FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

UC won a first-round BIG EAST Tournament match, 2-0, at Providence for the first tournament win since joining the league in 2005. Defeating the Friars exacted a measure of revenge for the Bearcats as PC knocked UC out of the BIG EAST Tournament in each of the past two seasons.

HOME FIELD DOMINANCE


UC was dominant at Gettler Stadium in 2007, posting a 7-1-0 record and outscoring opponents, 17-3. Highlighted by 4-0 shutout victories against rival Xavier and BIG EAST foe Seton Hall, the Bearcats started the season 5-0-0 at home with a 12-1 goal differential. Following the lone home loss, a 2-0 setback against St. John's, UC topped Villanova and upset No. 11 Michigan State at Gettler Stadium. The Bearcats are 18-5-2 over the last three seasons at home.

POSTSEASON HONORS

Kenny Anaba was named to the all-BIG EAST first team, while Amir Ikner earned honorable mention all-BIG EAST honors. Anaba's first-team selection marked the third time in three years of affiliation with the BIG EAST that the Bearcats have had a player selected to the conference's first team. Anaba also earned NSCAA/adidas All-Region honors for the second straight season. Patrick Baxter was named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District IV team, holding a 3.62 grade point average.

ANABA CLIMBS THE CHARTS

Kenny Anaba finished his successful four-year career as the seventh-best goal scorer and eight-best point scorer in school history. Anaba's team-leading 10 goals in 2007 gave him 26 in his career, while his career-high 23 points pushed his scoring total to 65. Anaba was drafted by Real Salt Lake of Major League Soccer in the supplemental draft, becoming the fourth Bearcat to be drafted by an MLS club in the last five seasons.



CINCINNATI STATE CONNECTION

Patrick Baxter and Scott Stockum, both former Cincinnati State standouts, have made the transition to Division I soccer look easy. Baxter, a senior, was named BIG EAST Offensive Player of the Week and earned a spot on the *CollegeSoccerNews.com* National Team of the Week on Sept. 24 after scoring three goals and adding an assist in UC's weekend sweep of Georgetown and Seton Hall. Stockum, a junior, finished fifth on the team with seven points, posting two goals and three assists in 14 matches last season. The pair followed an all-time Bearcats great from Cincinnati State, Omar Cummings, who earned a pair of unanimous all-BIG EAST first-team honors and the first first-team all-America award in UC men's soccer history in 2006.

FRESH FACE IN GOAL

Freshman goalkeeper Miguel Rosales started all but the first match of the season in goal for the Bearcats, posting his first career shutout against Xavier on Sept. 13. A two-time Colorado Player of the Year as a prep star at Smoky Hill High School, Rosales has posted 72 saves, a 0.81 goals against average, and seven shutouts. He was named the BIG EAST Rookie of the Week on Sept. 24 and earned BIG EAST Goalkeeper of the Week accolades on Nov. 5. Rosales was especially hot late in the season, posting four straight shutouts in leading the Bearcats to four consecutive wins and a BIG EAST Tournament berth.



A HELPING HAND

Lionel Jackson posted a career-best eight assists during the 2007 season. The Bearcats' primary weapon on corner kicks and set pieces, the junior left back led the squad in helpers and ranked third in the BIG EAST.

CENTERS OF ATTENTION

UC's pair of center backs, senior Amir Ikner and junior Brad Simpson, formed one of the top defensive duos in the BIG EAST in 2007. Ikner, an all-BIG EAST selection, scored two goals - including the game winner against Villanova - and added an assist while Simpson finished fifth on the team with six points (1G, 4A). Simpson scored the goal in UC's 1-1 draw at No. 2 Notre Dame. The pair helped the Bearcats to four straight shutouts late in the season and eight total shutouts.

LUCK 'O THE IRISH

The Bearcats have played some of their best soccer against one of the BIG EAST's top programs, Notre Dame. Since joining the power conference in 2005, UC is 2-0-1 against the Irish. In 2005, UC topped the 18th-ranked Irish, 2-1, at Alumni Field. The Bearcats defeated No. 12 Notre Dame by the same score in 2006 and played the No. 2-ranked Irish to a 1-1 draw on the road in 2007.

YOUNG GUNS

Redshirt freshman Chris Thompson and true freshmen Mark Konitsch and Matt Telting provided a glimpse into the Bearcats future with their play in 2007. Each totaled four points on the season, with Telting - who started all 20 matches at the wide midfield position - finishing second on the team with four assists. Thompson and Konitsch scored for the first time in their careers and added a pair of assists each.
