Tournament Time

- The University of Cincinnati men's soccer team opens the inaugural American Athletic Conference Tournament with a first round match against Rutgers. The Bearcats are the nine seed in the tournament, while Rutgers is the eighth seed.
- The winner will move on to face regular season champion Louisville on Saturday, Nov. 9.
- The semifinals and finals will be held Friday, Nov. 15, and Saturday, Nov. 17, at Toyota Stadium in Dallas, Texas, home of Major League Soccer's FC Dallas.
- In last year's conference tournament, the Bearcats fell at Marquette in the first round, 3-0. UC last advanced in a postseason match in 2010, when the drew with UConn in the first round of the BIG EAST Tournament and advanced on penalty kicks. The Bearcats last win in a postseason game was in 2007, a 2-0 victory at Providence in the first round of the BIG EAST Tournament.

Series History

- Cincinnati and Rutgers have played 10 times, with RU holding a 6-3-1 advantage in the series. The Scarlet Knights took this season's meeting, 1-0, in Piscataway. Rutgers won the lone neutral match in 2001, a 2-1 decision.
- Cincinnati at Louisville would be meeting for the 40th time, with UC holding a 22-15-2
 advantage in the series. The Cardinals leads the series, 10-9, in Louisville. UC's 2-0 win over UL
 on Oct. 23 of this season was the only defeat in league play for the Cards and their only loss
 since September 14.

Dayes Marches On

- Head Coach Hylton Dayes has reached a pair of milestones this season, recording both his 200th career victory and his 100th win at UC.
- He recorded his 200th career win on Saturday, Oct. 19, with a victory over Belmont. For his career, Dayes' record is 201-194-54.
- Dayes picked up his 100th win as coach at Cincinnati on Sept. 13 at SIU Edwardsville. He now posts a record of 104-109-35 at UC, making him the program's second-winningest coach (Bob Muro, 114-111-13 in 12 seasons).



Temple Recap

- For the second consecutive game, the University of Cincinnati men's soccer team dropped a 1-0 decision in overtime, this time at Temple on Saturday, Nov. 2.
- The Owls controlled the run of play in the first 45 minutes, outshooting UC, 9-1. Bearcats keeper Alex Gill (Beavercreek, Ohio/Beavercreek) made three saves in the half.
- The second half saw things favor UC a little bit more, with the Bearcats having an 8-5 advantage on shots in the frame, while shots on target in the half were even at two apiece.
- For the second match in a row, the Bearcats went to extra time. The first 10 minute period was also scoreless, with each team getting one shot on target.
- The Owls earned the victory early in the second overtime when Ryan Bradbury sent a pass in to Vaughn Spurrier and Spurrier found the upper left corner for the gamewinner.
- UC had four shots on goal in the match, a pair by Gabriel Robinson (Easton, Pa./La Salle). Alan Rovira (Simi Valley, Calif./Simi Valley/Tyler JC) and Peter Jannelli (Springfield, Pa./Springfield) each registered a shot on goal. Gill made six saves to keep the Bearcats in the match, while Temple's Dan Scheck made four saves in the clean sheet victory.

TopDrawer Goal of the Week Nominee

- The Bearcats received national attention for their last second, game-winning goal against IUPUI in October.
- The goal, scored by sophomore Ben Keane (Mount Laurel, N.J./Bishop Eustace Prep), was a nominee for the TopDrawerSoccer.com College Goal of the Week.
- The clip is also approaching 6,000 views on the CincinnatiBearcats YouTube channel.



Gill Takes Over

- Redshirt freshman goalkeeper Alex Gill (Beavercreek, Ohio/Beavercreek), who went unbeaten in his first three starts also recorded a clean sheet against Evansville in his first career start.
- He has since added a pair of shutouts, including one at Cleveland State and another against No. 8/6 Louisville. He followed up the win over the Cardinals by keeping both No. RV/8 UConn and Temple off the scoreboard until overtime, with the Bearcats suffering a pair of 1-0 extra time losses to the Huskies and Owls.
- For his efforts, Gill was named Goalkeeper of the Week by the American Athletic Conference, the fourth time this season a Bearcat has been among the weekly honors.
- Gill has made 15 starts on the year, posting a .780 save percentage and 1.25 goals against average, en route to a 6-8-1 record.



Honors & Awards

- Prior to Gill's Goalkeeper of the Week Award, the last UC honor came on Oct. 7. John Manga (Lexington, Ky./Henry Clay) earned the nod after scoring UC's lone goal in a 1-0 win at Cleveland State. It marked the sophomore's first goal of the season and second of his career.
- Junior Ashani Walker (Kingston, Jamaica/Jamaica College) was honored for his three-point (one goal, one assist) performance in UC's overtime win at SIU Edwardsville. Walker had the gamewinning goal on a penalty kick in overtime.
- UC picked up its first weekly honor from the American on Monday, Sept. 9, when Alex Gill (Beavercreek, Ohio/Beavercreek) was named to the Weekly Honor Roll. He recorded a clean sheet in his first career start, a 2-0 victory over Evansville.
- The Bearcats had three players named to the Bearcat Soccer Classic All-Tournament team. Gill was joined on the squad by Alan Rovira (Simi Valley, Calif./Simi Valley/Tyler JC) and Ashani Walker (Kingston, Jamaica/Jamaica College), who each had a tally in the win over Evansville.
- At the season-opening Bert & Iris Wolstein Soccer Classic in Columbus, Matt Remaley (Highlands Ranch, Colo./Mountain Vista) and Rovira were named to the all-tournament team.
 Rovira had five shots on goal and started both matches, while Remaley made one start and had one shot on goal.



Playing The Best

- The Bearcats took on a ranked team for the fourth time this season when they visited No. RV/8 UConn, while also facing a top opponent for the second time in a week after scoring a victory over No. 6/9 Louisville.
- UC is 1-2-0 this season against ranked teams, having dropped a 4-0 decision to No. 14/7 Saint Louis and a 2-0 loss to No. RV/14 Memphis.
- UC has recorded 14 decisions over ranked opponents under Hylton Dayes (since 2001).
- The Bearcats are 4-36-7 against Top 25 foes since 2001, including a win against No. 1

• Last season, the Bearcats went 0-4-1 against ranked teams: falling 3-0 to No. 12/9 Indiana on Aug. 26, 2-1 at No. 22 Xavier on Sept. 2, 3-0 at No. 12/16 St. John's on Oct. 6, 1-0 to No. 14/18 Louisville on Oct. 27, and tying No. 21/20 USF 0-0 following double overtime on Oct. 3.



Preseason Chatter

- Richardo Israel (Free Town, Jamaica/Lennon), a year after being named to the BIG EAST All-Rookie team, has been named to the American Athletic Conference's Preseason All-Conference Team.
- Israel started all 18 games last season and was instrumental in the Bearcats' streak of 672 minutes without allowing a goal
- As a team, the Bearcats were picked to finish eighth in the inaugural season of The American
- Last season, UC finished fifth in the BIG EAST Red Division and fell in the first round of the tournament at No. 10 Marquette, 3-0.



New Kids On The Block (and Continent)

- With John Manga (Lexington, Ky./Henry Clay) as the only returning goal scorer from last season, UC has looked to add fire power via newcomers.
- Look for Alan Rovira (Simi Valley, Calif./Tyler Junior College/Simi Valley) and a pair of foreign imports, Brad Miguel (High Wycombe, England/Amersham & Wycombe College) and Calvin Opperman (Aukland, New Zealand/Saint Kentigern College), to be among the sources for offense.
- Rovira led Tyler Junior College (Calif.) to the junior college national championship last fall, leading the squad with 12 goals. He also boasts international experience, having played on the El Salvador U-20 national team and receiving a call up to the full national team for a friendly versus Honduras in 2010. The rookie recorded five shots during UC's first two matches of 2013, tops on the team.
- Miguel is an Englishman who was Amersham & Wycombe's leading scorer the past two years, while helping them finish in the top three of the English Colleges League twice
- Opperman comes from New Zealand, where he represented his country in the U-17 World Cup. The Kiwi has helped his senior squads finish in the top-two of the New Zealand National League tables.
- Miguel and Opperman become the fourth and fifth foreign players on the UC roster, joining Jamaicans Richardo Israel (Free Town, Jamaica/Lennon) and Ashani Walker (Kingston, Jamaica/Jamaica College), as well as Jonathan Cottrell (Dubai, United Arab Emirates/Dubai College).
- UC also welcomes eight other freshmen into the fold: GK Pedro Diaz (Mason, Ohio/Mason), D Jacob Hauser-Ramsey (Seattle, Wash./Kings), F Mark Simpson (Lauderhill, Fla./Pine Crest), D Miles Dale (Rochester Hills, Mich./Rochester), D Malik Morgan (Round Rock, Texas/Stony Point), F Rantz Bourgeois (St. Amant, La./St. Amant), M Brian Martin (Fishers, Ind./Hamilton Southeastern) and D Sam Revercomb (Charleston, W.Va./Charleston Catholic).



The American

- 2013 will mark the first season of competition for the American Athletic Conference in men's soccer. Joining UC, Louisville, Rutgers, UConn and USF from the BIG EAST will be Memphis, SMU, Temple and UCF for a total of nine men's soccer programs this season.
- The Bearcats have previously played all of the newcomers except Temple, highlighted by 22 matches versus Memphis dating back to when the two schools were members of Conference USA. UC leads the series with the Tigers, 12-10-0, with the last match having occurred in 2004.
- UCF won the only meeting with UC in 2007, while UC is 1-3-0 against SMU, with the most recent match in 2006.
- All nine teams will make the 2013 American Athletic Conference Tournament. The eighth and ninth-place teams will participate in a play-in match at the site of the regular season champion, for the right to move on to the quarterfinals, which will be hosted by the top-four teams in the league. The semifinals and finals will be played in Frisco, Texas, at FC Dallas Stadium, home of Major League Soccer's FC Dallas.
- Three teams in The American, Louisville, UConn and USF, reached the NCAA Tournament last season, while five of the nine schools finished the year in the top-35 of the RPI.
