OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Clayton Tune • Sr. • QB • Houston

Tune threw five touchdown passes to lead Houston to a 38-20 win at Navy. He staked the Cougars to a 21-7 halftime lead with three TD passes in the first half and had a pair of second half touchdowns to help Houston answer the Midshipmen's comeback bid. Tune completed 21 of 30 passes for 261 yards and added 43 rushing yards to finish with 304 yards of total offense. He became the sixth FBS player this season to throw five or more touchdown passes without an interception in a game.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Jireh Wilson • Jr. • S • East Carolina

Wilson led a defensive effort that limited UCF, which had averaged 41.3 points and 525.2 yards per game, to 13 points, 130 rushing yards and 426 total yards in a 34-13 victory. Wilson figured in two of the Pirates' four takeaways as he had an interception and a fumble recovery in the first half, both of which led to East Carolina points, allowing ECU to build an 17-0 lead. He also finished with three tackles..



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Mason Fletcher • So. • P • Cincinnati

Fletcher set two school and American Athletic Conference records in the Bearcats' 29-27 win at SMU. He averaged a record 65.0 yards on three punts, breaking the conference's previous single-game best by 10.5 yards, and hit an 84-yard punt that topped The American's previous record by five yards and was the longest punt by an FBS player this season.

Scored 17 points, including a school-record five field goals (30, 25, 52, 44, 31) in a 29-27 win at SMU.

Holton Ahlers • Sr. • QB • East Carolina

Completed 30 of 36 passes for 311 yards and a touchdown, scored a rushing TD, and became the school's career touchdown passes leader (87) in a 34-13 win against UCF.

AMERICAN NOTEBOOK

Everyone Wins

Since the start of the 2014 season, all 11 American Athletic Conference teams have been ranked at least once in the Associated Press top 25 poll. The American, the ACC and the Big 12 are the only FBS conferences that have had each member ranked since 2014.

Conference Call

The American will finish the regular season with a combined 9-3 record against non-autonomous FBS conference opponents in 2022.

Ride The Wave

Tulane is ranked in the top 25 for the first time since the end of the 1998 season, when the Green Wave finished the year at No. 7.

Groundbreaking

Tulane is 4-0 in American Athletic Conference play for the first time.

Internal Affairs

Cincinnati tied the American Athletic Conference record with its 19th consecutive win against conference teams (regular season and championship games). The Bearcats matched UCF's 19-game winning streak from 2017-19.

Top Of The Chart

Cincinnati head coach Luke Fickell improved his record to 54-16 with the Bearcats, surpassing Rick Minter for the most wins in program history. Fickell's 54 wins are the most by an American Athletic Conference coach since the league's formation in 2013.

Flip The Field

Cincinnati P Mason Fletcher set two American Athletic Conference records in the Bearcats' win at SMU. Fletcher averaged 65.0 yards on three punts, breaking the old conference mark by 10.5 yards. He had an 84-yard punt that bettered the previous long in the conference by five yards and was the longest punt by an FBS player this season.

We Must Defend This House

Cincinnati has won 30 consecutive games at Nippert Stadium, trailing only Clemson (38) for the nation's longest active home field winning streak. UCF has won 33 of its last 36 home games.

Happy Returns

Tulane WR Jha'Quan Jackson had a 90-yard punt return for a touchdown in the win against Memphis, registering the second-longest punt return in American Athletic Conference history.

Isn't That Special

Memphis K Chris Howard leads the nation in field goal percentage (14-for-14, 1.000). P Joe Doyle is second nationally in punting at 47.9 yards per punt.

Gus' House

UCF is unbeaten (6-0) in American Athletic Conference home games under Gus Malzahn.

Catching On

Tulsa WR Keylon Stokes and SMU WR Rashee Rice are tied for second nationally in receiving yards (114.6 ypg).

Long Time Coming

Tulsa WR Keylon Stokes broke a 57-year-old school record, becoming the Golden Hurricane's career receiving leader in Friday's win against Temple. Stokes finished the game with 3,352 career yards, breaking the old mark of 3,343 set by Howard Twilley from 1963-65.

At A Loss

Cincinnati LB Ivan Pace Jr. is the national leader in tackles for loss at 2.1 per game. Pace has 14.5 tackles for loss in 2022.

Halfway There

Cincinnati LB Ivan Pace Jr. was chosen as an Midseason All-America selection by the Associated Press, Sporting News and The Athletic. SMU WR Rashee Rice was a second-team Midseason All-America choice of The Athletic.

One And Only ...

Cincinnati finished the 2021 regular season as the nation's only unbeaten team (13-0). The Bearcats' only loss in 2021 came to Alabama in the CFP Semifinals.

... But Not The Only One

The American Athletic Conference has had an undefeated team entering Bowl Season in four of the last five seasons (UCF in 2017 and 2018; Cincinnati in 2020 and 2021).

Variety Show

The American Athletic Conference was the only Division I conference that had a team in the 2021 NCAA Men's Final Four (Houston) and in the 2021-22 College Football Playoff (Cincinnati).

Guess Who's Back

Nine of The American's 11 teams return their regular starting quarterback from last season. The only teams in The American to not return their starting signal-caller are Cincinnati and South Florida.

Draft Cards

The American matched its best showing in the NFL Draft with 19 players selected in 2022. Two American players – Cincinnati CB Ahmad Gardner at No. 4 and Tulsa OT Tyler Smith at No. 24 – were chosen in the first round, while The American had 10 players taken in the first two days of the draft, surpassing the league's previous high of six players.

Mark Your Calendars

Cincinnati's selection to the CFP Semifinal marked the seventh time in the nine-year history of The American that the league has had a team in a Bowl Championship Series or CFP New Year's Six bowl.

2022 MAJOR RULES CHANGES

Targeting

In games that have instant replay, when a targeting foul occurs in the second half, the carryover penalty (of sitting out the first half of that player's next game) will be eligible for further appeal.

The process will begin with a conference submitting a request to the NCAA national coordinator of officials, who would review video of the play. If it is obvious that a player was incorrectly penalized for targeting, the call would be overturned, and the player would be cleared to play in the first half of the next game.

Deceptive Actions

To address teams that are awarded an injury timeout through deceptive actions, panel members approved a reporting and investigation process. Schools and conferences will be able to report questionable scenarios to the national coordinator of officials, who will review and provide feedback to the conference for further action. Any penalties levied would be up to the conference office or school involved.

Blocking Below The Waist

The panel approved a proposal to improve safety and simplify the rules governing blocking below the waist. The proposal will allow blocking below the waist only by linemen and stationary backs inside the tackle box. Outside the tackle box on scrimmage plays, blocking below the waist will be prohibited.

Analysis of available NCAA injury surveillance data indicates a decreasing knee injury trend that coincides with recent rules changes in this area

Feet-First Slides

If a ball-carrier simulates a feet-first slide, officials will declare the runner down at that spot.

Illegal Block or Contact (Fair Catch)

A player who has made a valid or invalid signal for a fair catch and does not touch the ball shall not block or foul an opponent during that down. The penalty is 10 yards from the spot of the foul on a free kick or 10 yards from the postscrimmage kick enforcement on a scrimmage kick. A personal foul committed in conjunction with the action would result in a 15-yard penalty, with flagrant offenders ejected or disqualified.

Illegal Touching

The penalty for illegal touching a legal forward pass shall be five yards from the previous spot and a loss of down.

Defensive Holding

Defensive Holding will remain a 10-yard penalty, but will always carry an automatic first down.

COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

Every Game Counts

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a postseason event to determine college football's national champion on the field, while emphasizing the significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

Rankings

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

Tradition

The New Year's holiday period belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl Game and Sugar Bowl.

Championship Monday

The two teams that win the Playoff Semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. The national championship game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

Selection Committee

A talented group of 13 high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are Mitch Barnhart, Tom Burman, Boo Corrigan (chair), Rick George, Chet Gladchuk, Jim Grobe, Warde Manuel, Will Shields, Gene Taylor, Joe Taylor, John Urschel, Rod West and Kelly Whiteside.

Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

The American Bowl Lineup

American Athletic Conference teams are guaranteed at least seven bowl appearances annually as part of the conference's new postseason lineup, which began in the 2020 season and is in place through 2025..

The American, as it has done five times in the first seven years of the current bowl cycle, will continue to send its champion to a New Year's Six bowl if that team finishes higher than the champions of four other conferences in the final College Football Playoff rankings. American Athletic Conference teams are also eligible for the College Football Playoff if they are among the top four teams in the final CFP rankings.

As part of the current bowl cycle, The American will annually send teams to the Military Bowl presented by Peraton against an Atlantic Coast Conference opponent, the Fenway Bowl in Boston, also against an ACC team, and a third annual spot which will alternate between the Lockheed Martin Armed Forces Bowl and the SoFi Hawaii Bowl. The 2022 season will include the Radiance Technologies Independence Bowl among The American's guaranteed spots.

Additionally, The American will annually have regular appearances from a group of eight bowls. The American extended its existing partnerships with the TicketSmarter Birmingham Bowl, the Union Home Mortgage Gasparilla Bowl, the RoofClaim Boca Raton Bowl, the Tropical Smoothie Cafe Frisco Bowl and the Duluth Trading Cure Bowl.

New to The American's lineup in the current cycle are the SERVPRO First Responder Bowl, the New Mexico Bowl and the Myrtle Beach Bowl.

THE AMERICAN ON TELEVISION

The American and ESPN reached agreement on a 12-year media rights extension that began with the 2020-21 academic year.

With the current agreement, The American has a stronger and more extensive presence on ESPN's primary TV networks - ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU - than at any point in its history. The Conference will also be a valuable part of ESPN+, ESPN's industry-leading direct-to-consumer sports streaming service.

In football, a minimum of 40 regular-season telecasts per season will be televised on ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU, including at least 20 across ABC, ESPN and ESPN2, which represents increased annual exposure across those ESPN networks. The American Championship game will be televised each year on ABC or ESPN.

Beyond select Navy football games, all conference controlled football games from The American will air on an ESPN network or ESPN+.
