WEEKLY HONORS

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Desmond Ridder • Cincinnati • Jr. • QB • Louisville Ky.

Ridder was responsible for four touchdowns and had 402 yards of total offense to help Cincinnati remain unbeaten with a 55-17 win against East Carolina. Ridder completed 24 of 31 passes for a season-high 327 yards and three touchdowns (33, 45, 12) and added a team-high 75 rushing yards including a 7-yard TD. Ridder, who leads the Bearcats with 14 touchdown passes and nine rushing scores, has accounted for 17 touchdowns in the Bearcats' last four games.



DEFENSIVE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Jarell White • Cincinnati • Sr. • LB • Cincinnati, Ohio

White, who was also chosen as the Walter Camp National Defensive Player of the Week, led a Cincinnati defense that limited East Carolina to 17 points and 293 total yards in the Bearcats' 55-17 win. White had seven tackles, including a sack, and scored his first career touchdown on a 26-yard interception in the first quarter. White leads The American with 9.3 tackles per game this season.



Zaven Collins • Tulsa • Jr. • LB • Hominy, Okla.

Collins led a defensive effort that held SMU scoreless in the second half and without a touchdown in the final 44:58, allowing Tulsa to rally for a 28-24 win to keep the Golden Hurricane unbeaten in American Athletic Conference play. Collins had six tackles to go with a sack, two tackles for loss and the clinching interception with 1:29 left on SMU's final possession. Collins leads The American in interceptions per game (0.60) and has three picks and 10.0 tackles for loss in 2020.



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Marcus Jones • Houston • Jr. • CB/PR • Enterprise, Ala.

Jones had 145 yards on four punt returns, including a 72-yard return for a touchdown, in Houston's 56-21 win against USF. A transfer from Troy, where he was the 2017 Sun Belt Conference Freshman of the Year, Jones gave the Cougars a 35-0 lead early in the third quarter with his touchdown. His 145 yards ranks second on The American's single-game chart and moved Jones into fourth among NCAA FBS players with a 21.6-yard average on punt returns.

Completed 26 of 38 passes for 325 yards and three touchdowns in a 28-24 win against No. 19 SMU.

Defend This House

Cincinnati has won its last 19 games at Nippert Stadium, which is the fourth-longest home field winning streak nationally, while Memphis is fifth with 13 straight home wins. Clemson leads the nation at 27 straight home wins, followed by Notre Dame (23) and Ohio State (22).

Representing The Defense

Cincinnati ranks third nationally in scoring defense at 12.4 points allowed per game. The Bearcats are fourth nationally in pass efficiency defense (91.41) and 10th in total defense (300.9 ypg).

Pulling Rank

Cincinnati and Tulsa both have two wins against top-25 teams in 2020. The Golden Hurricane has defeated two top-25 opponents in the same season for the first time in program history.

Feels Like The First Time

Tulsa is off to a 4-0 start in conference play for the first time as a member of The American. Tulsa has won its last five conference games, dating to last season.

Conference Calls

On A Roll

Cincinnati has gone 31-5 since the start of the 2018 season. UCF is 40-6 since the beginning of the 2017 season. SMU is 17-5 and Memphis is 15-5 since the start of the 2019 campaign.

Moving The Chains

UCF leads the nation in total offense, averaging 619.1 yards per game, more than 25 yards better than North Texas, which is second at 593.6 ypg.

Air Travel

UCF is also the national leader in passing offense at $396.9\,$ yards per game.

Big Three

SMU QB Shane Buechele leads all NCAA FBS players with 2,781 passing yards in 2020. UCF QB Dillon Gabriel is fourth with 2,506 yards, while Memphis QB Brady White is 10th at 2,128 yards.

Taking Offense

UCF QB Dillon Gabriel is ranked second nationally in total offense at 411.4 yards per game, trailing only UCLA's Dorian Thompson-Robinson (412.0 ypg), who has played one game.

My Guy Or No Guy

UCF QB Dillon Gabriel has thrown 188 consecutive passes without an interception.

Career Day

SMU QB Shane Buechele is the NCAA FBS active career leader in passing yards (11,146). Memphis QB Brady White is third with 9,697 career yards.

Career Day II

East Carolina K Jake Verity leads all active FBS players with 73 career field goals.

Penetration

Tulane DE Patrick Johnson is fourth nationally with 11.5 tackles for loss in 2020. Green Wave LB Dorian Williams is sixth with 11.0 TFL.

Paper Or Plastic?

Tulane DE Patrick Johnson is the national FBS leader with 10.0 sacks.

Long Division

After playing five years as a 12-team, two-division conference, The American will feature 11 teams in a single-division format for the 2020 season. Each team is scheduled to play eight conference games this season. The top two teams in the final regular season standings will play in the 2020 American Athletic Conference Football Championship, which will take place Dec. 19 at the home stadium of the team with the best winning percentage in conference games.

Leadership

Tulsa OT Chris Paul is the chair of the American Athletic Conference Student-Athlete Advisory Committee and is one of 32 student-athletes nationally on the NCAA SAAC, which reports directly to the NCAA Division I Council.

2020 COLLEGE FOOTBALL RULES CHANGES

Players Numbering

No more than two squad members may be assigned or wear the same jersey number. There were no limits to duplicate numbers in previous seasons. With the recognized popularity of the single-digit numbers, the digit "0" is added as a legal number. Any number to be preceded by "0" such as "07" or "00" remains illegal.

Targeting - Disqualified Player

There were no changes to the targeting rule from an on-field officiating perspective and the rule continues to serve the game well and is changing player behavior in terms of use of the helmet. The change for 2020 is that now a player disqualified for targeting will be declared ineligible for further participation in the game, but the player may remain in the team area.

All other disqualifying fouls such as fighting, two unsportsmanlike conduct fouls, flagrant personal fouls, etc. will be reclassified as fouls requiring ejection. Players ejected will be required to leave the playing enclosure and must remain out of view of the field of play under team supervision.

Pregame Warmup /Officials' Jurisdiction

The Rules Committee address issues of unsportsmanlike behavior in the pregame and took steps to clean this action up. The officials' jurisdiction will now begin at 90 minutes before kickoff (previously 60 minutes). Additionally, when any squad member enters the playing enclosure prior to the game, the head coach or an assistant coach from that team must be present on the field. Furthermore, when any squad member is present within the playing enclosure after the officials' jurisdiction, they must be wearing their jersey or have their numeral readily visible. Players without their numeral readily visible must leave the playing enclosure.

Defensive Linemen on Scrimmage Kick Plays

To further enhance the protection of the snapper on scrimmage kicks, if the offense is in a scrimmage kick formation at the snap, any defensive player within one yard of the line of scrimmage must be aligned completely outside the frame of the body of the snapper at the snap. This change paired with the current rule that does not allow the defense to initiate contact with the snapper until one second has elapsed on these type plays will further protect the snapper on kick downs.

Instant Replay/Clock Adjustment and Review Time

If the clock expires at the end of a half, and replay determines that there was time remaining on the clock, and the clock would start on the referee's signal after review, there must be at least three seconds remaining when the ball should have been declared dead to restore time to the clock. With two seconds or one second remaining on the clock, the half is over. This change will not impact situations when the clock is stopped and will remain stopped until the snap such as incomplete passes and runners out of bounds. In addition, the expectation is that the instant replay official will not exceed two minutes to complete any review. The exception is if the review has end-of-game impact or has multiple aspects as a part of the review, it should be completed efficiently but will have no stated time limit.

Other Changes:

- A second jersey meeting all requirements of the jersey rule worn concurrently is allowed.
- The penalty for a team not complying with the jersey rule (i.e., legal and contrasting numbers or a colored jersey in violation of the rule) will be a 15-yard penalty after the kickoff of each half and the loss of a timeout in each quarter that illegal jerseys are worn.
- Defensive team substitution infractions will now be treated as a live ball foul.
- All fouls that have an option to carry over to the succeeding kickoff will also contain an option to carry over to the succeeding spot in extra periods.

Tulane has won three consecutive games after the Green Wave scored a 38-12 win against No. 25 Army last Saturday... The win against the Black Knights was Tulane's first against a top-25 team since the 1984 season ... Tulane has scored exactly 38 points in each of its last three victories... The Green Wave is averaging 36.7 points, which ranks 28th nationally ... QB Michael Pratt has started the last seven games and has thrown for 1,308 yards and 14 touchdowns against four interceptions ... COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a big success. Fans, including many who are new to the sport, enjoy it. The first College Football Playoff semifinals and national championship were the three most-viewed programs in cable television history.

Every Game Counts

The playoff preserves the excitement and significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

Four Teams

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

Two Games, One Goal

The kickoff of the new year belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl and Sugar Bowl. The two teams winning the playoff semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. That game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

Selection Committee

A talented group of high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are: Gary Barta (chair), Paola Boivin, Tom Burman, Joe Castiglione, Rick George, Ken Hatfield, Ronnie Lott, Terry Mohajir, Ray Odierno, R.C. Sllocum, Todd Stansbury, Scott Stricklin and John Urschel.

Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

BOWL PARTNERSHIPS

The American And Bowl Season

American Athletic Conference teams are guaranteed at least seven bowl appearances annually as part of the conference's new postseason lineup, which begins with the 2020 season and is in place through 2025...

The American, as it has done three times in the first five years of the current bowl cycle, will continue to send its champion to a New Year's Six bowl if that team finishes higher than the champions of four other conferences in the final College Football Playoff rankings. American Athletic Conference teams are also eligible for the College Football Playoff if they are among the top four teams in the final CFP rankings.

As part of the new bowl cycle, The American will annually send teams to the Military Bowl presented by Perspecta against an Atlantic Coast Conference opponent, the Fenway Bowl in Boston, also against an ACC team, and a third annual spot which will alternate between the Lockheed Martin Armed Forces Bowl and the SoFi Hawaii Bowl.

Additionally, The American will annually have four appearances in a group of eight bowls. The American has extended its existing partnerships with the TicketSmarter Birmingham Bowl, the Gasparilla Bowl, the Cheribundi Boca Raton Bowl, the Tropical Smoothie Cafe Frisco Bowl and the Cure Bowl.

New to The American's lineup are the SERVPRO First Responder Bowl and the Myrtle Beach Bowl.

THE AMERICAN ON TELEVISION

The American and ESPN reached agreement on a 12-year media rights extension that begins with the 2020-21 academic year.

With the new agreement, The American will have a stronger and more extensive presence on ESPN's primary TV networks – ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU. The Conference will also be a valuable part of ESPN+, ESPN's industry-leading direct-to-consumer sports streaming service.

In football, a minimum of 40 regular-season telecasts per season will be televised on ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU, including at least 20 across ABC, ESPN and ESPN2, which represents increased annual exposure across those ESPN networks. The American Championship game will be televised each year on ABC or ESPN.

Beyond select Navy football games, all conference controlled football games from The American will air on an ESPN network or ESPN+.
