WEEKLY HONORS

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Desmond Ridder • Cincinnati • Jr. • QB • Louisville, Ky.

Ridder, who was chosen as the Walter Camp National Offensive Player of the Week, led Cincinnati to a 42-13 win against then-No. 16 SMU. Ridder accounted for 305 yards of offense and four touchdowns against the previously unbeaten Mustangs. He rushed for 179 yards and and three touchdowns and was 13-of-21 passing for 126 yards and a TD. He capped his performance with a 91-yard touchdown run, which ranks as the fifth-longest rushing play in American Athletic Conference history and the second-longest by a quarterback.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Zaven Collins • Tulsa • Jr. • LB • Hominy, Okla.

Collins led a defense that limited USF to 13 points and 305 total yards in a 42-13 victory against the Bulls. He finished with six tackles, including five solo stops, to go with a forced fumble and a 37-yard interception return for a touchdown. His forced fumble ended a USF drive at the Tulsa 6-yard line just before halftime, while his interception provided a backbreaking score to give the Golden Hurricane a 35-13 second-half lead.



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Dalton Witherspoon • Houston • Sr. • K • Moore, Okla.

Witherspoon scored 13 points, going 3-for-3 on field goal attempts and 4-for-4 on PATs to help Houston to a 37-21 victory at Navy. Witherspoon accounted for 10 of Houston's 16 first-half points, including a 53-yard field goal that tied the Cougars' program record. Witherspoon also was successful from 33 and 45 yards, while his four extra points extended his streak to 125 consecutive made PATs.

Scoreboard Watching

The winning teams in the American Athletic Conference averaged 42.6 points in Week 8. The five winning teams scored 37, 41, 42, 42 and 51 points.

Defend This House

Cincinnati has won its last 16 home games, which is the fourth-longest home field winning streak nationally, while Memphis is fifth with 12 straight home wins. Clemson leads the nation at 26 straight home wins, followed by Notre Dame (22) and Ohio State (21).

Representing The Defense

Cincinnati ranks 10th nationally in scoring defense (sixth among teams that have played more than one game) at 12.5 points allowed per game. The Bearcats are fourth nationally in pass efficiency defense (84.78), first among teams with more than one game.

Big Three

According to ESPN Stats & Information, UCF QB Dillon Gabriel is the third NCAA FBS player in the last 15 seasons to have at least 400 passing yards and five touchdown passes without an interception in consecutive games. The others were California's Jared Goff in 2015 and LSU's Joe Burrow in 2019, who were both No. 1 selections in the NFL Draft.

This Goes To 11

Tulsa's first two games this season were against teams ranked No. 11 in the Associated Press poll at gametime. The Golden Hurricane was 1-1 in those games (16-7 loss at Oklahoma State, 34-26 win at UCF).

Road Warriors

Tulsa is the only team nationally that has played more than one total game and has not yet played a home game. The Golden Hurricane hosts East Carolina Friday in its home opener.

Conference Calls

The American Athletic Conference ranks second among the five NCAA FBS conferences that have played more than one nonconference game in 2020.

Moving The Chains

UCF leads the nation in total offense, averaging 646.8 yards per game, more than 53 yards better than North Texas, which is second at 593.6 ypg. Memphis is fifth at 548.8 ypg.

Air Travel

UCF is also the national leader in passing offense at 435.0 yards per game.

1-2 Punch

UCF QB Dillon Gabriel leads all NCAA FBS players with 2,178 passing yards. SMU QB Shane Buechele is third with 1,926 yards.

Taking Offense

UCF QB Dillon Gabriel is the national leader in total offense at 461.0 yards per game, while Memphis QB Brady White is fourth at 362.8 ypg.

Back-To-Back

UCF QB Dillon Gabriel has thrown for 1,023 yards and 10 touchdowns with no interceptions in his last two games.

Career Day

SMU QB Shane Buechele is the NCAA FBS active career leader in passing yards (10,491). Memphis QB Brady White is fourth with 8,944 career yards.

In Tune

Houston QB Clayton Tune is the first Cougar player with four consecutive 300-yard passing games since Case Keenum in the 2011 season.

Penetration

Navy LB Diego Fagot is sixth among NCAA FBS players with 8.5 tackles for loss in 2020. Houston DE Payton Turner and Tulsa LB Zaven Collins are tied for seventh at 8.0 per game. Tulsa is fifth among FBS teams, and second among teams that have played more than one game, at 10.7 tackles for loss per game.

Paper Or Plastic?

Tulane defensive end Patrick Johnson is fourth among NCAA FBS players with 6.0 sacks this season. Tulane is fourth among all FBS teams with 20 sacks.

Get These Hands

UCF WR Marlon Williams is the national leader in receiving yards (150.6 yards per game). Williams leads the nation in both total receptions (54) and receiving yards (753).

What A Rush

Cincinnati QB Desmond Ridder scored a 91-yard rushing touchdown in the fourth quarter of the Bearcats' win at SMU Saturday. It tied for the fifth-longest rushing play in American Athletic Conference history and was second among quarterbacks. Former Navy QB Malcolm Perry had a 92-yard run against SMU and a 91-yard run against Air Force, both in the 2017 season.

Long Division

After playing five years as a 12-team, two-division conference, The American will feature 11 teams in a single-division format for the 2020 season. Each team is scheduled to play eight conference games this season. The top two teams in the final regular season standings will play in the 2020 American Athletic Conference Football Championship, which will take place either Dec. 12 or 19 at the home stadium of the first-place team.

Leadership

Tulsa OT Chris Paul is the chair of the American Athletic Conference Student-Athlete Advisory Committee and is one of 32 student-athletes nationally on the NCAA SAAC, which reports directly to the NCAA Division I Council.

Perfection

Cincinnati is one of nine NCAA FBS teams that is undefeated while having played at least four games in 2020.

2020 COLLEGE FOOTBALL RULES CHANGES

Players Numbering

No more than two squad members may be assigned or wear the same jersey number. There were no limits to duplicate numbers in previous seasons. With the recognized popularity of the single-digit numbers, the digit "0" is added as a legal number. Any number to be preceded by "0" such as "07" or "00" remains illegal.

Targeting - Disqualified Player

There were no changes to the targeting rule from an on-field officiating perspective and the rule continues to serve the game well and is changing player behavior in terms of use of the helmet. The change for 2020 is that now a player disqualified for targeting will be declared ineligible for further participation in the game, but the player may remain in the team area.

All other disqualifying fouls such as fighting, two unsportsmanlike conduct fouls, flagrant personal fouls, etc. will be reclassified as fouls requiring ejection. Players ejected will be required to leave the playing enclosure and must remain out of view of the field of play under team supervision.

Pregame Warmup /Officials' Jurisdiction

The Rules Committee address issues of unsportsmanlike behavior in the pregame and took steps to clean this action up. The officials' jurisdiction will now begin at 90 minutes before kickoff (previously 60 minutes). Additionally, when any squad member enters the playing enclosure prior to the game, the head coach or an assistant coach from that team must be present on the field. Furthermore, when any squad member is present within the playing enclosure after the officials' jurisdiction, they must be wearing their jersey or have their numeral readily visible. Players without their numeral readily visible must leave the playing enclosure.

Defensive Linemen on Scrimmage Kick Plays

To further enhance the protection of the snapper on scrimmage kicks, if the offense is in a scrimmage kick formation at the snap, any defensive player within one yard of the line of scrimmage must be aligned completely outside the frame of the body of the snapper at the snap. This change paired with the current rule that does not allow the defense to initiate contact with the snapper until one second has elapsed on these type plays will further protect the snapper on kick downs.

Instant Replay/Clock Adjustment and Review Time

If the clock expires at the end of a half, and replay determines that there was time remaining on the clock, and the clock would start on the referee's signal after review, there must be at least three seconds remaining when the ball should have been declared dead to restore time to the clock. With two seconds or one second remaining on the clock, the half is over. This change will not impact situations when the clock is stopped and will remain stopped until the snap such as incomplete passes and runners out of bounds. In addition, the expectation is that the instant replay official will not exceed two minutes to complete any review. The exception is if the review has end-of-game impact or has multiple aspects as a part of the review, it should be completed efficiently but will have no stated time limit.

Other Changes:

- A second jersey meeting all requirements of the jersey rule worn concurrently is allowed.
- The penalty for a team not complying with the jersey rule (i.e., legal and contrasting numbers or a colored jersey in violation of the rule) will be a 15-yard penalty after the kickoff of each half and the loss of a timeout in each quarter that illegal jerseys are worn.
- Defensive team substitution infractions will now be treated as a live ball foul.
- All fouls that have an option to carry over to the succeeding kickoff will also contain an option to carry over to the succeeding spot in extra periods.

East Carolina looks to bounce back from a 27-23 loss to Navy Oct. 17, which preceded last week's open date ... The Pirates' lone win was a 44-24 decision at USF Oct. 10 ... The Pirates have averaged 387.2 yards of offense and 31.0 points per game, but have allowed 458.2 yards and 37.8 points through four games ... QB Holton Ahlers is expected to return to the starting lineup after he missed the game against Navy ... Ahlers has thrown for 673 yard and six touchdowns with four interceptions in three games ... Freshman RB Rahjai Harris is averaging 82.5 rushing yards per game with three TDs ... WR C.J. Johnson has a team-high three touchdowns with four interceptions in three games ... COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a big success. Fans, including many who are new to the sport, enjoy it. The first College Football Playoff semifinals and national championship were the three most-viewed programs in cable television history.

Every Game Counts

The playoff preserves the excitement and significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

Four Teams

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

Two Games, One Goal

The kickoff of the new year belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl and Sugar Bowl. The two teams winning the playoff semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. That game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

Selection Committee

A talented group of high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are: Gary Barta (chair), Paola Boivin, Tom Burman, Joe Castiglione, Rick George, Ken Hatfield, Ronnie Lott, Terry Mohajir, Ray Odierno, R.C. Sillocum, Todd Stansbury, Scott Stricklin and John Urschel.

Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

The American And Bowl Season

American Athletic Conference teams are guaranteed at least seven bowl appearances annually as part of the conference's new postseason lineup, which begins with the 2020 season and is in place through 2025..

The American, as it has done three times in the first five years of the current bowl cycle, will continue to send its champion to a New Year's Six bowl if that team finishes higher than the champions of four other conferences in the final College Football Playoff rankings. American Athletic Conference teams are also eligible for the College Football Playoff if they are among the top four teams in the final CFP rankings.

As part of the new bowl cycle, The American will annually send teams to the Military Bowl presented by Perspecta against an Atlantic Coast Conference opponent, the Fenway Bowl in Boston, also against an ACC team, and a third annual spot which will alternate between the Lockheed Martin Armed Forces Bowl and the SoFi Hawaii Bowl.

Additionally, The American will annually have four appearances in a group of eight bowls. The American has extended its existing partnerships with the TicketSmarter Birmingham Bowl, the Gasparilla Bowl, the Cheribundi Boca Raton Bowl, the Tropical Smoothie Cafe Frisco Bowl and the Cure Bowl.

New to The American's lineup are the SERVPRO First Responder Bowl and the Myrtle Beach Bowl.

THE AMERICAN ON TELEVISION

The American and ESPN reached agreement on a 12-year media rights extension that begins with the 2020-21 academic year.

With the new agreement, The American will have a stronger and more extensive presence on ESPN's primary TV networks – ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU. The Conference will also be a valuable part of ESPN+, ESPN's industry-leading direct-to-consumer sports streaming service.

In football, a minimum of 40 regular-season telecasts per season will be televised on ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU, including at least 20 across ABC, ESPN and ESPN2, which represents increased annual exposure across those ESPN networks. The American Championship game will be televised each year on ABC or ESPN.

Beyond select Navy football games, all conference controlled football games from The American will air on an ESPN network or ESPN+.
