### 2000 CLUB

Junior Kevin Mensah gained 70 hard-earned yards on 21 carries and scored two touchdowns against the Bulls, becoming the ninth player in UConn history to rush for more than 2,000 career yards. With three games remaining this season and another season of eligibility to go, Mensah will take a shot at catching UConn's all-time leader, Donald Brown, and his 3,800 yards. He is currently at 2,409 yards.

### UCONN VS. RANKED TEAMS

Saturday's game vs. Cincinnati will be the 34th time in school history that the Huskies have faced a team ranked in the Associated Press poll at the time of the contest and UConn has three victories in those games, including vs. Houston on Nov. 21, 2015 when the Huskies defeated the No. 13 Cougars 20-17. The other wins were vs. No. 19 Louisville on November 24, 2012 by a 23-20 score in triple overtime and on Oct. 27, 2007 with a 22-15 win over No. 11 USF. UConn first played a ranked team in the 2001 season opener at No. 9 Virginia Tech. UConn has played the country's top ranked team once when it traveled to Miami on Oct. 5, 2002.

### RUNNING OVER MINUTEMEN

For the first time in 2019, the Huskies rushed for over 300 yards with Kevin Mensah (164) and Art Thompkins (135) both going over the century mark. It was the first time since 2010 that two UConn running backs had eclipsed the century mark in the same game. (Jordan Todman & Robbie Frey vs. Texas Southern).

Mensah notched a career-high five touchdowns in the 56-35 victory, becoming the first Husky since Wilbur Gilliard did it against James Madison during the 1993 season. With his performance, the junior running back earned American Athletic Conference Co-Offensive Player of the Week honors.

Thompkins reached the 100 yard mark for the first time in his UConn career and added a rushing score in the contest.

## GET HIM THE ROCK

Freshman Cam Ross hauled in a career-high nine receptions against Houston. Ross leads the Huskies with 40 catches for 478 yards, averaging a team-high 68.29 yards per game. With the combination of Ross with fellow freshman Matt Drayton, the Huskies could have one of the most dangerous receiving cores down the road.

Ross was named to the FWAA Freshmen All-American Watch List last week and backed up his addition with a nine catch, 120 yard performance against UMass. Ross hauled in a 59 yard TD pass to help the Huskies earn the road victory.

## FLASHES OF ART

The Huskies continue to see flashes from grad transfer Art Thompkins with his speed and elusiveness. Thompkins totaled a career-high seven catches for 54 yards and a touchdown against the Cougars.

The Huskies running back combined for 100 yards with 46 on the ground against Houston and rushed for a season-best 135 yards in the win over UMass on October 26.

## YOUNG PUPS ON DEFENSE

The Huskies received stand out performances by their underclassmen on the

defensive side of the ball against Houston. Freshman Jackson Mitchell made his first career start at linebacker and recorded a career-high 10 tackles. Mitchell now has **31 tackles** in his last **three games**.

Redshirt sophomore Rob King stepped up with a career-high nine tackles after Tyler Coyle and Diamond Harrell had to leave the game with injury.

## GIVE ME THAT

The UConn defense has turned the page on a tough 2018 campaign with bright stretches during 2019. A big change has been the ability to turn over their opponents. The Huskies **matched** last season's total of **11 turnovers forced** in only eight games this season.

## RED ZONE SUCCESS

UConn has taken advantage of its opportunities when the team gets in the red zone. On 25 trips, the Huskies have scored 22 times with 10 rushing touchdowns, eight passing and four made field goals. In 2018, the Huskies converted on 26 scores in 35 red zone opportunities.

## GROUND AND POUND

The Huskies won their season-opening game against Wagner, 24-21, behind a strong running attack from Kevin Mensah and Art Thompkins. Mensah rushed for 144 yards and one touchdown on a career-high 36 carries. It was the sixth time in the junior's career that he rushed for 100-yards or more.

In his UConn debut, Thompkins rushed for 91 yards and a score.

## GETTING TO THE QB

The Huskies racked up four sacks in their season opener against Wagner. Lwal Uguak (2.0 sacks), Pierce DeVaughn and Dillon Harris all registered their first career sacks. UConn only sacked the quarterback on 11 occasions in 2018 and did not record a four-sack effort. UConn has posted 7.0 sacks in 2019 after recording only 11 in 2018. Uguak leads the team with 3.5 sacks this season. Darrian Beavers sacked the QB a team-high 4.0 times in 2018.

## PENCILING IN PEART

Redshirt senior Matt Peart has started all 42 games that he has played since stepping on the UConn campus. The offensive lineman redshirted in 2015 and since then has been a fixture in the starting lineup.

## YOUTH OF A NATION

The UConn Huskies relied on a youth movement to eat up the majority of the playing time in 2018. The Huskies played 40 underclassmen (Freshmen, Redshirt Freshmen and Sophomores) last season which ranks T5th in the nation. The list of schools is below:

## CONTINUITY ON THE OFFENSIVE LINE

UConn had the same quintet play in every game on the offensive line in 2018 (LT Ryan Van Demark, LG Nino Leone, C Ryan Crozier, RG Cam DeGeorge, RT Matt Peart). The Huskies were one of only six programs nationally to start the same group in every game last season and are joined by Hawaii, Illinois, Louisiana, Ole Miss and Washington State.

Entering the season, the Huskies were tied for 11th in the country with 98 career starts among their offensive linemen.

Redshirt senior Matt Peart has been selected to participate in the 2020 Senior Bowl Watch List. The Senior Bowl's 2020 Watch List includes athletes from nearly every level of college football. These are the players who we are looking to fill the 110 roster spots that form the North and South squads for the nation's premier all-star game

## THE STADIUM

The Huskies moved into Rentschler Field in East Hartford for the 2003 season and are set to begin its 17th season as the home of UConn football. The stadium officially became known as Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in 2015.

UConn has an all-time record of 63-45 at Rentschler Field and a 35-16 mark in non-conference games. UConn set a new all-time single-game attendance record at Rentschler Field on Sept. 21, 2013 against Michigan with a crowd of 42,704. That capacity was achieved with extra bleachers brought in for that game. Against ECU in 2017 the Huskies had a record-low crowd with an announced attendance of 14,036.
