FOCUS OF THE MONTH

COMPLIMENTARY TICKETS

- All complimentary tickets need to be requested in ARMS by noon two days prior to the event.
- Student-athletes cannot receive payment from any source for their complimentary ticket, and cannot exchange them for any item of value.
- Guests who have received complimentary tickets are not permitted to receive any payment for the tickets or exchange them for any item of value.
- Student-athletes are provided one complimentary general admission ticket to every home event. They will need to show their UC ID at the complimentary ticket table, located on the third floor of Lindner.

REMINDERS

- Employee Attestation Forms are due by Friday 9/3. Please turn them into the compliance office ASAP!
- Labor Day is September 6.
 - All out-of-season sports are prohibited from CARA that day.
 - All in-season sports do not have daily hour limitations, but must stay within 20 hours for the week, 4 daily hours for the other days, and have one day off. Labor Day can be used as an off day.
 - All official and unofficial visits must be uploaded into ARMS for compliance approval.

TEXAS A&M INFRACTIONS CASE

- The Texas A&M men's basketball program committed multiple NCAA recruiting violations
- The head coach had impermissible contact with a prospect during an evaluation period.
- An assistant coach observed a prospective student-athlete participating in an open gym on an unofficial visit and conducted two 45-minute tryouts with that prospect, during which he provided coaching instruction.
- The assistant coach also impermissibly conducted 24 supervised off-campus workouts with a prospect and several men's basketball student-athletes. The assistant coach arranged for noncoaching staff members to supervise and conduct the workouts, exceeding the permissible limits for countable coaches.
- The head coach allowed six noncoaching staff members to participate in on-court activities and engage in skill instruction, exceeding NCAA countable coaches by three.
- The head coach violated head coach responsibility rules when he did not promote an atmosphere of compliance because of his personal involvement in the violations and because he did not monitor his staff's involvement in violations.
- **PENALTIES**
- Two years or probation
- Reduction in men's basketball official visits by 5 for the 2021-22 academic year.
- Suspension of unofficial visits for the first 3 conference games for the 2021-22 academic year.
- Reduction in men's basketball recruiting days by 5% for the 2021-22 academic year.
- Two-game suspension for the head coach
- The assistant coach was suspended from June 2020 through the end of the 2020-21 basketball season.
