#### The Game:

• The University of Cincinnati men's soccer team will welcome No. 18/11 St. John's to Gettler Stadium for the regular season finale on Saturday, Oct. 29. The Bearcats and Red Storm will kick off at 7 p.m. with a senior day ceremony taking place prior to the match to honor D.J. Albert and Sam Klosterman.

#### **Series History:**

- St. John's leads the all-time series, 4-2-0.
- The Red Storm are 3-0-0 in Gettler Stadium with wins in 2005, 2007, and 2009.
- Last season, the Bearcats topped St. John's 2-0 in Queens, N.Y.

# **Story Lines:**

- The Bearcats have started five true freshmen and two first-year transfers this season.
- Freshman Cole DeNormandie and junior college transfer Leon Powell have combined to score nine of UC's 21 goals this season. Newcomers have accounted for 13 goals in 2011.
- Ten different players have accounted for goals this season for UC.
- DeNormandie is second in the BIG EAST in goals scored amongst freshmen with seven.
- UC's win against Villanova extended its unbeaten streak to seven straight against the Wildcats (6-0-1) since joining the BIG EAST in 2005.
- UC's win against SIU Edwardsville snapped a five-match winless streak and was the 90th win at Cincinnati for head coach Hylton Dayes.
- UC and crosstown rival Xavier played to a 1-1 draw on Sept. 28 in Gettler Stadium, extending the Bearcats' unbeaten streak against XU at home to 14 matches (11-0-3).
- The Bearcats' seven combined goals against Central Arkansas and IUPUI are the most since scoring seven in back-to-back contests against Canisius (5-0) and Wright State (2-0) on Sept. 4 and Sept. 6 of 2009, respectively.
- Head coach Hylton Dayes is in his 11th season at Cincinnati and 22nd as a head coach. Dayes holds an 91-89-30 mark at UC and a 187-173-49 overall record.

# **2011 MEN'S SOCCER NOTES**

- Dayes is the second-winningest coach in UC history behind only Bob Muro, who posted a 114-111-13 mark in 12 seasons on the Bearcats sideline.
- Redshirt freshman Taylor Hafling made his first career start in goal against Villanova, earning the win and making five saves.
- Junior midfielder Shamar Shelton scored the game-tying goal and assisted on another in UC's 3-1 season-opening win at Western Michigan.
- Senior defender Sam Klosterman scored the game-winner at Western Michigan from the penalty spot and was named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll for his efforts.
- Freshman midfielder Emmanuel Appiah tallied his first career goal in the second half at Virginia Tech in the Hilton Garden Inn Invitational.
- Freshman Will Diebold scored his first career goal against Oakland, giving the Bearcats a lead in the 67th minute.
- Freshman Matt Remaley scored his second career goal, the game-winner, against SIU Edwardsville in the 36th minute.
- Junior Mike Brizzi scored his first career goal late in the first half to give UC a 1-0 lead at Rutgers.
- Sophomore Michael Millay scored his first goal of the season on a header against DePaul. He added a second in the next contest at Syracuse.
- In 2010, UC posted a 7-5-7 overall mark, including a 5-1-3 ledger in BIG EAST play and a second-place BIG EAST Red Division finish. The Bearcats advanced to the BIG EAST Championship semifinals for the first time in program history.
- Returning to the roster this season are second-team all-BIG EAST midfielder Matt Bahner and all-Ohio selection Roger Thompson. Both have missed nearly the entire season due to injury (Thompson saw action in the season opener).
- The Bearcats look to replace a starting forward, two starting midfielders, a starting defender, and a third-team all-conference goalkeeper from a season ago.
- UC welcomes a class of 14 newcomers in 2011, a recruiting class ranked No. 28 in the nation by *CollegeSoccerNews.com*.

#### **BIG EAST/National Honors:**

- Cole DeNormandie was named the BIG EAST Freshman of the Week on Sept. 12 after scoring three goals, including a pair of game-winners, in wins against Central Arkansas (Sept. 9) and IUPUI (Sept. 11).
- Senior defender Sam Klosterman and freshman midfielder Emmanuel Appiah were named to the Hilton Garden Inn Invitational all-tournament team following the weekend tourney in Blacksburg, Va., on Sept. 4.
- Senior captain Sam Klosterman was named to the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll after scoring the game-winner from the penalty spot in a 3-1 win at Western Michigan on August 27.
- Four UC freshmen were named to the *TopDrawerSoccer.com* Top 100 Freshmen list on Oct. 28. Cole DeNormandie was No. 14 on the list, while Will Diebold (No. 69), Matt Remaley (No. 85), and Emmanuel Appiah (No. 95) were also recognized.

# **2011 MEN'S SOCCER NOTES**

#### **Last Time Out:**

- The University of Cincinnati men's soccer team dropped a 3-0 decision at No. 6/7 USF on Wednesday evening at the USF Soccer Stadium.
- Cincinnati (5-11-1, 1-7-0 BIG EAST) was eliminated from BIG EAST Conference tournament contention with the loss. UC has qualified for the BIG EAST Tournament in five of the seven seasons in which it has been affiliated with the league, missing only the 2009 and 2011 tourneys.
- USF (12-2-2, 7-0-1), which clinched the BIG EAST Red Division championship with the win, got a pair of goals from Dom Dwyer, who leads the BIG EAST with 16, a USF record.
- Dwyer started the scoring for the Bulls in the 10th minute off an assist from Ashani Fairclough.
- The Bearcats trailed, 1-0, at the half, despite outshooting the Bulls by a 6-2 count in the first 45 minutes.
- USF put in a pair of goals within minutes of each other early in the second half. In the 57th minute, Sebastien Thuriere scored his second goal of the season and Dwyer added his second of the day in the 58th minute to produce the final margin.
- UC has not won at USF since 1999 and is winless against the Bulls in the last three meetings (0-2-1).
