The Game:

• The University of Cincinnati men's soccer team will travel down I-71 to take on longtime rival No. 10/9 Louisville on Wednesday evening at Cardinal Park at 7 p.m.

Series History:

- Cincinnati leads the all-time series, its second-longest behind the crosstown rivalry with Xavier.
- UC holds a 21-13-2 advantage, but Louisville has won each of the last four meetings.
- UC's 4-3 overtime win against the Cardinals in 2005 was the first BIG EAST victory for any UC program.
- The series is tied 9-9-0 in Lousiville.

Story Lines:

- The Bearcats have started five true freshmen and a first-year transfer this season.
- Freshman Cole DeNormandie and junior college transfer Leon Powell have combined to score seven of UC's 16 goals this season. Newcomers have accounted for 11 goals in 2011.
- Nine different players have accounted for goals this season for UC.
- UC's win against SIU Edwardsville snapped a five-match winless streak and was the 90th win at Cincinnati for head coach Hylton Dayes.
- UC and crosstown rival Xavier played to a 1-1 draw on Sept. 28 in Gettler Stadium, extending the Bearcats' unbeaten streak against XU at home to 14 matches (11-0-3).
- The Bearcats' seven combined goals against Central Arkansas and IUPUI are the most since scoring seven in back-to-back contests against Canisius (5-0) and Wright State (2-0) on Sept. 4 and Sept. 6 of 2009, respectively.
- Head coach Hylton Dayes is in his 11th season at Cincinnati and 22nd as a head coach. Dayes holds an 90-85-30 mark at UC and a 186-170-49 overall record.
- Dayes is the second winningest coach in UC history behind only Bob Muro, who posted a 114-111-13 mark in 12 seasons on the Bearcats sideline.

2011 MEN'S SOCCER NOTES

- Junior goalkeeper Joey Barnard has allowed 15 goals in 12 matches, posting his first career shutout in UC's home opener against Central Arkansas. He has made 42 saves and holds a .737 save percentage.
- Junior midfielder Shamar Shelton scored the game-tying goal and assisted on another in UC's 3-1 season-opening win at Western Michigan.
- Senior defender Sam Klosterman scored the game-winner at Western Michigan from the penalty spot and was named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll for his efforts.
- Freshman midfielder Emmanuel Appiah tallied his first career goal in the second half at Virginia Tech in the Hilton Garden Inn Invitational.
- Freshman Will Diebold scored his first career goal against Oakland, giving the Bearcats a lead in the 67th minute.
- Freshman Matt Remaley scored his second career goal, the game-winner, against SIU Edwardsville in the 36th minute.
- Junior Mike Brizzi scored his first career goal late in the first half to give UC a 1-0 lead at Rutgers.
- In 2010, UC posted a 7-5-7 overall mark, including a 5-1-3 ledger in BIG EAST play and a second-place BIG EAST Red Division finish. The Bearcats advanced to the BIG EAST Championship semifinals for the first time in program history.
- Returning to the roster this season are second-team all-BIG EAST midfielder Matt Bahner and all-Ohio selection Roger Thompson, both currently sidelined with injury.
- The Bearcats look to replace a starting forward, two starting midfielders, a starting defender, and a third-team all-conference goalkeeper from a season ago.
- UC welcomes a class of 14 newcomers in 2011, a recruiting class ranked No. 28 in the nation by *CollegeSoccerNews.com*.

BIG EAST/National Honors:

- Cole DeNormandie was named the BIG EAST Freshman of the Week on Sept. 12 after scoring three goals, including a pair of game-winners, in wins against Central Arkansas (Sept. 9) and IUPUI (Sept. 11).
- Senior defender Sam Klosterman and freshman midfielder Emmanuel Appiah were named to the Hilton Garden Inn Invitational all-tournament team following the weekend tourney in Blacksburg, Va., on Sept. 4.
- Senior captain Sam Klosterman was named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll after scoring the game-winner from the penalty spot in a 3-1 win at Western Michigan on August 27.

Last Time Out:

- Mike Brizzi scored his first goal of the season, but UC could not hold on to a 1-0 halftime lead in a 2-1 loss at Rutgers on Oct. 9 at Yurcak Field.
- The Bearcats (4-7-1, 0-3-0 BIG EAST) are winless in their first three BIG EAST matches for the first time since 2008, when they opened league play 0-2-1.
- For the second match in a row, Sam Klosterman used the throw-in to create a scoring chance for his side, earning the assist on Brizzi's first career goal in the 42nd minute. Klosterman, a senior captain, now has a pair of assists on the season to go with a goal.
- The Bearcats held the lead at half, but Rutgers (5-5-1, 2-1-0 BE) wasted little time leveling things. In the 53rd minutes, a dangerous cross in the box was misplayed and caromed off a Bearcats defender past Joey Barnard for an own goal and a tie game.
- The Scarlet Knights took the lead for good in the 67th minute on a combination at the top of the box, which resulted in Nate Bourdeau's second goal of the season.

Up Next:

• UC returns to Gettler Stadium, welcoming Villanova on Saturday, Oct. 15, at 7 p.m. The match is part of Homecoming Weekend on campus, with the annual homecoming football game being played on Saturday against Louisville at noon in Paul Brown Stadium.
