

Media Credentials

Credentials to cover Cincinnati home football games may be secured by contacting the Cincinnati Sports Communications Office (Kelby Siler coordinates football credentials). Credentials and parking passes will be mailed if requests are received at least one week in advance. Credentials requested less than a week in advance of the game will be available at media will call.

Credentials shall be allocated and space in the press box shall be assigned according to the following priority:

- (1) originating radio and television outlets;
- (2) daily newspapers providing regular coverage of Cincinnati and its opponent;
- (3) national news agencies servicing the print and broadcast media;
- (4) radio and television outlets providing regular coverage of Cincinnati and its opponent;
- (5) national or regional print, broadcast and electronic media;
- (6) officially sanctioned student media, specialty publications and electronic publications of Cincinnati and its opponent;
- (7) other types of print and broadcast media Spouses, dates, nonworkers and anyone under the age of 18 are not allowed in the media areas of the press box in compliance with the working code of the Football Writers Association of America (FWAA).

Entering The Press Box

An elevator to the press box is located at the 50-yard line on the west concourse of Nippert Stadium. A media credential is required for entry to the elevator.

Press Box Levels

The Nippert Stadium press box has three levels. The first level is for newspaper, radio, and television reporters. The middle level is for quests of the university. The upper level is for video crews, radio, and television outlets broadcasting the game, as well as coaches.

Press Box Services

A media packet, including a game program, game notes, depth charts and statistics, is available to each media member. A meal is provided before each game. During the game, guickie statistics are distributed after each quarter. Complete play-by-play, scoring summary, and individual and team statistics are distributed following the game.

In accordance with Football Writers Association of America guidelines, no cheering is allowed in the media areas of the press box in order to provide a proper working environment.

Sideline Passes

The University of Cincinnati follows NCAA guidelines regarding media representatives on the sidelines. Photographers and videographers are permitted to shoot between the 23-yard lines and the goal lines on both sidelines, or anywhere behind the restraining line in the end zone.

Internet

Wireless internet is available in the press box at Nippert Stadium. Members of the Sports Communications staff will be available to assist you. There is no access fee.

Telephones

Telephone lines are available in the Nippert Stadium press box. Media representatives requiring their own phones should contact Dan Krone, Assistant Director of Athletics for Facilities and Operations at (513) 556-3541.

Professional Scouts

Seats in the press box will be available to professional scouts on a first-come, first-serve basis based on availability. If seats are not available in the press box, scouts will be provided a reserved ticket along with a press box pass that will allow them access to the press area for statistics, notes and food. Requests should be made well in advance of the game to guarantee availability and should be requested through the Cincinnati Sports Communications Office.

Practices

During a typical Saturday game week, media may interview players and coaches 15 minutes prior to practice or immediately following practice on either Tuesday or Wednesday. Unless special arrangements are made, there are no player interviews the final two days prior to a game.

Practice is not generally open to the public. Anyone hoping to observe practice, should contact Kelby Siler in advance. Failure to do so, may result in an individual's removal from the venue.

Weekly Release

During the season, information about the University of Cincinnati football team is updated on a weekly basis and made available at www.GoBEARCATS.com.

Brian Kelly by Appointment

Coach Kelly and his entire coaching staff are available each weekday for one-on-one interviews. Contact Kelby Siler to schedule interviews.

BIG EAST Teleconference

The BIG EAST coaches are featured on a weekly teleconference each Monday, starting at 11:10 a.m. (ET) during the season. To access the teleconference, contact the BIG EAST Conference. A replay is available each Monday beginning at 5 p.m.

Brian Kelly Media Conference

The Bearcats hold a weekly media luncheon each Tuesday in the Richard E. Lindner Center. The luncheon, which begins at Noon, is hosted by Brian Kelly and selected players will be present for interviews.

Post Practice

Coach Kelly and the entire coaching staff are available for one-on-one interviews after practice on Tuesday and Wednesday during a typical Saturday game week.

BIG EAST Satellite Feed

The BIG EAST will begin its weekly satellite on Wednesday, September 5. The feed will be available each Wednesday afternoon during the season, concluding on November 28. Approximately three and a half minutes of highlights and interviews are available for Cincinnati and Coach Kelly. For satellite coordinates and scheduled times for the feed, contact the BIG EAST Conference.

Postgame Interviews

Cincinnati's locker room is closed to all members of the media. At home games, following a 10-minute "cooling off" period, head coach Brian Kelly and selected players will be brought to the Bob Goin Team Room. Requests for player interviews should be coordinated with the Cincinnati Sports Communications staff. The visiting team's locker room at Nippert Stadium will be operated according to the policy of the visiting team. Quotes for both teams will be provided by the Sports Communications staff shortly after they conclude.

Directions to Nippert Stadium

FROM I-71 South (Columbus)

- I-71 south to Exit 3 Taft Road (Taft is one-way going west).
- Stay on Taft approximately seven blocks to the intersection of Jefferson Avenue. University Plaza will appear on the right.
- Turn right at the University Plaza onto Jefferson Avenue.
- At the first light, turn left on Corry Street.
- · Corry Street Garage is on the left.

FROM U.S. 50 (Portsmouth and East)

- U.S. 50 to Taft Road (Taft is one-way going west).
- Stay on Taft to the intersection of Jefferson Avenue.
- Turn right at the University Plaza onto Jefferson Avenue.
- At the first light, turn left on Corry Street.
- Corry Street Garage is on the left.

FROM I-75 North or South

- Take Exit 3 Hopple Street. At the end of the ramp (stop light) turn left (east).
- Cross over interstate and through Central Parkway. Hopple eventually becomes Martin Luther King Drive, the campus will appear on the right.
- At the sixth light, turn right onto Jefferson Avenue.
- At the second light, Corry Street, turn right. Corry Street Garage is on the left.

FROM I-74 (Indianapolis and West)

- Take I-74 to I-75 south
- Follow directions above from I-75.

Fifth Third Arena at Shoemaker Center is to the right with Nippert Stadium next to it. Armory Fieldhouse is behind the Shoemaker Center. Gettler Stadium is on the left.



niversity of Cincinnati fans have had no trouble tracking the Bearcats due to their expansive media exposure.

WLW-AM 700 begins its 14th season as the Bearcats' broadcast partner. The station's 50,000-watt signal can project Cincinnati games to 38 states and a third of Canada, and worldwide via XM Channel 173, making it possible for UC football fans to hear every game.

WLW augments the broadcast coverage with pre-game and postgame programming. Additionally, head coach Brian Kelly is featured on an hour-long call-in show each week from the original Montgomery Inn, allowing Cincinnati fans to meet the coach and ask their questions up close and personal.

Dan Hoard returns for his eighth year as the play-by-play voice. Hoard has been a focal point of Bearcat broadcasts since coming to Cincinnati from Syracuse, N.Y. in 1995. He served as the Bearcats' radio voice in 1996 and handled the play-by-play on the local television football and basketball telecasts from 1996-2000. He took over the radio play-byplay duties in 2000.

Jim Kelly, a standout receiver for the Bearcats in the mid-1970s, returns for his 17th season as analyst. Former UC quarterback Deontey Kenner is back for his second season providing analysis as the third member of the broadcast team.

WXIX-TV 19, a FOX affiliate, is UC's television partner. FOX 19 produces and televises the weekly Brian Kelly Show. Brian Giesenschlag, the station's sports director, serves as the host of the show.

FOX 19 is the Cincinnati home for the BIG EAST television package, carrying all UC games plus other contests from the series. When possible, the FOX 19 originates its own broadcasts of Bearcat games, under the direction of Emmy-winning producer/director David Ashbrock.

UC continues to achieve regional and national exposure. The program's membership in the BIG EAST Conference opens extensive television arrangements with ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPN Regional Television for national telecasts and a regionally-syndicated Game of the Week package.
