POSTSEASON HONORS

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Desmond Ridder • Jr. • QB • Cincinnati • Louisville, Ky.

Ridder, who is a semifinalist for the Maxwell Award as the nation's most outstanding player, has been instrumental in Cincinnati's 8-0 record. He has passed for 1,821 yards and 16 touchdowns while rushing for 526 yards and 11 TDs, engineering an offense that averages 40.9 points and 473.1 yards per game. He has accounted for 21 touchdowns in the Bearcats' last five games, throwing 10 touchdown passes and rushing for 11 scores. Ridder, who was The American Rookie of the Year in 2018, is the first Cincinnati player to be chosen as the conference's Offensive Player of the Year.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Zaven Collins • Jr. • LB • Tulsa • Hominy, Okla.

Collins was unanimously chosen as The American Defensive Player of the Year, becoming the first player in league history to earn unanimous player-of-the-year honors. A finalist for the Bronko Nagurski Trophy as the nation's top defensive player and for the Butkus Award as the top linebacker, Collins has registered 51 tackles, 11.5 tackles for loss, four sacks and four interceptions, including two that were returned for touchdowns. Two of Collins' four interceptions clinched wins for Tulsa, including a highlight-reel 96-yard pick six against Tulane in an overtime victory. He is the first player from Tulsa to be named as the conference's Defensive Player of the Year.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Chris Naggar • Sr. • K • SMU • Arlington, Texas

Naggar is a semifinalist for the Lou Groza Collegiate Place-Kicker Award and is the first SMU player to be selected as The American's Special Teams Player of the Year. Naggar leads the conference in scoring in 2020, averaging 9.4 points per game, and has made a league-leading 17 field goals in 21 attempts. He hit game-winning field goals in back-to-back weeks for the Mustangs in victories against Memphis and Tulane to help SMU to a 5-0 start.

ROOKIE OF THE YEAR

Rahjai Harris • Fr. • RB • East Carolina • Duncan, S.C.

Harris rushed for 624 yards and four touchdowns in eight games, averaging 4.9 yards per carry and ranking third in The American in rushing as a true freshman (78.0 ypg).

Ulysses Bentley IV • RFr. • RB • SMU • Houston, Texas

Bentley, a redshirt freshman, led The American with 913 rushing yards and 11 touchdowns in 10 games and topped the conference with 91.3 yards per game.

COACH OF THE YEAR

Luke Fickell • Cincinnati

Fickell was named as The American Coach of the Year for the second time in three seasons. Fickell takes his 8-0 Cincinnati squad into Saturday's American Athletic Conference Championship Game with a national ranking of No. 6 in the Associated Press and USA Today polls. The Bearcats have won their eight games by an average of 25.9 points against a schedule that included two top-25 opponents.

The Stage Is Set

The pairings for the 2020 American Athletic Conference Football Championship Game are set as Cincinnati will face Tulsa Dec. 19.

Defend This House

Cincinnati has won its last 19 games at Nippert Stadium, which is the fourth-longest home field winning streak nationally, while Memphis is fifth with 14 straight home wins. Clemson leads the nation at 28 straight home wins, followed by Notre Dame (24) and Ohio State (23).

Representing The Defense

Cincinnati ranks fifth nationally in scoring defense at 15.0 points allowed per game. The Bearcats are second nationally in pass efficiency defense (94.74) and ninth in total defense (308.1 ypg).

Pulling Rank

Cincinnati and Tulsa both have two wins against top-25 teams in 2020. The Golden Hurricane has defeated two top-25 opponents in the same season for the first time in program history.

Feels Like The First Time

Tulsa is 6-0 in conference play for the first time as a member of The American. Tulsa has won its last seven conference games, dating to last season.

On A Roll

Cincinnati has gone 30-5 since the start of the 2018 season. UCF is 41-7 since the beginning of the 2017 season. SMU and Memphis are both 17-6 since the start of the 2019 campaign. Tulsa has won eight of its last 10, dating to last season.

Big Three

Navy CB Cameron Kinley and Memphis QB Brady White were both chosen as finalists for the 2020 William V. Campbell Trophy, which is presented to the top scholar-athlete in college football. Kinley and White both earned \$18,000 postgraduate scholarships as finalists.

Big Three

UCF QB Dillon Gabriel is second among all NCAA FBS players with 3,353 passing yards in 2020. Memphis QB Brady White is sixth at 3,096 yards, while SMU QB Shane Buechele is seventh at 3,095 yards.

Taking Offense

UCF QB Dillon Gabriel is the national leader in both total offense (387.9 yards per game) and passing offense (372.6 ypg).

Get Your Picks

Tulsa LB Zaven Collins, SMU CB Brandon Crossley and East Carolina CB Ja'Quan McMillian are tied for fifth nationally with four interceptions each. Collins is one of three players nationally with two interception returns for touchdowns.

Career Day

SMU QB Shane Buechele is the NCAA FBS active career leader in passing yards (11,660). Memphis QB Brady White is third with 10,419 career yards.

Career Day II

East Carolina K Jake Verity leads all active FBS players with 74 career field goals.

Penetration

Tulane LB Dorian Williams and Green Wave DE Patrick Johnson are tied for sixth nationally with 14.5 tackles for loss.

Paper Or Plastic?

Tulane DE Patrick Johnson is the national FBS leader with 10.0 sacks.

Bullies

Cincinnati is 12- 1 all-time as a top-10 team.

Stay To The End

Tulsa has won four games this season in which it has trailed by at least 14 points.

Long Division

After playing five years as a 12-team, two-division conference, The American will feature 11 teams in a single-division format for the 2020 season. Each team is scheduled to play eight conference games this season. The top two teams in the final regular season standings will play in the 2020 American Athletic Conference Football Championship, which will take place Dec. 19 at the home stadium of the team with the best winning percentage in conference games.

Leadership

Tulsa OT Chris Paul is the chair of the American Athletic Conference Student-Athlete Advisory Committee and is one of 32 student-athletes nationally on the NCAA SAAC, which reports directly to the NCAA Division I Council.

2020 COLLEGE FOOTBALL RULES CHANGES

Players Numbering

No more than two squad members may be assigned or wear the same jersey number. There were no limits to duplicate numbers in previous seasons. With the recognized popularity of the single-digit numbers, the digit "0" is added as a legal number. Any number to be preceded by "0" such as "07" or "00" remains illegal.

Targeting - Disqualified Player

There were no changes to the targeting rule from an on-field officiating perspective and the rule continues to serve the game well and is changing player behavior in terms of use of the helmet. The change for 2020 is that now a player disqualified for targeting will be declared ineligible for further participation in the game, but the player may remain in the team area.

All other disqualifying fouls such as fighting, two unsportsmanlike conduct fouls, flagrant personal fouls, etc. will be reclassified as fouls requiring ejection. Players ejected will be required to leave the playing enclosure and must remain out of view of the field of play under team supervision.

Pregame Warmup /Officials' Jurisdiction

The Rules Committee address issues of unsportsmanlike behavior in the pregame and took steps to clean this action up. The officials' jurisdiction will now begin at 90 minutes before kickoff (previously 60 minutes). Additionally, when any squad member enters the playing enclosure prior to the game, the head coach or an assistant coach from that team must be present on the field. Furthermore, when any squad member is present within the playing enclosure after the officials' jurisdiction, they must be wearing their jersey or have their numeral readily visible. Players without their numeral readily visible must leave the playing enclosure.

Defensive Linemen on Scrimmage Kick Plays

To further enhance the protection of the snapper on scrimmage kicks, if the offense is in a scrimmage kick formation at the snap, any defensive player within one yard of the line of scrimmage must be aligned completely outside the frame of the body of the snapper at the snap. This change paired with the current rule that does not allow the defense to initiate contact with the snapper until one second has elapsed on these type plays will further protect the snapper on kick downs.

Instant Replay/Clock Adjustment and Review Time

If the clock expires at the end of a half, and replay determines that there was time remaining on the clock, and the clock would start on the referee's signal after review, there must be at least three seconds remaining when the ball should have been declared dead to restore time to the clock. With two seconds or one second remaining on the clock, the half is over. This change will not impact situations when the clock is stopped and will remain stopped until the snap such as incomplete passes and runners out of bounds. In addition, the expectation is that the instant replay official will not exceed two minutes to complete a review. The exception is if the review has end-of-game impact or has multiple aspects as a part of the review, it should be completed efficiently but will have no stated time limit.

Other Changes:

- A second jersey meeting all requirements of the jersey rule worn concurrently is allowed.
- The penalty for a team not complying with the jersey rule (i.e., legal and contrasting numbers or a colored jersey in violation of the rule) will be a 15-yard penalty after the kickoff of each half and the loss of a timeout in each quarter that illegal jerseys are worn.
- Defensive team substitution infractions will now be treated as a live ball foul.
- All fouls that have an option to carry over to the succeeding kickoff will also contain an option to carry over to the succeeding spot in extra periods.

THE GAME

Saturday's game will be the 35th meeting between Cincinnati and Tulsa in a series that dates to 1946 ... Tulsa holds a 17-15-2 series lead, but Cincinnati has won six of the last seven, including a 24-13 win at Nippert Stadium last year ... Cincinnati is making its second consecutive appearance in The American Championship, while Tulsa is in the championship game for the first time ... Tulsa becomes the seventh American Athletic Conference team to play in the championship game since 2015 ... Cincinnati won a share of The American title in 2014, the year before the introduction of the conference championship game, while Tulsa will be looking for its first league title under The American's banner ... The schools tied for first place in The American's regular-season standings with 6-0 league records, but Cincinnati is serving as the host institution for Saturday's game based on a higher showing in the Dec. 8 College Football Playoff rankings ... Tulsa's undergraduate enrollment of 3,269 is the smallest of NCAA FBS programs, while Cincinnati has an enrollment of 46,338 ... This year's game marks the sixth time in as many years that The American Championship is carried live on ABC ... Tulsa has won eight of its last nine games dating to last season as the Golden Hurricane shook off an Opening Day loss to Oklahoma State to reel off six consecutive wins entering The American Championship ... Tulsa's six conference wins are the most for the Golden Hurricane as an American Athletic Conference member ... Tulsa is looking for its first conference title since 2012, when the Golden Hurricane topped UCF 33-27 in overtime in the Conference USA Championship Game ... Tulsa is playing in its fifth conference championship game and is looking for its third championship game victory ... Tulsa has come back from double-digit deficits to win four times in seven games this season ... Tulsa is ranked No. 20 in both national polls this week, marking the fifth straight week that Tulsa has been in the top 25 ... The last time that Tulsa was ranked in five consecutive polls was in 1945 ... The Golden Hurricane was picked ninth in The American's preseason media poll, while Tulsa defeated the teams picked first (UCF), fourth (SMU), fifth (Navy) and sixth (Tulane) in that poll ... Tulsa has been outscored 46-12 in the first quarter, but has outscored its opponents by a 182-92 margin the rest of the way ... LB Zaven Collins continues to establish himself as one of the nation's top players and a bona fide candidate for national postseason honors ... Cincinnati is making its second consecutive appearance in the American Athletic Conference Championship Game after the Bearcats fell to Memphis in last year's contest ... The Bearcats will be playing for the first time after a 28-day layoff that included an open week and two games canceled due to COVID-19 issues ... Cincinnati's last game was a 36-33 win at UCF Nov. 21 ... The Bearcats ended the home portion of their regular-season schedule having won 19 straight at Nippert Stadium ... Cincinnati is 8-0 for the fourth time in program history, joining the 1951, 1954 and 2009 Bearcats ... Saturday's game will be the latest date during a season for a game at Nippert Stadium, surpassing a Dec. 7, 1918, matchup against Xavier ... Cincinnati is ranked No. 6 in the national polls, but have fallen to No. 9 in the CFP rankings during the layoff ... The Bearcats had a school-record 17 all-conference players this season ... Leading the way was QB Desmond Ridder, who was chosen as The American's Offensive Player of the Year ... Ridder has thrown for 1,821 yards and 16 touchdowns and has rushed for 526 yards and a team-high 11 TDs ... Ridder has passed for 1,224 yards and 10 touchdowns and has 455 rushing yards with 11 more TDs in the last five games, becoming the first player since Lamar Jackson in 2018 to enjoy a similar five-game stretch ... RB Gerrid Doaks has a team-high 660 rushing yards with seven touchdowns ... TE Josh Whyte leads the team with five touchdown receptions ... Cincinnati's defense ranks fourth nationally in scoring defense (15.0 ppg), second in pass efficiency defense (94.74) and 10th in total defense (308.1 ypg) ... Three members of the Bearcat secondary were chosen as first team all-conference selections as CB Ahmad Gardner, CB Coby Bryant and S James Wiggins earned the honor ... Gardner and Bryant both have three interceptions and nine passes defended in 2020 ... LB Jarell White is second in The American with 8.5 tackles per game on 68 stops in eight games ... Cincinnati quarterback Desmond Ridder and Tulsa linebacker Zaven Collins, who will be on opposing sides Saturday in the American Athletic Conference Championship Game, have been chosen as The American's Offensive and Defensive Players of the Year, respectively, by the league's 11 head coaches.

SMU kicker Chris Naggar was named The American's Special Teams Player of the Year. A pair of freshman running backs – East Carolina's Rahjai Harris and SMU's Ulysses Bentley IV – were chosen as the conference's Rookies of the Year. Cincinnati head coach Luke Fickell was tabbed by his counterparts as The American's Coach of the Year.

Ridder, who is a semifinalist for the Maxwell Award as the nation's most outstanding player, has been instrumental in Cincinnati's 8-0 record. He has passed for 1,821 yards and 16 touchdowns while rushing for 526 yards and 11 TDs, engineering an offense that averages 40.9 points and 473.1 yards per game. He has accounted for 21 touchdowns in the Bearcats' last five games, throwing 10 touchdown passes and rushing for 11 scores. Ridder, who was The American Rookie of the Year in 2018, is the first Cincinnati player to be chosen as the conference's Offensive Player of the Year.

Collins was unanimously chosen as The American Defensive Player of the Year, becoming the first player in league history to earn unanimous player-of-the-year honors. A finalist for the Bronko Nagurski Trophy as the nation's top defensive player and for the Butkus Award as the top linebacker, Collins has registered 51 tackles, 11.5 tackles for loss, four sacks and four interceptions, including two that were returned for touchdowns. Two of Collins' four interceptions clinched wins for Tulsa, including a highlight-reel 96-yard pick six against Tulane in an overtime victory. He is the first player from Tulsa to be named as the conference's Defensive Player of the Year.

Naggar is a semifinalist for the Lou Groza Collegiate Place-Kicker Award and is the first SMU player to be selected as The American's Special Teams Player of the Year. Naggar leads the conference in scoring in 2020, averaging 9.4 points per game, and has made a league-leading 17 field goals in 21 attempts. He hit game-winning field goals in back-to-back weeks for the Mustangs in victories against Memphis and Tulane to help SMU to a 5-0 start.

Harris and Bentley were named The American's Rookies of the Year after they made immediate impacts on their respective teams' backfields. Harris rushed for 624 yards and four touchdowns in eight games, averaging 4.9 yards per carry and ranking third in The American in rushing as a true freshman (78.0 ypg). Bentley, a red-shirt freshman, led The American with 913 rushing yards and 11 touchdowns in 10 games and topped the conference with 91.3 yards per game. Both players were chosen to The American's all-conference first team.

Fickell was named as The American Coach of the Year for the second time in three seasons. Fickell takes his 8-0 Cincinnati squad into Saturday's American Athletic Conference Championship Game with a national ranking of No. 6 in the Associated Press and USA Today polls. The Bearcats have won their eight games by an average of 25.9 points against a schedule that included two top-25 opponents.

COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a big success. Fans, including many who are new to the sport, enjoy it. The first College Football Playoff semifinals and national championship were the three most-viewed programs in cable television history.

Every Game Counts

The playoff preserves the excitement and significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

Four Teams

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

Two Games, One Goal

The kickoff of the new year belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl and Sugar Bowl. The two teams winning the playoff semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. That game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

Selection Committee

A talented group of high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are: Gary Barta (chair), Paola Boivin, Tom Burman, Joe Castiglione, Rick George, Ken Hatfield, Ronnie Lott, Terry Mohajir, Ray Odierno, R.C. Sillocum, Todd Stansbury, Scott Stricklin and John Urschel.

Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

The American And Bowl Season

American Athletic Conference teams are guaranteed at least seven bowl appearances annually as part of the conference's new postseason lineup, which begins with the 2020 season and is in place through 2025..

The American, as it has done three times in the first five years of the current bowl cycle, will continue to send its champion to a New Year's Six bowl if that team finishes higher than the champions of four other conferences in the final College Football Playoff rankings. American Athletic Conference teams are also eligible for the College Football Playoff if they are among the top four teams in the final CFP rankings.

As part of the new bowl cycle, The American will annually send teams to the Military Bowl presented by Perspecta against an Atlantic Coast Conference opponent, the Fenway Bowl in Boston, also against an ACC team, and a third annual spot which will alternate between the Lockheed Martin Armed Forces Bowl and the SoFi Hawaii Bowl.

Additionally, The American will annually have four appearances in a group of eight bowls. The American has extended its existing partnerships with the TicketSmarter Birmingham Bowl, the Gasparilla Bowl, the RoofClaim.com Boca Raton Bowl, the Tropical Smoothie Cafe Frisco Bowl and the Cure Bowl.

New to The American's lineup are the SERVPRO First Responder Bowl and the Myrtle Beach Bowl.

THE AMERICAN ON TELEVISION

The American and ESPN reached agreement on a 12-year media rights extension that begins with the 2020-21 academic year.

With the new agreement, The American will have a stronger and more extensive presence on ESPN's primary TV networks - ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU. The Conference will also be a valuable part of ESPN+, ESPN's industry-leading direct-to-consumer sports streaming service.

In football, a minimum of 40 regular-season telecasts per season will be televised on ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU, including at least 20 across ABC, ESPN and ESPN2, which represents increased annual exposure across those ESPN networks. The American Championship game will be televised each year on ABC or ESPN.

Beyond select Navy football games, all conference controlled football games from The American will air on an ESPN network or ESPN+.
