UCFACTS 💥

- > In his first stint as a head coach, Scott Frost took over a winless UCF team from 2015 and turned it into a 6-7 squad that earned a bowl berth in 2016. The Knights have continued that momentum, starting the 2017 season 3-0.
- ▶ After defeating Memphis to improve to 3-0 for the first time since 2013, the Knights found themselves in the Top 25 since the end of that same season. UCF was ranked in 25th in both the AP and Coaches Poll on Sunday.
- >> UCF is one of just three teams in nation that are ranked in the top 10 in both scoring offense and scoring defense, joined by Alabama and Washington. The Knights are seventh in both categories.
- >> The Knights' first three opponents this season FIU, Maryland and Memphis are undefeated in 2017 when they don't play UCF. Each is 3-1 with its only loss coming against the Knights.
- >> Sophomore quarterback McKenzie Milton has improved on his stellar freshman campaign, currently ranking seventh in the nation in passing efficiency (173.0). He has thrown for 791 yards with eight touchdowns and just two interceptions in three games.
- >> Shaquem Griffin returned to lead the defense in 2017. The outside linebacker was the 2016 American Athletic Conference Defensive Player of the Year and was named a USA Today Sports Preseason All-American.
- >> Junior Mike Hughes joined fall camp late and made an immediate impact at corner. He has had two interceptions - one for a touchdown - and leads the nation with 2.33 passes defended per game.

📈 LAST TIME OUT 📈

UCF (3-0, 1-0) thoroughly dominated Memphis (3-1, 0-1) in every facet of the game to the tune of a 40-13 victory on Saturday night at Spectrum Stadium. It was the American Athletic Conference opener for both squads.

The Knights ran wild over the Tigers with 350 rushing yards, led by Adrian Killins, Jr.'s career-high 115 on the ground. Quarterback McKenzie Milton ran for 88 yards and Taj McGowan added 63 yards and a rushing score. On the defensive side, the Black and Gold held the Tigers to 75 yards on the ground and forced four turnovers. Memphis reached UCF territory on seven drives, five of which ended in turnovers or on fourth-down stops.

Up 9-7 late in the first quarter and backed up to their own four-yard line, the Knights shifted the momentum when Killins, Jr. bounced a handoff outside all the way to the end zone, which set numerous records including the longest play from scrimmage in program history. The score opened the floodgates, as the Knights scored 36 unanswered points and rendering the highly rated Memphis offense inept. Milton was efficient in the pocket, throwing for 253 yards on 19-of-31 passing with three scoring tosses, leading the offense to its first 600-yard game since 2013.



ORLANDO'S HOMETOWN TEAM NOTES 💥

GOOD COMPANY

- >> There are currently three teams in the entire nation who rank in the Top 10 in both scoring offense and scoring defense -- Alabama, Washington and UCF.
- >> The Knights are No. 7 in both categories.
- >> UCF scores 46.3 points per game and allows just 13.3.

THIIIRRRRRRRD DOWN! (AND FOURTH)

- >> The Knights currently rank No. 4 in the nation and No. 1 in The American in 3rd-down conversion defense.
- >> UCF opponents have only converted 21.6 percent (8-of-35) of their third-down opportunities into a fresh set of downs.
- >> Here's a breakdown of the third-down conversion rates for each of the Knights' three opponents so far this season: FIU - 2/12; Maryland - 2/13; Memphis - 4/12.
- >> The Knights are pretty solid on fourth down, as well. After allowing two fourth-down conversions against FIU, UCF has allowed just 2-of-6 in the past two games.

OPPONENTS UNDEFEATED AGAINST EVERYONE ELSE

- >> FIU, Maryland and Memphis are a combined 0-3 against UCF. The Panthers, Terrapins and Tigers are 9-0 against everyone else they've played.
- >> FIU lost 61-17 to UCF and holds wins over Alcorn State, Rice and Charlotte.
- Maryland lost 38-10 to the Knights and holds victories over Texas, Towson and Minnesota.
- >> Memphis lost 40-13 to UCF and has defeated UL-Monroe, UCLA and Southern Illinois.

BAKING TURNOVERS

- >> UCF is currently No. 1 in the nation in turnover margin at +2.33 per game.
- >> UCF scored four turnovers vs. FIU, added a pair of interceptions at Maryland and tallied five more takeaways vs. Memphis last week.
- >> The Knights' offense has only turned the ball over three times in three games this season. The Knights had 2 takeaways vs. FIU, 0 against Maryland and tossed 1 pick vs. Memphis.
- >> The Knights are No. 6 in turnovers lost (3) and No. 19 in turnovers gained (10).

2016 TURNAROUND

- >> Head coach Scott Frost and his team will tell you they're tired of being congratulated for going 6-7 last season. But the fact remains that in his first season at the helm of the Knights, Frost guided a program that was winless in 2015 to six victories and a bowl berth.
- >> Only eight teams in the history of NCAA FBS football have gone from winless to a bowl game in one season.
- >> While the Knights don't want to make a habit of that, it was the second time UCF has accomplished the feat. In 2004, the Knights were 0-11 and posted an 8-5 mark in 2005.
- >> The six-win improvement was the fourth-largest turnaround season in the past 20 years.

AWESOME ACADEMICS

- >> As a department, UCF has gone 9.5 years (19 semesters) with an average GPA of 3.0+.
- >> This past spring, UCF Athletics posted a department-record 3.27 grade-point average. More than 60 percent of UCF's 435 student-athletes posted a 3.0 or better, with 36 percent earning Dean's List honors (3.4 or better). A total of 37 Knights posted a 4.0 GPA last spring.
- >> The Knights' football team boasts a 983 NCAA Academic Progress Rate score. That ranks UCF No. 11 among all FBS institutions and No. 6 among public, non-military schools. UCF's APR tally has been tops in all of Florida for the past three years.
- >> The Knights are graduating as well. As a department, UCF's NCAA Graduation Success Rate is at 94 percent. In the most recent ranking (November 2016), UCF was tied for sixth in the nation among FBS institutions. For three straight years, the Knights have boasted the best GSR among NCAA Division I FBS public institutions.

UCF-PHRASES

- >> Coach Frost mentioned the word fast numerous times in his introductory press conference. UCF Athletics quickly began using the hashtag/catch-phrase UCFast (pronounced UCF-Fast), following other similar phrases like UCFiesta (during the Fiesta Bowl) and UCFamily.
- >> UCFast became the offensive catch-phrase. UCFierce was quickly adopted for the defense.
- >> Frost came from Oregon, where the mantra was Win The Day. At UCF, it is Rise & Conquer.

📈 #UCFAST NOTES 📈

MASTERFUL MILTON

>> Sophomore McKenzie Milton has made huge strides forward this season. He had an upand-down campaign in 2016, where he was thrust in the starting lineup three games into his collegiate career. But he's making solid decisions and is hurting opponents with his arm and his legs in 2017. Milton ranks No. 7 in the nation in passing efficiency and No. 11 in passing yards per completion. He ranks No. 108 in the nation in rushing.

QUARTERBACK NOTEBOOK

- >> Milton gets chunks of yards nearly every time he throws the ball. He currently ranks No. 9 in the nation, averaging 9.55 yards per pass attempt.
- >> Milton also ranks No. 39 in the nation in passing touchdowns with 8 in just three games.
- Milton is also No. 14 in the country in total offense at 325.7 yards per game.
- >> True freshman Noah Vedral has seen action in all three games so far this season.

HE GOOOOONE! (COPYRIGHT @TJ LSUDAD)

>> Sophomore Adrian Killins Jr. received a great deal of hype from YouTube/Twitter football commentator @TJ LSUDAD when he busted an 87-yard TD run at Michigan and a 100-yard kick return at ECU last season. Killins lit up the internet, Twitter, etc. again on Saturday. His 96-yard sprint off right tackle broke UCF and American Athletic Conference records for longest rush, longest TD rush and longest play from scrimmage.

RUNNING BACK NOTEBOOK

- >> Killins rushed for 115 yards on nine carries vs. Memphis. It was his first career 100-yard rushing day and the first for UCF since C.J. Jones ran for 123 at Cincinnati on Oct. 31, 2015.
- >> Taj McGowan scored the Knights' first TD vs. Memphis, giving him a total of 4 rushing TDs this season. He rushed for 63 yards last week.
- >> True freshmen Otis Anderson and Cordarrian Richardson combined for 12 carries for 66 yards vs. Memphis.
- >> Six different running backs carried the rock vs. Memphis last week, if you include Anderson who is listed as a WR but will often line up in the backfield.

TOUCHDOWN TRE'QUAN

>> Junior wide receiver Tre'Quan Smith is the Knights' leading receiver with 10 catches for 172 yards. Of those 10 receptions, he has pulled in 4 touchdowns. Smith needs just one more touchdown reception to match his career high of 5 from last season. Smith was the American Athletic Conference Rookie of the Year in 2015, despite the Knights going 0-12 that season.

RECEIVER NOTEBOOK

- >> Smith has 13 touchdown receptions in 28 games for the Knights. His 2 touchdowns vs. Memphis marked the third time in his career he has found the end zone more than once -- he has now done it twice this season.
- >> Weapons galore ... 11 different receivers (WR/TE) caught at least one pass vs. FIU and 12 different receivers (not including RBs) have caught at least one ball this season.
- >> Youngsters abound in the Knights' receiving corps. Freshman Gabriel Davis started in his first collegiate game and caught 4 passes for 53 yards and a TD. True freshmen Emmanuel Logan-Greene, Marlon Williams and Otis Anderson all have receptions this season as well.
- >> Tight end Jordan Akins leads the team with a 19.4-yard average per reception.

ART BY AARON

>> Senior Aaron Evans has been staple in the Knights' lineup for the past two-plus seasons. Last week was his 29th consecutive start at left tackle. An accomplished artist, Evans has designed all his own tattoos and often fills free time by sketching and even creating origami.

OFFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

- >> Every offensive lineman listed atop the Knights' depth chart has at least six starts.
- >> Junior right tackle Wyatt Miller has now started 24 games.
- >> Senior Chavis Dickey was an Honorable Mention Freshman All-America selection by CollegeFootballNews.com in 2014 at right tackle. He moved to guard in 2016.
- >> Sophomore Jordan Johnson started 12 games as a true freshman in 2016.





#UCFIERCE NOTES

THE GOODS ON GRIFFIN

>> Senior Shaquem Griffin is the reigning, defending, undisputed (copyright Paul Heyman) American Athletic Conference Defensive Player of the Year. He went from virtual unknown to one of the top defensive players in the nation and apparently all it took was a position change. Griffin was a backup safety for his first three years at UCF. But the new coaching staff moved him to outside linebacker and the rest is history. Griffin notched his first sack of the season vs. Memphis, stripping the QB and forcing a turnover in the process. That play came with the Tigers knocking on the door at the UCF 5-yard line. He has 3 tackles for-loss this season.

LINEBACKER NOTEBOOK

- >> Griffin was named a Second-Team Preseason All-America by USA Today.
- >> Griffin is on the preseason watch list for the Butkus Award, the Nagusrki Trophy, the Bednarik Award and the Wuerffel Trophy. He's also an AFCA Good Works Team nominee.
- >> Junior Pat Jasinski has played in all 28 games with 9 starts during his career. He leads the team with 19 tackles. Jasinski recovered the fumble Griffin forced vs. Memphis last week.
- >> Senior Chequan Burkett started every game in 2015 and has started all 3 this year.
- >> Six UCF linebackers currently have 10 or more tackles and rank top nine on the team.

FABULOUS FRONT

>> The strength of UCF's defense is the defensive line. All three starters return up front off a defense that was among the best in the nation last season. Senior Jamiyus Pittman, sophomore Trysten Hill and senior Tony Guerad have started all three games. Pittman and Hill switched positions, however. Pittman slid out to end, while Hill is now at nose.

DEFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

- >> The defensive line accounted for 8 of 12 tackles for-loss and 4.5 of 5.0 sacks at Maryland.
- >> Pittman and Guerad each tallied 1 tackle for-loss in the win over Memphis.
- >> Guerad led the group from a statistical standpoint in 2016, tallying 10 tackles for-loss and 3.5 sacks. His 62 tackles were also most among the defensive front.
- >> Guerad leads the D Line with 9 tackles, including 3 tackles for-loss.
- >> Pittman earned Second-Team All-Conference honors from The American last season. He posted 28 tackles, 4.5 tackles for-loss, a pair of sacks, a pass breakup and two fumble recoveries in 2016. He is on the Outland Trophy Preseason Watch List.
- >> Pittman has 6 tackles in 2017 and has made the most of them, with 3 TFLs and 2 sacks.
- >> Hill is the strongest Knight. He has been a social media sensation with videos coming out of the UCF weight room in the past.
- >> While all three starters are returning, the Knights have plenty of depth up front. Connors has played in 24 games with 4 starts. Junior A.J. Wooten played in all 13 games last season with five starts. Senior Seyvon Lowry has played in 33 total games.
- >> Nine defensive linemen have recorded tackles this season. Hill, Pittman, Guerad, Connors, Wooten, Lowry, Aaron Cochran, Brendon Hayes and Josh Odigie have all put marks in the stats sheet.

BALL HAWKS

>> Juniors Tre Neal and Kyle Gibson are the newly-minted starters at safety. Both have turned in in big plays in the first two games. Neal recorded the first interception of the season for the Knights and returned it 29 yards vs. FIU. Gibson has picks in each of the last two games and both have been SportsCenter worthy.

SECONDARY NOTEBOOK

- >> Junior college transfer Mike Hughes was added to the Knights' roster on August 18 and has made an immediate impact. He broke up three passes vs. FIU, tallied a Pick Six at Maryland and added two more PBUs and an INT vs. Memphis
- >> With 7 passes defended for an average of 2.33 per game, Hughes ranks No. 1 in the nation in that category.
- >> Red-shirt freshman Brandon (Bam) Moore started the first three games of the season at cornerback. He broke up 3 passes last week and has registered 8 tackles for the season, including 1 stop behind the line of scrimmage.

>> Junior Mac Loudermilk can do a bit of everything. His versatility was on display in the season-opening victory over FIU. Loudermilk has taken over the starting punter's role this season. All three of his punts vs. FIU were downed inside the 20-yard line. One of those punts stopped at the 1-yard line and led to a safety for the Knights' defense. He also served as the holder on PAT/field goal attempts. Following the Knights' first score of the game, he successfully converted a pass to tight end Jordan Franks for a 2-point conversion. In the 2016 Spring Game, Loudermilk was working at tight end and hauled in a long TD reception. Coach Frost joked on UCFKnights.TV after the game that the only thing Loudermilk doesn't know how to do is **shave**. Loudermilk does have the **most impressive beard** on the squad.

SPECIALIST NOTEBOOK

- >> Junior Matthew Wright is in his third season handling field goal and point-after duties for the Knights. He has successfully converted 71-of-74 PAT attempts in his career. Wright is 29-of-35 on field-goal attempts after going 2-of-2 vs. Memphis.
- >> Wright also took over kickoff duties this season. He is averaging 61.1 yards per kickoff with 6 touchbacks on 23 kicks.
- >> Junior Caleb Perez takes over the long-snapping duties this season.
- >> Loudermilk has punted 13 times for a 38.6-yard average with 7 ending up inside the opponents' 20-yard line.
- >> There will be no shortage of weapons in the kick-return game. The ever-dangerous sophomore Adrian Killins can line up at that position after averaging 25.1 yards per return, including a 100-yard jaunt at ECU and a 75-yarder vs. Tulsa.
- >> Junior Mike Hughes took over the punt return duties in the season-opener. He made an immediate impact, with his first punt return as a Knight going back 43 yards.
- >> Hughes also returned kickoffs the last two weeks.

Scott Frost was named the 10th head coach in the history UCF Football on Dec. 1, 2015. On the day he was hired, Frost told fans to buckle their seatbelts because the Knights were going to punch the accelerator and go fast.

True to his word and to the team's trademark offense — UCFast — Frost quickly led the Black and Gold back to its winning ways. The former national-champion quarterback at Nebraska took over a Knights team that went 0-12 in 2015 and led them to a postseason bowl game in his first season at the helm.

UCF went 6-7 in the inaugural season under the leadership of Frost, and earned a bid to the 2016 AutoNation Cure Bowl at Orlando's Camping World Stadium. It marked the first time a team had gone from winless to a bowl game since UCF went 0-11 in 2004 and then played in the 2005 Hawaii Bowl.

DEFENSIVE TURNAROUND

With Frost at the helm, UCF made one of the best defensive turnarounds in the nation in 2016. The Knights led the American Athletic Conference in five defensive statistical categories, ranked second in the nation in red zone defense and third in the nation with five defensive touchdowns.

In 2015, the Knights ranked 117th in the nation, allowing 37.7 points per game. In 2016, Frost's squad allowed just 24.6 points per contest, ranking 42nd in the nation. UCF also went from just 13 forced turnovers in 2015 (115th nationally) to 26 turnovers forced in 2016 (18th nationally).

EARLY HONORS

In November of 2016, Frost was named a national semifinalist for the George Munger Coach of the Year Award, which is presented yearly by the Maxwell Football Club. The list included 16 candidates for the award, which were selected by the MFC National Selection Committee.

A HIGH-POWERED SHOW

Frost came to UCF from Oregon, where he was an assistant coach from 2009-15, ascending to offensive coordinator in 2013. In 2009, the Ducks ranked

33rd in total offense and eighth in scoring. One year later, they climbed to first in the FBS in both categories, and never dropped below sixth with Frost on staff.

Oregon won at least 10 games each year from 2009-14, and had a 79-11 record during Frost's tenure before he accepted the role at UCF. The Ducks appeared in the national title game in 2010 and 2014 along with the Rose Bowl, Fiesta Bowl and Alamo Bowl.

Frost was the offensive coordinator as Marcus Mariota won the Heisman Trophy following a 2014 campaign where he threw for 4,454 yards and 42 touchdowns with just four interceptions. Mariota completed 66.8 percent of his passes with 105 passing touchdowns and 14 picks as a Duck, as well as rushing for 2,237 yards and 29 touchdowns from 2012-14.

ENTERING THE COACHING RANKS

Frost originally kicked off his career on the sidelines as a graduate assistant at Nebraska in 2002, then held the same role with Kansas State in 2006. His first full-time position came as the linebackers coach for Northern Iowa in 2007 and then as co-defensive coordinator in 2008. Both of those seasons the Panthers appeared in the FCS Playoffs.

FROST'S PLAYING DAYS

A native of Wood River, Neb., Frost traveled to Stanford to begin his college career under legendary Pro Football Hall of Fame head coach Bill Walsh. Frost played at both quarterback and free safety for the Cardinal. He then returned home to suit up for Nebraska and head coach College Football Hall of Famer Tom Osborne. After sitting out the 1995 campaign where the program went 12-0 en route to the national title, he took over for Tommie Frazier in 1996 as the Cornhuskers' starting signal-caller. That season, he was selected as the Big 12 Offensive Newcomer of the Year thanks to throwing for 1,440 yards with 13 touchdowns and just three picks. He also rushed for 438 yards and nine touchdowns.

As a senior in 1997, Frost was a Johnny Unitas Award finalist, a Davey O'Brien Award semifinalist and a CoSIDA Academic All-America selection. He was voted on to the All-Big 12 Second Team, throwing for 1,237 yards and rushing for 1,096 along with 19 touchdowns on the ground.

During 1997, the Cornhuskers faced off with UCF in Lincoln, where the Knights, who were in just their second year in the FBS, surprised the home team with a 17-14 halftime lead. No. 6 Nebraska bounced back with 17 points in the third quarter for a 38-24 win, and the Cornhuskers eventually were a perfect 13-0 to claim yet another national championship.

Frost would later be tagged in the NFL Draft's third round by the New York Jets, and played in regular season games on defense for the Jets, Browns and Buccaneers.
