FOCUS OF THE MONTH

VOLUNTARY SUMMER WORKOUTS

Individual Sports Exceptions (T&F, SWD, MGO, WGO, WTE)	If a SA requests assistance during a vacation period or the summer, coaches may be present and provide skill instruction to SAs. Coaches may be present and may not conduct the workout (standard provide skill instruction to SAs.				
Team Sports	Unfortunately, SAs may not participate in any voluntary athletically related activities with countable coaches during any institutional vacation period and/or summer.				
All Sports Exception	SAs can take part in specific works conducted by S&C coaches, provid conducted at the request of the SA	led the workouts are voluntary and			

- For a workout to be voluntary, it must be requested by the SA, the coaching staff doesn't supervise or direct the workout, information from the workout isn't related back to the staff, attendance is not recorded, and there is no penalty for not participating. (17.02.19)
- 1st time participants must undergo a medical exam within 6 months prior to participation, including a sickle cell test. (13.11.3.7.3, 13.11.3.8.1)
- PSAs can receive workout apparel on an issuance and retrieval basis as long as they've signed an NLI, or offer of admission/financial aid. (13.11.3.7.1, 13.11.3.8)

SUMMER CAMP EMPLOYMENT

- A SA may be employed by their institution, by another institution, or by a private organization to work a camp or clinic as a counselor, unless otherwise restricted by NCAA legislation. (12.4.3)
- A current SA can be employed at any sports camp or clinic, provided compensation is pursuant to 12.4.1. (13.12.2.1)
- SAs with remaining eligibility cannot conduct their own camp or clinic. (13.12.2.1.1)
- PSAs can be employed at institutional camps or clinics, provided they have signed an NLI and/or a written offer of admission/financial aid, or the institution has received the PSA's financial deposit in response to its offer of admission. (13.12.1.7.1.1)

CAN YOU SPOT THE VIOLATION?

Courtney Kort is a volleyball player at Central University. Over the summer, players could attend voluntary summer workouts with a noncountable strength coach. In June, Courtney asked to meet with her coach to discuss her upcoming class schedule. During the meeting, the coach asked Courtney to make a list of teammates who missed the next summer workout, as they would have to run on the first day of practice.



The violation occurred when the coach asked Courtney to record who missed the voluntary summer workout in order to punish those who missed. The activity is no longer considered "voluntary" because the following conditions were not met:

(c) The student-athlete's attendance and participation in the activity (or lack thereof) may not be recorded for the purposes of reporting such information to coaching staff members or other studentathletes; and (d) The student-athlete may not be subjected to penalty if he or she elects not to participate in the activity. In addition, neither the institution nor any athletics department staff member may provide recognition or incentives (e.g., awards) to a student-athlete based on his or her attendance or performance in the activity.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Question: How can the institution advertise a camp or clinic?

Contact Period

Answer: Advertisements may be placed in a recruiting publication provided the publication includes a camp director that meets the following requirements. A) The size and format of such advertisements must be identical, and B) The camp directory must include multiple listings of summer camps on each page. 13.4.3.2.1

Question: May a camp or clinic be used as a tryout event with workouts devoted to agility, flexibility, speed, or strength?

Answer: No. Member institutions may not host, sponsor, or conduct a tryout camp, clinic, group workout or combine devoted to agility, flexibility, speed or strength. 13.11.1.14
