■ FAST FACTS

- >> Saturday will mark the first-ever meeting between Murray State and Cincinnati. The Racers are 1-29-1 all-time against FBS opponents and 0-4 against Top 25 FBS opponents. Saturday's contest will mark the fourth time MSU has faced a top 10 opponent and the third time since 2012.
- » With expectations at a recent high, the Racer did not disappoint in their season opener against Mississippi Valley State. Murray State shutout the Delta Devils in the win, 35-0.
- >> Appearing in most, if not all, conversations on this year's Heisman race, Cincy quarterback Desmond Ridder showed why he is being considered for college football's top honor last week in a 49-14 thrashing of Miami (OH). The Louisville native was 20-for-25 passing in the game for 419 yards and four touchdowns to go along with a rushing touchdown and 31 yards on the ground.
- The Bearcat receiving corps is also über-talented this season with 11 different receivers catching a pass and four different receivers scoring against Miami. On the ground, Jerome Ford rushed for 121 yards and a score, while Jabari Taylor paced the defense with five tackles, 2.0 tackles-for-loss and 1.0 sacks.
