### OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### Davis Brin • Sr. • QB • Tulsa

Brin led Tulsa to a come-from-behind win against Northern Illinois with a career-high four touchdown passes in a 38-35 victory. Brin completed 19 of 32 passes for 322 yards and engineered a pair of fourth-quarter drives that put Tulsa ahead.

### DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### Derek Parish • Sr. • DE • Houston

Parish set a pair of American Athletic Conference records in a 33-30 overtime loss at Texas Tech as he finished with 4.5 sacks and 6.5 tackles for loss among his 11 total tackles. Parish also had a forced fumble against the Red Raiders.

### SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### De'Von Fox • RFr. • WR • Temple

Fox blocked three punts, finishing one shy of the NCAA single-game record, to help Temple to a 30-14 win against Lafayette. Two of his blocks led to Temple touchdowns on the ensuing drives, while his third was recovered in the end zone for a safety.

## Career Day

Six American Athletic Conference quarterbacks have eclipsed their respective career highs in passing yards through the first two weeks of the 2022 season. Tulsa QB Davis Brin threw for 460 yards – the most of any NCAA FBS player – against Wyoming. SMU QB Tanner Mordecai had 432 passing yards against North Texas. Cincinnati's Ben Bryant had 325 yards against No. 19 Arkansas. UCF QB John Rhys Plumlee had 308 passing yards against South Carolina State. Navy QB Tai Lavatai had 135 passing yards against Delaware. Tulane QB Michael Pratt had 318 yards in a win against Alcorn State.

## Out Of The Gate

Tulane is 2-0 for the first time since the 2002 season after a 52-0 win against Alcorn State.

## Zero Hour

The Green Wave's win against Alcorn State was its first shutout since a 56-0 victory against Louisiana-Lafayette Nov. 1, 1997..

## Expanding Horizons

SMU has won 14 consecutive regular-season nonconference games after the Mustangs' 45-16 win against Lamar last Saturday.

## Not Over 'Til It's Over

Tulsa has registered six come-from-behind wins since the start of the 2021 season after the Golden Hurricane's 38-35 win against Northern Illinois last Saturday.

## Titletown

Through the first two weeks of the season, American Athletic Conference teams have defeated two of the other nine FBS conference champions from 2021. Houston was a 37-35 overtime winner against UTSA (Conference USA) in Week 1, and Tulsa defeated Northern Illinois (MAC) 38-35 Saturday.

## We Must Defend This House

Cincinnati has won 28 consecutive games at Nippert Stadium, trailing only Clemson (32) for the nation's longest active home field winning streak. UCF has won 31 of its last 34 home games, while Memphis has gone 31-4 at home since 2017.

## Behind Enemy Lines

Houston DE Derek Parish set American Athletic Conference single-game records with 4.5 sacks and 6.5 tackles for loss in last Saturday's game against Texas Tech.

## Blocking Schemes

Temple WR De'Von Fox blocked three punts in the Owls' win against Lafayette last Saturday, finishing one shy of the NCAA single-game record.

## Consistency

Tulane QB Michael Pratt has thrown at least one touchdown pass in 22 of his 23 career games after his three-TD performance against Alcorn State.

## Trifecta

Tulsa had three 100-yard receivers in the same game for the first time in program history in the 40-37 double-OT loss at Wyoming in Week 1. WR Kylon Stokes (169 yards), WR Malachai Jones (103) and WR JuanCarlos Santana (102) all hit triple digits against the Cowboys.

## Point Production

SMU QB Tanner Mordecai set the American Athletic Conference's single-season record with 39 touchdown passes in 2021. Mordecai has six touchdown passes through two weeks of the 2022 season.

## One And Only ...

Cincinnati finished the 2021 regular season as the nation's only unbeaten team (13-0). The Bearcats' only loss in 2021 came to Alabama in the CFP Semifinals.

## ... But Not The Only One

The American Athletic Conference has had an undefeated team entering Bowl Season in four of the last five seasons (UCF in 2017 and 2018; Cincinnati in 2020 and 2021).

## Variety Show

The American Athletic Conference was the only Division I conference that had a team in the 2021 NCAA Men's Final Four (Houston) and in the 2021-22 College Football Playoff (Cincinnati).

## Guess Who's Back

Nine of The American's 11 teams return their regular starting quarterback from last season. The only teams in The American to not return their starting signal-caller are Cincinnati (Desmond Ridder) and South Florida (Timmy McClain).

## Draft Cards

The American matched its best showing in the NFL Draft with 19 players selected in 2022. Two American players – Cincinnati CB Ahmad Gardner at No. 4 and Tulsa OT Tyler Smith at No. 24 – were chosen in the first round, while The American had 10 players taken in the first two days of the draft, surpassing the league's previous high of six players.

## Magnificent Seven

Seven of The American's 11 teams were selected for Bowl Season in 2021. American Athletic Conference teams were 3-1 in bowl games that were played (three games were canceled)

## Mark Your Calendars

Cincinnati's selection to the CFP Semifinal at the Goodyear Cotton Bowl marked the seventh time in the nine-year history of The American that the league has had a team in a Bowl Championship Series or CFP New Year's Six bowl.

Cincinnati coach Luke Fickell was chosen as the 2021 national coach of the year by seven different organizations.

## 2022 MAJOR RULES CHANGES

### Targeting

In games that have instant replay, when a targeting foul occurs in the second half, the carryover penalty (of sitting out the first half of that player's next game) will be eligible for further appeal.

The process will begin with a conference submitting a request to the NCAA national coordinator of officials, who would review video of the play. If it is obvious that a player was incorrectly penalized for targeting, the call would be overturned, and the player would be cleared to play in the first half of the next game.

### Deceptive Actions

To address teams that are awarded an injury timeout through deceptive actions, panel members approved a reporting and investigation process. Schools and conferences will be able to report questionable scenarios to the national coordinator of officials, who will review and provide feedback to the conference for further action. Any penalties levied would be up to the conference office or school involved.

### Blocking Below The Waist

The panel approved a proposal to improve safety and simplify the rules governing blocking below the waist. The proposal will allow blocking below the waist only by linemen and stationary backs inside the tackle box. Outside the tackle box on scrimmage plays, blocking below the waist will be prohibited.

Analysis of available NCAA injury surveillance data indicates a decreasing knee injury trend that coincides with recent rules changes in this area

### Feet-First Slides

If a ball-carrier simulates a feet-first slide, officials will declare the runner down at that spot.

### Illegal Block or Contact (Fair Catch)

A player who has made a valid or invalid signal for a fair catch and does not touch the ball shall not block or foul an opponent during that down. The penalty is 10 yards from the spot of the foul on a free kick or 10 yards from the postscrimmage kick enforcement on a scrimmage kick. A personal foul committed in conjunction with the action would result in a 15-yard penalty, with flagrant offenders ejected or disqualified.

### Illegal Touching

The penalty for illegal touching a legal forward pass shall be five yards from the previous spot and a loss of down.

### Defensive Holding

Defensive Holding will remain a 10-yard penalty, but will always carry an automatic first down.

# COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF

## Every Game Counts

The College Football Playoff (CFP) is a postseason event to determine college football's national champion on the field, while emphasizing the significance of college football's unique regular season where every game counts.

## Rankings

The selection committee ranks the teams based on the members' evaluation of the teams' performance on the field, using conference championships won, strength of schedule, head-to-head results, and comparison of results against common opponents to decide among teams that are comparable.

## Tradition

The New Year's holiday period belongs to college football, with two semifinal games rotating annually among the Cotton Bowl, Fiesta Bowl, Orange Bowl, Peach Bowl, Rose Bowl Game and Sugar Bowl.

## Championship Monday

The two teams that win the Playoff Semifinals compete for the College Football Playoff National Championship. The national championship game is in a different city each year, always on a Monday night.

## Universal Access

Every FBS team has equal access to the College Football Playoff based on its performance. No team automatically qualifies.

## Governance

University presidents and chancellors from all 10 FBS conferences and Notre Dame serve on the CFP Board of Managers and govern the administrative operations, with commissioners (the Management Committee) managing the event. A small staff in the playoff office in Irving, Texas, carries out the detailed responsibilities.

## Selection Committee

A talented group of 13 high-integrity individuals with experience as coaches, student-athletes, college administrators and journalists, along with sitting athletics directors, comprise the selection committee. Members of the committee are Mitch Barnhart, Tom Burman, Boo Corrigan (chair), Rick George, Chet Gladchuk, Jim Grobe, Warde Manuel, Will Shields, Gene Taylor, Joe Taylor, John Urschel, Rod West and Kelly Whiteside.

## Selection Committee Responsibilities

- Rank the top 25 teams and assign the top four to semifinal sites.
- Assign teams to New Year's bowls
- Create competitive matchups
- Attempt to avoid rematches of regular-season games and repeat appearances
- Consider geography

## Participants In New Year's Bowls

Both participants in the Orange, Rose and Sugar Bowls are contracted outside the playoff arrangement (Big Ten and Pac-12 to Rose Bowl; SEC and Big 12 to Sugar Bowl; ACC to Orange Bowl against the highest ranked available team from the SEC, Big Ten and Notre Dame). If a conference champion qualifies for the playoff, then the bowl will choose a replacement from that conference. When those bowls host the semifinals and their contracted conference champions do not qualify, then the displaced champion(s) will play in one of the other New Year's bowls.

When not hosting semifinals, the Cotton, Fiesta and Peach Bowls will welcome displaced conference champions and the top-ranked champion from a non-contract conference. The highest-ranked available teams will fill any other berths. The selection committee will make the pairings.

# BOWL PARTNERSHIPS

## The American Bowl Lineup

American Athletic Conference teams are guaranteed at least seven bowl appearances annually as part of the conference's new postseason lineup, which began in the 2020 season and is in place through 2025..

The American, as it has done five times in the first seven years of the current bowl cycle, will continue to send its champion to a New Year's Six bowl if that team finishes higher than the champions of four other conferences in the final College Football Playoff rankings. American Athletic Conference teams are also eligible for the College Football Playoff if they are among the top four teams in the final CFP rankings.

As part of the current bowl cycle, The American will annually send teams to the Military Bowl presented by Peraton against an Atlantic Coast Conference opponent, the Fenway Bowl in Boston, also against an ACC team, and a third annual spot which will alternate between the Lockheed Martin Armed Forces Bowl and the SoFi Hawaii Bowl. The 2022 season will include the Radiance Technologies Independence Bowl among The American's guaranteed spots.

Additionally, The American will annually have regular appearances from a group of eight bowls. The American extended its existing partnerships with the TicketSmarter Birmingham Bowl, the Union Home Mortgage Gasparilla Bowl, the RoofClaim Boca Raton Bowl, the Tropical Smoothie Cafe Frisco Bowl and the Duluth Trading Cure Bowl.

New to The American's lineup in the current cycle are the SERVPRO First Responder Bowl, the New Mexico Bowl and the Myrtle Beach Bowl.

# THE AMERICAN ON TELEVISION

The American and ESPN reached agreement on a 12-year media rights extension that began with the 2020-21 academic year.

With the current agreement, The American has a stronger and more extensive presence on ESPN's primary TV networks – ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU – than at any point in its history. The Conference will also be a valuable part of ESPN+, ESPN's industry-leading direct-to-consumer sports streaming service.

In football, a minimum of 40 regular-season telecasts per season will be televised on ABC, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU, including at least 20 across ABC, ESPN and ESPN2, which represents increased annual exposure across those ESPN networks. The American Championship game will be televised each year on ABC or ESPN.

Beyond select Navy football games, all conference controlled football games from The American will air on an ESPN network or ESPN+.

## Annual Awards

The American Athletic Conference will name first and second all-conference teams, players of the year on offense, defense and special teams, rookie of the year and coach of the year.
