wings.

DEFENDERS

UC's lone senior, Brad Simpson, returns as a three-year starter at center back, an all-conference caliber defender, and the team's unquestioned leader. Junior Luke Henke returns after starting 14 matches at right back in 2007. After losing all-conference pick Amir Ikner, the Bearcats will be looking for a center back to team with Simpson. Freshmen Kashmar Briscoe and Kit North each have the potential to fill that void in their rookie seasons. Will Davis, who trained with the team in the spring, will push for time at center back as well as defensive midfielder. Last year's left back, Lionel Jackson, led the team and finished second in the BIG EAST with eight assists. Vying to replace him in 2008 will be freshmen Sam Klosterman and Andrew Myton, who can play on either flank.

GOALKEEPERS

Sophomore Miguel Rosales returns after a stellar freshman campaign in which he posted seven shutouts and a 0.81 goals-against average. Redshirt sophomore Matt Williams will compete with Rosales for the starting position. A pair of freshmen round out the goalkeeping corps. Peter Steve, a state champion and three-time all-conference selection as a prep and Joey Barnard, conference goalkeeper of the year as a junior at McKinney (Texas) High School, solidify the position for the Bearcats.
