## WEEKLY HONORS

### OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Brady White • Memphis • Jr. • QB • Newhall, Calif.

White was responsible for six touchdowns and 348 yards of total offense as Memphis took a 45-27 win at Houston, moving the Tigers into a tie for first place in The American's West Division. White completed 22 of 33 passes for 341 yards and matched his career high with five touchdown passes. He added a 14-yard rushing touchdown to help Memphis overcome an early 17-7 deficit.

### DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Quincy Roche • Temple • Jr. • DE • Randallstown, Maryland

Roche set an American Athletic Conference single-game record with 6.0 tackles for loss in Temple's 29-21 win against Tulane. He finished the game with 12 tackles, 3.0 sacks, a forced fumble, a fumble recovery and a quarterback hurry and had two key sacks on Tulane's final drive as the Green Wave threatened to tie the game.

### SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Sam Crosa • Cincinnati • Sr. • K • Columbus, Ohio

Crosa scored eight points, including the game-winning field goal as time expired, to lift Cincinnati to a 20-17 win against USF, giving the Bearcats a two-game lead in The American's East Division standings. Crosa's gamewinner came from 37 yards, and he drilled a 41-yard attempt late in the third quarter to bring the Bearcats within a touchdown.

Rushed for 134 yards and a touchdown on 26 carries and had two catches for 30 yards in a 20-17 win at USF.

## A League Of Our Own

American Athletic Conference teams are a combined 27-1 (.964) against opponents from outside the power conferences/Notre Dame this season.

## Conference Call

American Athletic Conference teams are 6-0 against Conference USA this season. The American is 4-0 against the Sun Belt, 3-0 against the Mountain West and 1-1 against the MAC. Teams from The American are 3-1 against FBS independents in 2019.

## To Be The Best ...

American Athletic Conference teams have played nine games against top-25 opponents in 2019. Conference teams have faced three top-10 teams this season.

## Exclusivity

The American, the Big Ten and the SEC are the only FBS conference that have three teams with one loss or fewer through Week 12.

## Home Is Where The Wins Are

UCF has won 20 straight home games, trailing only Clemson (22) for the longest home winning streaks nationally.

## Ground Troops

Navy leads the nation in rushing, averaging 349.3 rushing yards per game.

## Two Steps Back

UCF leads the nation in tackles for loss, averaging 9.4 TFL per game. USF is fourth at 8.9, while SMU is fifth at 8.6.

## They're Honored

Memphis RB Kenneth Gainwell and Temple C Matt Hennessey were named to the Associated Press Midseason All-America team. Both players were second team selections.

## Finally

Memphis QB Brady White is one of five finalists for the Johnny Unitas Golden Arm Award, which is given to the nation's top quarterback who is a senior, or a fourth-year junior on schedule to graduate with his class.

## We'll Take That

USF and Cincinnati are ranked third nationally in turnovers gained. The Bulls and Bearcats both have 22 takeaways, trailing only Illinois (26) and Clemson (24).

## It's East vs. West

The American's East Division finished the 2018 season with a 10-8 head-to-head record against the league's West Division, marking the first time in the four-year history of the conference's two-division format that the East had the better head-to-head record. West Division teams hold a 46-40 all-time lead against East Division opponents since 2015.

## Nice Runs

Cincinnati is 20-3 since the start of the 2018 season. SMU is 15-5 in its last 20 games. UCF is 32-4 since the start of the 2017 season.

## Best In Class

Memphis RB Kenneth Gainwell is ranked ninth nationally in rushing at 116.6 yards per game. Gainwell is the only freshman ranked among the top 40 players in rushing.

## Malcolm In The Mid

Navy QB Malcolm Perry leads all quarterbacks in rushing at 128.8 yards per game. Perry ranks fifth among all FBS players in rushing trailing.

## Passing Fancy

SMU QB Shane Buechele is fourth nationally in passing yards, averaging 319.5 yards per game.

## Any Way You Want It

Memphis WR Antonio Gibson became the first FBS player to score touchdowns by rushing, receiving and on special teams in a game this season. Gibson scored on a 50-yard reception, a 78-yard run and a 97-yard kickoff return in the Tigers' 54-48 win against No. 14 SMU Nov. 2.

## The 2019 Championship

The 2019 American Athletic Conference Football Championship will be played Saturday, Dec. 7, at 3:30 p.m. ET and will be televised nationally on ABC for the fifth consecutive season.



The championship will be played between the champions of the East and West divisions, based on the highest winning percentage in conference games.

The site of the championship will be the home venue of the division winner with the highest winning percentage in conference games.

The following tiebreakers are in place for the 2019 season.

### Two-Team Tie for Divisional Championship

- Head-to-head result
- Divisional winning percentage
- Head-to-head results within the division against the team with the next best conference winning percentage, in descending order
- Winning percentage against common non-divisional conference opponents
- College Football Playoff Selection Committee rankings, provided that team wins in the final weekend of the regular season. If the higher-ranked team loses in the final weekend, then a composite average of computer rankings will determine the divisional champion.
- Overall winning percentage, excluding exempt games
- Coin toss

### Multiple-Team Tie for Divisional Championship

The following is used to eliminate teams until two teams remain, at which point the two-team tiebreaker is used

- If one team defeated all other teams, it will be the divisional champion
- If two teams defeated the other tied team(s), the defeated team(s) is eliminated
- Divisional winning percentage
- Head-to-head results within the division against the team with the next best conference winning percentage, in descending order
- Winning percentage against common non-divisional conference opponents
- College Football Playoff Selection Committee rankings, provided that team wins in the final weekend of the regular season. If the higher-ranked team loses in the final weekend, then a composite average of computer rankings will determine the divisional champion.
- Overall winning percentage, excluding exempt games
- Coin toss

### Championship Host Tiebreaker

UCF has an active streak of 36 consecutive games with at least one rushing touchdown and one touchdown pass ... The Knights are 5-0 at home and 2-3 on the road this season and have won 20 consecutive home games ... QB Dillon Gabriel has passed for 2,806 yards and 24 touchdowns with seven interceptions ... WR Gabriel Davis has 59 catches for 1,060 yards and 10 TDs, while WR Tre Nixon has 41 catches for 705 yards and seven TDs ... RB Otis Anderson is the leading rusher with 609 rushing yards and three touchdowns, while RB Adrian Killins has 508 yards and six TDs ... # COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a big success. Fans, including many who are new to the sport, enjoy it. The first College Football Playoff semifinals and national championship were the three most-viewed programs in cable television history.

## Every Game Counts

The playoff preserves the excitement and significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

## Four Teams

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

## Two Games, One Goal

The kickoff of the new year belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl and Sugar Bowl. The two teams winning the playoff semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. That game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

## Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

## Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

## Selection Committee

A talented group of high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are: Rob Mullens (chair), Frank Beamer, Paola Boivin, Jeff Bower, Joe Castiglione, Herb Deromedi, Ken Hatfield, Chris Howard, Bobby Johnson, Ronnie Lott, Gene Smith, Todd Stansbury, and Scott Stricklin.

## Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

## Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

## The American Bowl Lineup

In addition to the College Football Playoff and New Year's Bowls, The American has either a primary or secondary affiliation with nine bowl games for 2019 season. The American works annually with its member schools and bowl partners to create the most sensible and attractive postseason matchups.

The **Military Bowl presented by Northrop Grumman** takes place at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium in Annapolis, Maryland, while the events and activities surrounding the game are based in Washington, D.C. The American Athletic Conference will face an opponent from the Atlantic Coast Conference in 2019.

The **Birmingham Bowl** takes place at Legion Field in Birmingham, Alabama. The American/Big East has partnered with the bowl since its inception in the 2006 season. The American Athletic Conference will face an opponent from the Southeastern Conference.

The **Bad Boy Mowers Gasparilla Bowl** is played at Raymond James Stadium in Tampa, Florida. Conference USA will provide the opponent for The American's team in the 2019 season.

The **Cheribundi Boca Raton Bowl** began in 2014 and is played at FAU Stadium in Boca Raton, Florida. The American representative will play a team from the Mid-American Conference in 2019.

The **Tropical Smoothie Cafe Frisco Bowl** will be played for the third time in 2019. An American Athletic Conference team will face an opponent to be determined at Toyota Stadium in Frisco, Texas.

The **AutoNation Cure Bowl** made its debut in 2015 at Exploria Stadium in Orlando, Florida. An American Athletic Conference team will be paired against an opponent from the Sun Belt Conference. Net proceeds from the game will benefit the Breast Cancer Research Foundation.

The **SoFi Hawaii Bowl** is played at Rainbow Stadium on the campus of the University of Hawaii. The American Athletic Conference will face the Mountain West in a Christmas Eve matchup.
