The Game:

- The University of Cincinnati men's soccer team returns to conference play when it welcomes ^{RV/25}West Virginia to Gettler Stadium on Saturday, Oct. 1. Kickoff between the Bearcats and Mountaineers is set for 7 p.m.

Series History:

- West Virginia leads the all-time series, 4-0.
- The Bearcats and Mountaineers have met twice as BIG EAST Conference foes, with WVU earning a pair of 2-0 wins (2006, 2009).
- WVU has won both meetings between the clubs in Cincinnati (2009, 1987).

Story Lines:

- The Bearcats have started five true freshmen and a first-year transfer this season.
- Freshman Cole DeNormandie and junior college transfer Leon Powell have combined to score seven of UC's 13 goals this season. Newcomers have accounted for 10 goals in 2011.
- DeNormandie is third in the BIG EAST with five goals and Shamar Shelton is fourth with three assists.
- UC and crosstown rival Xavier played to a 1-1 draw on Sept. 28 in Gettler Stadium, extending the Bearcats' unbeaten streak against XU at home to 14 matches (11-0-3).
- The Bearcats' seven combined goals against Central Arkansas and IUPUI are the most since scoring seven in back-to-back contests against Canisius (5-0) and Wright State (2-0) on Sept. 4 and Sept. 6 of 2009, respectively.
- Head coach Hylton Dayes is in his 11th season at Cincinnati and 22nd as a head coach. Dayes holds an 89-83-30 mark at UC and a 185-168-49 overall record.
- Dayes is the second winningest coach in UC history behind only Bob Muro, who posted a 114-111-13 mark in 12 seasons on the Bearcats sideline.

2011 MEN'S SOCCER NOTES

- Junior goalkeeper Joey Barnard has allowed 11 goals in nine matches, posting his first career shutout in UC's home opener against Central Arkansas. He has made 35 saves and holds a .761 save percentage.
- Junior midfielder Shamar Shelton scored the game-tying goal and assisted on another in UC's 3-1 season-opening win at Western Michigan.
- Senior defender Sam Klosterman scored the game-winner at Western Michigan from the penalty spot and was named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll for his efforts.
- Freshman midfielder Emmanuel Appiah tallied his first career goal in the second half at Virginia Tech in the Hilton Garden Inn Invitational.
- Freshman Will Diebold scored his first career goal against Oakland, giving the Bearcats a lead in the 67th minute.
- In 2010, UC posted a 7-5-7 overall mark, including a 5-1-3 ledger in BIG EAST play and a second-place BIG EAST Red Division finish. The Bearcats advanced to the BIG EAST Championship semifinals for the first time in program history.
- Returning to the roster this season are second-team all-BIG EAST midfielder Matt Bahner and all-Ohio selection Roger Thompson, both currently sidelined with injury.
- The Bearcats look to replace a starting forward, two starting midfielders, a starting defender, and a third-team all-conference goalkeeper from a season ago.
- UC welcomes a class of 14 newcomers in 2011, a recruiting class ranked No. 28 in the nation by *CollegeSoccerNews.com*.

BIG EAST/National Honors:

- Cole DeNormandie was named the BIG EAST Freshman of the Week on Sept. 12 after scoring three goals, including a pair of game-winners, in wins against Central Arkansas (Sept. 9) and IUPUI (Sept. 11).
- Senior defender Sam Klosterman and freshman midfielder Emmanuel Appiah were named to the Hilton Garden Inn Invitational all-tournament team following the weekend tourney in Blacksburg, Va., on Sept. 4.
- Senior captain Sam Klosterman was named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll after scoring the game-winner from the penalty spot in a 3-1 win at Western Michigan on August 27.

2011 MEN'S SOCCER NOTES

Last Time Out:

- UC played to a 1-1 double-overtime draw against crosstown rival Xavier on Sept. 28 in front of a season-high 1,106 spectators in Gettler Stadium.
- The Bearcats (3-5-1) are unbeaten in the last seven matches against Xavier (5-1-1), winning five with a pair of draws. UC is unbeaten in its last 14 home matches against the Musketeers, dating back to 1983. The Bearcats are 11-0-3 in those contests.
- XU got on the board first in the 24th minute when Matt Walker finished a Gino DiPaoli cross inside the box for his first goal of the season.
- UC faced a 1-0 deficit at the half and wasted little time tying things up in the second 45. After a Xavier foul was whistled 25 yards from goal in the 47th minute, Emmanuel Appiah sent a free kick screaming on goal. The save was initially made by XU keeper Justin Marshall, but Cole DeNormandie was there for the rebound and his fifth goal of the campaign, knotting things at 1-1.
- Momentum had shifted to the Bearcats until the 62nd minute when Zach Patterson was sent off after his second yellow card. UC was faced with playing the final 28 minutes of regulation down a man.
- Goalkeeper Joey Barnard was strong for UC, coming up with a handful of quality saves to keep the Bearcats in it.

Up Next:

- UC wraps up non-conference action when Southern Illinois-Edwardsville comes to town for a 7 p.m. kick on Oct. 4 in Gettler Stadium.
