LAST TIME VS. PITTSBURGH

UC picked up its first win of the season by defeating Pittsburgh, 5-2, at the Huntington Tennis Club on Jan. 23, 2005. The Bearcats won two of three doubles matches to take the doubles point. In the singles action, UC won at four spots. Cristina Reyes beat Becky Emmers at the top spot, and Hannah Hinton followed with a win over Jill Williams. Jill Klauck at No. 3 earned a straight-set win over Anne Davies and Julie Klauck posted UC's final win at the No. 6 place over Carlie Smith.

LAST TIME VS. WEST VIRGINIA

UC opened its spring season with a loss to West Virginia, 4-2, at the Huntington Tennis Club on Jan. 21, 2005. The Mountaineers swept the doubles category while winning three of five completed singles matches. Natalia Prinz defeated UC's Cristina Reyes in No. 1 singles while Kelly Walsh clinched the match with a thrilling, 6-4, 7-6, victory over Hannah Hinton in two seed action. Jill Klauck opened with a victory over Kathryn Gerber at No. 3 for UC and Samantha Liu followed with a win over Raynie Theis. WVU's Stacey Percival was a winner in a battle of freshmen after defeating Lindsay Willeford.

PLAYING SHORTHANDED

In UC's opening three dual matches, coach Kimberly Jones has had some difficulty filling out a lineup as only four Bearcats were healthy to play singles. Three of those missing were newcomers, but two were UC's leading returning winners, Jill Klauck and Hannah Hinton. With this lineup the Bearcats went 0-3, as freshman Elizabeth Young earned the only win. Hinton returned to doubles play last weekend and Klauck should be back this weekend.

YOUTH IS SERVED

Now in her third year, head coach Kimberly Jones is getting settled in her recruiting and this year has UC's largest freshman class in years. After graduating a very successful senior class last season, UC has five newcomers this year. Three of them, Carling Arundel, Jenny Rowen and Elizabeth Young, are tied for the team lead in wins.

SUCCESSFUL WEEKEND

Senior Jill Klauck and freshman Jenny Rowen each won consolation championships at the season-opening Spartan Cup in September, hosted by Michigan State. Klauck defeated Michigan State's Pascale Schnitzer, 6-4, 6-2, to claim the Flight A consolation title. For the weekend, she won three-straight matches after dropping her opener. Rowen won the Flight B consolation title by forfeit after earning victories in two of her first three matches.

FRESHMAN TRADITION

The Bearcats have boasted extremely successful freshmen in the last five years. Lyndsey Molony won 19 singles matches in 2000-01, the third-most ever by a UC freshman. Julie Klauck surpassed that total the next year with 20 wins, and Jill Klauck took it further in 2002-03 with 21 wins. Hannah Hinton won 17 singles matches and a team-best 23 doubles contests in her initial season. This year boasts three freshmen each have a team-best five singles wins: Carling Arundel, Jenny Rowen and Elizabeth Young.

HOME AT LAST

The Bearcats have been without on-campus courts since the 2000-01 season, playing at various venues around the city and a majority of matches on the road. This spring that changes as the brand new, six-court UC Tennis Center opens as part of the Richard E. Lindner Varsity Village. The inaugural match on the courts is scheduled for Wednesday, March 1 against Ball State.
