



Postgame Notes

No. 4 UConn 58, No. 1 Cincinnati 56

Records: UConn 26-7, Cincinnati 27-6

UConn advances to Saturday's final, where they will take on No. 2 Louisville. Tipoff is at 5 p.m. (CT) on ESPN.

The two schools met in the 2011 Big East Conference Final, where UConn won 69-66 for their fifth win in five days. The loss for Louisville was their last loss in a conference tournament.

During the regular season Louisville swept the Huskies, winning 76-64 and 81-48.

Cincinnati took a 41-37 lead with 13:43 left in the second half. UConn responded with a 17-2 run over the next 9:36 and never relinquished the lead.

UConn's Shabazz Napier led the Huskies in scoring for the 19th time this season, netting a game-high 15.

After 11 first half turnovers, the Huskies turned the ball over just four times in the second half.

UConn's Amida Brimah recorded at least four blocks for the eighth time this season.

UConn shot 50 percent or better on three-pointers for the eighth time this season and the second consecutive game.

Four of eight games in the conference tournament have been decided by four points or less.
