THE OPENING KICKOFF

• Houston and Cincinnati are meeting for the 30th time in the history of the programs and second as co-Big 12 Conference members. The Cougars lead the all-time series 15-14 but have dropped four straight in the series (2019-present) after consecutive wins in 2015-16.

• The Big 12 is the fourth different league UH and Cincinnati have competed in together. The two schools were co-members of the Missouri Valley (1957-59), Conference USA (1996-04) and American Athletic Conference (2013-22). On July 1, 2023, each joined the Big 12. Cincinnati defeated Houston 24-14 a season ago inside TDECU Stadium.

• Like Cincinnati (Victory Bell win over Miami), Houston is fresh off a trophy-game victory, trouncing Rice, 33-7, last Saturday. Houston held Rice to nine first downs, the fourth fewest allowed by the Cougars against an FBS opponent since 2000. Rice's first third down conversion occurred with just over five minutes left in the game. The Owls were 0-of-11 on third downs before converting.

• Saturday marks Houston's first visit to Nippert Stadium since the 2021 American Athletic Conference Championship Game. The #4/3 Bearcats defeated the #16/16 Cougars, 35-20, snapping Houston's 11-game win streak, en route to an appearance in the College Football Playoff. Only two student-athletes from UH's current roster appeared in the game: offensive lineman **Tank Jenkins** who started at right guard and played 80 total snaps and tight end **Matt Byrnes** who appeared on special teams.

• Houston linebackers/DOGs coach **James Ross III**, who is in his first season with the Cougars, spent the 2022 season as Cincinnati's Outside Linebackers Coach, helping the Bearcats to a 9-4 record. That season, the Bearcats ranked 14th nationally in tackles for loss (7.2), 17th in red zone defense (.762) and tops in The American in total defense (335.5).

• UH Assistant Head Coach/Wide Receivers Coach **Derrick Sherman** hails from Cincinnati. As a four-year starter with 100+ receptions at Winthrow High School, he was a three-star prospect and ranked as Ohio's No. 29 overall prospect. The Cincinnati East-West All-Star Game participant was named all-city and all-region as a junior and senior. Sherman played collegiately at Purdue and Morgan State.

• The Cougars have limited opponents to a combined 38 first downs through the first three games. That total is the third fewest across Houston's first three games since 2000, trailing only 2021 (33 first downs) and 2016 (34 first downs). Houston ranks 23rd nationally in first downs defense after finishing the 2023 season ranked 103rd in the category.

• Houston wide receiver **Joseph Manjack IV**, who has hauled in a reception in 19 consecutive games, caught two touchdowns in last season's 24-14 loss to Cincinnati. Houston's defense was led by defensive back **A.J. Haulcy's** 13 tackles (10 solo stops) and **Jamal Morris's** 8.0 stops. Defensive lineman **Anthony Holmes Jr.** posted 2.5 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks.

• Head Coach **Willie Fritz**, who earned his first victory at Houston last Saturday, led #19 Tulane to a 27-24 win at #24 Cincinnati on Nov. 25, 2022, vaulting the Green Wave into the American Athletic Conference Championship Game while snapping Cincinnati's 32-game home winning streak. It marked Tulane's first win against a ranked team since 1984. Current Cougar **Keith Cooper Jr.** posted 5.0 tackles including a sack on the Bearcats' final drive in the Green Wave victory.

• Houston has held opponents to exactly 75 rushing yards in back-to-back games. Last time out, Houston limited Rice to 159 total yards (the fewest by a UH FBS opponent in TDECU Stadium history). One week prior, #15/13 Oklahoma's 75 rushing yards marked its fewest since being held to 72 yards vs. Texas Tech on Oct. 30, 2021. The last time UH held consecutive FBS opponents to 75 rushing yards or less was when it accomplished the feat in four straight to begin the 2016 season against Oklahoma, Cincinnati, Texas State and UConn.

LOUISIANA 13, HOUSTON 7

Date: Sept. 21, 1946
Location: HISD's Public School Stadium

On this date 78 years ago, the University of Houston faced then-Southwestern Louisiana Institute in its first ever intercollegiate football game, doing so as a member of the Lone Star Conference. Quarterback **Charlie Manichia** scored the first touchdown in Houston program history for the game's first points. The Cougars fell 13-7 in front of 11,000 fans. Under the direction of Head Coach **Jewell Wallace**, the Cougars went on to finish 4-6 during their inaugural season, bouncing back from their Week 1 opener to run off three consecutive victories including the team's first on Sept. 27, 1946, against West Texas State.

TEAM NOTES

- Then-linebacker **Hershey McLaurin** played 22 snaps for West Virginia against Cincinnati a season ago (Nov. 18, 2023). Then-SMU defensive back **Bryan Massey** logged 6.0 tackles alongside a 19-yard punt return against Cincinnati on Oct. 2, 2022, and 4.0 tackles with 41 kickoff return yards vs. the Bearcats on Nov. 20, 2021. Then-East Carolina defensive back **Teagan Wilk** registered one tackle and one pass breakup against the Bearcats on Nov. 11, 2022.
- Through its first two games of the season, Houston was averaging just 48.0 rushing yards per game (131st nationally) alongside 1.6 yards per carry and no rushing touchdowns. The Cougars broke things open last Saturday, totaling 237 yards on the ground (5.6 per carry) and three rushing touchdowns. UH's 237 rushing yards were its most since totaling 261 at South Florida on Nov. 6, 2021.
- **Robert Newhouse's** 237 rushing yards on Sept. 25, 1971, against Cincinnati stands as the fifth-most in UH program history. **Elmo Wright's** 244 receiving yards on Oct. 4, 1968, against the Bearcats stand as the sixth-most in team history. The Cougars have had three 100+ yards rushers in a game three times in its history including once vs. Cincinnati on Oct. 25, 1974, when **John Housman** (141), **Reggie Cherry** (116) and **Marshall Johnson** (102) reached the century mark.
- Twelve former UH standouts have played for the Cincinnati Bengals all-time including three First-Round selections: defensive tackle **Wilson Whitley** (1977; pick #8), quarterback **David Klingler** (1992; pick #6) and cornerback **William Jackson III** (2016; pick #24).
- Houston defensive lineman **Keith Cooper Jr.** is off to a standout start through three games. The Tulane transfer blocked a field goal alongside three tackles and a sack against UNLV, posted five solo tackles including a career best 3.0 tackles for loss at #15/13 Oklahoma and added two stops against Rice. Cooper Jr.'s three quarterback hits rank 13th among Power Four edge defenders.
- Houston wide receiver and punt returner **Mekhi Mews** sparked the Cougars with a 75-yard punt return touchdown last time out against Rice. The punt return TD was Houston's sixth since the start of the 2019 season – a mark which ranks second nationally. Mews is one of 23 players, including three Big 12 standouts, with a punt return TD this season. Meanwhile, Houston kick returner **Bryan Massey** ranks 25th nationally with a 22.6 return average.
- Twenty-nine different Cougars have recorded at least one tackle through three games this season highlighted by 24 different players earning a stop last Saturday against Rice. Houston's 24 different tacklers vs. Rice ranked as the fifth most by a Big 12 team this season.
- Houston quarterback **Donovan Smith** has strung things together in his last two games. Against Rice, Smith accounted for three total touchdowns (2 rushing, 1 passing). On Saturday, Sept. 7, at #15/13 Oklahoma, the senior completed 85.7% of his passes (24 of 28), the best mark by any quarterback nationally against a team in the AP Top 25 since 2022 (minimum 25 passes attempted).
- Houston and BYU pace the Big 12 with three cornerbacks each ranked inside the league's Top 16 for defensive grade according to Pro Football Focus (PFF). Houston's **Jeremiah Wilson**, who registered his second career interception at #15/13 Oklahoma, ranks sixth nationally and tops in the Big 12 among cornerbacks in defensive grade (85.8) and coverage grade (86.7). **Latrell McCutchin Sr.** ranks 12th in defensive grade (72.1) followed by **Ajani Carter** in 16th (70.6).
- Defensive lineman **Carlos Allen** paces all Big 12 interior defenders with an 87.5 rush defense grade. The mark ranks fifth in the Power Four. Defensive back **A.J. Haulcy** is third among Big 12 safeties in rush defense (84.0) and **Juwon Gaston** is sixth among league safeties in coverage grade (77.8). **Jalen Garner** is fourth among Big 12 linebackers in defensive grade (80.5).
- Houston's 2024 roster is comprised of 27 college graduates (23% of the roster). The total ranks 15th among FBS programs, ninth among Power Four programs and second among in-state programs.
- Houston's 63 newcomers are tied with Colorado for the most among Power Four members. The Cougars' 36 transfers are the second most among the Power 4 behind only Colorado's 44. It is tied with New Mexico State and North Texas for the fifth most in all FBS.
- Among Houston's 119-member roster, 63 student-athletes – or 52.9% – are entering their first season with the Scarlet & White this fall. The group consists of 26 defensive players, 30 on offense and seven specialists. It is made up of 27 freshmen, four redshirt freshmen, nine sophomores, nine juniors and 14 seniors. In total, 34 of the 63 players (53.9%) call the state of Texas home.
- Fritz was named the 16th head coach in UH history on December 3, 2023. The back-to-back American Athletic Conference Coach of the Year is in the midst of his 32nd season as head coach. Fritz ranks fifth nationally among active FBS head coaches with 209 victories, trailing only LSU's Brian Kelly (285), North Carolina's Mack Brown (285), Sam Houston's K.C. Keeler (264) and Iowa's Kirk Ferentz (210).
- Houston Football has relied on resources and valued feedback from current NFL players, including league veteran and Cougar great **Case Keenum**, alongside coaches and staff, with the first-year implementation of helmet communication. The Cougars have taken a "keep it simple" philosophy, limiting conversation to the call and tip as needed. Houston quarterbacks sport the "green dot" on offense while UH's free safeties, primarily **Kentrell Webb** and **Teagan Wilk**, have utilized the feature over the last two games.
- Several new themes have been seen and heard around the UH program this year including "recruit, retain and develop." According to Fritz, the Cougars are placing an emphasis on recruiting Division I student-athletes with character. Despite 36 first-year transfers on this year's roster, Fritz's emphasis will be to sign 20-25 high school players each year while using the transfer portal to fill in needs.
- Houston Football is in the midst of its 79th season (1946-present) and second as a member of the Big 12 Conference. The Big 12 is the seventh league the Cougars have competed in. As a member of the American Athletic Conference, alongside Cincinnati, from 2013-22, the Cougars went 80-53 overall, including 50-28 in league games alongside nine bowl appearances and four bowl victories.

TEAM NOTES

• Houston's 81.8 pass-block grade (PFF) last time out against Rice was its best since Sept. 23, 2023, vs. Sam Houston (84.2) and its second-best mark in the last 16 games dating to the end of the 2022 season. For the first time in at least 20 years, Houston returns just one starting offensive lineman (right guard **Tank Jenkins**). The Cougars are among four Big 12 schools with one or no returning starters on the offensive line.

• Ten Houston transfers have made their way to the Bayou City from the state of Louisiana this offseason: linebacker **Kendre Gant** (Louisiana), quarterback **Zeon Chriss** (Louisiana), defensive lineman **Keith Cooper Jr.** (Tulane), defensive back **Kentrell Webb** (Tulane), linebacker **Corey Platt Jr.** (Tulane), defensive back **Kriston Davis** (Southern), linebacker **Christian Brathwaite** (LSU), linebacker **Michael Batton** (ULM), long snapper **Pierson Parent** (Tulane) and offensive lineman **Dakota White** (Louisiana Tech).

• Through three games, UH has spread the ball out, completing passes to 12 different players including a combined 10 receptions by running backs. UH wideout **Joseph Manjack IV** has hauled in touchdown catches in two of UH's first three games. **Stephon Johnson** ranks 14th among Power Four wide receivers with six missed tackles forced after a reception. Tight end **Maliq Carr**, whose 82.1 run-block grade ranks second nationally among Power Four players, boasts five first down receptions (18th among Power Four tight ends) and 49 yards after catch (26th among Power Four tight ends).

• Through two games, the Cougars rank inside the Top 30 nationally in six statistical categories.

• Houston's 103 victories since the start of the 2011 season rank third in Texas, trailing only Texas A&M (106) and TCU (105). The Cougars are also third in the state for wins (77) since 2014, trailing TCU (83) and Texas A&M (79).

• Houston is picked to finish 15th among 16 Big 12 Conference schools, garnering just 157 points, according to the league's media representatives. The Cougars don't have to look far for team's bucking the trend. A season ago, West Virginia (9-4 overall, 6-3 Big 12), picked last preseason among 14 teams, finished tied for fourth. The Mountaineers finished tied with Iowa State, picked preseason No. 10.

THE 2024 SCHEDULE

• Houston's 12-game schedule ranks among the hardest in the country according to Phil Steele who utilized the "NCAA Method" to rank schedules, compiling each team's opponent's records from the previous season. The Cougars will face the nation's fifth-toughest schedule and the toughest schedule in the Big 12 Conference.

• UH will face five of the Big 12's best according to the league's preseason poll including preseason favorite Utah (20 first-place votes) and projected runner-up Kansas State (19 votes) during consecutive weeks at TDECU Stadium. The Cougars take on five opponents ranked inside the AP Top 25 Preseason Poll and US LBM Preseason Coaches' Poll: #12/13 Utah, #16/16 Oklahoma, #18/17 Kansas State, #21/21 Arizona and #22/24 Kansas. Houston takes on another pair of opponents receiving votes: Iowa State (33/15) and UNLV (---/5).

• After playing just twice out of the state a season ago, the Cougars will leave Texas on five occasions during 2024 capped by a regular season ending visit to BYU on Nov. 30. Despite 30 all-time meetings against Baylor, Houston's Nov. 23 Senior Day matchup inside TDECU Stadium, will mark the first ever matchup against the Bears on the Cougars' campus.

UP NEXT

• Houston returns to the friendly confines of TDECU Stadium for its Big 12 home opener against Iowa State on Saturday, Sept. 28. The matchup will be the first all-time between the two conference mates. Following the contest, the Cougars hit the road for two straight and will not return home until Saturday, Oct. 26, against preseason league-favorite Utah.

- Snap Cincinnati's four-game win streak in the series and be Houston's first against the Bearcats since Sept. 15, 2016
- Move Houston to 16-14 all-time against Cincinnati and 6-8 at Cincinnati
- Be Houston's second in the Head Coach **Willie Fritz** era and mark Fritz's 249th win of his career
- Move Head Coach **Willie Fritz** to 11-1 in his last 12 road contests (dating to the start of the 2022 season)
- Give UH consecutive wins in the same year for the first time since Nov. 12-19, 2022, vs. Temple (43-36) and at ECU (42-3)
- Be the Cougars' third Big 12 victory and the second Big 12 road victory (last: Nov. 4, 2023; 25-24 in overtime at Baylor)
- Be Houston's 12th road victory since 2021. UH's 11 road wins since 2021 entering the weekend rank 15th nationally.

HOUSTON (AP) – UNLV quarterback Matthew Sluka threw for 71 yards and two touchdowns and ran for 59 yards as the Rebels beat Houston 27-7 inside TDECU Stadium in the season opener for both teams and Willie Fritz's first game as the Cougars' coach.

Sluka, who was 6-of-13 passing, threw touchdown passes of 13 and 24 yards to Jacob DeJesus in the first half as the Rebels (1-0) led 14-0 at the half.

Jalen Catalon, who finished with two interceptions, had a 36-yard interception return for a touchdown in the third quarter.

Michael Allen rushed for 65 yards, and Jaden Braden caught two passes for 60 yards. UNLV outgained Houston 308-247 yards.

UNLV got its first win over a Big 12 team since beating Iowa State 34-31 in overtime on Sep. 20, 2008.

Donovan Smith finished 15-of-30 passing for 135 yards with two interceptions. **Mekhi Mews** caught three passes for 57 yards for Houston (0-1).

The Cougars avoided a shutout on a 2-yard touchdown pass from sophomore backup **Ui Ale** to **Joseph Manjack IV** with a minute left in the fourth quarter. Ale was 7-of-8 for 74 yards and a touchdown on the drive.

THE TAKEAWAY

UNLV: The Rebels dominated both lines of scrimmage. UNLV rushed for 195 yards. The UNLV defense finished with 10 tackles for loss, including six sacks. Jackson Woodard finished with 11 tackles, including three sacks.

Houston: The Cougars struggled with UNLV's rush throughout. Houston had 59 yards in the first half. The Cougars finished 2 of 15 on third downs.

NORMAN, Okla. (AP) – University of Houston senior quarterback **Donovan Smith** threw for 260 yards and a touchdown on 24-of-28 passing, but it would not be enough as #15/15 Oklahoma escaped with a 16-12 win over the Cougars at Gaylord Family-Oklahoma Memorial Stadium.

Oklahoma quarterback Jackson Arnold threw two touchdown passes to lead the Sooners.

The Sooners (2-0) struggled to move the ball and punted seven times. The Cougars (0-2) outgained Oklahoma 318-249 in total yards, including 260-174 in passing.

Oklahoma, which had six sacks and six turnovers in its opener, got a late interception from Robert Spears-Jennings to end one drive and a late safety to extend a slim lead.

Oklahoma led 14-6 at the half. The Sooners punted on their first two possessions, but led 7-0 after converting a muffed punt by Houston's **Mekhi Mews** into points when Arnold found receiver Brenan Thompson for a 10-yard touchdown pass on the next play.

The offense got going on the next possession, driving 81 yards in eight plays. Arnold threw to tight end Jake Roberts for an 11-yard touchdown strike to make it 14-3. Houston's **Joseph Kim** kicked a 43-yard field goal as time expired to pull the Cougars closer.

Houston scored quickly on its first possession of the third quarter. Smith found **Joseph Manjack IV** behind the defense for a 44-yard touchdown pass to make it 14-12.

A promising Oklahoma drive followed but fell short of the end zone when Arnold's pass intended for Deion Burks was intercepted by **Jeremiah Wilson** at the 7. It was Arnold's first pick and the team's first turnover of the season.

THE TAKEAWAY

The Sooners continued to struggle offensively and had to rely on their defense to bail them out. The Cougars needed a bounce-back performance after losing at home to UNLV last weekend, and they got one against Oklahoma even though they came up short.

UP NEXT

The Cougars return to TDECU Stadium to play host to crosstown rival Rice at 7 p.m., Saturday.

HOUSTON (AP) — University of Houston senior quarterback **Donovan Smith** threw for 142 yards and accounted for three touchdowns, and junior running back **Stacy Sneed** rushed for 82 yards and a touchdown as the Cougars earned their first win under Head Coach **Willie Fritz**, beating crosstown rival Rice 33-7 inside TDECU Stadium on Saturday night.

Sneed rushed around right end for a 65-yard touchdown with 5 1/2 minutes left in the first quarter, and junior wide receiver **Mekhi Mews** returned a punt 75 yards for a touchdown less than two minutes later.

After Houston senior linebacker **Michael Batton** recovered a muffed Rice punt, Smith, who finished 12-of-21, found junior wide receiver **Stephon Johnson** for a 44-yard touchdown pass midway through the second quarter as Houston took a 20-0 lead into halftime.

Smith rushed for touchdowns covering 1 and 37 yards in the second half. Redshirt freshman running back **Re'Shaun Sanford II** rushed for 71 yards for Houston. The Cougars (1-2) out-gained Rice 379-159 yards.

E.J. Warner finished 12-of-21 passing for 50 yards with an interception for Rice (1-2). Dean Connors rushed for 32 yards and had a 4-yard touchdown run.

THE TAKEAWAY

Rice: The Owls, who entered with a nation-best 11 sacks, had three sacks and nine tackles for loss overall. Rice went 2 for 13 on third downs.

Houston: The Cougars finally got going offensively after scoring 19 points over its first two games.

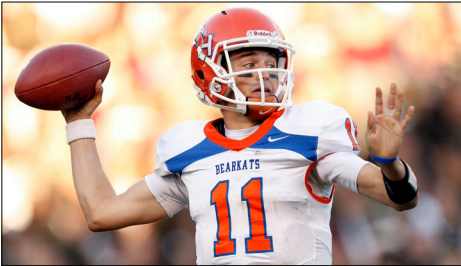

OFFENSIVE OVERVIEW

Houston's offense takes new form during 2024 under the direction of first-year offensive coordinator **Kevin Barbay** who joined the Cougars following recent stints in the same capacity at Mississippi State (2023), Appalachian State (2022), Central Michigan (2019-21) and Stephen F. Austin (2018).

The Cougars return 10 letterwinners on offense including senior starting quarterback **Donovan Smith** who is back for his second season with the Cougars and fifth season in the Big 12 Conference (Texas Tech; 2020-22). For its share of new faces, Houston's running backs room returns two student-athletes who saw significant time a season ago. Despite **Tony Mathis Jr.**'s season-ending injury during camp, 85.3% of Houston's rushing yards from 2023 are back.

The Cougars look starkly different up front with only right guard **Tank Jenkins** returning among starters. He is joined by returning letterwinners **Shamar Hobdy-Lee** and **Peyton Dunn**. To bolster the unit, Houston added a host of others including Power 5 transfer **Jake Wiley** (UCLA).

UH also mined the transfer portal as it looked to replace outgoing wide receiver production leaders Matthew Golden and Samuel Brown. In their place, returners **Joseph Manjack IV** and **Stephon Johnson** lead a unit which includes eight newcomers and six non-letterwinners returning.

After ranking 12th in the Big 12 Conference in scoring offense (23.7) and 13th in total offense (360.2) a season ago, the Cougars are looking to make strides during their second season in their new league home.

QUARTERBACK

- Donovan Smith (Sr.)** – Started all 12 games at quarterback in 2023... 256 of 397 passing (64.5 completion %) for 2,801 passing yards and 22 TDs... 138 rushes for 428 yards and 6 rushing touchdowns... 64.5 completion % ranked third in Big 12... one of eight Power 5 QBs with 250+ completions, 2,500+ passing yards, 20+ passing TDs and 5+ rushing TDs... six games with 20+ completions, 225+ passing yards and 2+ passing touchdowns were tied for fifth-most among Power 5 quarterbacks.
- Zeon Chriss (So.)** – Joined Houston after two seasons at Louisiana (2022-23) ... played in 12 games ... 111 of 168 passes for 12 TDs and 1,331 yards... completed 66% of passes and averaged 110.9 passing per games ... rushed for six touchdowns in 2023.

- Parker Jenkins (So.)** – Appeared in all 12 games including eight starts in '23 ... led the team in rushing yards (464) and yards per game (38.7)... had three rushing touchdowns ... 15 receptions for 81 yards ... Big 12 Newcomer of the Week ... first time in UH history a player accounted for 3 rushing TDs in his first start ... had five rushes of 50+ yards.
- Tony Mathis Jr. (Sr.)** – Will miss entire 2024 season after suffering ACL tear on Aug. 7 ... appeared in 10 games including two starts in 2023... 41 rushes for 170 yards... 11 receptions for 79 yards and a touchdown.
- Stacy Sneed (Jr.)** – Appeared in all 12 games including two starts in '23... ranked third on the team in rushes (48), rushing yards (282) and rushing TDs (1)... 13 receptions for 95 yards and a touchdown... fifth on the team in all-purpose yards (519)... 3.50 yards per rush after contact ranked ninth in Big 12 among running backs (min. 40 rushes)... 5.9 yards per rush ranked 12th in Big 12 among running backs (min. 40 rushes).

Houston junior running back **Stacy Sneed**'s 65-yard touchdown rush against Rice marked Houston's longest play from scrimmage this season. It was also Sneed's career long (previous: 58 yards vs. West Virginia; Oct. 12, 2023).

Houston's 81.8 pass-block grade (PFF) last time out in its Bayou Bucket victory against Rice was its best since Sept. 23, 2023, vs. Sam Houston (84.2) and its second-best mark in the last 16 games dating to the end of the 2022 season.

- **Mekhi Mews (Jr.)** – Joined UH after three seasons at Georgia (2021-23) ... appeared in 18 games including 13 during 2023.

DEFENSIVE OVERVIEW



The 2024 season is **Shiel Wood**'s 15th coaching Division I football and 11th on the defensive side of the ball. In all four seasons as Defensive Coordinator or Co-DC, his units have ranked inside the Top 25 nationally in rushing yards allowed – including tops in The American in 2023 and first in the Southern Conference in 2017.

The Cougars are relying on first-year Defensive Coordinator **Shiel Wood** to turn the tide for a unit which ranked 108th in the FBS with 31.5 points allowed per game a season ago. Houston looks to be aggressive in its coverage and lean into its personnel in hopes of replicating Wood's feats at Tulane a season ago which included ranking 24th nationally with 20.5 points per game allowed. Houston's defenses are multiple and base out of a 3-4 scheme. Up front, Houston had to replace its top-three sack leaders. Wood's Tulane defense boasted six different players with 3+ sacks and 35 total sacks, compared to the Cougars 25, a season ago.

- **Anthony Holmes Jr. (So.)** – Appeared in all 12 games including three starts in '23 ... 21 tackles, 4.5 tackles for loss, and 2.5 sacks ... third on team in tackles for loss (4.5)... 68.9 defensive grade was top among Big 12 freshmen interior defenders ... eight in Big 12 in QB pressures (20).
- **Carlos Allen (Jr.)** – Spent three years (four seasons including spring '21 season) at Kennesaw State before joining Cougars for 2024 season ... 24 career games played at Kennesaw State, piling up 48.0 career tackles including 11.5 TFLs ... Metro Atlanta All-Region honors at standout high school player at Frederick Douglass.

SPECIAL TEAMS OVERVIEW



Houston wide receiver and punt returner **Mekhi Mews** sparked the Cougars with a 75-yard punt return TD last time out against Rice. The punt return TD was Houston's sixth since the start of the 2019 season – a mark which ranks second nationally.

Head Coach **Willie Fritz**'s teams have historically prided themselves on success in special teams and the aim is no different in 2024 under Special Teams Coordinator **Mike Krysl**, who played for Fritz at Central Missouri (2005-07) and re-joined Fritz at Tulane as Special Teams Analyst. The Cougars returned primary place kicker and kickoff specialist **Jack Martin** (8 of 14 field goals and all 34 extra-points in '23). Houston once again went down under, bringing in Geelong, Victoria, native **Liam Dougherty** who is among three punting newcomers. The Cougars have seen no shortage of elite ability in the return game and have a trio of strong candidates. Wide receiver **Mekhi Mews**, who ranked 14th nationally in kickoff return yards (607) and 16th in punt return average (10.2) a season ago at Georgia, is Houston's primary punt returner. Kick returner and defensive back **Bryan Massey**, an SMU transfer, is one of nine active players with 1,000 kickoff return yards and 2+ kickoff return touchdowns since 2020. At snapper, **Jacob Garza** is back for his fifth season with the program alongside Division I transfers **Pierson Parent** (Tulane) and **Justin Wood** (Miami, Fla.). With the guidance of Krysl in 2023, Tulane ranked seventh nationally in kickoff return average (26.08) and 22nd nationally in punt return average (11.92).

HEAD COACH WILLIE FRITZ

FIRST SEASON AT HOUSTON (1-2) | 32ND SEASON OVERALL (248-123-1)

- Willie Fritz was named the 16th head coach in University of Houston football history on Sunday, Dec. 3, 2023. The 2024 season will be his first with the Cougars and 32nd overall.
- The back-to-back American Athletic Conference Coach of the Year boasts 31 years of collegiate head coaching experience.
- Fritz, who ranks fifth nationally among active FBS head coaches with 209 victories, led Tulane to consecutive American Athletic Conference Championship games. The Green Wave's 23 wins between 2022-23 ranked fourth nationally while the program's 15 conference wins were fifth in the country in that timeframe.
- The Shawnee Mission, Kan., native owns eight career 10-plus win seasons and seven conference championships, including the 2022 American Athletic Conference title. The 2023 Paul "Bear" Bryant Coach of the Year Award Watch List honoree is 247-121-1 all-time as a head coach dating to his 1993 beginnings at Blinn College.
- Fritz's Tulane teams spent 19 weeks ranked inside the AP Top 25 in 2022-23, including topping out at #9 following a thrilling 46-45 Cotton Bowl victory against #8 USC on Jan. 10, 2023. The Green Wave appeared in the CFP Top 25 rankings in 11 of 12 polls (91.6%) between the 2022-23 seasons. Tulane's 11 weeks in the rankings in that timeframe ranked as the 10th most nationally.
- Entering 2024, Fritz spent each of the last 31 seasons as a head coach, at Blinn College (1993-96), Central Missouri (2007-09), Sam Houston (2010-13), Georgia Southern (2014-15) and Tulane (2016-23). During that stretch, he has coached 54 players who were either NFL Draft selections or NFL free-agent signees.
- In 2022, Fritz led the Green Wave to complete the biggest turnaround season in FBS history, improving to 12-2 and a No. 9 final AP Poll ranking following 2-10 in 2021. The No. 9 finish was the highest final ranking since the program's undefeated 1998 season.
- As a result of his leadership during the storied 2022 season, Fritz was awarded with both the Dodd Trophy and the George Munger College Coach of the Year Award. The Green Wave's appearance in the 2023 Goodyear Cotton Bowl marked the 16th bowl appearance in the 128-year history of the program.
- In the 2021 regular season, Fritz guided the Green Wave to a 2-10 record after Hurricane Ida forced the team to evacuate for a month. Overall, five of the team's 10 losses came by one score or less. Following the 2021 season, Tulane had four players that earned post-season recognition from the American Athletic Conference in Ryan Wright (First), Dorian Williams (Honorable Mention), Sincere Haynesworth (Honorable Mention) and Macon Clark (Honorable Mention). The program also had 12 players that earned selection by Phil Steele Magazine for its All-American Athletic Conference Team.
- In 2019, Fritz led the Green Wave to the best start to a season in over 20 years and came within one spot of cracking the top 25 in both the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches Poll for the first time over 20 years. The Green Wave also established a strong home field advantage under Fritz's direction in 2019, as they posted a 5-1 record inside Yulman Stadium. Tulane's 2019 unit also featured an impressive rushing attack, which ranked 13th in the country, averaging 249.8 yards per game.
- In 2018, Fritz guided Tulane to its first bowl trip since 2013, a share of the American Athletic Conference title and just its sixth winning season in the last 37 years, while facing the second toughest schedule among teams from the conference.
- The 2017 campaign saw Tulane finish the year with its highest win total since 2013 despite facing one of the nation's toughest schedules, as nine of its opponents earned invitations to bowl games. In addition, four of the Green Wave's losses came by six points or fewer. The 2017 season also served as a milestone season for Fritz as he earned his 200th victory as a head coach and in the process became just the fourth active Football Bowl Subdivision head coach with 200 wins.
- Fritz was twice named the National Coach of the Year, including the American Football Coaches Association FCS Coach of the Year in 2011 and the Liberty Mutual FCS Coach of the Year in 2012. In his two seasons at Georgia Southern, he led the Eagles to a combined record of 17-7, a 2014 Sun Belt Conference title and the school's first NCAA postseason bowl game with a berth in the 2015 GoDaddy.com Bowl.

- Georgia Southern concluded the 2015 regular season with an 8-4 overall record including a mark of 6-2 in conference play.
- Fritz led the Eagles to a 9-3 overall record and a perfect mark of 8-0 in conference play during his first season at Georgia Southern in 2014, and was named the Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year. However, the school's waiver claim to allow Georgia Southern to play in a bowl despite being in the second year of the NCAA's transition period was denied. Georgia Southern was the first team in NCAA history to post an undefeated conference season in its first season at the Division I FBS level.
- Fritz served as head coach at Sam Houston from 2010-13, leading the Bearkats to back-to-back Southland Conference titles, NCAA Division I Championship game appearances in 2011 and 2012 and a third straight NCAA playoff berth in 2013. In 2011 and 2012, Sam Houston posted the two highest single-season win totals in program history with marks of 14-1 (2011) and 11-4 (2012) while more than 50 Bearkats student-athletes earned All-Southland Conference honors in his last four years, not including additional Player of the Year, Offensive Player of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year and Newcomer of the Year awards. All-America status from national coaching and media outlets were bestowed on 11 Sam Houston State players during his tenure.
- Fritz revitalized Central Missouri and guided the Mules to 11 winning seasons in 13 years. The NCAA Division II program's ledger included two 10-win seasons with the 2001 Mule squad earning its first postseason trip in more than 30 years. A 97-47 mark in 13 seasons ranked Fritz as the winningest coach in the program's history. He was the only coach to ever win seven or more games in eight consecutive seasons, and his victory total ranked him 15th among active Division II coaches at the time.
- In addition to his impressive 67.4 winning percentage with the Mules, Fritz coached his student-athletes to achieve their potential on the field and in the classroom. More than 150 Mules were recognized with All-MIAA honors with 41 first-team selections and 24 All-Americans.
- Under Fritz, Central Missouri recorded a graduation rate of 84 percent with 144 MIAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll recipients, 14 Academic All-Region and three Academic All-Americans. For all of his accomplishments guiding Central Missouri, Fritz was honored by the school with induction into its Athletics Hall of Fame on Feb. 11, 2017.
- Prior to his time at Central Missouri and Sam Houston State as a head coach, Fritz spent two different stints as an assistant coach with the Bearkats. He first served as a graduate assistant during the 1984

- and 1985 seasons when he earned a master's degree in kinesiology. During that two-year stretch, Sam Houston State posted a 16-6 record and won the 1985 Gulf Star Conference championship.
- He returned to Sam Houston State a second time in 1991 after spending four years at Coffeyville Community College in Kansas under legendary coach Dick Foster, earning a promotion to defensive coordinator after one year. He stayed another two years to work for Coach Foster's Skip and the Red Ravens. During the 1990 season, Fritz served as the defensive coordinator where he helped guide the Red Ravens to a national title.
- When Fritz was brought back to Sam Houston State in 1991 under Ron Randleman as secondary and special teams coach, he instilled an attitude of excellence on special teams that would last more than a decade. The Bearkats' "block party" racked up 80 blocked punts, field goals and extra points beginning with Fritz in 1991 and lasting through 2004.
- In Fritz's first year as a full-time assistant coach at Sam Houston State in 1991, the Bearkats won the Southland Conference. That league title and an eight-win season launched Sam Houston State to the program's second-ever appearance in the NCAA Division I Football Championship.
- Fritz departed Huntsville for a second time prior to the 1993 season for an opportunity to be the head coach at Blinn College, where he would turn around a program that had only five wins in its previous three seasons.
- From 1993-96, Fritz and the Buccaneers would rack up 39 victories against only five losses with a tie and claim two national junior college championships. He was inducted into the NJCAA Football Hall of Fame for the environment of success he created at Blinn.
- One of seven children, Fritz is the son of the late Harry Fritz, who coached the Central Missouri football team in 1952 before continuing his career as the Executive Director at the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) in Kansas City. The elder Fritz also served at several colleges and universities in administration as an athletics director.
- Fritz played on two conference title teams and was a four-year starter at defensive back at Pittsburg State where he earned a Bachelor's degree in 1983. While working as a graduate assistant during his first stint with Sam Houston from 1984-85, he earned his Master of Kinesiology in 1986. Early coaching stops included a year at Shawnee Mission Northwest (Kansas) High School in 1983 and Willis (Texas) High School in 1986, with his return to Sam Houston for graduate school in between those years.

TDECU STADIUM

BERT F. WINSTON BAND COMPLEX

A 39,089-square foot building on the east end of TDECU Stadium housing the Spirit of Houston Band Recital Halls and classroom spaces, Coach Bill Yeoman Hall and the UH Athletics Ticket Office.

COACH BILL YEOMAN HALL

A 2,000-square foot tribute area to University of Houston history located on the northeast corner of TDECU Stadium. Serves as a gameday club for ticket holders in section 129 and north side loge boxes.

DORIS NANTZ PRESS BOX

The Doris Nantz Press Box contains seats for 70 working media along with a press dining area and a wired photographer work room.

FIELD SURFACE

The synthetic surface installed at TDECU Stadium is the SS-M manufactured by UBU. SS-M, a Speed Series product, is a slit-film turf blade with a sand/rubber combination for infill. It is the same surface installed at the Houston Football practice facility. The turf is designed to host a multitude of events, including but not limited to, high school football games, band practice, specific UH intramural events, etc.

LEGENDS PLAZA

A plaza area recognizing the proud tradition of Houston Football at the northeast corner of TDECU Stadium.

LOCKER ROOM (HOME)

State-of-the-art 5,000-square foot home locker room located at the southeast corner of TDECU Stadium. Views exclusive to the club area give those fans an opportunity to watch team members travel from the locker room to the field level.

LOCKER ROOM (VISITOR)

Located at the west end of the stadium with a field entrance in the northwest corner of TDECU Stadium. Multi-functional locker room can be split and serve two separate teams simultaneously.

ORIENTATION OF STADIUM

East-to-west giving fans and television audiences a spectacular view of the downtown Houston skyline while also keeping in line with the University's grid system and creating more efficient parking. Sun and shade studies were also conducted to improve the best level of comfort for Houston fans and not affect student-athletes.

PARTY PATIOS

Four (4) open-air lower bowl party decks with 24 armchairs (20 inches wide). Both the east and west lower bowl end zones contain a party deck with two located on the north lower bowl sideline.

PREMIUM SEATING

Consists of 5,000 of the 40,000 seats in the TDECU Stadium.

Club Area - The stylish club area is the ultimate Houston Football experience. With 12,400 square feet of multi-purpose club area overlooking the field of play, fans with access to the club area enjoy upscale food and drinks while receiving first-class hospitality on game days. The climate-controlled area also feature high-definition televisions and private restrooms. The area is also available to host special events, meetings and classes.

Suites - Spanning from end zone to end zone on the south side of TDECU Stadium with a view of downtown Houston, 26 premium suites each containing 12 outside padded arm chairs, four inside bar stools and entertainment area. Houston fans enjoy comfort and style in these 325-square foot suites with individual upscale service and amenities.

Loge Boxes - 42 loge boxes each containing four seats and high-definition monitors located throughout the stadium.

Club Seats - 766 armchair style padded club seats that are 22 inches wide and located in the lower bowl of TDECU Stadium.

Additional Premium Seating - 2,778 armchair seats that are 20 inches wide and 1,210 benches with backs with the majority located in the lower bowl of TDECU Stadium.

SUITE DECKS

Two (2) open-air party suites located on the suite level positioned at each end (east and west end) of the suites. Each open-air suite contains 60 padded armchairs (21 inches wide).

TICKET OFFICE

The University of Houston Athletics Ticket Office is located on the northeast corner of TDECU Stadium facing Cullen Blvd. The facility has eight exterior ticket-selling windows along with two interior windows in the ticket office lobby in close proximity to the stadium parking garage.

VIDEO BOARD

State-of-the-art HD-video board located on the west end of TDECU Stadium. Measuring 45 feet tall by 160 feet wide, the new video board is nearly triple the size of the previous video board (2,584 square feet) and ranks 11th nationally among all Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) schools. Installed by Piros with Daktronics handling the commissioning and integration, the new board is capable of generating more than 68 billion colors with a viewing angle of 170 degrees.
