## THE AMERICAN TODAY

Eight days after Memphis and Cincinnati battled each other in a thrilling conclusion to their regular seasons, those same teams will play a rematch in the 2019 American Athletic Conference Football Championship at Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium in Memphis Saturday, Dec. 7, at 3:30 p.m. ET/2:30 p.m. CT. The game will be televised nationally on ABC.

The Tigers (11-1) clinched their third consecutive West Division title with a 34-24 win against the Bearcats last Friday at the Liberty Bowl. Cincinnati (10-2) had secured its first appearance in the championship game with last week's win against Temple. The winner of The American Championship will be eligible to be chosen for the Goodyear Cotton Bowl Classic as part of the College Football Playoff selection process.

This year's championship will be the fifth straight to be televised live on ABC. The American Digital Network will have exclusive pregame and postgame coverage from Memphis Friday and Saturday.

Cincinnati saw a nine-game winning streak come to an end in the regular season finale at Memphis. The only other loss on the Bearcats' ledger was a setback to then-No. 5 Ohio State Sept. 7. Cincinnati is looking for its sixth conference championship in the last 13 seasons.

A win against Memphis would give the Bearcats 11 victories in consecutive seasons and their fourth 11-win season in program history (2008, 2009, 2018). Cincinnati played the regular-season finale against Memphis without QB Desmond Ridder, who saw a streak of 23 consecutive starts end thanks to an apparent shoulder injury. QB Ben Bryant made his first career start last week and completed 20 of 32 passes for 229 yards and a touchdown with two interceptions against the Tigers.

RB Michael Warren II has rushed for 1,061 yards and 12 touchdowns, breaking the 1,000-yard mark for the second consecutive season. TE Josiah Deguarra leads the team with 34 catches for 470 yards and seven touchdowns, while WR Alec Pierce has 29 catches for 534 yards and two TDs.

The defense is led by S Darrick Forrest, who has a team-high 92 tackles and three interceptions. LB Michael Pitts has 5.5 sacks and 9.5 tackles for loss to lead the team in both categories, while S JaVon Hicks has a team-high four interceptions with four fumble recoveries.

Memphis enters the American Athletic Conference Championship as one of the hottest teams in the nation as the Tigers take a six-game winning streak into the postseason following the win against Cincinnati last Friday. The victory gave the Tigers their first 11-win season in program history and it hit a milestone as the program's 500th win.

The Tigers are playing in The American Championship for the third consecutive season, making Memphis one of eight teams in FBS history to reach three consecutive conference championship games. Memphis is 6-0 at home this season and has won its last eight home games.

QB Brady White enters the postseason as The American's leader in pass efficiency (177.7). White has completed 219 of 330 passes for 3,307 yards and 32 touchdowns against eight interceptions. Redshirt freshman RB Kenneth Gainwell leads all freshmen nationally in rushing at 115.1 yards per game. Gainwell has 1,381 yards and 12 touchdowns on 204 carries and is the Tigers' second-leading receiver with 41 catches for 492 yards and three more TDs. WR Damonte Coxie leads the team with 59 receptions for 979 yards and nine touchdowns.

The defense is led by LB Austin Hall, who has a team-high 62 tackles to go with two fumble recoveries ... The Tigers have pair of outstanding defensive ends – DE Bryce Huff has 6.0 sacks and 14.0 tackles for loss, while DE Joseph Dorceus has 5.0 sacks and 14.5 TFL.

## A League Of Our Own

American Athletic Conference teams are a combined 27-1 (.964) against opponents from outside the power conferences/Notre Dame this season.

## Conference Call

American Athletic Conference teams are 6-0 against Conference USA this season. The American is 4-0 against the Sun Belt, 3-0 against the Mountain West and 1-1 against the MAC. Teams from The American are 3-1 against FBS independents in 2019.

## To Be The Best ...

American Athletic Conference teams have played nine games against top-25 opponents in 2019. Conference teams have faced three top-10 teams this season.

## Exclusivity

The American, the Big Ten, and the SEC are the only FBS conferences that have at least three 10-win teams this season.

## Home Is Where The Wins Are

UCF has won 21 straight home games, trailing only Clemson (22) for the longest home winning streak nationally. Cincinnati has won 13 straight home games, which ranks seventh nationally.

## Ground Troops

Navy leads the nation in rushing, averaging 360.8 rushing yards per game.

## Two Steps Back

UCF leads the nation in tackles for loss, averaging 9.3 TFL per game. SMU is third at 8.8, while USF is sixth at 8.3.

## This Goes To 11

Memphis has won 11 games for the first time in program history.

## Orwellian

SMU has registered its first 10-win season since 1984.

## Bowling League

The American has seven bowl-eligible teams in 2019. UCF, Cincinnati, Memphis, Navy, SMU, Temple and Tulane will be continuing their seasons in bowl games. The American has had at least seven teams in bowl games in each year of the league's 12-team alignment, which began in 2015.

## What A Guy

Houston P Dane Roy was named as one of three finalists for the Ray Guy Award as the nation's top punter. Roy becomes the second American Athletic Conference player in as many years to be named a Ray Guy Award finalist, joining Cincinnati P James Smith, who made the final cut in 2018.

## Finally

Memphis QB Brady White is one of five finalists for the Johnny Unitas Golden Arm Award, which is given to the nation's top quarterback who is a senior, or a fourth-year junior on schedule to graduate with his class.

## It's East vs. West

The American's West Division finished the 2019 season with an 11-7 head-to-head record against the league's East Division, marking the second time in the five-year history of the conference's two-division format that the West had the better head-to-head record. West Division teams hold a 49-41 all-time lead against East Division opponents since 2015.

## Nice Runs

Cincinnati is 21-4 since the start of the 2018 season. SMU is 16-6 in its last 22 games. UCF is 34-4 since the start of the 2017 season.

## Malcolm In The Mid

Navy QB Malcolm Perry leads all quarterbacks in rushing at 136.4 yards per game. Perry ranks fifth among all FBS players in rushing trailing only Oklahoma State's Chase Hubbard, Wisconsin's Jonathan Taylor, Boston College's A.J. Dillon and Ohio State's J.K. Dobbins.

## Best In Class

Memphis RB Kenneth Gainwell is ranked 11th nationally in rushing at 117.6 yards per game. Gainwell is the only freshman ranked among the top 50 players in rushing.

## Passing Fancy

SMU QB Shane Buechele is sixth nationally in passing yards (3,626).

## Paper Or Plastic?

Temple DE Quincy Roche is sixth nationally in sacks with 13.0 total sacks and an average of 1.08 per game. SMU LB Patrick Nelson is eighth with 12.0 sacks and 1.00 per game.

## The Grind

USF has played the third-toughest schedule in the nation as ranked by the NCAA. Tulsa's schedule is rated 10th, while Houston's is 11th.

## The 2019 Championship

The 2019 American Athletic Conference Football Championship will be played Saturday, Dec. 7, at 3:30 p.m. ET and will be televised nationally on ABC for the fifth consecutive season.



The championship will be played between the champions of the East and West divisions, based on the highest winning percentage in conference games.

The site of the championship will be the home venue of the division winner with the highest winning percentage in conference games.

The following tiebreakers are in place for the 2019 season.

### Two-Team Tie for Divisional Championship

- Head-to-head result
- Divisional winning percentage
- Head-to-head results within the division against the team with the next best conference winning percentage, in descending order
- Winning percentage against common non-divisional conference opponents
- Higher-ranked team in the College Football Playoff Selection Committee rankings, provided that team wins in the final weekend of the regular season. If the higher-ranked team loses in the final weekend, then a composite average of computer rankings will determine the divisional champion.
- Overall winning percentage, excluding exempt games
- Coin toss

### Multiple-Team Tie for Divisional Championship

- RB Shamari Brooks ended the season with 1,046 rushing yards, becoming the 21st player in school history to surpass 1,000 yards in a season.
- QB Zach Smith had a career-high five touchdown passes in the season-finale.

## THE GAME

Saturday's game will be the 36th meeting between Cincinnati and Memphis in a series that dates to 1966 ... The Tigers hold a 22-13 series lead and have won the last four against the Bearcats, including a 34-24 decision last week in Memphis ... Cincinnati's last win in the series was a 34-21 win at the Liberty Bowl in 2013 ... Memphis is making its third consecutive appearance in The American Championship, while Cincinnati is in the championship game for the first time ... The schools were part of a three-way tie for The American title in 2014, the year before the conference championship game was introduced ... The 2019 championship marks the fourth time in NCAA FBS history that a conference championship game is a rematch of the final regular-season game between the participating teams ... The three previous times were in 2012 (Stanford beat UCLA in the Pac-12 Championship after winning the regular-season finale), 2017 (Boise State beat Fresno State in the Mountain West Championship after falling to the Bulldogs a week earlier) and 2018 (UAB won the Conference USA title against Middle Tennessee after the Blue Raiders took the regular-season meeting) ... This year's game marks the fifth time in as many years that The American Championship is carried live on ABC ... The American Championship has drawn more than two million viewers in each of its first four years.

The only other loss on the Bearcats' ledger was a 42-0 decision at then-No. 5 Ohio State Sept. 7 ... Cincinnati went 6-0 at home this season and has won 13 straight at Nippert Stadium ... The loss to Memphis also snapped a nine-game winning streak in conference play, dating to last season ... Cincinnati is looking for its sixth conference championship in the last 13 seasons ... A win against Memphis would give the Bearcats 11 victories in consecutive seasons ... Cincinnati has had three 11-win seasons in program history (2008, 2009, 2018) ... The Bearcats have overcome deficits of six or more points to win four times this season ... Ridder has completed 149 of 265 passes for 1,836 yards and 17 touchdowns ... QB Ben Bryant made his first career start and completed 20 of 32 passes for 229 yards and a touchdown with two interceptions against the Tigers ... RB Michael Warren II has rushed for 1,061 yards and 12 touchdowns, breaking the 1,000-yard mark for the second consecutive season ... TE Josiah Deguerra leads the team with 34 catches for 470 yards and seven touchdowns, while WR Alec Pierce has 29 catches for 534 yards and two TDs ... The defense is led by S Darrick Forrest, who has a team-high 92 tackles and three interceptions ... LB Michael Pitts has 5.5 sacks and 9.5 tackles for loss to lead the team in both categories, while S Ja'Von Hicks has a team-high four interceptions with four fumble recoveries ... Cincinnati has 24 takeaways this season ... K Sam Crosa has made 12 of 17 field goal attempts and has two walk-off gamewinners this season (vs. ECU and USF) ... P James Smith was a Ray Guy Award finalist in 2018 and has averaged 43.0 yards per punt this season ... Memphis enters the American Athletic Conference Championship as one of the hottest teams in the nation as the Tigers take a six-game winning streak into the postseason following a 34-24 win against Cincinnati last Friday ... The win against Cincinnati gave the Tigers their first 11-win season in program history and it hit a milestone as the program's 500th win ... The Tigers are playing in The American Championship for the third consecutive season, making Memphis one of eight teams in FBS history to reach three consecutive conference championship games ... This year's game will mark the first conference championship game to be played at Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium ... Memphis is 6-0 at home this season and has won its last eight home games ... The only blemish on Memphis' ledger this season is a 30-28 loss at Temple Oct. 12 ... The Tigers have averaged 41.5 points and 483.5 yards per game as well as 7.1 yards per play ... # COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a big success. Fans, including many who are new to the sport, enjoy it. The first College Football Playoff semifinals and national championship were the three most-viewed programs in cable television history.

## Every Game Counts

The playoff preserves the excitement and significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

## Four Teams

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

## Two Games, One Goal

The kickoff of the new year belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl and Sugar Bowl. The two teams winning the playoff semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. That game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

## Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

## Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

## Selection Committee

A talented group of high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are: Rob Mullens (chair), Frank Beamer, Paola Boivin, Jeff Bower, Joe Castiglione, Herb Deromedi, Ken Hatfield, Chris Howard, Bobby Johnson, Ronnie Lott, Gene Smith, Todd Stansbury, and Scott Stricklin.

## Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

## Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

The **Military Bowl presented by Northrop Grumman** takes place at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium in Annapolis, Maryland, while the events and activities surrounding the game are based in Washington, D.C. The American Athletic Conference will face an opponent from the Atlantic Coast Conference in 2019.

The **TicketSmarter Birmingham Bowl** takes place at Legion Field in Birmingham, Alabama. The American/Big East has partnered with the bowl since its inception in the 2006 season. The American Athletic Conference will face an opponent from the Southeastern Conference.

The **Bad Boy Mowers Gasparilla Bowl** is played at Raymond James Stadium in Tampa, Florida. Conference USA will provide the opponent for The American's team in the 2019 season.

The **Cheribundi Boca Raton Bowl** began in 2014 and is played at FAU Stadium in Boca Raton, Florida. The American representative will play a team from the Mid-American Conference in 2019.
