Seeding scenarios:

UC win; GU, UND, USF all lose:

UC will be #3 seed since it holds the tiebreaker in a four-way tie at 12-6.

UC win; GU, UND win; USF lose:

UC will be #6 seed since it loses a tie at 12-6 with USF

UC win; GU, USF win; UND lose:

UC win; UND, USF win; GU lose:

UC will be #5 seed since it wins a tie at 12-6 with UND or GU.

UC win; GU win; UND, USF lose:

UC will be #6 seed since it loses a three-way tie at 12-6 with UND and USF

UC win; UND win; GU, USF lose:

UC will be #4 seed since it wins a three-way tie at 12-6 with GU and USF

UC win; USF win; GU, UND lose:

UC will be #4 seed since it wins a three-way tie at 12-6 with GU and UND

UC loss:

In all scenarios, a UC loss will result in a #6 seed. UC and UL could tie with 11-7 records, but UC defeated UL head-to-head.

UC, GU, UND, USF win:

UC will be #6 seed as only 12-6 finisher.
