THE AMERICAN TODAY

Four teams from the American Athletic Conference are off to 2-O starts as UCF, Cincinnati, Memphis and SMU picked up their respective seconds wins of the young season Saturday.

Six of The American's 11 teams scored at least 35 points in their wins, while five of the six had at least 42 points. Two teams from The American broke the 60-point barrier.

The most exciting game turned out to be Memphis' 55-50 road win against Arkansas State as the schools combined for 105 points and 1,360 yards. QB Seth Henigan threw for 417 yards and five touchdowns in his second career start, while WR Calvin Austin III had six catches for 239 vards and three TDs.

SMU held a 7-6 halftime lead against North Texas, but the Mustangs picked up the pace in the second half to win 35-12 at Ford Stadium. QB Tanner Mordecai was 21of-33 for 312 yards and four touchdowns, giving him 11 TDs – the most by an SMU player in his first two games in program history.

No. 7 Cincinnati found itself locked in a 7-7 halftime tie with Murray State, but the Bearcats piled on 35 secondhalf points to win 42-7 at Nippert Stadium. RB Jerome Ford led the way with 113 yards and three touchdowns on 18 carries.

UCF rode a four-touchdown performance from RB Isaiah Bowser to a 63-14 win against Bethune-Cookman in Orlando. QB Dillon Gabriel threw for 312 yards and a touchdown and added a 44-yard rushing TD.

Temple went on the road for its first win of the season as two defensive touchdowns helped key a 45-24 victory at Akron. QB Justin Lynch threw for 245 yards and a touchdown and added a rushing TD in his first career start.

Houston enjoyed a second straight fast start and the Cougars were able to maintain the pace in a 44-7 win against Rice in the Bayou Bucket Classic. RB Alton McCaskill found the end zone three times (two rushing, one receiving), becoming the first true freshman at Houston since 2008 to score three touchdowns in a game.

Tulane rolled to a 69-20 win against Morgan State in Birmingham, Alabama, as the Green Wave built a 45-20 halftime lead. Nine players scored touchdowns for Tulane.

East Carolina and Tulsa held fourth-quarter leads against South Carolina and Oklahoma State, respectively, but saw their opponents rally down the stretch. The Pirates fell 20-17 to the Gamecocks on a field goal as time expired, whle the Golden Hurricane fell 28-23 to the Cowboys.

Cincinnati is 33-6 since the start of the 2018 season. UCF is 43-8 since the beginning of the 2017 season. Memphis is 22-5 and SMU is 19-6 since the start of the 2019 campaign.

Bullies

Cincinnati has won 29 consecutive games against unranked teams.

Consistency

Cincinnati has been ranked in 29 consecutive national polls, dating to the rankings of Oct. 6, 2019. The Bearcats would have to be ranked in the next four polls of the 2021 season to tie UCF's American Athletic Conference record of 33 straight national rankings.

Variety Show

Nine of the 11 American Athletic Conference schools have been ranked in the top 25 since the start of the 2018 season.

Welcome Aboard

The American's top two rushing leaders in 2020 were freshmen. SMU UB Ulysses Bentley led the league with 91.3 rushing yards per game, while East Carolina RB Rahji Harris was second at 78.0 ypg.

Veterans Day

Tulsa lost only eight letterwinners from last year's team. The Golden Hurricane has 14 'super seniors' who elected to return for 2021 with an extra year of eligibility.

Trailblazer

SMU QB Tanner Mordecai tied an American Athletic Conference record with seven touchdown passes against Abilene Christian in Week 1 and had four TD passes against North Texas last Saturday. The 11 touchdown passes are the most by an SMU player thorugh two games in program history.

Familiar Faces

The American Athletic Conference returns 10 of its 11 head coaches from last season. The only new head coach in The American in 2021 will be UCF's Gus Malzahn.

Great Eight

Cincinnati is the first American Athletic Conference team with a preseason top-10 ranking since Louisville was ranked No. 9 to start the 2013 season. The Bearcats' No. 8 preseason rank is the highest for an American Athletic Conference team in the league's history.

Draft Class

The American Athletic Conference saw 19 players selected in the 2021 NFL Draft, the most in conference history. Former Tulsa LB Zaven Collins (16th to Arizona) and former Houston DE Payton Turner (28th to New Orleans) were both first-round selections.

2021 COLLEGE FOOTBALL RULES CHANGES

Overtime

Teams will be required to run a 2-point conversion play after a touchdown when a game reaches a second overtime period. Previously, a 2-point attempt was required after the third overtime period.

Also, if the game reaches a third overtime, teams will run alternating 2-point plays, instead of starting another drive at the opponent's 25-yard line. This is a change from the previous rule, which started to use 2-point plays in the fifth overtime period.

This rules change is being made to limit the number of plays from scrimmage and bring the game to a quicker conclusion. Teams can still choose whether to kick the point after touchdown or run a 2-point conversion play during the first overtime period.

Team Area

The Playing Rules Oversight Panel approved the team area being permanently extended to the 20-yard lines, starting in the 2021 season. Previously, the team area extended to the 25-yard lines, but this area was expanded to the 15-yard lines last season to create more spacing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Unsportsmanlike Tactics

In an editorial change to the rules book, video board and lighting system operators have been included in those personnel who may not create any distraction that obstructs play.

Feigning Injuries

The panel supported the Football Rules Committee proposal to provide a framework to allow a school or conference to request a postgame video review about questionable actions through the NCAA secretary-rules editor/national coordinator of officials

Points Of Emphasis

- For the 2021 season, it will be a point of emphasis for officials to penalize any taunting action directed toward an opponent. Committee members think these actions reflect poorly on the game and can lead to unnecessary confrontations.
- Officials are directed to be alert to players who are significantly in violation of uniform rules and to send violators out of the game to correct the issue. This will include specifically the pants, jerseys and T-shirts that extend below the torso.
- Coaches should not enter the field of play or leave the team area to debate officiating decisions. Those who do so will have committed an automatic unsportsmanlike conduct foul.

COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

Every Game Counts

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a postseason event to determine college football's national champion on the field, while emphasizing the significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

Rankings

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

Tradition

The New Year's holiday period belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl Game and Sugar Bowl.

Championship Monday

The two teams that win the Playoff Semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. The national championship game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

Selection Committee

A talented group of 13 high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are Mitch Barnhart, Gary Barta (chair), Paola Boivin, Tom Burman, Charlie Cobb, Boo Corrigan, Chris Del Conte, Rick George, Will Shields, Joe Taylor, John Urschel, Rod West and Tyrone Willingham.

Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- · Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

BOWL PARTNERSHIPS

The American Bowl Lineup

American Athletic Conference teams are guaranteed at least seven bowl appearances annually as part of the conference's new postseason lineup, which began in the 2020 season and is in place through 2025...

The American, as it has done four times in the first six years of the current bowl cycle, will continue to send its champion to a New Year's Six bowl if that team finishes higher than the champions of four other conferences in the final College Football Playoff rankings. American Athletic Conference teams are also eligible for the College Football Playoff if they are among the top four teams in the final CFP rankings.

As part of the new bowl cycle, The American will annually send teams to the Military Bowl presented by Peraton against an Atlantic Coast Conference opponent, the Fenway Bowl in Boston, also against an ACC team, and a third annual spot which will alternate between the Lockheed Martin Armed Forces Bowl and the EasyPost Hawaii Bowl.

Additionally, The American will annually have four appearances in a group of eight bowls. The American extended its existing partnerships with the TicketSmarter Birmingham Bowl, the Union Home Mortgage Gasparilla Bowl, the RoofClaim Boca Raton Bowl, the Tropical Smoothie Cafe Frisco Bowl and the Cure Bowl.

New to The American's lineup are the SERVPRO First Responder Bowl, the New Mexico Bowl and the Myrtle Beach Bowl.

THE AMERICAN ON TELEVISION

The American and ESPN reached agreement on a 12-year media rights extension that began with the 2020-21 academic year.

With the current agreement, The American has a stronger and more extensive presence on ESPN's primary TV networks - ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU - than at any point in its history. The Conference will also be a valuable part of ESPN+, ESPN's industry-leading direct-to-consumer sports streaming service.

In football, a minimum of 40 regular-season telecasts per season will be televised on ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU, including at least 20 across ABC, ESPN and ESPN2, which represents increased annual exposure across those ESPN networks. The American Championship game will be televised each year on ABC or ESPN.

Beyond select Navy football games, all conference controlled football games from The American will air on an ESPN network or ESPN+.
