### UCFACTS

► Since the start of the 2017 season, the Knights have won 40 of their last 46 games overall, which included a school-record streak of 25 straight wins. Since Josh Heupel took over for the 2018 season, UCF is 27-6, and his 22-4 record in 2018 and 2019 was the best two-year record for any FBS program that had a new coach take over in 2018.

► In the last three years, UCF has won two American Athletic Conference Championships and been to two New Year's Six bowl games. A 10-win season in 2019 is nothing to take for granted, especially when all three of the Knights' losses a year ago were on the road by a combined seven points, but they always strive for more. The Knights are again aiming to be better after opening up the 2020 season 5-2.

► The Knights went 13-0, 12-1 and 10-3 the previous three seasons, totaling 35 wins during that span, which made UCF one of just six FBS programs in the nation to do so. The Knights joined Alabama, Clemson, Georgia, Ohio State and Oklahoma in the elite category from 2017-19.

► Heading into the 2020 season, UCF had won 21 consecutive games at its home stadium, fondly named the Bounce House. That streak was the second longest in the nation, behind only Clemson, but the Knights had it snapped by Tulsa on Oct. 3. UCF has gotten back to its winning ways at home in the last two, defeating Tulane and Temple to give the Knights 23 wins in their last 24 home games.

► UCF has been an impressive team offensively for four seasons now, but 2020 has been the Knights' best yet in terms of total offense. The Knights aren't only leading the nation with 619.1 yards of total offense per game, they aren't just on pace to set a new school record, they are in fact just off the pace of the FBS record for yards of offense per game, currently held by Houston in 1989 when the Cougars finished the season averaging 624.9 yards per game.

UCF and Cincinnati have met five times in the all-time series between the two teams, beginning in 2015 when the Bearcats defeated the Knights 52-7 in Cincinnati during UCF's winless season.

The Knights won the next three matchups 24-3 (2016), 51-23 (2017), and 38-13 (2018), before the Bearcats came back with a 27-24 victory in Ohio last year.

UCF has won both matchups in games played in Orlando in 2016 and 2018.

**LAST TIME OUT**

It was another balanced performance for the Knights, as the UCF football team led from wire-to-wire in a 38-13 home victory over visiting Temple Saturday night at the Bounce House.

The defense was impressive all night, allowing just three points prior to the fourth quarter with a total of 290 yards of offense and turned Temple over three times in the victory.

Junior linebacker Eriq Gilyard might have been the best of the bunch, finishing the night by matching a career high of 12 tackles and setting a new career high with 3.0 tackles for loss.

He was the one that got everything start on the Owls' (1-5, 1-5) first possession, getting a strip sack, ripping the ball out of Re-al Mitchell's hands, and getting the UCF offense onto the field quickly.

The Knights (5-2, 4-2) turned that into points when Greg McCrae found the end zone for the first of two times on the night.

On Temple's next possession it was Tatum Bethune making it happen for the defense, snagging his first career interception. The Knights turned the takeaway into points again as Otis Anderson ran in for a score to put the Knights up 14-0 early.

McCrae scored again later in the first to put the Knights up 21-0 and UCF never looked back. The Knights led 21-3 at halftime and built the advantage to 38-3, before allowing the Owls to score 10 late points in the fourth quarter.



**ORLANDO'S HOMETOWN TEAM NOTES****AWESOME ACADEMICS**

- ▶ This past spring, UCF Athletics extended its streak to 25 straight semesters with a department average GPA of 3.0 or better and it marked the seventh straight semester of a 3.2 or better as a department.
- ▶ The UCF football team put 51 student-athletes on the American Athletic Conference All-Academic Team this past spring.

**WINNINGEST FOUR-YEAR RUN**

- ▶ Prior to the start of the 2016 season, the UCF football program's best four-season run was from 2010 to 2013, when the Knights went 38-15, won two conference championships and earned a trio of bowl victories.
- ▶ During UCF's most recent four-year run starting with the 2016 season, the Knights went 41-11 to mark the winningest four-season stretch in program history.
- ▶ UCF has won two conference championships and appeared in four bowls during that span, the first time the Knights have played in four consecutive bowl games.
- ▶ All UCF will need to do is go better than 6-7 in 2020 to mark an even better four-year stretch, and the Knights have opened up the year 5-2.

**NATIONAL EXPOSURE**

- ▶ UCF ranks among the national leaders in national television appearances by its football squad over the previous two seasons.
- ▶ In 2018 and 2019 combined, the Knights appeared 18 times on either ABC, ESPN or ESPN2, ranking tied for 11th nationally in that category.
- ▶ UCF has appeared on ABC in three of its seven games of the 2020 season and played on ESPN2 twice. This week the Knights play their first game of the season on ESPN proper.

**KNIGHTS IN THE TOP 25**

- ▶ The Knights finished the 2019 season ranked 24th in both the AP Top 25 Poll and the Amway Coaches Poll, marking the fifth time in program history ending the season ranked in the top 25 (2010, 2013, 2017, 2018, 2019).
- ▶ UCF entered the 2020 season ranked 21st in both polls, earning a preseason ranking for the third consecutive season.
- ▶ The Knights moved up to 11th in the AP Poll and 12th in the Coaches Poll, the highest they had ever been ranked at that point in the season, before falling to Tulsa.
- ▶ As it stands, UCF has been ranked in the Top 25 for 52 total weeks, and holds a record of 37-5 when ranked. The first time the Knights were ranked was Week 11 of the 2010 season. UCF's highest ranking was sixth, the final ranking of the 2017 season.

**BOWL HISTORY**

- ▶ The Knights appeared in their fourth consecutive bowl game in 2019, a first for the program. UCF played in the Cure Bowl in 2016, the Peach Bowl in 2017, the Fiesta Bowl in 2018 and the Gasparilla Bowl following the 2019 season.
- ▶ The 2019 Gasparilla Bowl marked UCF's seventh bowl appearance in the last eight seasons and the Knights' 11th in the past 15 years.

**UCF SUCCESS IN ALL SPORTS**

- ▶ For the last three full seasons, every sport that plays a head-to-head schedule at UCF has finished with a winning record.
- ▶ The Knights were the only FBS athletics program in the nation to do so in both 2017-18 and 2018-19, and then did it again in 2019-20.

- ▶ McNamara Cove—and "Covegating"—officially are coming to UCF. Covegating in McNamara Cove will generate new operating revenues for UCF Athletics while also delivering college football's most unique gameday tailgating experience for both individuals and corporate clients.
- ▶ UCF will offer a capacity of 250 all-inclusive "Covegating" membership packages for all regular-season home football games that includes food, beverage and parking among other amenities. The groundbreaking for McNamara Cove has already been held and expected opening is for 2021.

**#UCFAST OFFENSE NOTES****PRETTY DARN OFFENSIVE**

►► UCF has been one of the best offensive teams in the country the last four seasons and has put up the points to prove it. In fact, the Knights scored 30 or more points in 31 straight games from Aug. 31, 2017 to Sept. 28, 2019, which is a record for the longest streak in the Associated Press Poll era (since 1936).

►► Although the streak was snapped, the Knights have still scored 30 or more points in 43 of their last 45 outings and currently rank 11th in the nation with 44.0 points per game.

►► UCF has scored 40 or more points in 28 of its last 45 games, has reached the 50-point plateau 14 times in the last 45 outings and has scored at least 24 points in 46 straight contests, a streak that leads the nation.

**KEEP IT ROLLING**

►► UCF set a program record with 540.5 yards of total offense per game in 2019, ranking second in the nation, behind only national champion LSU.

►► Through seven games of 2020, the Knights have been markedly better, leading the nation with 619.1 yards of offense per game.

►► As another reference point, the FBS record for yards of offense per game is 624.9 yards per contest by Houston in 1989.

**DILLON DAZZLES**

►► Sophomore quarterback Dillon Gabriel was one of the best freshmen in the nation in 2019, throwing for 3,653 yards, a UCF freshman record and the fourth most in school history.

►► He has looked even better in the first seven games of 2020, leading the nation with 396.3 passing yards per game and ranking second with 411.4 yards of total offense per game.

►► His 23 passing touchdown also rank second in the nation and he has thrown at least one touchdown in every game of his career, with his streak of 20 consecutive games ranking as the fourth longest in program history.

►► Gabriel set a new UCF record at ECU with 18 consecutive completions and a record at Memphis with 601 passing yards.

►► The sophomore has thrown for 400 or more yards in four of seven games in 2020, which is more than any other Knight has done in an entire career.

►► Gabriel has not thrown an interception in his last 188 attempts, which is the second longest streak ever at UCF and is currently the third longest streak in the nation.

►► He is the only quarterback in the last 10 years to throw for 2,500 or more yards, at least 20 touchdowns and two or fewer interceptions over a six-game span.

►► Gabriel is also the third FBS quarterback in the last 15 years to have at least 400 yards passing, five touchdown passes and no interceptions in consecutive games.

**MARLON AND JAYFLASH**

►► With top returning target Tre Nixon missing the last six games due to injury, senior Marlon Williams and sophomore Jaylon Robinson - nicknamed JayFlash - have stepped up in a big way, ranking second and fifth in the nation for receiving yards with 942 and 822, respectively.

►► Williams and Robinson have both gone over 100 yards in the same game four times this year, a UCF record for a duo, while Robinson has done it six times and Williams has achieved it five times individually.

►► At Memphis Ryan O'Keefe also went over 100 yards to give UCF three players over 100 receiving yards in a game for the first time.

►► Williams also ranks fifth in the nation with 9.0 receptions per game and fourth with eight touchdown receptions.

**BALANCED ATTACK**

►► While the air attack has been impressive, don't sleep on the Knights' ground game, which now ranks 20th in the nation.

►► UCF is third in The American with its 222.3 yards of rushing per game.

►► The win over Houston was the Knights' first game over 300 yards rushing since the Gasparilla Bowl win to end 2019.

►► Both Otis Anderson (170) and Greg McCrae (107) went over 100 yards against the Cougars, the sixth time a UCF duo both went over 100 yards on the ground and the first since Kevin Smith and Jason Peters did it on Oct. 4, 2006.







## #UCFIERCE DEFENSE NOTES

## TURNOVER TOWN

- ▶ The Knights have forced 19 turnovers through seven games, leading the nation, and UCF is also sixth in the nation with a 1.57 turnover margin.
- ▶ UCF recovered only eight fumble recoveries all of 2019 and has already recovered 10 fumbles through seven games of 2020, a mark that also leads the nation.
- ▶ Senior Richie Grant and junior Eriq Gilyard rank second in the nation with two fumble recoveries each.

## TOO MANY YARDS

- ▶ The UCF defense has given up too many yards in 2020, ranking 92nd of 124 teams in the nation, allowing 447.9 yards of offense per game.
- ▶ The Knights are giving up 28.7 points per game, which ranks 60th in the nation and fifth in the conference.
- ▶ Over the last two games, however, the Knights have held their opponents' offenses to just 13.5 points per game.

## TERRORIZING TFL NUMBERS

- ▶ The UCF defense made it difficult on offenses in 2019 with their ability to get pressure in the backfield, leading the nation with 9.0 tackles for loss per game.
- ▶ It was definitely a team effort, as not a single UCF player had enough tackles for loss to be ranked nationally.
- ▶ The Knights are just a bit under last year's pace this year, averaging 7.6 tackles for loss per game, which ranks 28th in the nation.
- ▶ In the win over Tulane on Oct. 24, it looked familiar, as UCF had a season-high 11.0 tackles for loss and a season-best 5.0 sacks.

## RIDING WITH RICHIE

- ▶ Richie Grant has been a leader on the defense for the last three years and entered 2020 on the watch lists for the Bednarik, Nagurski and Thorpe awards.
- ▶ Grant has been named first-team all-conference in The American in two consecutive seasons and picked off six passes in 2018.
- ▶ He currently ranks second in the nation with two fumble recoveries and fourth with three interceptions.
- ▶ Grant's three interceptions this season give him 10 for his career, which ties him with Josh Robinson for fifth most in UCF history.
- ▶ He is also tied for fourth all-time at UCF with seven career forced fumbles.
- ▶ Among active FBS players, Grant ranks fifth in career interceptions, eighth in forced fumbles and ninth in solo tackles (174 in his career).

## SPECIAL NOTES

## KICKIN' IT

- ▶ Matthew Wright left UCF as the program's all-time leader in field goals made, field-goal percentage, extra points made and consecutive extra points made following the 2018 season.
- ▶ Dylan Barnas was the next man up in 2019 and went 15-for-17 on field goal attempts, ranking 11th in the nation and marking the second-best percentage in program history.
- ▶ UCF now has a new kicker again in 2020 with sophomore Daniel Obarski taking over. He ranks second among AAC kickers with 8.9 points per game and has connected on 9-of-14 field goal attempts, earning conference Special Teams Player of the Week honors twice.

## OTHER SPECIALTIES

- ▶ Andrew Osteen returns for punting duties in 2020 after punting 57 times for 2,408 yards in his first season of competition in 2019.
- ▶ He averaged 42.2 yards per punt and recorded a 71-yard punt at Pittsburgh, which was the third longest in UCF history. He's now averaging 45.1 yards per punt in 2020, which ranks second in the league.
- ▶ Alex Ward also returns for his second season as the team's long snapper.

## ANDERSON'S ACCOLADES

- ▶ In addition to running back and wide receiver duties, Otis Anderson has also played the role of punt returner exceptionally well for the Knights during his career.
- ▶ Anderson ranked sixth in the nation with 13.2 yards per return last season.

## 150+ REC YARDS

The Knights had a player record 150 yards or more in back-to-back games to start the 2020 season, as Marlon Williams went for 154 at Georgia Tech and Jaylon Robinson had 150 at ECU.

It was the first time UCF has achieved such a feat since 2002 when Jimmy Fryzel went for 174 at Miami (Ohio) on Nov. 23 and then Doug Gabriel had 179 against Ohio University on Nov. 30.

Heupel's two seasons at UCF both have produced perfect homefield records—and the Knights head into the 2020 season with 21 consecutive home victories (tying Clemson for the longest streak in the country in that category).

The Knights in 2018 put a league record 17 student-athletes on All-American Athletic Conference teams—then added a dozen in 2019. Milton in 2018 became the first player in conference history to repeat as the Offensive Player of the Year. Offensive lineman Jake Brown and safety Richie Grant earned first-team honors in both seasons. Additional first-team selections for UCF were wide receiver Gabriel Davis (2019), center Jordan Johnson (2018), offensive lineman Cole Schneider (2018), linebacker Nate Evans (2018) and cornerback Nevelle Clarke (2018). Milton finished sixth in 2018 Heisman Trophy voting.

UCF went 11-0 in the 2018 regular season, earning the American Athletic Conference East Division crown and a spot in the league title game. The Knights came back from a 17-point deficit to defeat Memphis 56-41 in the AAC Championship Game. The Knights earned a berth to the 2019 Fiesta Bowl, where they ultimately fell to LSU 40-32, snapping the team's 25-game win streak. Including three victories to open the 2019 campaign, the Knights extended their regular-season win streak to 28 games (including two AAC Championship Games).

Heupel was named the First Year Coach of the Year by the Football Writers Association of America and was a finalist for the AP National Coach of the Year Award, the Paul "Bear" Bryant Coach of the Year Award and the Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year Award. He led UCF to as high as seventh in both the Associated Press top 25 and Amway poll of coaches, the highest regular-season rankings in program history. The Knights finished the year ranked 11th in the AP and 12th in the coaches' poll.

The Knights had 43 players selected to the 2018-19 AAC All-Academic Team. UCF also won a 2019 NCAA Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award as its four-year 984 APR figure for football ranked it among the top 10 percent of schools in that sport.

Heupel is the 11th head coach in the history of UCF football. UCF vice president and director of athletics Danny White announced the hire on Dec. 5, 2017. Heupel received an initial five-year contract and then signed a one-year extension in December 2018 to keep him as the Knights' head coach through the 2023 season.

Heupel came to UCF after serving as offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at Missouri for two seasons in 2016 and 2017. In 2015, prior to Heupel's arrival, Missouri ranked 124th in the nation in total offense (280.9). In 2016, the Tigers led the Southeastern Conference and were ranked No. 13 in the nation, averaging 500.5 yards per game. In 2017, Mizzou ranked eighth in the nation in total offense, averaging 502.2 yards per game. The Tigers were also 14th in the nation in scoring at 37.5 points per game.

Missouri quarterback Drew Lock blossomed under Heupel's tutelage. Lock led the SEC in passing as a sophomore, throwing for 3,399 yards and 23 TDs. He followed that with an even stronger junior campaign in 2017, passing for 3,964 yards and an SEC-record 44 TD tosses.

Heupel served as assistant head coach/offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach at Utah State in 2015. Despite the loss of its starting quarterback to injury, Heupel's unit improved from 81st nationally to 60th in scoring offense.

Heupel started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at the University of Oklahoma, his alma mater. He was on a coaching staff that took part in back-to-back national championship games following the 2003 and 2004 seasons. Heupel helped mentor Jason White to the Heisman Trophy in 2003.

He spent the 2005 season at Arizona before heading back to Oklahoma as a full-time assistant.



He returned to his alma mater for the 2006 season and coached the quarterbacks for five seasons. Heupel coached Sam Bradford to the Heisman Trophy, Davey O'Brien and Sammy Baugh Awards in 2008. Bradford led the nation in passing efficiency that season and the Sooners tallied an NCAA record five straight 60-point games.

Heupel was promoted to offensive coordinator in 2011 and served in that role for four seasons. His 2011 offense ranked fourth in the nation in total offense and passing offense. The 2012 unit ranked fifth in the nation in passing and 12th in total offense. In 2013, OU led the Big 12 in rushing and total offense. In his final season with OU, the Sooners led the nation in fewest sacks and led the Big 12 and ranked 10th in the nation in rushing, as well as finishing 20th in the nation in scoring and 23rd in total offense.

Heupel was a national championship-winning quarterback at Oklahoma. He was runner-up for the Heisman Trophy in 2000 while leading the Sooners to a victory over Florida State in the 2001 Orange Bowl, sealing the national title for the Sooners. In 2001, Heupel was the Associated Press Player of the Year, Walter Camp Award winner, Archie Griffin Award winner and a consensus All-America performer.

During his two seasons as the starting quarterback at Oklahoma, Heupel posted a 20-5 record. He passed for 7,456 yards and 53 TDs. Overall, he still ranks among OU's top three quarterbacks in passing yards, completions and TD passes, despite playing just two seasons. He was a junior college All-America performer at Snow College in Utah in 1999, throwing for 2,308 yards and 28 TDs. He was drafted in the sixth round of the 2001 NFL Draft by the Miami Dolphins.

An Aberdeen, South Dakota, native, Heupel earned his bachelor's degree in business marketing from Oklahoma in 2001. He and his wife Dawn have two children—daughter Hannah and son Jace.
