## GAMEDAY INFORMATION

After winning eight games in nine chances, the University of Cincinnati baseball team is in the midst of a three-game losing streak after getting swept by Michigan State University over the weekend. Cincinnati (8-9) will play its first midweek games of the 2012 season on Tuesday and Wednesday. UC will travel to Indianapolis, Ind. on Tuesday to play the Butler University Bulldogs (10-10) at 3 p.m. Bearcats freshman right-handed pitcher Bryan Chenoweth is expected to make his first collegiate state for UC after pitching in four games out of the bullpen. His counterpart will be Butler freshman RHP Kyle Allen, who will also be making his first start. The Bearcats-Bulldogs game can be heard live on ButlerSports.com. Following the Butler game, UC will face No. 16 University of Kentucky at 4 p.m. Wednesday at Marge Schott Stadium, with UC's starter TBA. The Bearcats will try to be the first team to top the Wildcats, who have started the season with a school record 21-game winning streak and are the last remaining unbeaten team in NCAA Division I baseball. The UK-Cincinnati game can be heard live on Real Talk 1160 (WQRT-AM) or RealTalk1160.com, and can be viewed live on GoBEARCATS.com.

**SETTING THE SCENE**

- ▶ After winning eight of nine ballgames, UC was swept in a three-game series by Michigan State University, Friday through Sunday at Marge Schott Stadium.
- ▶ In the series opener, junior center fielder Jake Proctor hit his second homer of the season. Trailing 4-2 in the top of the eighth, Cincinnati (8-6) had a great opportunity to tie or take the lead, but could only muster one run. Proctor led off the eighth with his second home run of the season after crushing a 3-2 pitch over the left-field wall that landed into Sheakley Lawn that made the score 4-3.
- ▶ On Saturday, UC freshman lefty Zach Morris pitched his second straight quality start, allowing three runs in six innings. The Bearcats rallied for two runs to force extra innings trailing 4-2 in the ninth inning, but ultimately fell 5-4 in a 14-inning marathon.
- ▶ In the series finale on Sunday, sophomore right fielder Justin Glass went 4 for 4 and freshman designated hitter Taylor Schmidt went 3 for 3, but UC dropped a 9-4 decision to Michigan State, which tagged the Bearcats pitching staff for 16 hits, four walks and two hit batsmen.

**ON THE MOUND FOR THE BEARCATS**

- ▶ Freshman right-handed pitcher Bryan Chenoweth will make his first start of his collegiate career on Tuesday against Butler. In four appearances out of the bullpen this season, Chenoweth owns a 2-1 win-loss record and a 7.50 ERA with five walks and one strikeout in six innings pitched.
- ▶ Wednesday's starter for the Bearcats against Kentucky is to be announced.

**SCOUTING BUTLER**

- ▶ Butler was picked to finish fifth out of 10 Horizon League baseball teams in 2012 by the conference coaches.
- ▶ In 2011 Butler went 23-28-1 overall and 11-14-1 in league play.
- ▶ Butler leads the Horizon League in home runs (11), RBIs (99) and runs scored (113), and is ranked fourth in batting average at .269.
- ▶ Junior outfielder Pat Gelwicks ranks first in the Horizon League in runs scored (15) and fourth in batting average (.403).
- ▶ Junior first baseman Jimmy Risi is second in the conference rankings in home runs (4) and RBIs (17).

**SCOUTING KENTUCKY**

- ▶ Kentucky was picked to finish 2012 fifth in the Eastern Division of the Southeastern Conference standings after the Wildcats placed fifth with an 8-22 league record in 2011.
- ▶ Kentucky was unranked in the preseason polls, but after a school-record 21-0 start to the 2012 season,

UK is now ranked No. 13 in the March 19, 2012 NCBWA poll.

- ▶ The Wildcats lead the SEC in batting average (.333), runs scored (172) and doubles (47). They also rank second in home runs (21) and fifth in stolen bases (24).
- ▶ Junior outfielder Zac Zellers ranks sixth in the league with a .393 batting average.
- ▶ Freshman outfielder Austin Cousino is second in the conference in base hits (34) and tied forth in runs scored (22) and doubles (9).
- ▶ UK pitching is limiting opponents to a .238 batting average and averages 9.52 strikeouts per 9 innings pitched.

**BIELEK ON A ROLL**

- ▶ Freshman third baseman Joey Bielek is currently on a 12-game hitting streak that began Feb. 26 vs. UMBC at the Wake Forest Invitational in Winston-Salem, N.C.
- ▶ During the streak, Bielek is hitting .415 (22 of 53) with 13 RBIs and .429 on-base and .547 slugging percentages.
- ▶ Twice during the streak, Bielek has recorded a 4-for-5 outing: Game 1 of a March 3 doubleheader vs. Oakland; and the second game of a doubleheader on March 10 vs. Chicago State.

**MR. 400**

- ▶ UC baseball head coach Brian Cleary earned career win No. 400 after the Bearcats defeated Chicago State 6-0 in the first game of a March 10th doubleheader.
- ▶ Heading into the midweek vs. Butler and Kentucky, Cleary has 402 career wins, which are two away from tying UC hall-of-famer Glenn Sample's all-time UC mark of 404 career victories.
- ▶ Sample coached the Bearcats baseball team for 21 seasons from 1961-1981.

**SHOWING THE GLOVE**

- ▶ Cincinnati ranks third in the BIG EAST Conference with a .973 fielding percentage as a team.
- ▶ UC's 18 fielding errors are tied for the fewest of any team in the BIG EAST.
- ▶ The Bearcats lead the conference in fewest stolen bases allowed (12) and most runners caught stealing (12).
- ▶ Senior catcher Jake Saylor is tied for first in the conference with a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage in 119 chances.
- ▶ Saylor has thrown out eight base runners this season, which ranks first in the BIG EAST.

**LOOK WHO'S BACK**

- ▶ Cincinnati returns 19 letterwinners from 2011, including seven of eight position players from a UC team that went 30-27 and finished fourth in the BIG

- ▶ UC returns 68.5 percent of its home runs from last year, led by 1B Nic Spence's six and OF/C Braden Kline's five.
- ▶ The Bearcats also return 63.4 percent of its RBI from 2011, led by Justin Glass' 45 and Braden Kline's 31.

**THREE 'CATS EARN PRESEASON HONORS**

- ▶ So. OF/Justin Glass, Sr. OF/C Braden Kline and Jr. OF Jake Proctor were all named 2012 preseason All-Buckeye State baseball honorees by FOX Sports Ohio.
- ▶ Last season, Glass batted .326 with four home runs and 45 RBI in 57 games on his way to being named a second-team All-BIG EAST Conference honoree, as well as a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American. Additionally, the 6-foot-2 left-handed slugger was named to the 2011 BIG EAST/Big Ten Challenge All-Tournament Team and was the MVP of '11 Joe Nuxhall Classic during his freshman campaign
- ▶ Kline hit .326 with five home runs and 31 RBI after moving from catcher to the outfield last year, and was named a third-team all-conference choice. The 6-foot-1 power hitter finished the season in the BIG EAST top 10 in home runs (5 - 16th) and hitting (.356 - ninth) during league play.
- ▶ After starting 56 of 57 games in the outfield in 2011, Proctor ended the season with a .286 batting average with a team-best 51 runs scored, 30 RBI and three home runs. In 23 attempts, the 6-foot-2 speedster led the Bearcats with 21 stolen bases, which were just three shy of cracking the UC all-time single-season top 10.
- ▶ Glass and Kline each now have two preseason honors to their names after both were named 2012 Preseason All-BIG EAST selections by College Sports Madness.

**UC PICKED SEVENTH IN BIG EAST PRESEASON POLL**

- ▶ For the second consecutive year, the Bearcats were picked to finish in seventh in the BIG EAST Preseason Coaches Poll.
- ▶ St. John's was chosen as the favorite to take the 2012 title in the BIG EAST preseason coaches' poll.

**GLASS NAMED 2011 FRESHMAN ALL-AMERICAN**

- ▶ Justin Glass was named to the Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American team on June 8, 2011; the second year in a row a Bearcat earned the honor.
- ▶ Glass started all 57 games for UC as the designated hitter and finished second on the team with a .326 batting average with four home runs, 45 RBI and nine stolen bases. Glass is the seventh freshman all-American recipient in UC history.
- ▶ In 2010, right-hander Andrew Strenge was named a Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America.

**UC SHOWS OFFENSIVE IMPROVEMENT DESPITE NEW NCAA REGULATIONS**

- ▶ The 2011 college baseball season marked the initial year of the NCAA's Batted Ball Coefficient of

- Restitution (BBCOR) bat standards. As designed, BBCOR bats greatly reduce offensive efficiency; however, the opposite was true for the UC offense
- ▶ The Bearcats increased their runs scored per game from 4.9 in 2010 to 5.6 in 2011. Comparatively across NCAA Division I baseball, scoring was down 1.35 runs per game per team from 2010.
- ▶ UC also raised its team batting average from .251 in 2010 to .285 in 2011, while nationally, team batting averages were down by .026 points from 2010.

**JENSEN CONTINUES UC'S MLB DRAFT STREAK**

- ▶ Senior right-handed pitcher Dan Jensen was selected in the 20th round (No. 625 overall) by the Cincinnati Reds in the 2011 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft.
- ▶ The 6-foot-8 hurler led the Bearcats with a 3.11 earned run average and 87 strikeouts while holding opponents to a .257 batting average in 89.2 innings pitched in 2011. His 56 strikeouts during BIG EAST play ranked third in the conference. With the Reds' drafting of Jensen, UC has now had at least one player selected in the MLB First-Year Player Draft in each of the past seven years.

**REWRITING THE RECORD BOOK**

- ▶ Two graduated Bearcats ended stellar careers following the conclusion of the 2011 baseball season.
- ▶ Senior shortstop Chris Peters finished his career playing in 225 games, which ranks fourth in the all-time UC career record book. Peters, who signed a free-agent contract with the Toronto Blue Jays in June of 2011, also ended his Bearcats career in the top 10 in at-bats - 827 (3rd), walks - 118 (4th), sacrifice hits - 18 (tied for 5th), stolen bases - 49 (6th), hits - 226 (7th), runs - 155 (8th) and doubles - 46 (9th).
- ▶ Senior outfielder Justin Riddell concluded his four-year playing career sitting in the UC top 10 in games played - 203 (7th), RBI - 141 (7th), total bases - 343 (8th), at-bats - 699 (8th) and hits - 217 (9th). Riddell's 67 RBI in 2011 ranks 6th on the all-time UC single-season record book.



**BEARCATS BASEBALL  
ON REAL TALK 1160 WQRT-AM**

The University of Cincinnati Department of Athletics reached an agreement with Steve Jarnicki Productions to broadcast 19 Bearcats baseball games on Real Talk 1160 (WQRT-AM) during the 2012 season.
