• Tulane (3-5, 1-3 American Athletic Conference | West) hosts Cincinnati (2-6, 0-4 American Athletic Conference | East) for Homecoming 2017 at Yulman Stadium.

ABOUT TULANE

- Tulane seeks its first homecoming win at Yulman Stadium, having lost to Memphis in 2014 (38-7 on Nov. 15), UConn in 2015 (7-3 on Nov. 5) and SMU in 2016 (35-31 on Oct. 29).
- A win over Cincinnati would give the Green Wave a win on homecoming for the first time since a 24-21 victory over North Texas on Oct. 5, 2013.
- Of Tulane's 32 touchdowns scored so far this season, 15 have been with plays that went 20 yards or longer. The Green Wave's six longest plays have resulted in touchdowns three rushing (75, 72, 58) and three passing (73, 62, 62). In total, Tulane has converted 46 plays on offense and special teams of 20 yards or longer.
- Tulane enters the game ranked fourth in The American and 15th nationally in rushing offense at 248.0 yards per game.
- Tulane has rushed for 100 or more yards in 23 straight games, dating back to the final three games of the 2015 season.
- The Green Wave now forced a turnover in nine consecutive games, dating back to the final game of last season at UConn on Nov. 26, 2016.
- Tulane is tied for fifth in the nation with nine other teams with six turnovers lost.
- The Green Wave also leads The American in passing defense (204.0) and passes had intercepted (3), which is tied for seventh in the nation.
- Of head coach Willie Fritz' 200 on-field victories, 63 have come on the NCAA Division I level (Football Bowl Subdivision and Football Championship Subdivision).

SERIES NOTES

- Tulane and Cincinnati are meeting for the 16th time on the gridiron with the Green Wave leading the all-time series 11-4.
- The two teams last met in New Orleans on Oct. 31, 2014 during Tulane's inaugural season playing in Yulman Stadium and inaugural season in the American Athletic Conference. Cincinnati won that game 38-14.
- Tulane's last home win over the Bearcats was a 35-17 victory in a Conference USA matchup on Oct. 2, 2002. That season, the Green Wave went 8-5, capping the season with a 36-28 win over Hawai'i in the Hawai'i Bowl.
- Seven of Tulane's wins in the series have come in New Orleans.
- Tulane is looking for its sixth conference win as member of The American with its previous wins coming vs. UConn and at Houston in 2014, vs. UCF in 2015, at UConn in 2016 and vs. Tulsa in 2017.

- Cincinnati is one of 30 NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision teams with 100 wins since 2005. The Bearcats' .667 winning percentage since 2007 ranks among the top 20 teams in the FBS, winning at least nine games seven times in the last 11 years.
- The Bearcats have dropped five straight games with the losses coming to teams that have a combined 2017 record of 29-5.
- Cincinnati has dropped five straight games overall and eight consecutive American Athletic Conference games, dating to last year.
- The Bearcats started conference play against four of the top offenses in The American that have a combined record of 25-5 while its last four foes of 2017 currently sit at 11-20.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

• Tulane's offense is picking up where it left off last season in converting long drives into points. This season, all drives of 70 yards or more have resulted in touchdowns. Last season, only one of the team's 17 drives of 70 yards or more did not result in points. And of those that resulted in points, only one was not a touchdown. - Senior running back Dontrell Hilliard is just the 12th running back in school history to eclipse 2,000 career rushing yards. He enters the game ranked fifth on the school's career rushing yards list with 2,625 career yards.
- Hilliard's 27 career running touchdowns rank fifth all-time in school history.
- Hilliard had his streak of six straight games with a rushing touchdown snapped at Memphis. The streak had dated back to the Navy game on Sept. 9.
- Hilliard's eight career 100-yard rushing performances rank sixth in school history.
- Hilliard ran for a career-high 175 yards and a career-high four touchdowns in Tulane's win over Tulsa. It was his first, multi-touchdown game since rushing for two scores at Tulsa on Oct. 22, 2016.
- Hilliard's four touchdowns vs. Tulsa marked the seventh time in school history a player scored four or more touchdowns in a game.
- On the first offensive play of the game against Army West Point, Hilliard carried the ball 75 yards for a touchdown, his longest run since an 85-yard touchdown run against Maine on Sept. 19, 2015.
- Hilliard's 27 rush attempts at Navy were a career high, topping 25 carries at Houston on Nov. 8, 2014.
- Junior quarterback Jonathan Banks has thrown for more than 200 yards in consecutive games 221 vs. USF and 203 at Memphis.
- Banks has been responsible for four touchdowns (three passing, one rushing) in a game twice so far this season vs. Grambling State and at Memphis.
- Banks ran for a career-high 93 yards vs. Tulsa. His 50-yard run in the first quarter of that game was his longest rush of the season.
- Banks' 73-yard touchdown pass to redshirt junior wide receiver Terren Encalade vs. USF was the longest pass reception of the season. The touchdown pass was the longest of Banks' Tulane career and the catch was the longest of Encalade's collegiate career.

- The Banks-to-Encalade, 62-yard touchdown connection vs. Tulsa was on a one-play, 11-second drive, equaling the shortest drive of the season with Hilliard's 75-yard touchdown run vs. Army West Point.
- · Banks threw the first interception of his Tulane career at FIU.
- Encalade enters the game with 1,152 career receiving yards.
- Encalade's rushing touchdown vs. Grambling State was the first of his career and his longest rush (58 yards) of his career. In that same game, he was the first Tulane player to catch and run for a touchdown in a game since Hilliard did so (one rushing, one receiving) at Houston on Nov. 8, 2014.
- Redshirt junior tight end Charles Jones II caught his first two touchdown passes of the season and the seventh and eighth of his career at Memphis. It was his first, multi-touchdown game of his career and his first touchdown catches since catching a touchdown on Nov. 11, 2015 at SMU.
- Redshirt senior running back Sherman Badie's 72-yard touchdown run vs. Army West Point was his first rushing touchdown since Oct. 29, 2016 against SMU. The run was his longest rushing score since Sept. 27, 2014, when he ran for an 86-yard touchdown against Rutgers.
- Sophomore quarterback Johnathan Brantley's 19 rush attempts at Oklahoma set a career high, eclipsing his previous high of 12 at Navy.
- Freshman running back Stephon Huderson scored the first touchdown of his career on a two-yard run vs. Tulsa.
- Sophomore running back Darius Bradwell ran for a career-high 71 yards vs.
 Tulsa.
- Junior wide receiver Jabril Clewis caught the first pass of his Tulane career at Oklahoma, while redshirt freshman wide receiver Jacob Robertson Jr. caught his first collegiate catch vs. Army West Point.
- Clewis has caught a pass in six straight games, dating back to the Oklahoma game on Sept. 16.
- Sophomore wide receiver Darnell Mooney set a personal single-game high with 70 receiving yards at Memphis, topping his 63 receiving yards at Houston on Nov. 12, 2016.
- Freshman wide receiver Jaetavian Toles got the first touch of his collegiate career on a one-yard run vs. Tulsa and caught his first collegiate catch at Memphis.
- Redshirt freshman running back Miles Strickland, playing in his first game of the season and the second game of his career vs. Tulsa, and carried the ball three times for 17 yards. He played in one game as a true freshman, making an appearance vs. UL Lafayette on Sept. 24, 2016.
- Redshirt junior tight end Kendall Ardoin got his first start this season and his 18th career start vs. USF.
- Two freshmen quarterback Khalil McClain and quarterback/wide receiver Dane Ledford – saw their first collegiate action at Oklahoma.
- Tulane's four, first-time starters in the season-opener vs. Grambling State were on the offensive side of ball freshman offensive lineman Corey Dublin made his first career start, while Clewis, Banks, and junior offensive lineman Dominque Briggs Jr. made their first career starts at Tulane.
- Dublin was first true freshman to start on the offensive line in a season opener since Andrew Nierman in 2007 vs. Mississippi State.
- Against Grambling State, Tulane had three wide receivers (Hilliard, Encalade and sophomore Darnell Mooney catch touchdown passes in a single game for the first time since the 2015 season finale against Tulsa when the trio of Hilliard, Teddy Veal and Andrew Hicks each caught a touchdown.
- Also vs. Grambling State, Tulane posted rushing touchdowns from three different players (Encalade, Banks and sophomore more running back Darius Bradwell) in a single for the first time since Hilliard (2), Josh Rounds (1) and Lazedrick Thompson (1) did so at Tulsa on Oct. 22, 2016.

- In 20 games under head coach Willie Fritz, Tulane has:
- Recorded an interception in 15 games (eight last season and Grambling State, Navy, Army West Point, Tulsa, FIU, USF and Memphis this season), including in 11 of the team's last 13 games and 14 of the team's last 17 games.
- Forced a fumble in nine games (six last season and Navy, Oklahoma and Army West Point this season).
- Recovered a fumble in nine games (six last season and Navy, Oklahoma and Tulsa this season).
- Redshirt senior cornerback Parry Nickerson has 13 career interceptions, which ranks tied for fourth in school history with Mitchell Price (1987-89).
- With one pass breakup at Memphis, Nickerson sits fourth all-time in school history with 28 career pass breakups.
- Nickerson set a career high with nine tackles at FIU, eclipsing his previous best of eight at East Carolina on Nov. 22, 2014.
- Redshirt junior cornerback Donnie Lewis Jr. picked off his third interception this season and fifth of his career vs. USF.
- Nickerson and Lewis Jr. have accounted for 10 of Tulane's last 13 interceptions, dating back to last season: UCF (Nickerson), Houston (Lewis Jr.), UConn (Nickerson and Lewis Jr.) last season and Grambling State (Lewis Jr.), Navy (Nickerson), Army West Point (Lewis Jr. and Nickerson), FIU (Nickerson) and USF (Lewis Jr.) this season.
- Redshirt senior nickelback Jarrod Franklin recorded a career-high 12 tackles vs. USF, topping his previous high of 11 tackles vs. SMU on Oct. 29, 2016.
- Franklin grabbed his first interception of the season and third of his career at Memphis.
- Freshman safety Chase Kuerschen recorded a career-high 14 tackles vs. USF, topping his previous high of eight tackles at Navy on Sept. 9.
- Senior linebacker Rae Juan Marbley set a career high with 15 tackles at FIU with nine of those tackles coming in the first half. His previous best was 13 tackles vs. Army West Point. He has also recorded the first two sacks of his career this season at Navy (1.0) and vs. Tulsa (1.0).
- Marbley was one of seven players recording career highs in tackles vs. Army West Point redshirt junior linebacker Zachery Harris (14), redshirt senior linebacker Luke Jackson (8), freshman defensive end Cameron Sample (6), freshman defensive end Patrick Johnson (4), redshirt junior defensive tackle Braynon Edwards (3) and redshirt freshman defensive lineman De'Andre Williams (3).
- Redshirt freshman cornerback Tre Jackson grabbed his first career interception at FIU, while freshman safety Chase Kuerschen grabbed the first interception of his career vs. Tulsa. Kuerschen was first Green Wave player with an interception, outside of Nickerson and Lewis Jr., since junior free safety Taris Shenall and redshirt senior defensive end Quinlan Carroll each had an interception vs. SMU on Oct. 29, 2016.
- Kuerschen and Jackson were credited with the first forced fumbles of their careers at Navy and freshman safety Tirise Barse was credited with the first forced fumble of his career at Oklahoma.

- Kuerschen earned the first start of his Tulane career at Oklahoma, while Johnson made his first career start vs. Army West Point.
- Senior defensive end Ade Aruna recovered his first fumble of the season and third of his career vs. Tulsa.
- Junior safety Roderic Teamer Jr.'s 52-yard fumble recovery for a touchdown at Navy was the first touchdown of his career and his first career fumble recovery.
- Teamer's fumble return touchdown was the sixth-longest fumble return in school history and longest since Darion Monroe returned a fumble 54 yards for a touchdown vs. Memphis on Nov. 10, 2012. Tulane's previous fumble recovery for a touchdown was a 48-yard scoop and score by Parry Nickerson at Army West Point on Nov. 14, 2015.
- Nickerson entered the 2017 season as one of the top returning cornerbacks in the country. According to *Pro Football Focus*, opponents registered a passer rating of just 32.5 when throwing towards Nickerson in 2016. That figure ranked first among all cornerbacks returning for this season. Last season, he was among the FBS leaders in total passes defended (tied for 26th) and interception return yardage (fourth).

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- Tulane blocked two kicks (PAT attempt and field goal attempt) vs. USF, marking the first time the Green Wave blocked two kicks in a game since the UConn game last season on Nov. 26, 2016. That game was also the last time Tulane blocked a field goal attempt.
- Redshirt senior running back Sherman Badie is the ninth player in school history to amass 1,000 career kick return yards. He enters the game ranked ninth in school history with 1,121 career kick return yards.
- Junior safety Roderic Teamer Jr.'s block of the PAT attempt in the second quarter vs. USF was the first block of his career. It also marked Tulane's first block of the season.
- Teamer's block was the first time Tulane had blocked a PAT since Derrick Strozier did so vs. Memphis on Oct. 22, 2011.
- Redshirt junior cornerback Donnie Lewis Jr.'s block of the field goal attempt in the fourth quarter vs. USF was the first block of his career.
- Junior quarterback Jonathan Banks kicked the second punt of his Tulane career in the second quarter vs. USF. His 31-yard punt was downed at the USF one-yard line. His first career punt vs. Army West Point was a 40 yard punt downed at the Black Knights' three-yard line.
- Redshirt junior quarterback Glen Cuiellette kicked the fifth punt of his career at Oklahoma. His 31-yard punt was downed at the Oklahoma five-yard line.
- Sophomore placekicker Merek Glover saw his first career game action, handling kickoff duties vs. Grambling State, and recorded his first career points with two PATs at Oklahoma. He connected on his first career field goal (35 yards) at FIU.
- Redshirt freshman placekicker Coby Neenan connected on his first career field goal (21 yards) vs. Grambling State.
- Senior long snapper Aaron Golub became the first legally blind student-athlete to play in an NCAA football game when he snapped an extra point vs. UCF on Oct. 3, 2015. He is legally blind with no sight in his right eye and limited vision in his left.

HALL OF FAMER ON THE MIC

- Tulane radio network analyst Steve Barrios is serving his 35th season calling Green Wave football.
- On the field, Barrios earned three letters for Tulane from 1969-71 and finished his career with 60 receptions for 1,197 yards and eight touchdowns. He had two 100-yard receiving games in his career and was just the sixth player in school history to record a 100-yard receiving game. Barrios finished his career as the holder of four school records. His career average of 19.95 yards per catch still stands as a school record.
- He was a member of the 1970 Liberty Bowl team and served as team captain in the 1971 season. Barrios was a three time All-South Independent selection and spent two seasons playing professionally with the Jacksonville franchise in the World Football League.
- He was inducted into the Tulane Athletics Hall of Fame in 2000 as player and his 1970 team that won the Liberty Bowl was inducted as a part of the 2017 class.
- During his 35 seasons in the booth calling Tulane games, he has worked with seven different play-by-play announcers, six different athletics directors and 10 different head coaches.

BIG NUMBERS IN BIG WIN

Tulane put up impressive numbers in its 62-28 win vs. Tulsa:

• 62 points – The second most points scored in a conference

- 62 points The second most points scored in a conference game in school history, behind the 64 points scored in a 64-33 win at Louisville in a Conference USA matchup on Oct. 11, 1997. It also marked the most points in a conference game since a 55-45 victory over UAB in a Conference USA matchup on Oct. 27, 2012 and the most points scored in an American Athletic Conference game, eclipsing the 45 points scored vs. UCF in 2015.
- 48 first-half points The most points in a half in a conference game since joining the American Athletic Conference.
- 653 total offensive yards The most offensive yards since compiling 706 yards against UL Lafayette on Oct. 31, 1998.
- 488 rushing yards The most rushing yards since rushing for 504 yards vs. Clemson on Nov. 18, 1944.
- Eight rushing touchdowns The most rushing touchdowns in a conference game since rushing for five touchdowns vs. Mississippi State in a Southeastern Conference matchup on Nov.
- 1, 1952. The eight rushing touchdowns are believed to be the most ever in a conference game and the second most in school history behind the school-record 15 rushing touchdowns against UL Lafayette on Oct. 12, 1912.

GOOD START, GOOD FINISH

• The 2013 season was the last time Tulane closed with an above .500 record and earned a bowl appearance. It was also the last time the Green Wave won their season opener. Tulane hopes history repeats itself in 2017, starting this season with a 43-14 win over Grambling State.

YULMAN STADIUM

Yulman Stadium, the crown jewel of the university's athletics complex, opened its doors for the first time in front of a capacity crowd on September 6, 2014 against Georgia Tech. Yulman Stadium marked the beginning of a renaissance of Tulane Athletics, which saw Green Wave football return to campus for the first time in nearly 40 years.

Tulane's new home field advantage came from the generosity of three couples in particular - Richard Yulman and his late wife Janet, Gayle and Tom Benson and Jill and Avie Glazer.

Richard Yulman, the retired chairman and owner of mattress manufacturing giant Serta International, donated \$15 million toward construction of this \$73 million facility. Yulman Stadium is named in honor of Richard, Janet and the Yulman family.

New Orleans Saints owner Tom Benson and his wife Gayle, a member of the Board of Tulane, donated \$7.5 million to Yulman Stadium. Benson Field, which will host the games of Yulman Stadium, is named in their honor.


Jill and Avie Glazer supported the stadium with a multi-million dollar gift. The Jill H. and Avram A. Glazer Family Club, the premium space in which to experience games at Yulman Stadium is named in their honor.

Construction of Yulman Stadium began in January 2013. Gould Evans and Associates and Lee Ledbetter & Associates served as the project architects, while Woodward Design + Build LLC was the contractor.

Tulane football has been a part of the fabric of New Orleans since the Green Wave played its first season back in 1893. Generations experienced college football at the old Tulane Stadium from 1926-1974.

It is not hard to find a story about someone's experience at old Tulane Stadium. Boy Scouts selling programs, a record crowd of 86,598 watching the Green Wave defeat LSU in 1973, the annual Sugar Bowl and early Saints football, are all part of the story of Tulane Stadium.

Now in its fourth year, a new chapter continues to be written in a new home by a new (and old) generation of Green Wave fans.



Tulane Stadium was the home to Tulane Football from 1926 until 1974. Built on an old plantation where sugar was first granulated, the original construction cost approximately \$300,000 and was made mostly from brick and concrete. As the site of the annual Sugar Bowl, Tulane Stadium was often informally referred to as "Sugar Bowl Stadium." After its expansion in the 1940's, Tulane Stadium became the largest football stadium in the south.

The American Athletic Conference consists of 13 prestigious institutions: the University of Central Florida, the University of Cincinnati, East Carolina University, the University of Connecticut, the University of Houston, the University of Memphis, the U.S. Naval Academy (in football only), the University of South Florida Southern Methodist University, Temple University, Tulane University, the University of Tulsa, and Wichita State University (in basketball and Olympic sports).

Under the leadership of commissioner Mike Aresco, the American Athletic Conference has an impressive list of accomplishments, both in the competitive arena and the classroom. The American has taken its place at the forefront of intercollegiate athletics, with a collection of national team and individual championships and football and men's and women's basketball postseason victories that place The American among the elite Division I FBS conferences.

The league has produced four NCAA championship teams - UConn men's basketball in 2014 and UConn women's basketball in 2014, 2015 and 2016 - in addition to two New Year's Six bowl champions, five NCAA individual championships, and a Rhodes Scholar. Additionally, American Athletic Conference teams have advanced to the College World Series, reached the semifinal and final rounds of the NIT, qualified for the match play round of the NCAA Men's Golf Championship and registered top-10 finishes at the NCAA Cross Country and Outdoor Track and Field championships.

The American Athletic Conference was one of six finalists for the 2016 Sports Business Journal Sports League of the Year award, along with Major League Baseball, Major League Soccer, NASCAR, the National Basketball Association and the PGA Tour.

In football, Temple and Navy were ranked in the final College Football Playoff poll of the 2016 season, marking the second straight season that The American finished with at least two ranked teams. Seven teams from The American played in bowl games, while three teams (USF, Temple, Tulsa) finished with at least 10 wins.

The American has had a combined 15 teams play in bowl games in the last two seasons, highlighted by Houston's win against Florida State in the 2015-16 Chick-fil-A Peach Bowl. Houston's finish at No. 8 nationally in 2015 gave The American a top-10 team in the final national polls for the second time in three seasons after UCF finished No. 10 in the 2013 rankings after the Knights' Fiesta Bowl win against Baylor. Additionally, Memphis, Navy, USF and Temple have all finished in the top 25 of either the CFP, Associated Press or USA Today polls as members of The American.

Individual teams in The American have enjoyed unprecedented success since the conference's formation. Houston went 13-1 in the 2015 football season, setting a school record for wins, while Navy won a program-record 11 games in its first season in the conference, also in 2015. The 2014 season saw Memphis finish with 10 wins in football for the first time since 1938, while Temple enjoyed its first 10-win season in 2015.

Beyond the gridiron, The American sent four teams to the 2016 NCAA Men's Basketball Championship, and the league had the best men's basketball postseason record of any conference in 2014. Since the conference's formation in 2013-14, teams from The American have registered top-10 national rankings in football, men's basketball, women's basketball, baseball, men's soccer, men's golf, and men's track and field. Student-athletes from The American won three NCAA individual titles in track and field in 2016-17 as Cincinnati's Annette Echikunwoke won the indoor weight throw, Tulsa's Marc Scott won the outdoor 10,000-meter title, and Houston won the crown in the outdoor 4x100-meter relay.

Under The American's banner, SMU advanced to the NCAA Men's Basketball Championship for the first time since 1993. The UConn women's basketball team won its NCAA-record ninth, 10th and 11th national championships and broke its own NCAA record with a 111-game winning streak that spanned three seasons. UCF, East Carolina and Houston have all achieved top-10 rankings in baseball in the past three years. Tulsa placed sixth at the 2016 NCAA Men's Cross Country Championship, while USF finished the 2014-15 season at No. 8 in the final men's golf national ranking.

The American Athletic Conference holds media rights partnerships with ESPN and CBS Sports, which provide the conference with outstanding national exposure on the two industry leaders in sports television. The football portion of the contract calls for nearly 90 percent of conference-controlled games on national broadcast or national cable platforms. The first two American Athletic Conference Football Championships were televised by ABC as part of Championship Saturday. The American had the two highest-rated Thursday telecasts of the 2016 football season.

American Athletic Conference teams have access to the pinnacle of college football's postseason structure. An American representative would be chosen for the College Football Playoff semifinals if it is among the top four teams in the CFP selection committee's final ranking. Otherwise, the league would place its champion in a New Year's Bowl if it is ranked higher than the champions of Conference USA, the Mid-American Conference, the Mountain West Conference and the Sun Belt Conference.

Additionally, The American holds primary or secondary partnerships with 12 bowls for the current six-year cycle, ensuring multiple annual matchups against the nation's top conferences and providing desirable postseason destinations to member institutions.

The American Athletic Conference serves its membership from a state-of-the-art office located in Providence, Rhode Island. The location of the conference headquarters - just steps from the city's Amtrak station and 10 minutes from T.F. Green International Airport - gives the conference easy access to its member schools. The conference headquarters also serves as the home of the American Digital Network, which provides live coverage of all 21 conference championships.





WILLIE FRITZ

Head Coach · Second Season Shawnee Mission, Kan. Pittsburg State, 1983

In his second season at the helm of Tulane football in 2017, Willie Fritz brings an enthusiasm and winning culture poised to catapult the Green Wave to become one of the top programs in the American Athletic Conference and NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision.

In his first season in the Crescent City, he guided Tulane to a 4-8 record and earned his first American Athletic Conference victory in the team's season finale at UConn. The Green Wave posted 30 or more points in five games in 2016, four of which were in wins. Three of the eight losses were by seven points or less with Tulane in four of those games entering the fourth

The Shawnee Mission, Kan., native was named the Green Wave's 40th head coach by Director of Athletics Troy Dannen on Dec. 15, 2015. At that time, he brought 33 years of collegiate experience as a football student-athlete or coach to Tulane, having led teams to six combined conference championships (one at every level he had coached) and two bowl appearances. He was twice named the national coach of the year, including the American Football Coaches Association FCS Coach of the Year in 2011 and the Liberty Mutual FCS Coach of the Year in 2012.

Fritz came to New Orleans from Georgia Southern where he spent two seasons and led the Eagles to a combined record of 17-7, a 2014 Sun Belt Conference title and the school's first-ever NCAA postseason bowl game with their berth in the 2015 GoDaddy.com Bowl. Georgia Southern concluded the 2015 regular season with an 8-4 overall record, including a mark of 6-2 in conference play.

Fritz led the Eagles to a 9-3 overall record and a perfect mark of 8-0 in conference play during his first season at Georgia Southern in 2014, and was named the Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year. However, the school's waiver claim to allow Georgia Southern to play in a bowl despite being in the second year of the NCAA's transition period was denied. In the 2014 Sun Belt preseason poll, the Eagles were ranked ninth out of 11 teams, making them the first squad in NCAA history to transition from an FCS ranking to an undefeated conference record in the same year.

Prior to Georgia Southern, Fritz served as head coach at Sam Houston State from 2010-13, where he led the Bearkats to back-to-back Southland Conference titles, NCAA Division I Championship game appearances in 2011 and 2012 and a third-straight NCAA playoff berth in

Honored as the American Football Coaches Association Regional Coach of the Year in 2011 and 2012, Fritz was selected by the media and his peers in the Southland Conference as the league's Coach of the Year in 2011 after his team went a perfect 7-0 in conference play.

in 2011 and 2012, Sam Houston State posted the two highest single-season win totals in program history with marks of 14-1 (2011) and 11-4 (2012) and Bearkat players were showered with accolades. More than 50 earned All-Southland Conference honors under Fritz in the last four years, not including additional Player of the Year, Offensive Player of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year and Newcomer of the Year awards. All-America status from national coaching and media outlets were bestowed on 11 Sam Houston State players during his tenure.

Prior to his head coaching tenure at Sam Houston State, Fritz revitalized Central Missouri and guided the Mules to 11 winning seasons in 13 years. The NCAA Division II program's ledger included two 10-win seasons with the 2001 Mule squad earning its first postseason

In 2002, Central Missouri made its first-ever appearance in the NCAA Division II playoffs and was the Mid-America Athletic Association (MIAA) co-champion a year later. A 97-47 mark in 13 seasons ranks Fritz as the winningest coach in the program's 118-year history. He was the only coach to ever win seven or more games in eight consecutive seasons and his victory total ranked him 15th among active Division II coaches at the time. In addition to his impressive 67.4 winning percentage with the Mules, Fritz coached his student-athletes to achieve their potential both on the field and in the classroom. More than 150 Mules were recognized with All-MIAA honors with 41 first-team selections and 24 All-Americans Under Fritz, Central Missouri recorded a graduation rate of 84 percent with 144 MIAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll recipients, 14 Academic All-Region and three Academic All-Americans

For all of his accomplishments guiding Central Missouri, Fritz was honored by the school with induction into its Athletics Hall of Fame on Feb. 11, 2017.

Prior to his time at Central Missouri and Sam Houston State as a head coach, Fritz spent two different stints as an assistant coach with the Bearkats. He first served as a graduate assistant during the 1984 and 1985 seasons when he earned a master's degree in kinesiology. During that two-year stretch, Sam Houston State posted a 16-6 record and won the 1985 Gulf Star Conference championship. He returned to Sam Houston State a second time in 1991 after spending two years at Coffeyville Community College in Kansas under legendary coach Dick Foster, earning a promotion to defensive coordinator after one year. He stayed another two years to work for Coach Skip Foster and the Red Ravens.

When Fritz was brought back to Sam Houston State in 1991 under Ron Randleman as secondary and special teams coach, he instilled an attitude of excellence on special teams that would last more than a decade. The Bearkats "block party" racked up 80 blocked punts, field goals and extra points beginning with Fritz in 1991 and lasting through 2004.

In Fritz's first year as a full-time assistant coach at Sam Houston State in 1991, the Bearkats won the Southland Conference. That league title and eight-win season launched Sam Houston State to the program's second-ever appearance in the NCAA Division I

Football Championship.
Fritz departed Huntsville for a second time prior to the 1993 season for an opportunity to be the head coach at Blinn College, where he would turn around a program that had only five wins in its previous three seasons.

From 1993-96, Fritz and the Buccaneers would rack up 39 victories, including an NJCAA record 25 straight wins, against only five losses with a tie and claim two national junior college championships. He was inducted into the NJCAA Football Hall of Fame for the environment of success he created at Blinn.

One of seven children, Fritz is the son of the late Harry Fritz, who coached the Central

Missouri football team in 1952 before continuing his career as the Executive Director at the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) in Kansas City. The elder Fritz also served at several colleges and universities in administration as an athletics director.

Fritz played on two conference title teams at Pittsburg State. He was a four-starter at defensive back for Randleman and also started two years on the basketball squad. Fritz remained at his alma mater as a student assistant coach in 1982. Early coaching stops included a year at Shawnee Mission Northwest High School (Kansas) in 1983 and Willis High School (Texas) in 1986, with his return to Sam Houston State for graduate school in between those years.

Fritz and his wife Susan have been married for 30 years, and have three children.

Wesley, Lainie and Brooke. Their son Wesley is a member of the Tulane football staff. Lainie is television sports reporter and anchor at KPRC-TV in Houston, Texas, while Brooke is a student at Georgia.
