MILESTONE MOMENTS SYRACUSE

Marvin Washington (TD Pass), Xavier Scott (TD Catch) and Ian Swenson (Forced Fumble) all recorded career highlights with first career moments on Saturday at Syracuse. Washington fired a 26 yard touchdown pass to Tyler Davis on his first career passing attempt. Ian Swenson made a fantastic hustle play that resulted in a forced fumble at the goal line to take a touchdown away from the Orange. While Scott hauled in his first career touchdown catch in the midst of a career-high seven receptions.

AUSSIE, AUSSIE, AUSSIE

Redshirt freshman punter Luke Magliozzi has been a weapon on special teams for the Huskies, averaging 45.0 yard per punt, ranking 13th in the country. The Australian native was added to the Ray Guy Award Watch List, given to the most outstanding punter in the country, last week.

RUNNING WILD

Kevin Mensah (144 yards) and David Pindell (137 yards) both eclipsed the 100-yard mark vs. Rhode Island on Sept. 15. It was the first time that the Huskies had a pair of 100-yard rushers in the same game since 2010 against Texas Southern.

Pindell has already recorded a 100-yard rushing game on two occasions this season. He is the first UConn quarterback in the FBS era to notch multiple 100-yard rushing games in the same season.

MILESTONE MOMENTS RHODE ISLAND

Many UConn newcomers came up with milestone moments en route to a 56-49 win against Rhode Island on Sept. 15. Oneil Robinson (interception), Heron Mauriceau (touchdown reception), Eli Thomas (sack), Jordan Morrison (fumble recovery) all recorded "Firsts" as a Husky to contribute to their first win in the blue and white.

SATURDAY TO REMEMBER

Senior quarterback David Pindell threw for 308 yards and added 137 more on the ground to lead UConn to a 56-49 victory over Rhode Island on Saturday. Pindell was 20-27 en route to his career-high 308 yards and he also added career bests with four passing touchdowns and two rushing TD's.

Pindell keyed a UConn offensive attack that posted the 12th-most points and sixth-most total yards in program history.

His 445 yards of total offense is the third-highest in UConn history and the most since Bryant Shirreffs in 2015 and his four TD passes fell one short of Dan Orlovsky's school record. His accomplishments earned him the Gold Helmet Award for Week 3 and a spot on the American Athletic Conference honor roll.

FIVE FRESHMEN, AND ZERO UPPERCLASSMEN, START ON DEFENSE

When the Huskies traveled to Boise to take on the No. 20/19 Broncos on September 9, five true freshmen started on defense for the first time since the program moved to FBS in 2002. Jonathan Pace (DE), Travis Jones (DT), Lwal Uguak (DE), Kevon Jones (LB) and Ryan Carroll (CB) made up the starting contingent of true freshmen and were joined as starters on defense by two redshirt freshmen (DE Caleb Thomas, LB/DB Ian Swenson). The starting defense was rounded out by two sophomores (LB Darrian Beavers, S Omar Fortt) and two redshirt sophomores (CB Tahj Herring-Wilson, S Tyler Coyle).

NORTH OF THE BORDER

The Huskies feature five players from Canada on the 2018 roster. Terrance Ganyi, Hergy Mayala, Phillippe Okounam, Michael Tarbutt and Lwal Uguak all hail from north of the border.

Previous Huskies that represented the country include Martin Bedard (Laval, Que.), Moe Petrus (St. Laurent, Que.), Alex Mateas (Ottawa, Ont.) and Jesse Joseph (Laval, Que.).

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONESES

Linebacker Kevon Jones leads all true freshman with 28 total tackles this season. Jones recorded career-highs in sacks (1.0) and tackles for loss (2.5) in win against Rhode Island (Sept. 15).

SUPER SENIORS

It is a common practice that college football teams are littered with players that have redshirted and return for a fifth and final year with the program. In 2018, that will not be the case at UConn. At last check the Huskies have the least amount of fifth year seniors in the country. Ryan Crozier and James Atkins are the only Huskies to be with the program for five years. PEART NOMINATED FOR WUERFFEL TROPHY

Redshirt junior offensive lineman Matt Peart was announced to the 2018 Wuerffel Trophy Watch List with 105 other players from college football's Football Bowl Subdivision.

The Wuerffel Trophy, known as "College Football's Premier Award for Community Service," is presented annually at the All Sports Association's Awards Banquet in Fort Walton Beach. Named after 1996 Heisman Trophy winning quarterback Danny Wuerffel from the University of Florida, the Wuerffel Trophy is awarded to the FBS player that best combines exemplary community service with athletic and academic achievement.

Peart has started all 12 games the past two seasons for the Huskies and has been a part of football team's leadership council the past two seasons.

CROZIER UP FOR RIMINGTON TROPHY

University of Connecticut redshirt senior Ryan Crozier (Plantation, Fla.) has been named to the 2018 Rimington Trophy Watch List. The Rimington Trophy is presented annually to the most outstanding center in the country.

Crozier played 10 games on the offensive line as a true freshman in 2014 – starting the final three games at left guard. He was moved to the center position in the spring of 2015 but missed all but one game due to injury that season.

Crozier started at center in all 12 games for UConn in 2016 and started last season at the position but was injured three games into 2017. Crozier has been named to the Rimington Trophy Spring Watch list the past three years.



HUSKIES FROM FAR AND WIDE

The 2018 Huskies span all over the country and the world with the team represented by 18 states, Washington D.C. and four countries outside the United States. UConn has five players from Canada, Matt Peart from Jamaica, Luke Magliozi from Australia and Xavier Scott from Germany. THE STADIUM

The Huskies moved into Rentschler Field in East Hartford for the 2003 season and are set to begin its 16th season as the home of UConn football. The stadium officially became known as Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in 2015.

UConn has an all-time record of 62-40 at Rentschler Field and a 34-16 mark in non-conference games. UConn has played to 83.2-pct. of capacity all-time there, drawing 3,326,555 fans, or an average of 33,280 per game. UConn set a new all-time single-game attendance record at Rentschler Field on Sept. 21, 2013 against Michigan with a crowd of 42,704. That capacity was achieved with extra bleachers brought in for that game. Against ECU the Huskies had a record-low crowd with an announced attendance of 14,036.
