Sprints/Hurdles


Cedric Powell and Bob Kandell will return as the Bearcats' top sprinters. They are joined by Justin Conway, Antione Drakeford and Keith Hamilton to form a deep, veteran group that should prove successful in the BIG EAST. Scott Maze and Brandon Wright return to lead the hurdles group, while Dominick Davolio, Isaac Hendricks and Troy Lammers will have an impact before the season is done, as will freshmen Ekundayo Igeleke and Alan Moore.



After struggling throughout the 2006 season, the women's sprint teams will be better prepared for the challenges that await in 2007. Juniors Dominique Davis and Jasmine Smith and sophomores Dennale Speakman and Camron Turner have a year's worth of BIG EAST experience under their belts and all have a shot at scoring in the BIG EAST Championships. Freshman Ashley Arnold is expected to be a consistent contributor. Junior Monica Hundley is primed for a breakout year in the hurdles. Cory Huber and Danielle Erwin are consistent contributors and freshman Sharika Thompson will make a splash.

Middle Distance

The 800 meters is one of the deepest events on the men's team. Junior Alex Ramsey, junior Patrick Starkey and senior Jake Richards each have the talent to score in the BIG EAST Championships. Brad Neuman returns to lead the 1,500 pack.




After losing Jocelyn

Gibson to graduation, the women's team has a big void to fill in the 800 and 1,500. UC will rely heavily on transfer Betsy Jacobs.

Distance

The men's distance events will be a strength in 2007 as junior John Dixon returns along with NCAA Regional qualifier Kevin Schwarz (3,000 steeplechase) to lead the way. Bill Keckeis and sophomore twins Randy and Rick King will be steady contributors, while redshirt freshman Solomon Kessio and true freshman Tommy Morgan have the potential to be scorers in the BIG EAST Championships.

The women's team features standouts senior Cristy Doll, junior Nichole Leslie and sophomore Megan Knapp, each of whom have the potential to qualify for the BIG EAST Championships. Juniors Jennifer Hannen and Amy Schoenfeld provide quality depth, while newcomers Lilian



Jelimo and Kayla Phelps give the Bearcats a solid group upon which to build.

Jumps

Despite losing NCAA participant Chandler Groves, the long jump again should be a solid event for the Bearcats. Senior Bob Kandell and juniors Tim Poirier and Cameron Widget will give UC a strong corps of leapers. Andrew Smith, who met the NCAA regional mark in the high jump in 2005, returns for his senior season. Joining Smith will be freshmen Anthony Busellato and Brandon Fitch, who each have the ability to score in the BIG EAST Championships. The pole vault will be led by junior Keller Schnier. Freshmen Shane Shockey and Elliot Vocke will be expected to step up and fill the void left by the graduation of BIG EAST qualifiers Dan Albrinck and Chad Beamer.




The jumping events should also be a strong suit for the women, as Renee Hein (high jump), Ashley Wilhelm (long jump), Shintara Carpenter (triple jump), Brittany Klima (pole vault) and Tara Meier (pole vault) each return as UC record-holders. Hein, who competed in the NCAA

Championships in 2005 and 2006, is joined in the high jump by Klima. Wilhelm and Ije Obiorah will score in the long jump, while Carpenter and Obiorah are expected to solidify the triple jump. Meier and Klima each have the ability to meet NCAA qualifying marks in the pole vault and should place in the BIG EAST Championships.

Throw:

Steve Kahle, he 2005 Conference USA shot put champion, returns after missing the 2006 season due to injury. Chad Hanson and Bryan Hardesty will handle the discus duties for the Bearcats and should both score in BIG EAST competition. Justin Salamon and Ryan Flynn also will contribute lan Jarman, UC's top hammer thrower, finished seventh in the BIG EAST during his freshman campaign.

Sophomore Lisa Klotz was superb in the indoor season in 2006, ranking 10th in the BIG EAST in the shot put,



before missing the outdoor season due to injury. She returns in 2007 as UC's top thrower. Senior Jenni Schmitmeyer returns to solidify the discus and hammer

events. Freshmen Emily Taylor, the Ohio state runner-up in the shotput, Krystal Barnhill, state shot put champ, and Meagan Williams will contribute as well.

Multi/Relays

The decathlon has traditionally been a dominant event for the Bearcats, as three decathletes have competed in the NCAA Championships in the last three seasons. This season, some youngsters will try to establish themselves as the next in the long line of decathlon stars. Sophomore Caleb Arthur and junior Keller Schnier, son of head coach Bill Schnier, are the top returnees, having finished eighth and 10th, respectively at the BIG EAST Championships. Sophomores Caleb Gaus and Lane Raney are improving and may be factors this season.



Senior Ashley Wilhelm, who provisionally qualified for the NCAA Championships in 2005 in the heptathlon, is the top returnee to the women's team. She is the school record holder in both the pentathlon and heptathlon and will be a force in 2007. Freshman Jasmine Cotten will make an immediate impact in both the pentathlon and heptathlon.

The defending BIG EAST champion 4x100 relay team, led by Bob Kandell, Cedric Powell and Justin Conway has a legitimate chance to qualify for NCAA competition. The 4x400 team, which finished second in the BIG EAST last season, looks for a championship this year. The 4x800 squad, an event featured at the BIG EAST Championships will be another strong point for the Bearcats as Alex Ramsey, Patrick Starkey, Jake Richards and Brad Neuman or Zach Webb will complete the team.

The women's relays will be led by Dominique Davis, Dennale Speakman, and Jasmine Cotten. Ashley Arnold, Danielle Erwin and Wilhelm will also contribute in the relay events.





BILL SCHNIER HEAD MEN'S COACH DISTANCE

Since Bill Schnier's arrival at the University of Cincinnati,

the Bearcat track and field program has progressed into one of the most competitive in the country.

Entering his 27th season at the helm of the Bearcats, Schnier looks to take the team to the top of the BIG EAST. He led the 2006 squad to a fifth-place finish at the BIG EAST Championships in its first year in the conference.

The Conference USA Coach of the Decade for both cross country and track, Schnier has led the men's team to 12 conference titles and did not finish lower than third at a conference championship meet since 1986 until 2006 when the Bearcats joined the BIG EAST.

Since arriving in 1980, Schnier has seen 124 of his athletes earn individual conference championships. He has qualified 15 athletes for the NCAA Championships and mentored five All-Americans. A 13-time conference coach of the year, Schnier was named Ohio Cross Country Coach of the Year in 1995.

UC added women's track in 1996 and in just three years, Schnier led the Bearcats to a best-ever fourth place finish at the C-USA indoor championship in 1999.

Healso garnered two third place finishes in cross country in 1998 and 1999. He turned the reigns of the women's program over to longtime assistant Jim Schnur in 2001.

Of Schnier's athletes, 15 have won the prestigious Jimmy Nippert Award, honoring the most outstanding male senior student-athlete. He has also coached three winners of the Helen Norman Smith award, honoring the top female student-athlete.

A 1966 graduate of Capital University in Bexley, Ohio, Schnier played baseball for two years before switching to track and eventually setting the school's half-mile record, which still stands. Schnier earned master's degrees from both Wright State and Indiana University in 1977 before earning his doctorate in human performance from Indiana in 1987. He taught history for seven years while coaching cross country and track and field at Trotwood Madison High in Trotwood, Ohio, before heading back to collegiate coaching, accepting an assistantship at Indiana.

Schnier is married to the former Kathy Henn. The couple has three children: Lorraine (27), Ellen (24) and Keller (22). Keller is a decathlete for the UC track and field team.

SUSAN SEATON ASSISTANT MEN'S COACH THROWS

Susan Seaton oversees both the men's and women's throwers for the University of Cincinnati program and also serves as the assistant coach for the men's team.

Seaton, who joined the UC staff in 2004-05, has already brought success to the Bearcats. Two of her athletes, Steve Kahle (shot put) and Jo Young (hammer) were crowned Conference USA Outdoor Champions in 2005. The Bearcats also recorded three NCAA Mid-East Regional qualifying marks, one NCAA Championship qualifying mark and four school records.

Seaton previously served six years as assistant coach at the University of Wisconsin. She coached student-athletes to four Big Ten crowns, two All-American honors, four NCAA qualifiers and eight school records.

Prior to her stint at Wisconsin, Seaton served for three years as an assistant coach at Northern Arizona University where she produced three All-Americans, 12 conference champions and five NCAA qualifiers.

Seaton was a standout athlete for the East German junior track and field team and competed in various track and field events for over 15 years. At the prime of her career she was a javelin specialist

and took third place at the 1989 East German Amateur National Championships and finished in second place at the 1986 National Club Championships.

A native of Saalfeld, Germany, Seaton earned her bachelor's of science from the German College of Sports Science in 1991 and a masters of science in exercises science from the University of Leipzig in 1994. Seaton is USATF Level I certified and a recent graduate of the NCAA Women Coaches Academy.

Susan and her husband, Robert, reside in College Hill, Cincinnati, and are parents to son Patrick (21) and Aidan (1).



JIM SCHNUR HEAD WOMEN'S COACH MULTI, JUMPS

A member of the Cincinnati coaching staff since 1984, Jim Schnur was named the head

women's track and field coach in 2001. He actively coaches the jumping and multi events for both programs while striving to build the women's team into a highly competitive program on the national level.

During the 2005 season, the women's team qualified two athletes for the NCAA Championships for the first time in school history and has sent three women to the NCAA Championships over the last four years. He also trained UC's first women All-American, Mimi Merrill, who placed eighth in the 2001 Indoor NCAA Track and Field Championships in the 20-pound weight throw. Schnur has seen 13 indoor and 15 outdoor school records fall during his tenure as head coach.

Focusing on the multi events, Schnur has built Cincinnati into a dominant force in the decathlon and heptathlon. The Bearcats won six Conference USA decathlon titles in the 10 years of affiliation with the league. He has guided three former walk-on decathletes to the NCAA Championships in the last two years, including All-American Chris Wineberg in 2004.

Schnur graduated from Cincinnati in 1978 with a degree in psychology. He represented UC in seven NCAA Championships in track and field, competing in the 400 meters (five times) and the decathlon (twice). Schnur placed

A former All-American decathlete at UC, Chris Wineberg joined the coaching staff in 2006 as assistant women's coach. He special-

izes in the sprints and multi events and has responsibilities throughout the program including recruiting, team travel and team training.

A two-time Conference USA decathlon champion, Wineberg holds the UC record with a score of 7,584. He finished eighth in the event at the 2004 NCAA Championships, earning the school's first All-American honors in the decathlon. He also holds the UC record in the heptathlon and finished fifth in the event at the U.S. National Championships in 2005 and 2006.

After graduating in 2004 with a bachelor's of science in mechanical engineering, Wineberg was a part-time assistant with the Bearcats while continuing to train and compete on the national level.

A native of South Vienna, Ohio, Wineberg is married to former UC track star Mary Danner. The two were wed in the summer of 2006 and reside in Cincinnati.

inducted into the UC Athletic Hall of Fame.

Schnur began his career at UC as the sprints and field events coach in 1984. He has personally coached over 90 Conference Champions during his tenure here. He has mentored 10 NCAA Qualifiers and two All-Americans while at UC.

Academic achievement is also stressed under Schnur's watch. Since taking the reigns of the women's program, 57 Bearcats have earned Conference USA Commissioner's Honor Roll accolades, which recognizes those studentathletes who have maintained a cumulative 3.0 grade point average, and over 180 Bearcat (3.0 GPA, quarter) and Topcat (3.5) Scholar honors were awarded in 2005 alone.

Schnur is married to the former Denise Wanner. The couple has four children: Kelly (23), Katie (21), Audrey (18), and Jason (16).

BIG EAST CHAMPS



ACADEMIC HONORS POUR IN

Junior high jumper Andrew Smith and senior distance runner Karen Berling were named to the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-District second team in 2006.

Berling also was named the UC BIG EAST/ Aeropostale Scholar-Athlete of the Year and awarded a \$2,000 postgraduate scholarship.

Senior middle distance runner Jake Richards was inducted into Phi Beta Kappa, the nation's oldest and largest academic honors society.



2006 BIG EAST CHAMPIONSHIPS

The men's team finished fifth in its first BIG EAST Championships. The women's team finished 14th at the Indoor Championships and 13th outdoors. John Bowie won the 100 meter dash crown and helped the 4x100 relay team to a title. Ashley Wilhelm finished second in the indoor pentathlon and Renee Hein was second in the outdoor high jump. Sixteen student-athletes earned All-BIG EAST Honors, including five first-team mentions.

HEIN OF THE TIMES

Junior Renee Hein placed second in the high jump at the BIG EAST Outdoor Championships and qualified for the regional meet for the third time in her career. The school recordholder in the indoor high jump, Hein is second in UC history in the outdoor jump. She competed in the NCAA Championships for the second straight season.

PAIR REPRESENTS UC AT NCAAS

Chandler Groves and Renee Hein competed at the NCAA Championships in Sacramento, Calif. in 2006. Groves automatically qualified in the long jump after finishing fifth at the Mid-East Regional Championships. Hein made her second straight NCAA appearance as an at-large selection in the high jump. She finished 19th in the country and second at the BIG EAST Championships.

The team of Justin Conway, Cedric Powell, Bob Kandell and John Bowie set a school record with a 40.08 at the Mid-East Regional Championships. The Bearcats won six 4x100 titles during the season and finished outside of the top spot just twice.
