GAME STORYLINES

- $\sqrt{\text{Following a 55-24 season-}}$ opening win over Kent State, Pitt plays its first road game of the 2024 campaign at Cincin-
- $\sqrt{\text{The Panthers and Bearcats met}}$ annually as Big East foes from 2005-12. The series was revived in 2023 when Cincinnati defeated host Pitt, 27-21.
- √ Pitt holds an 8-5 series edge but has lost the last three encounters.
- $\sqrt{\text{Pat Narduzzi spent three years}}$ as defensive coordinator at Cincinnati (2004-06) under Coach Mark Dantonio, helping the Bearcats to a pair of bowl appearances.
- √ Pitt linebacker coach Ryan Manalac was a standout player at that same position for Cincinnati from 2005-08, compiling nearly 200 career tackles and helping the Bearcats to the 2008 Big East title.

- $\sqrt{\text{Pitt rolled up 570 yards last}}$ week, its highest single-game output since the 2021 ACC title season.
- $\sqrt{\text{Making his collegiate debut,}}$ redshirt freshman Eli Holstein threw for 336 yards and three touchdowns.
- $\sqrt{\text{Running back Desmond Reid}}$ an All-American at Western Carolina last year, compiled 234 all-purpose yards in his initial FBS game. Reid scored twice, including a dazzling 78yard punt return touchdown.
- $\sqrt{\text{Pitt collected five sacks and } 12}$ total tackles for loss against Kent State. The Panthers are 27-2 under Pat Narduzzi when they collect at least five sacks in a game.
- $\sqrt{\text{Pitt will play Big } 12 \text{ foes in}}$ consecutive weeks. In addition to Cincinnati, the Panthers host West Virginia for the "Backyard Brawl" on September 14.

**ACC champions

- √ The 2024 season marks Pat Narduzzi's 10th as Pitt's Chris Bickell '97 Head Football Coach. During his tenure, Narduzzi has led the Panthers to an ACC championship (2021) and two ACC Coastal Division titles (2018 and 2021).
- √ Narduzzi has compiled a 66-50 overall record. His 66 victories rank second alltime at Pitt, trailing only the legendary Jock Sutherland, who compiled 111 wins from 1924-38.
- $\sqrt{\text{From 2015-23}}$, Narduzzi directed Pitt to 43 victories in ACC play, the conference's second-highest win total during that span, trailing only Clemson (64).
- √ Over the 2021-22 seasons, Narduzzi directed the Panthers to a combined 20 wins. Pitt previously achieved 20 wins over a two-year span in 1981-82.
- $\sqrt{\mbox{In 2022}}$, Pitt finished 9-4, including a stirring 37-35 win over nationally ranked UCLA in the Sun Bowl.
- √ Pitt finished 2022 in the national Top 25 for the second consecutive season, placing No. 22 in both major polls. It marked the first time since 1979-83 that Pitt earned Top 25 finishes in back-to-back years.
- √ In 2021, Narduzzi led Pitt to one of the most accomplished seasons in school history. The Panthers' stormed to 11 victories—their most since 1981—and claimed their first outright conference title with a 45-21 triumph over Wake Forest in the ACC Championship Game.
- √ Pitt earned a No. 13 ranking in the final 2021 polls, its highest finish since 1982. Pitt placed No. 12 in the final College Football Playoff ratings, its highest ever.
- √ Narduzzi has coached nine first team All-Americans at Pitt. In 2022, defensive tackle Calijah Kancey earned unanimous All-America status, the Panthers' first unanimous pick since defensive tackle Aaron Donald in 2013.
- √ In 2021, quarterback Kenny Pickett won the Johnny Unitas Golden Arm Award (nation's top upperclassman quarterback) and was a Heisman Trophy finalist, wide receiver Jordan Addison won the Biletnikoff Award (nation's outstanding receiver) and specialist Cal Adomitis earned the Patrick Mannelly Award (nation's top long snapper).

- √ Under Narduzzi's watch, Pitt continues to produce high-level NFL prospects. Over the past four NFL drafts (2021-24), the Panthers' 17 picks are the second most of any ACC program (trailing only Clemson's 19.)
- √ Six Pitt products—Kancey, offensive tackle Carter Warren, running back Israel Abanikanda, linebacker SirVocea Dennis and safeties Erick Hallett II and Brandon Hill—were selected in the 2023 NFL Draft, the most in the ACC (tied with Clemson) and fifth most nationally.
- √ Kancey was drafted in the first round by the Tampa Bay Buccaneers, marking the second consecutive year Pitt produced a first-round pick. In the 2022 draft, quarterback Kenny Pickett was a first-round selection of the Pittsburgh Steelers—the first Pitt QB to be picked in the opening round since Dan Marino in 1983.
- √ Narduzzi's Panthers have a well-earned reputation as a dangerous opponent for highly ranked foes. In 2019, Pitt scored a 35-34 triumph over UCF, which visited Heinz Field riding a 27-game non-bowl winning streak. The winning touchdown—a gadget-play pass caught by quarterback Kenny Pickett—has been immortalized as the "Pitt Special."
- $\sqrt{\mbox{In 2017, Pitt closed the season with a}}$ 24-14 victory over No. 2 Miami, which entered the game undefeated and on the cusp of the College Football Playoff.
- √ In 2016, the Panthers defeated two teams that finished in the top 5 of the final CFP rankings. Pitt gave No. 2 Clemson—that year's national champion—its only loss (43-42) and kept No. 5 Penn State out of the playoff field by defeating the Nittany Lions, 42-39.
- √ Pitt has also thrived off the field under Narduzzi's watch. During the 2021-22 academic year, Pitt led all college football programs in community service hours.
- √ During Narduzzi's tenure, Pitt has two recipients of the Disney Spirit Award, presented to the most inspirational figure in college football: James Conner (2016) and Tre Tipton (2021). Additionally, Deslin Alexandre was honored as the Jason Witten Collegiate Man of the Year and the male collegiate recipient of the Coach Wooden Citizenship Cup for 2022.

- √ In 2020, Pitt earned an NCAA Public Recognition Award for achieving an Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranked in the top 10% of all football programs. The Panthers' multi-year 988 APR set a Pitt football program record and was 24 points higher than the national average.
- √ Narduzzi arrived at Pitt following eight highly successful years as the defensive coordinator at Michigan State under Mark Dantonio. The Spartans were the only team to rank in the nation's top 10 in total defense and rushing defense each season from 2011-14.
- √ Michigan State boasted the nation's top rushing defense in 2014, yielding just 88.5 yards per game. The Spartans finished with a No. 5 national ranking and 11-2 record following a 42-41 victory over Baylor in the Cotton Bowl.
- √ In 2013, Michigan State finished No. 3 in the country following a Big Ten title and 24-20 victory over No. 5 Stanford in the Rose Bowl. Narduzzi was named the 2013 recipient of the prestigious Broyles Award, annually presented to the country's top assistant coach.
- √ Narduzzi tutored an impressive list of decorated defensive players at Michigan State, including first team All-Americans in cornerback Darqueze Dennard, safety Kurtis Drummond, linebacker Greg Jones and defensive tackle Jerel Worthy.
- √ Dennard was a unanimous All-American in 2013, becoming the first Michigan State cornerback to earn that distinction. He also was the school's first winner of the Jim Thorpe Award, given annually to college football's top defensive back.
- √ Dennard was a first-round NFL Draft pick of the Cincinnati Bengals in 2014, the first Spartans defensive back taken in the initial round since 1961. In the 2015 draft, another Narduzzi pupil, Michigan State cornerback Trae Waynes, was a firstround pick of the Minnesota Vikings.
- √ Prior to Michigan State, Narduzzi spent three years (2004-06) as defensive coordinator under Dantonio at Cincinnati, helping the Bearcats to a pair of bowl invitations.

- √ In 2003, Narduzzi was the defensive coordinator at Miami of Ohio under the late Terry Hoeppner. The RedHawks stormed to a 13-1 record that season, capturing the Mid-American Conference (MAC) championship and defeating nationally ranked Louisville in the GMAC Bowl to finish No. 10 in the Associated Press poll.
- √ While quarterback Ben Roethlisberger headlined Miami's offense, Narduzzi's stout unit topped the MAC in rushing defense (19th nationally), scoring defense (22nd nationally) and pass efficiency defense (34th nationally).
- √ Narduzzi served as linebackers coach at Northern Illinois for three seasons (2000-02). NIU won a pair of MAC divisional titles during his tenure and in 2002 had the league's top rushing defense.
- √ From 1993-99, Narduzzi coached at his alma mater, Rhode Island, serving as the Rams' defensive coordinator his final two seasons. He began his coaching career at Miami of Ohio, working as a graduate assistant in 1990 and 1991, before earning his first full-time position as receivers coach for the 1992 season.
- √ Narduzzi was an All-Ohio performer at Youngstown's Ursuline High School, leading the Irish to the Steel Valley championship and state playoffs as a senior in 1984.
- √ Narduzzi was a starting linebacker under his father, the late Bill Narduzzi, as a freshman at Youngstown State in 1985 before transferring to Rhode Island, where he became a three-year starter for the Rams from 1987-89.
- √ Bill Narduzzi was head coach at YSU from 1975-85. He led the Penguins to two NCAA Division II playoff appearances, including the national championship game in 1979, and twice was named the Ohio Valley Conference Coach of the Year. One of Bill's first coaching posts was as a freshman line coach at Pitt in 1962.



SERIES NOTES

Pitt and Cincinnati renew ties for the 14th time overall and second year in a row...Pitt leads the overall series, 8-5...the Panthers won the initial seven games of the series, but enter the 2024 encounter having lost five of the past six, including a 27-21 setback in Pittsburgh last year... Pitt is 5-3 against the Bearcats in Pittsburgh and 3-2 on the road...the Panthers' last visit to Nippert Stadium was a 34-10 loss on Sept. 6, 2012... Pitt and Cincinnati were annual foes from 2005-12 when both schools were members of the Big East Conference...Pitt fell to the Bearcats in 2008 (28-21) and 2009 (45-44) with both games impacting the Big East's BCS berth...propelled by those victories, Cincinnati went on to win the Big East championship and play in the 2009 Orange Bowl and 2010 Sugar Bowl...the Panthers' last win in the series came on Dec. 4, 2010, a 28-10 decision in Nippert Stadium that secured a share of the Big East title for Pitt...but due to tiebreakers, the Panthers went to a non-BCS postseason destination in Birmingham's BBVA Compass Bowl.

Old Big East foes Pitt and Cincinnati renewed ties for the first time since 2012 as the visiting Bearcats (2-0) hung on for a 27-21 victory...the Panthers (1-1) struggled early and trailed 20-7 at the break... but Pitt rallied and nearly pulled off a 20-point comeback, holding the ball with a chance to take the lead late before turning it over on downs at the Cincinnati 39 with 4:10 remaining...the Bearcats would run out the clock for their third straight win over Pitt...Phil Jurkovec completed just 10-of-32 passes for the Panthers but threw three TDs, including a pair to Konata Mumpfield...Gavin Bartholomew's 16-yard touchdown catch with 11:53 left sparked hope of an epic rally by the Panthers but they ultimately could not take advantage...the Bearcats crucially outgained Pitt 216-83 on the ground...Pitt's Marquis Williams recorded the sixth interception of his career to set up the goahead chance that Pitt couldn't convert on its final drive...Cincinnati improved to 5-8 in the all-time series with the Panthers.

FITZGERALD GETS COLLEGE HALL CALL:

- $\sqrt{\,}$ One of the most breathtaking wide receivers ever, Larry Fitzgerald was elected to the College Football Hall of Fame 2024 Class, the National Football Foundation announced in January.
- $\sqrt{\mbox{Fitzgerald becomes the 25th man associated with Pitt to be}}$ elected to the College Football Hall of Fame.
- $\sqrt{\text{Pitt}}$ will honor Fitzgerald on Oct. 24 when the Panthers host Syracuse for an ESPN Thursday primetime telecast. He will receive his formal enshrinement at the 66th NFF Annual Awards Dinner on December 10 in Las Vegas.
- $\sqrt{}$ In only two collegiate seasons (2002-03), Fitzgerald totaled 161 catches for 2,677 yards (16.6 avg.) and a Pitt-record 34 receiving touchdowns in just 26 games.
- √ Fitzgerald caught a touchdown in an amazing 18 consecutive games to set an NCAA record. In total, he set or tied four NCAA marks, eight Big East Conference records and 11 Pitt marks.
- $\sqrt{\ }$ In 2003, he was a virtually unstoppable offensive weapon, compiling 92 catches for 1,672 yards (18.2 avg.) and 22 touchdowns. Fitzgerald led the nation in receiving yards per game (128.62 avg.) and TD catches.

Pitt opened the 2024 season with a resounding 55-24 victory over Kent State of the MAC...transfer redshirt freshman quarterback Eli Holstein impressed in his collegiate debut, completing 30-of-40 passes for 336 yards and three touchdowns...RB Desmond Reid (14 rushes, 145 yards, one TD), WR Kenny Johnson (seven receptions, 105 yards, one touchdown) and Holstein became the first trio of Panthers to have a 100-yard rushing game, 100-yard receiving game and 300yard passing game since Oct. 21, 2023 (at Wake Forest)...Pitt registered 570 total net yards on offense, its highest total since the 2021 ACC title season...the Panthers limited the Golden Flashes to 31 yards on the ground and 212 yards of total offense...during Narduzzi's tenure, Pitt has held an opponent under 250 yards 23 times and is 20-3 (.870) in those contests.
