ROAD WARRIORS

- Cincinnati caps its season-opening six-game road trip with games in the Palmetto State at Winthrop and Presbyterian.
- The six road games to open the year are the most in program history (five in 2012).
- UC's home schedule opens on Friday, March 14, when it hosts Coastal Carolina, before Iona visits on Sunday, March 16.

THE SERIES

- Cincinnati and Winthrop will be meeting for the first time.
- The Bearcats have won all three previous meetings with Presbyterian. UC took an 18-4 win in Cincinnati in 2010, a 20-16 victory in Clinton in 2012 and a 22-6 win last season at home.
- Among the returners for UC, Megan Bell led the way against the Blue Hose last season with five goals, while Taylor Young scored four times, Sarah Del Bene and Courtney Curtis each had a pair of goals, and Ashley Helmroth also found the back of the cage. Bell and Helmroth each added a pair of assists. Meg Gulmi made four saves to earn the win.

LAST WEEK

- Cincinnati dropped a 12-6 decision at Niagara.
- Courtney Curtis and Ashley Helmroth each scored twice for the Bearcats, while Kelsey Conway and Michelle Platz each had a single goal. Helmroth added two assists, while Megan Bell contributed on one goal.

BELL NAMED BIG EAST OFFENSIVE POTW

- Junior Megan Bell was named BIG EAST Offensive Player of the Week on Feb. 25 after scoring 10 points in games at Stetson and No. 7/5 Florida.
- Bell scored six times, while adding two assists, in UC's 17-5 win at Stetson. She also won a school-record 13 draw controls in the victory.

- The Parkton, Md., native then scored twice against the seventh-ranked Gators.
- It marked the second BIG EAST weekly award in Bell's career. She was named the league's Defensive Player of the Week on April 1, 2013.

BEARCATS AMONG BIG EAST LEADERS

- Megan Bell and Ashley Helmroth are both tied for 10th in the conference in points per game, averaging 3.00 per contest. Bell ranks 10th in the league in goals per game (2.25), while Helmroth is fifth in the league in assists per game (1.25). Bell is tied for the league lead in free position goals (1.00 per game), while Helmroth is tied for fourth in that category (0.75).
- Beyond scoring, Meg Gulmi ranks fifth in ground balls per contest at 2.50, while Bell is second in the league in draw controls, posting 5.00 per game.

OLIVER BRINGS HOME GOLD

- For the second time in her international career, UC head coach Gina Oliver helped Team USA win gold at the 2013 Federation of International Lacrosse (FIL) World Cup.
- Oliver, a defender, and the United States went 7-0 at the World Cup. The USA scored victories over England (17-7), Wales (19-2), Australia (18-9) and Canada (13-2) in pool play before downing England (21-8) and Canada (19-5) to capture gold.
- It marked the second World Cup gold for Oliver, who also helped the USA win it all in '09.

UC LACROSSE HISTORY

- Cincinnati lacrosse is in its seventh varsity season in 2014.
- The Bearcats are coming off their best season in program history in 2013, when Gina Oliver led them to a 7-9 record and their first BIG EAST Conference win in her first season leading the program.
