## CINCINNATI VS. TOLEDO

**SETTING THE SCENE:** Cincinnati, coming off its first defeat in nearly three weeks, returns home for a non-conference meeting with Toledo today at 4 p.m. The Bearcats (11-8) dropped a tough, 1-0 decision to crosstown rival Xavier on Tuesday afternoon. The Rockets (5-6) played for the first time since March 10 yesterday, defeating Findlay, 8-1. Today's game is UC's final tune-up for BIG EAST play which begins Friday at Pittsburgh.

### NOTING THE BEARCATS:

- The key to the Bearcats offensive success this season as been the stolen base as UC leads the BIG EAST with 63 thefts. The mark is the most by a Cincinnati team since the 2001 team finished with 85 stolen bases. The Bearcats are on pace to set a school record for steals in a season, with the current mark at 119.
- Junior speedster Tony Campana already ranks second in UC single season history with 31 stolen bases. Campana, who earlier this year set the single game record with six, needs just five more swipes to break Ken Schneider's mark of 35 set in 1991.
- Campana holds UC's longest current hitting streak as he has hit safely in 15 consecutive games. The junior hit in 18 in a row as a freshman at UNC Asheville.
- The Bearcat pitching has been anchored by sophomore starters Steve Blevins and Dan Osterbrock. The duo holds a combined 6-3 record and a 3.01 ERA.
- Since returning from a wrist injury earlier this month, freshman Michael Earley has batted .382 with three home runs and eight RBI in 11 games.

**HEAD COACH BRIAN CLEARY**

**BRIAN CLEARY** is in his 11th season at Cincinnati where he has compiled a 250-334-1 record. During his tenure at UC, Cleary has established himself as one of the top coaches ever to lead the Bearcats on the diamond. After taking over a struggling program in 1997, Cleary has led the Bearcats to 250 wins in his career, ranking second on the school's all-time win list behind the legendary Glenn Sample. The 38-year old spent time as the recruiting coordinator at both Tulane and Notre Dame before coming to UC. As a collegiate player, Cleary was a four-year letterwinner and a two-time all-conference academic choice at Fairfield.

**NOTING THE ROCKETS:**

- The Rockets, picked to finish last in the West Division of the MAC prior to the season, have started the season 5-6, but have played just once since March 10. UT topped Findlay, 8-1 yesterday afternoon.
- Senior OF Joel Visser and junior INF Scott Boley are the Rockets' top two hitting threats, hitting .390 and .370, respectively. Boley also leads the team with 12 RBI.
- The Toledo roster features Cincinnati native Jake Oester, son of former Cincinnati Reds' 2B Ron Oester.
- Sophomore lefty Ryan France (0-0, 7.04 ERA) will make his second start of the year on the mound. France last started on March 6 at Louisiana Tech, surrendering six runs and seven hits in 4.2 innings.

**OFF AND RUNNING:**

The Bearcats' running game has quickly evolved into one of the team's biggest weapons and is on track to be one of the best efforts in school history. In 19 games this year, the Bearcats have swiped 63 bags, already more than any UC team since 2001. Tony Campana has been the catalyst as he already ranks second on the UC single-season list with 31 thefts. Seven times this year, Campana has swiped multiple bags in a game including a school-record six in the second game of a doubleheader at North Carolina A&T on Feb. 24, topping Ken Schneider's previous high of five set in 1991. If the Bearcats stick to their current pace, they will shatter the school record of 119 thefts established in 1992.

**MILESTONE VICTORY:**

The Bearcats' victory over Chicago State on March 18 was a special one for UC head coach Brian Cleary as it marked the 250th triumph of his coaching career. Cleary ranks second in school history in coaching wins, trailing on the legendary Glen Sample who amassed 391 victories.

**ROTATION MAINSTAYS:**

The Bearcats' starting pitching has excelled this season thanks to the play of sophomores Steve Blevins and Dan Osterbrock. The pair rank two-three in the BIG EAST in strikeouts and have each won a BIG EAST Pitcher of the Week award. The duo has now been joined by classmate Michael Hill in the rotation. A closer look at each player's contributions this year:

- After being victimized by a lack of run support early in the season, Blevins has won three straight outings after starting

the year 0-3. He had his best outing on March 9 vs. Cleveland State, hurling eight shutout innings with five strikeouts. Over the course of his last three starts, Blevins has allowed just two earned runs in 20.2 innings. Blevins has excelled in the walk-to-strikeout ratio with just six free passes and 34 K's in 39 innings of work. His ERA stands at 3.00.

- Osterbrock has surrendered just three earned runs in his last 29.2 innings of work and has won three of his last four starts. The lefty holds a 3-0 record and a 3.03 ERA in 35.2 innings. His best outing came with a three-hit shutout of Dartmouth on March 3. With 33 strikeouts, Osterbrock is just five shy of his total from all of last season.

- After using a variety of hurlers in the No. 3 spot in the rotation, Hill has now assumed the slot. Hill has been impressive this year with three wins and 26 strikeouts, while ranking sixth in the BIG EAST with a .217 opponents batting average. His start against Chicago State on Sunday was a good one as he fanned nine in just five innings of work.

**HARRISON BACK AT IT:** Josh Harrison has picked up where he left off last year early in 2007, hitting .292 and leading the team in home runs (four) and RBI (20). At Austin Peay on Feb. 18, Harrison saw his career-best 18-game hit streak come to an end, but he bounced back with his fourth long ball one day later. In the 77 games making up his UC career, Harrison has failed to gather a hit in just 12 contests. The sophomore has shown his blend of speed and power this year, adding 10 stolen bases to his home run total. For his play at Florida Atlantic (Feb. 9-11), Harrison became the first Bearcat this season to be named to the College Baseball Foundation National Honor Roll.

**BULLPEN LOCKDOWN:** The Bearcats have enjoyed solid performances from the bullpen, with a returning ace, a newcomer and a surprising returnee leading the way.

- Junior A.J. Upton, a candidate for the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award shrugged off allowing a walk-off homer at Florida Atlantic with scoreless outings in three of his last four appearances. Despite a tough outing at Kentucky on March 7, Upton is still limiting opponents to a .190 batting average this season.

- Junior Billy Welsh has gotten his short stay off to a fine start, holding opponents to two runs in 14.1 innings (1.26 ERA) over seven appearances. The righty got his first win at UC with 2.2 innings of relief against Cleveland State and he is tied for third in the BIG EAST with three saves. Opponents are hitting just .119 against him.

- Junior southpaw Adam Calez has come on strong of late, holding opponents to just one unearned run in 10.1 innings, spanning six appearances. Calez holds a 1-1 record and has struck out 15 this season, while limiting opponents to an .061 batting average.

**OUTFIELD IN GOOD HANDS:** With LaFringe Hayes gone to graduation and Josh Harrison moved to the infield, UC entered the season needing someone to step up in the outfield. With the additions of Tony Campana and Cameron Satterwhite, the Bearcats have found the cogs to fill the holes.

- Campana has been a sparkplug at the top of the line-up, swiping 31 bases and hitting a team-best .351. Now riding a 15-game hit streak in which he has batted .407 (24-for-59), Campana has hit safely in all but two of UC's 18 games this season.

- Satterwhite is off to a good start ranking fourth in the BIG EAST with eight doubles. On the strength of a career-best eight-game hit streak, Satterwhite has raised his average to .323. On March 10, the sophomore hit a game-winning two-run homer to beat Cleveland State.

**THE LATEST POLLS**

**A MUCH NEEDED LIFT:** With Logan Parker's big bat lost in the middle of the line up, seniors Neall French and Brian Szarmach and freshman Michael Earley have stepped up to fill the hole:

• French has been hot of late, hitting safely in eight of his last 12 games at a .316 clip (12-for-38). His power numbers have been up as he has hit five doubles and three home runs and driven in 17 during the span. He is tied for third among BIG EAST players with 20 RBI. French had his best day as a Bearcat at Kentucky on March 7, as he hit a pair of three-run homers for a career-best six RBI.

• Szarmach is hitting a career-high .314 and is tied for sixth in the BIG EAST with 18 RBI. He has added four doubles, a triple and three home runs, including a solo shot on March 18 vs. Chicago State.

• Since returning from a wrist injury earlier this month, Earley has batted .382 with three home runs and eight RBI in 11 games.

**NO PLACE LIKE HOME:** In its two-plus seasons of existence, Marge Schott Stadium has provided a solid home field advantage for the Bearcats. Since its opening, the Bearcats hold a 47-25 (.653) record at home. Prior to a loss to Rutgers on April 14, 2006 the Bearcats had a 12-game home winning streak, the second-longest in school history, behind a 17-game streak in 1960-61. As was the case last season, the Bearcats' team numbers have been better at home than on the road. Both UC's team batting average (.297 to .255) and ERA (1.87 to 6.56) are significantly better at Marge Schott Stadium.

**BUCKEYE STRENGTH:** In recent years, Cincinnati has enjoyed success against its in-state rivals, winning 22 of its last 31 games against Ohio adversaries, including three of four this season. The Bearcats will work to continue that success again in 2007 with 11 match-ups against Ohio schools. The balance of the in-state contests are: March 21 vs. Toledo, March 28 vs. Wright State, April 3 at Dayton, April 11 vs. Xavier, April 17 vs. Ohio, May 9 vs. Miami and May 16 at Miami. In 2006, UC's .700 winning percentage against other Ohio teams ranked as the third-best in the state.
