



Postgame Notes

Cincinnati at Kansas State

Nov. 23, 2024 | Bill Snyder Family Stadium

Team Notes

- Cincinnati's all-time record now stands at 667-614-50.
- The Bearcats have now lost three straight games vs. Kansas State and their lead in the all-time series falls to 4-3.
- Cincinnati had four captains pre-game: redshirt junior defensive tackle Dontay Corleone, redshirt senior safety Derrick Canteen, redshirt senior offensive lineman Gavin Gerhardt, and redshirt senior offensive lineman Luke Kandra.

Offensive Notes

- Redshirt sophomore quarterback Brendan Sorsby completed 21-of-39 passes for 200 yards and two touchdowns.
- Senior running back Corey Kiner rushed for 140 yards on 15 carries. It was his fifth 100-yard rushing game of the season and the 12th of his career. That ties him with Allen Harvin (1978-82) for sixth-most ever in program history.
- Kiner now has 1,043 rushing yards on the season, his second straight 1,000-yard campaign. He joins previous back-to-back 1,000-yard rushers in Mike Warren (2018-19), Isaiah Pead (2010-11), Reggie Taylor (1984-86) and James Bettis (1980-81). David Small also had two separate 1,000-yard seasons (1991, 1993).
- Kiner sits at 2,452 rushing yards for his career at UC, which ranks ninth all-time in school history. James Bettis (1978-81, 2,498 yards) ranks eighth.
- Redshirt junior wide receiver Tony Johnson caught a team-high eight balls for 52 yards and two touchdowns. He tied career-highs in receptions and TD catches.

Defensive Notes

- Redshirt sophomore star safety Antwan Peek Jr. Led UC with seven tackles
- Redshirt senior linebacker Jared Bartlett had 1.5 tackles for loss, giving him 11.5 on the season. That puts him at third in the Big 12 in TFLs.
- Freshman linebacker Simeon Coleman posted a season-best six tackles. His previous season-high was five tackles in the season opener vs. Towson on Aug. 31.

- Three Bearcats made their first career starts: redshirt sophomore cornerback Ormani Arnold, redshirt freshman linebacker Brian Simms III, and freshman linebacker Montay Weedon.
- Weedon is the fourth true freshman to start a game this season, following Jiquan Sanks, Gavin Grover, and Simeon Coleman. Three redshirt freshmen have started games this season including Simms, wide receiver Barry Jackson Jr., and defensive lineman Kamari Burns.

Special Teams Notes

- Senior kicker Nathan Hawks connected on a 42-yard field goal in the second quarter for UC's first points of the game. It was Hawks first field goal attempt from 40 yards or longer since the Arizona State game on Oct. 19.
