DePaul Notes

- Won eight of its last 10 games... won 10 straight games at McGrath-Phillips Arena... streak dates back to Nov. 17 when the Blue Demons topped Howard.
- DePaul is looking for its first BIG EAST road game and first road victory since the Blue Demons topped Loyola 87-69 on Dec. 18.
- DePaul is coming off a 79-67 win over Providence on Jan. 19... against the Friars, Brittany Hrynko scored a season-best 23 points.
- Following DePaul's win over Providence, Chanise Jenkins was named the BIG EAST Freshman of the Week and Brittany Hrynko was named to the league's weekly honor roll.
- On Jan. 21, it was announced that Anna Martin will miss 1-3 weeks with a left knee injury.
- Harry leads the BIG EAST with 10.9 rebounds... averaging 1.6 rebounds more than any other BIG EAST player... season average ranked 20th in Division I (thru Jan. 20 games).
- On the season, Martin leads three Blue Demons in double-figures with 16.2 points per game which ranks seventh in the BIG EAST... Hrynko ranks 10th in the league with 15.3 points... Jasmine Penny is 14th with 14.8... DePaul is the only school in the league to have three players ranked in the top 15 in scoring.
- DePaul ranks third in the BIG EAST and fourth in DI with 19.2 assists per game... the guard trio of Hrynko, Jenkins and Martin have accounted for 269 of DePaul's 364 assists (73.9%)... Hrynko is second in the BIG EAST and 28th in DI with 5.6 assists per game... Jenkins is sixth (4.8) and Martin is ninth with 4.0 assists... DePaul is the only team to have three players ranked in the top 15 in assists... the trio boasts a 1.52 assist/turnover ratio
- DePaul has an assist on on 65.5% of its baskets... recorded 20 or more assists in 11 games this season
- In BIG EAST games, Hrynko leads the league with 6.8 assists per game

Cincinnati Notes

- Looking for its first BIG EAST Conference win... dropped its last four games... played its last two games on the road.
- Led by Dayeesha Hollins 16.4 points which ranks sixth in the BIG EAST.
- Tiffany Turner's .559 FG% ranks fourth in the BIG EAST.

Series Notes

- 37th all-time series meeting on Tuesday... Blue Demons lead the all-time series 24-12 and have won the last five games... series that dates back to 1986 and is tied eight apiece in contests played in Cincinnati.

• **Noting the Blue Demons:** DePaul is 719-408 (.638) all-time... the 2012-13 campaign is the 38th season of women's basketball at DePaul University... since the start of the 2003-04 season (315 games), the Blue Demons have held 65.4 percent of their opponents to less than 70 points (206-of-315)... in that span, DePaul is 175-32 (.845) when holding opponents to less than 70 points... in that same time span, DePaul has scored 70 or more points in 206 games... DePaul is 180-26 (.874) when scoring 70 plus points... in the last eight-plus seasons (284 games), the Blue Demons are 202-82 (.711)... in the last 80 home games against conference opponents, DePaul has posted 67 victories... over the last ten plus seasons (405 games), DePaul has scored at least 80 points in 136 games... the Blue Demons hold a 129-7 (.949) record in those games... in the same span, DePaul is 56-1, including 54 straight wins, when scoring at least 90 points.

• **It Could Happen:** Katherine Harry needs four points to tie for 26th on the all-time scoring list... Harry could play in her 123rd career game which would tie for the 11th... Harry needs one rebound to tie for fourth all-time with Debra Robinson (1,013).

• **Missing Martin:** DePaul will be without Anna Martin for 1-3 weeks after she injured her left knee against Providence on Jan. 19.

• **Home Cookin':** Through 13-plus seasons, McGrath-Phillips Arena - formerly known as the DePaul Athletic Center - has proven itself as one of the toughest venues in the nation. The Blue Demons have posted a 159-24 (.869) record in the arena's 183 games. There have been three perfect seasons at McGrath-Phillips Arena-- DePaul went 13-0 in 2002-03, 14-0 in 2004-05 and 17-0 in 2010-11. In its 38-plus seasons of women's basketball at DePaul, the Blue Demons have an all-time home court record of 424-109 (.795). Over 26 seasons at Alumni Hall, the women's basketball program won over 75 percent of its games with a 242-80 all-time record. At the Allstate Arena, the women's program has posted an all-time record of 23-5.

There have been 17 streaks of at least 10 straight home victories. The longest streak was a 33-game run that started on Dec. 19, 2003 with a 99-63 win over Alabama State and ended on Jan. 28, 2006 with an 84-75 defeat to #5/4 Connecticut on Jan. 28, 2006. Over the last 11 years at McGrath-Phillips Arena (155 games), the team is 138-17 (.890) at home with six losses to teams ranked in the top five. DePaul lost in overtime to #2/2 Tennessee on Dec. 17, 2003, before the Connecticut loss in Jan. 2006. Tennessee, ranked third in both polls, served DePaul its fifth defeat before the 77-76 loss to #1/1 Connecticut on Mar. 1, 2008 and to #3/3 UConn this season.

DePaul is currently on a 10-game McGrath-Phillips Arena winning streak which dates back to Nov. 17 win over Howard. During its current streak, the Blue Demons are averaging 85.3 points while holding opponents to just 69.2 points.

The Blue Demons have also posted 128 victories in the last 134 games over unranked opponents.

• **Taking Advantage from Beyond the Arc:** Since the start of the 2005-06 season (252 games), the club has knocked down 1,745 (6.95 per game) trifectas compared to just 1,254 (4.98 per game) for the opposition... DePaul has knocked down at least one 3-pointer in its last 112 games and has tallied a three-pointer in 518 of the last 521 games... this season, DePaul is averaging 7.7 triples per game (147) and knocked down a season-best 13 3-pointers against Oral Roberts and at Syracuse... DePaul has made 200 or more 3-pointers in 14 of its last 15 seasons, including a school-record (256) in 2011-12... the 2009-10 team tallied 163 to end DePaul's streak at 10 seasons.

• **Streaking:** Dating back to last season and in some cases, the last couple of seasons, the Blue Demons have put together various streaks.

• **"I am open":** DePaul ranks fourth in Division I (games through Jan. 20) with 19.2 assists per game... season-best 29 assists against Oral Roberts... dished out 20 or more assists in 11 games... Brittany Hrynko (106), Chanise Jenkins (91) and Anna Martin (72) have dished out 269 of DePaul's 364 assists (73.9 percent)... Jenkins dished out a career-best 10 assists against Oral Roberts... Martin's career-best nine assists came against Dayton... Hrynko recorded a career-best nine assists at Syracuse... Hrynko is second in the BIG EAST with 5.6 assists... Jenkins is sixth with 4.8 assists per game... Martin is ninth with 4.0... DePaul is only school to have three players ranked in the top 15 in assists... the trio of guards combines for a 1.52 assists/turnover ratio...

HEAD COACH DOUG BRUNO

In 1988, when Doug Bruno returned to lead the women's basketball program at his alma mater, he wanted the Blue Demons to become a national factor on the women's basketball scene. Beginning his 27th season in Lincoln Park in 2012-13 Bruno has led his alma mater's program to national status as one of the top women's programs in the country.

Coach Bruno has won more than 500 collegiate games, led DePaul to 17 NCAA Tournaments including Sweet Sixteen appearances in 2006 and 2011. His teams have also made four WNIT appearances, won four conference tournament championships and four regular-season titles. Bruno's squads have also spent numerous weeks in both the Associated Press and USA Today/ESPN Coaches Top 25 polls. In 2010-11 the Blue Demons posted the program's biggest win with an impressive, 91-71 victory over No. 3/2 Stanford at McGrath-Phillips Arena on Dec. 16, 2010. The Blue Demons followed its historic win over the Cardinal with five more wins over top 25 opponents during the 2010-11 season. Along with its signature wins in 2010-11, the Bruno era has produced wins over ninth-ranked USC ('92-93), sixth-ranked Vanderbilt ('95-96), third-ranked Louisiana Tech ('96-97) and eighth-ranked Notre Dame ('02-03). The 2007-08 campaign saw the Blue Demons go on road for a pair of memorable victories at 11th-ranked West Virginia and 16th-ranked Notre Dame. While the Blue Demons topped No. 10/6 Florida State on a neutral floor during the 2009-10 season.

Bruno and the Blue Demons' success have also come against some of the best the nation has to offer. Since 1988, DePaul has played 192 games against teams that were in the top 25 when they played the Blue Demons. In 2010-11, the Blue Demons posted the program's biggest win with an impressive, 91-71 victory over No. 3/2 Stanford at McGrath-Phillips Arena on Dec. 16, 2010. The Blue Demons followed its historic win over the Cardinal with five more wins over top 25 opponents during the 2010-11 season. Along with its signature wins in 2010-11, the Bruno era has produced wins over ninth-ranked USC ('92-93), sixth-ranked Vanderbilt ('95-96), third-ranked Louisiana Tech ('96-97) and eighth-ranked Notre Dame ('02-03). The 2007-08 campaign saw the Blue Demons go on road for a pair of memorable victories at 11th-ranked West Virginia and 16th-ranked Notre Dame. While the Blue Demons topped No. 10/6 Florida State on a neutral floor during the 2009-10 season.

Off the court, the success has also been bountiful. DePaul has boasted 177 players that have earned mention on conference academic honor rolls and Anne McDonald was named to the GTE/Academic All-American team in 1998-99. Since the 2002-03 season, 12 student-athletes have been named to the I-AAA Academic All-Americans, while Allie Quigley was named the I-AAA Scholar Athlete of the Year. With academic success a priority, the Blue Demons finished No. 3 in the WBCA Team Academic top 25 poll the last two seasons. The Blue Demons have been ranked in the WBCA poll eight times since the poll's inception in 1997, while the last four seasons the Blue Demons earned the BIG EAST Sport Excellence Award for having the highest cumulative GPA among the league's women's basketball teams.

Additionally, Coach Bruno recently completed a two-year term as President of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association, serves as a consultant to the WNBA's the Chicago Sky, and coached the U19 National Team to the FIBA World Championships gold medal in August 2006 and 2007. In September of 2009 Coach Bruno was asked to join the USA Basketball National Team staff as an assistant coach. Bruno helped lead the USA National Team to an Olympic Gold at the London Olympics along with a Gold at the 2010 FIBA World Championships.

BLUE DEMONS SET TO WELCOME FOUR IN 2013-14

Nov. 15 -- DePaul head women's basketball coach Doug Bruno announced on Wednesday that Jessica January, Antania Hayes, ShaKeya Graves and Meri Bennett-Swanson and have all signed a National Letter of Intent and will join the Blue Demon program for the 2013-14 season.

"I am really excited about this class," Bruno said after receiving all of four of the program's NLIs.

"Jill (Pizzotti), Candis (Blankson), Bart (Brooks), Lisa (Ryckbosch) and Ciara (Johnson) always do a great job recruiting, but in the world of recruiting you don't always see results."

"These recruits bring a high-level of talent and competitiveness to our program. This class includes three talented and athletics guards and one very skilled post player."

January is a three-sport athlete and helped her Richfield High School to the State Championship basketball game as a junior. Ranked No. 74 by HoopGurlz, January is a 5-9 combo guard who surpassed the 1,000 point mark as a sophomore and averaged 26.0 points as a junior. Quick on her feet, January won the 100m hurdles as freshman and brook a 16-year old Minnesota record with her time of 14.33. January repeated her title as a sophomore and took second as a junior.

"Jessica January has great total guard skills and really understands how to play basketball. She is also a great athlete," Bruno said of the Richfield, Minnesota native.

Hayes, is a 6-1 forward and is ranked No. 36 overall in the HoopGurlz rankings. As a junior, Hayes led Detroit's Martin Luther King High School to the quarterfinals of the Michigan State High School tournament. Last season, Hayes averaged 14 points, seven rebounds and six assists per game.

"Antania Hayes is an exceptional swing player and combines guard skills with the ability to run, defend and rebound," Bruno added.

Graves, a Michigan Crossover AAU teammate of Hayes, is a 5-9 guard from Inkster, Michigan. She is ranked the No. 46 in her position by HoopGurlz. A proficient 3-point shooter, Graves averages 19 points, eight assists and five rebounds at John Glenn High School.

"ShaKeya Graves is another athletic player who also possess the ability to shoot the three."

Bennett-Swanson helped Vernon Hills to the Illinois High School Association 3A Championship game. A two-time all-area selection, the 6-3 forward became Vernon Hills' all-time leading scorer as a junior and heads into her senior season with 1,039 career points and 518 career rebounds.

"Meri Bennett-Swanson has excellent post skills. Meri is a player we believe was under recruited and could develop into the sleeper of this 2013 recruiting class," Bruno added of his final signee.

DePaul's 2013 class has been ranked No. 13 by BlueStar Basketball and is No. 17 by the Collegiate Girls Basketball Report.
